

ARKANSAS STATE POSTGAME NOTES Arkansas State at Michigan | September 14, 2024 | Michigan Stadium

TEAM

- Senior OL Jacob Bayer, senior LB Marvin Ham senior LB Charles Willekes and sophomore QB
 Jaylen Raynor were A-State team captains and represented the Red Wolves at midfield for the
 coin toss.
- A-State had 64 different players see playing time Saturday, including 39 in their first or second year in the program ... Five true freshmen played multiple snaps.
- The crowd of 110,250 is the largest crowd for an A-State game in program history ... It tops the previous high of 102,368 at Tennessee in 2007.

OFFENSE:

- A-State had 12 different receivers account for its 26 receptions.
- Junior QB Timmy McClain tossed two touchdown passes for his first two passing TDs as a Red Wolf ... It was the 15th and 16th career TD passes for McClain including his time at UCF ... Including his time at UCF, McClain now has five career multi-TD games.
- Junior WR **Reginald Harden Jr.** hauled in two receiving TDs, including his first as a Red Wolf ... He led the team with 52 receiving yards.

DEFENSE:

- A-State picked off three Michigan passes, most interceptions gained by an A-State team since having four at ULM in 2017.
- Senior LB **Charles Willekes**, a native of Rockford, Mich., registered his first career interception ... He also was credited with a pass break-up, his first since last season at ULM.
- Senior S **Trevian Thomas** recorded an interception for the second consecutive game and for the fifth time in his career ... He finished with a game-high nine tackles.
- Sophomore CB **Dontay Joyner** snagged his first career interception and matched his career-high with eight tackles ... He was also credited with a quarterback hurry on a pass that was intercepted.
- Senior LB Marvin Ham, a Belleville, Mich., native logged his second consecutive game with nine tackles
- Junior DE **Jayden Jones** registered his second career sack, both coming over the last three games.
- Redshirt-freshman DT lan Jefferies had a career-best with 1.0 sack.

SPECIAL TEAMS:

- Senior P **Ryan Heicher** had five punts travel a combined 234 yards for an average of 46.8 yards ... Two of his five punts landed inside the 20 and he posted a season-long of 53 yards.
- Sophomore PK **Clune Van Andel** converted a 27-yard field goal in the second quarter for his third career field goal made ... Van Andel is now 3-of-6 on the season.
