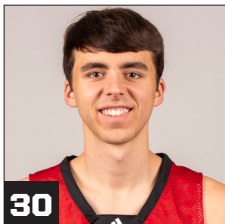

LAYOUT LINES

- » Arkansas State is set for its fifth nationally-televvised contest of the year on Tuesday, taking on High Point in the semifinals of the Ro CBI. Tip-off versus the top-seeded Panthers is slated for 6 p.m. CT on ESPN2 inside the Ocean Center in Daytona Beach, Fla. On the airwaves, the radio broadcast can be heard across the EAB Red Wolves Sports Network and the A-State Athletics mobile app.
- » A-State - one of just three Sun Belt teams in the postseason - is seeded 4th in the field of 15 teams, which features four other programs that made their conference championship games.
- » Head Coach **Bryan Hodgson** was named one of 16 finalists for the Joe B. Hall Award, presented annually to the top first-year head coach in Division I. He is one of four head coaches this season to guide their teams to the postseason in their first year as a bench boss.
- » Tuesday's matchup features a pair of those finalists, with High Point being led by Alan Huss. Hodgson and Huss are the only two first-year head coaches in with 20-plus Division-I wins in their first year this season.
- » The Red Wolves have won 20 or more games for just the seventh time in the program's 96-year history and has won 20 games over Division-I foes for just the fourth time ever and first since 1990-91.
- » A-State has one of five programs under a head coach in his first season at the helm to go from 20-plus losses to 20-plus wins (the others being McNeese, Bowling Green, UT Arlington and Ole Miss).
- » First Team All-Sun Belt and All-Tournament guard **Caleb Fields** earned NABC Second Team All-District 23 on Tuesday. Entering the CBI, he was tied for sixth nationally with six games of 10-plus assists. The rest of the Sun Belt has five combined.
- » Junior guard **Freddy Hicks** joined Fields on the SBC All-Tournament team after exploding for 22 points/game and 7.0 rebounds/game while shooting 62.9 percent from the field and 90.5 percent at the foul line. When Hicks plays 20 minutes or more, A-State is 9-1 on the year.
- » Junior guard **Taryn Todd** garnered Third Team All-SBC accolades and leads the team in scoring (12.5). He has scored in double figures a team-high 24 times this season.
- » A-State has scored 85 points or more 11 times this season, owning a 10-1 record when eclipsing the mark. The Red Wolves have surpassed 90 seven times - the most since 2001-01 (7).
- » Arkansas State boasts its most efficient offense in school history in the history of KenPom, ranking second in the conference with a rating of 113.5. In conference play, the Red Wolves upped that to a league-best 115.3. The Red Wolves have been as high as 129 in KenPom, the program's best since 2016-17 under Grant McCasland.
- » The Red Wolves rank among the top 30 in the country in offensive rebounding rate (34.5%) - third in the Sun Belt. They also rank 19th nationally in offensive rebounds per game, averaging 13.19 offensive boards per game.
- » **Izaiyah Nelson** is third in the Sun Belt Conference in blocked shots (72), ranking among the top 20 nationally.
- » This season's turnaround has not only occurred in the offensive numbers and win-loss record... A-State has also seen a significant jump in the NET rankings. The Red Wolves have been as high as 140 in the NET this season (the best since 2016-17) after finishing at 285 last season - over a 140-spot jump.

A WIN WOULD:

- » Improve Arkansas State's record to 21-16 on the year.
- » Advance the Red Wolves to the finals of the CBI.
- » Improve A-State's record to 4-0 all-time versus the Big South.
- » Be better than a loss.

A-STATE VERSUS THE BIG SOUTH

- » Arkansas State is facing an opponent from the Big South Conference for just the fourth time ever.
- » The Red Wolves are 3-0 all-time against the current Big South membership, with the last meeting coming on Nov. 24, 2018, in Asheville, N.C., against Gardner-Webb (W 77-69).

PAGING PRINCE...

- » Arkansas State's season did not end in the Sun Belt Conference tournament final, so Prince's line of "oops, out of time" in the hit "1999" is irrelevant.
- » The Red Wolves are still partying like it's 1999, though, with their in the CBI being the program's first postseason appearance since 1999 and just the third since 1990.
- » A-State has never played in the CBI, only making previous appearances in both the NIT and NCAA Tournament back in the late 80s and 90s.
- » Prior to Saturday's 86-85 win over Bethune-Cookman in the first round, it had been nearly 35 years between postseason victories for A-State. The then-Indians took down Memphis State in the second round of the 1991 NIT.

BREAKING DOWN THE CBI

- » The Ro College Basketball Invitational (CBI) has been a good launching pad for programs to take leaps the following year in the postseason picture, with several teams in previous years going from the CBI to the NIT or the NCAA Tournament in the next year or two.
- » This year's field features 10 squads which reached at least the semifinals of their respective conference tournaments, including five teams who made the championship game (A-State [SBC], Little Rock [OVC], Fairfield [MAAC], Montana [Big Sky] and Delaware State [MEAC]).
- » Eleven different conferences are represented, along with independent Chicago State.
- » Thirteen different states are represented in the field of 15, with two states (Arkansas and Connecticut) wielding two teams. In fact, the only two men's teams in the postseason from the Natural State will be playing in Daytona Beach.

HEATING UP AT THE RIGHT TIME

- » You want to start hitting your stride in late February and early March, and Arkansas State has done that to reach its first postseason tournament since the 1999 NCAA Tournament.
- » Since the start of February (14 games), A-State has won 11 contests. If you look back to Jan. 31, it's 12-3 over the last 15 games.
- » Over that 15-game stretch, A-State is averaging 79.5 points per game, while shooting 46.2 percent (34.3% from 3) and out-rebounding opponents by a +7.1 margin (38.7/31.6).
- » Freddy Hicks has played in 12 of those games, averaging a team-best 14.2 points and 6.7 rebounds.

- » Arkansas State eclipsed the 20-win threshold for just the seventh time in school history.
- » The Red Wolves forced 15 turnovers and out-rebounded the Grizzlies 42-31
- » Izaiyah Nelson recorded his seventh double-double of the year and led six Red Wolves in double figures.



GREAT FIRST IMPRESSION

- » Bryan Hodgson has begun to turn around the Arkansas State men's basketball program in his first season as a head coach, taking it to its first post-season tournament in 25 seasons.
- » Multiple offensive school records have also fallen in his first season, while he has led the Red Wolves to 20 Division-I wins - the most since 23 in 1990-91
- » Hodgson - a finalist for the Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year Award - signed a contract extension through the 2028-29 season on Thursday before A-State left Jonesboro for Daytona Beach.

THREE'S COMPANY

- » Make no mistake... when Arkansas State takes the court, there's a plethora of 3-pointers WILL be taken.
- » A whopping **43.1 percent** (966/2243) of the Red Wolves' field-goal attempts have come from deep. Of the team's total points, **35.1 percent** come from deep.
- » A-State has hit 10-plus 3-pointers in 16 games - the most since before 2010. The Red Wolves are one of just two Sun Belt teams to have hit 18 or more treys twice this year.
- » The Red Wolves' 332 3-pointers made this season is the most by a Sun Belt team since ULM hit 353 in 2018-19 and is 13th most nationally this season.
- » Individually, **Avery Felts** leads the way with 87.8 percent (166/189) of his field-goal tries emerging from beyond the arc. All but 34 of his points this season have come from deep.
- » **Derrian Ford** leads the way with 63 made treys, one ahead of Felts (62 3FGM), while Dyondre Dominguez has 60 to make A-State the lone Sun Belt squad to have three players with 60-plus 3-pointers made this season.
- » Defensively, the Red Wolves are one of the nation's best at locking down the perimeter, ranking third nationally with just 27.1 percent of opposing teams' field-goal attempts coming from 3.

FIELDS DAY

- » Fifth-year senior **Caleb Fields** is up to 671 assists for his career, ranking second in school history in helpers and fourth in Sun Belt history.
- » Fields is one of two players in Sun Belt history with at least 1500 points, 600 assists and 400 rebounds in a career, joining UT Arlington's Erick Neal (2015-18).
- » After playing in Saturday's first-round game, Fields is now the program's all-time leader in games played, appearing in 150 as a Red Wolf.
- » The Lewisburg, Tenn., native is one of five Division-I players to record multiple 20-point/10-assist outings, and one of five with a 20-point/13-assist performance.
- » Fields is the team's active scoring leader (6th all-time) with 1,609 points - one of six players in school history to amass 1,600 points, while also being the school's all-time leader in games started and free throws attempted. He is also second in career free throws made.
- » As of Monday, Fields stood 13th among the NCAA's active career leaders (all divisions) in assists (671) and 36th in assist/turnover ratio (1.99) among Division-I players. He is also ninth in free throws attempted (722) and 15th in free-throw makes (503).
- » This season, Fields leads the Sun Belt in both assists (195 - 22nd NCAA) and assists per game (5.7 - 26th), upping that average to 6.5 in league contests.

SHARE THE WEALTH

- » Arkansas State is one of the most unselfish teams in the Sun Belt, averaging 14.4 assists per game (4th SBC) and having an assist rate of 52.5 percent (3rd).
- » The Red Wolves have 15 or more assists in 16 games, including 20-plus five times this season - matching last year's total of five 20-dime games. The 16 games with 15-plus helpers is the most since 19 in 2021-22.
- » First-Team All-SBC guard **Caleb Fields** has been stellar as the Red Wolves' floor general, leading the Sun Belt Conference in assists (195) and assist average (5.7). In league play, he averaged 6.5 dimes per contest with a league-best assist/turnover ratio of 3.2. He is 22nd nationally in total assists and 25th in assists per game as of March 25.
- » The Red Wolves have had 12 games this season with an assist percentage of 60 percent or better.

- » If there was a "Most Improved Player" award in the Sun Belt, sophomore forward **Izaiyah Nelson** would be a prime candidate. See the chart below for a freshman-to-sophomore comparison.
- » He is already fourth in school history for career blocked shots, owning 116 blocks, passing A-State great John Tate (1986-89).
- » His 72 blocked shots this year currently rank 19th nationally and third in the Sun Belt. Nelson enters Tuesday's game ranked third in program history in a single season, passing career leader Freddy Hicks (63, 1998-99).

FAMILY TIES

- » Arkansas State's postseason appearance in the CBI will bear one resemblance to its last one 25 years ago, and that's the fact that a Freddy Hicks will have played in both.
- » Junior guard **Freddy Hicks**' father, also named Freddy, is Arkansas State's all-time blocks leader (204) and lettered for A-State from 1995-99. He anchored the post in the team's run to the 1999 NCAA Tournament.
- » The Searcy native scored in double figures in eight of his first 12 games of the season, including 16 at Louisville on Dec. 13, before going down to injury on Dec. 20 at Belmont.
- » Hicks has returned to early-season form and provided key buckets in A-State's late-season run. He has scored 12 or more in eight of the last 11 games, including 20-plus in three of the last four after 21 points against Bethune-Cookman on Saturday.
- » In the Sun Belt Tournament, Hicks averaged 22 points and 7 rebounds, shooting 62.9 percent and going 19-for-21 from the foul line en route to All-Tournament honors.
- » In the last 10 games in which he's played 20 or more minutes, the Red Wolves are 9-1.
- » Hicks is also no stranger to the CBI, having played in it last season for Tarleton State. In the Texans' lone game (an OT loss to Radford), Hicks went for 30 points and 11 rebounds while going 14-for-16 at the charity stripe.

FORD TOUGH

- » Sophomore guard **Derrian Ford** has shown this season why he was the two-time Gatorade Player of the Year in the state his last two years of high school.
- » The Magnolia, Ark., native enters Saturday having scored 10 or more 19 times this season, including 13 on a trio of treys on Monday against Montana.
- » Ford is also shooting the ball over or near 40 percent both overall (41.4%) and from deep (38.0%). In Sun Belt play, Ford shot 39.7 percent from the floor and 37.5 percent from 3, as well as a team-best 83.0 percent from the foul line as part of 11.5 points per game.

T-TODD PROVIDING A SPARK

- » Junior guard **Taryn Todd** has provided a key spark off the bench (and in several starting nods lately) for Arkansas State this season.
- » The Third Team All-Sun Belt pick leads the team in scoring (12.5) with a team-high 450 points scored on the year. He also has made a team-leading 170 field goals. Todd has been on a heater of late, scoring 10-plus in 12 of the last 14 games, as well as a team-leading 24 times on the year.
- » Before returning to the starting five, the Canadian averaged 10.6 points in games he entered off the bench, shooting 41.3 percent from the field.
- » Over the last 15 games, Todd is scoring 13.4 points per game while shooting 44.1 percent from the field and 39.0 percent from beyond the arc, while converting free throws at a 72.7-percent mark (24-33).

STILL D-R-E

- » **Dyondre Dominguez**, that is... He has scored nine or more points in 25 games this season, including double figures in 22 contests, to average 10.6 points.
- » On the glass, Dominguez ranks 10th in the Sun Belt Conference in total rebounds (209) and defensive rebounding (4.49) as of March 23.



FAST & FURIOUS (AND EFFICIENT)

- » Last season, Arkansas State ranked 344th nationally in pace, averaging 63.2 possessions per game.
- » This season has seen a drastic change in that area, with the Red Wolves averaging nearly 70 possessions.
- » Entering Tuesday's game, A-State is averaging 68.0 possessions per game. The Red Wolves have recorded 70 or more possessions in 18 games this year.
- » Despite the uptick in pace, the Red Wolves boast the league's most efficient offensive unit with a rating of 115.3 in Sun Belt Conference games. Their overall efficiency rating of 113.5 is the program's best in the history of KenPom, dating back to 1999.

- » The final five minutes of a game have been key for Arkansas State this season.
- » When leading with five minutes remaining in regulation, the Red Wolves are 20-2 on the year, while going 0-14 when tied or trailing at the under-5 mark.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

- » Points have not come at a premium for Arkansas State in the first year of the Bryan Hodgson era.
- » The Red Wolves dropped 85 or more in six league games (90+ in 5 games) to average a conference-leading 81.1 points in SBC play. It was the first time ever an A-State team eclipsed 85 points six or more times since conference affiliation began in 1964-65.
- » The Scarlet and Black also scored 75-plus in 14 of 18 conference games, the most since doing so 14 times in 1997-98.
- » This season has seen the Red Wolves eclipse the 90-point threshold seven times this season - the most since 2001-02 (7) - including three 100-point efforts for the first time since 2002-03.

- » The 2023-24 campaign marks the 96th season of Arkansas State basketball.
- » The Red Wolves have compiled a 1,284-1,242 (.508) all-time record dating back to the inaugural 1926-27 season.

SECURE(D) THE BANK

- » Home-court advantage is a huge deal, and that is no different for the Red Wolves.
- » A-State finished the home slate with a 10-3 ledger in the friendly confines and a +9.4 scoring margin. Below is a breakdown of the Red Wolves' statistics at home versus on the road.
- » The Red Wolves totaled 37,746 fans at its 13 home dates for an average of 2,904 - both the most since the 2016-17 season.

BATTLE-TESTED

- » Arkansas State faced one of the toughest non-conference schedules faced by a mid-major this season, including road trips to Wisconsin, Iowa, Alabama, Louisville and mid-major power Belmont. On the home front, the Red Wolves hosted (and routed) AAC tournament champion UAB.
- » A-State has faced four Quadrant 1 opponents this season. In the previous four seasons combined, the Red Wolves played just three Quad 1 foes.

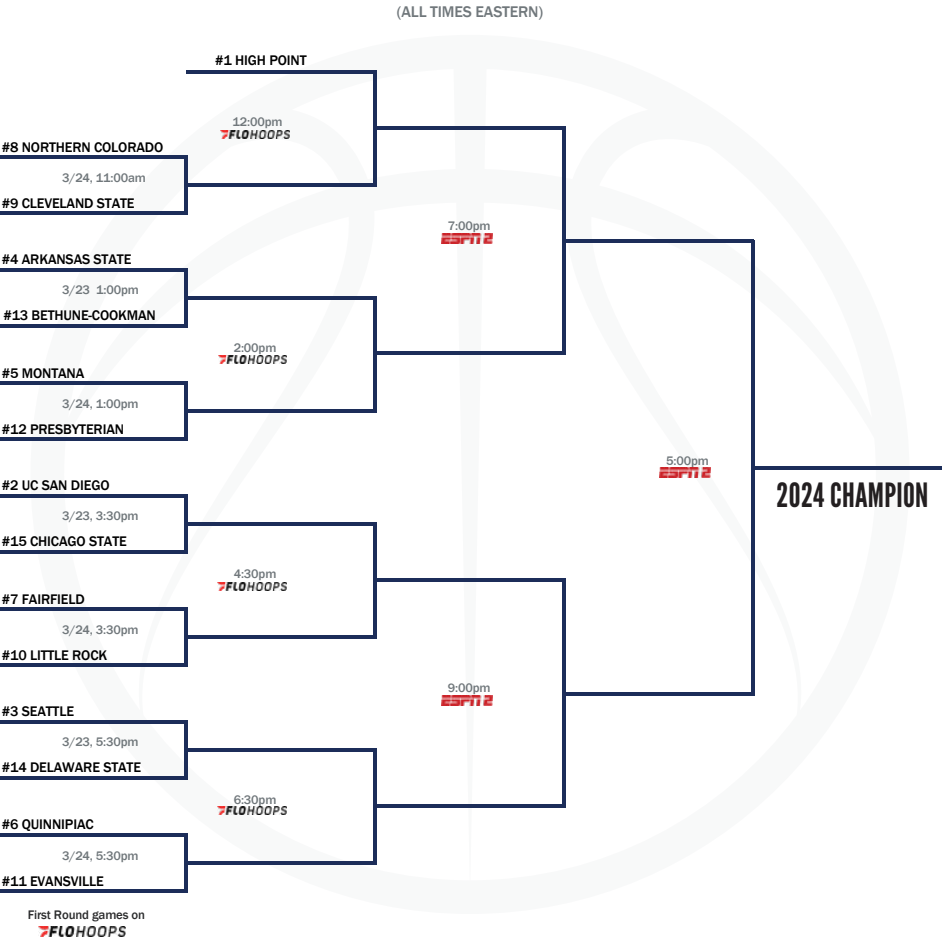

HEAD COACH BRYAN HODGSON



Bryan Hodgson, regarded as one of the top recruiters and assistant coaches in the nation with 15-plus seasons as a collegiate coach, was hired as Arkansas State's 17th men's basketball head coach in program history on March 22, 2023.

Hodgson came to Arkansas State after spending the last four seasons at the University of Alabama, which followed stops at the University of Buffalo (2015-19), Midland (Texas) Junior College (2013-15), Jamestown (NY) Community College (2010-13) and Fredonia State (NY) University (2007-10).

Recently rated as the No. 2 recruiter nationally by 247Sports.com, Hodgson played a vital role in recruiting top-15 classes each of the last four seasons in Tuscaloosa. Alabama, the overall No. 1 seed in 2023, posted a 92-42 record, advancing to the Sweet 16 twice in three-straight appearances at the NCAA Tournament since Hodgson joined head coach Nate Oats in Tuscaloosa. In total, Hodgson brings 15-plus seasons of collegiate coaching experience to Jonesboro, including six of the last seven NCAA Tournaments and a combined 15-2 record in Division I conference tournaments.

In his time with the Crimson Tide, Hodgson helped the program claim its first regular season conference title since 2002, first conference tournament title since 1991 and first Sweet 16 appearance since 2004. Four Alabama players have been drafted to the NBA since 2020 after the program had one selection from 1992-2019.

Last season, Hodgson assisted as Alabama was one of only two teams nationally, joining Houston, to rank in the top-15 in both defensive adjusted efficiency (No. 5) and in offensive adjusted efficiency (No. 15) according to KenPom. Alabama, winner of the SEC regular season and SEC Tournament crown, made its ninth NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in program history, its second appearance in the last three seasons.

After finishing the 2019-20 season with a 16-16 record and 8-10 mark in SEC play, Alabama finished the 2020-21 campaign ranked No. 5 in the final Associated Press poll, highest in program history at the time. The Crimson Tide's 26 overall wins were the second-most in school history, while the Sweet 16 appearance in the 2021 NCAA Tournament was the first for Alabama in 17 years. Alabama clinched its first regular season title in 19 years and captured the SEC Tournament title for the first time in 30 years.

Hodgson blazed a trail to Canada as he signed the first Canadian players in Crimson Tide program history - Joshua Primo and Keon Ambrose-Hilton - Canada's No. 1 and No. 3-ranked players, respectively, in 2020. He followed that by getting a third Canadian, Charles Bediako, to Tuscaloosa in 2021. Primo spent the 2020-21 season with Alabama before being selected 12th overall in the 2021 NBA Draft by the San Antonio Spurs.

In addition to ranking as one of the top recruiters in collegiate basketball, Hodgson was named to The Athletic's Top-25 up-and-coming coaches and one of the top 50 Most Impactful High Major Assistant Coaches. He was invited to participate in the prestigious 2020 TopConnect Seminar which identifies the top assistants in the country and connects them with mid-major athletic directors. Previously, Hodgson was one of 30 assistant coaches named to the 2016 Under Armour 30-under-30 Team by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC).

Hodgson spent four seasons (2015-19) with Oats at the University of Buffalo, where together they took the program to unprecedented heights. Hodgson helped guide the Bulls to three NCAA Tournament appearances and three Mid-American Conference Tournament championships, while also earning a pair of MAC regular season titles. Buffalo reached the Round of 32 in the NCAA Tournament in 2018 and 2019.

During his time at Buffalo, the Bulls were ranked for 20 weeks in the Associated Press Top-25 throughout the 2018-19 season marking the first time in school history the program had earned a national ranking. Buffalo went on to climb as high as No. 14 in the nation - the highest ranking by any MAC team in the past 40 years.

In the 2018-19 campaign, the Bulls finished with an impressive 32-4 overall record with the 32 victories marking the most in program history and most-ever by a MAC program. Coupled with a 27-9 mark in 2017-18, Buffalo had a combined 59-13 record from 2017-19 setting the best two-year stretch in school history.

In addition to his recruiting prowess, Hodgson is also known for his ability to develop talent. During his four seasons at Buffalo, nearly every player on the roster made tremendous strides on the court, none more so than 2019 MAC Player of the Year CJ Massinburg, who finished his career as a three-time All-MAC honoree and second in school history with 1,990 career points and 273 career treys. He went on to be named an honorable mention All-American by the Associated Press as a senior.

Hodgson served two seasons, one in a volunteer capacity, as an assistant coach at Midland (Texas) College, where he helped lead the team to a six-win turnaround during the 2014-15 season. He helped manage all aspects of recruitment for Midland and conducted individual skill development workouts and in-season team practice sessions.

A western New York native, Hodgson served as an assistant coach from 2010-13 at Jamestown Community College. In his time at JCC, he coached 14 players who received scholarships to four-year schools after their graduation while nine were all-region players.

Hodgson played collegiately for two seasons at Jamestown CC, serving as a two-year captain, before heading to Fredonia State. While at Fredonia State, he served as an assistant coach and earned his undergraduate degree in sports management in 2011. He later earned his masters degree in education from the University of the Southwest in 2015.

Adopted at the age of two, Hodgson has been an active participant in Big Brothers, Big Sisters Program throughout his career. He is the founder and president of Coaching Love, Inc., established to benefit at-risk youth, particularly those in the foster care system and those waiting to be adopted.
