WOLF HOWLS

A WORTHY CHALLENGE

The 2025-26 Arkansas State men's basketball season begins with the MAC-SBC Challenge, as the Red Wolves take on the Ohio Bobcats inside the Convocation Center in Athens, Ohio. The two programs first met on November 20, 2011 in Athens, with the Bobcats walking away with a 69-54 victory en route to a 29-8 record and a Sweet 16 appearance. Ohio made the trip to Jonesboro 12 years later as part of the first-ever MAC-SBC Challenge, and the Scarlet and Black evened the all-time record at one-game apiece with a 100-87 victory. This will be the 23rd matchup against a school located in Ohio, with the Red Wolves holding a 7-15 record against nine programs.

AGAINST THE MAC

A-State has faced 11 current members of the Mid-American Conference, holding an 8-22 all-time record against those foes. The Red Wolves are 7-12 versus those opponents after they joined the conference and 1-10 prior. The first meeting occurred against Northern Illinois on January 6, 1922 (L 23-25), 24 years before the formation of the MAC and 54 years prior to the founding of the Sun Belt. The first meeting against a MAC opponent was in 1949 versus Western Michigan (L 39-50). A-State has played the Huskies more than any other MAC opponent, facing off six times from 1922-1928.

RED WOLVES REDEFINED

A-State enters the 2025-26 campaign with a completely new look, bringing in 15 new players along with a new coaching staff. Ryan Pannone enters his first season in the scarlet and black, becoming the Red Wolves' 18th all-time head coach on March 30, 2025. He is joined by assistant coaches Hayden Sowers, Jordan Fair, Rashaad Richardson, Dean Cooper, and Anthony Goods. World War II was ongoing the last time A-State fielded no returners (players and head coach), as J.A. "Ilke" Tomlinson led a new-look program into the 1944-45 campaign.

HISTORY OF THE MAC-SBC CHALLENGE

The MAC-SBC Challenge enters its third season, and the Sun Belt looks to improve upon a 25-21 record since the 2023-24 campaign. The SBC won the first challenge in 2023-24 after posting a 13 wins in 24 meetings, but split with the same number of matchups with the MAC in 2024-25. A-State holds a 2-2 record in the series, splitting games at Akron (W 80-75°) and versus Kent State (L 75-76) last season.

RYAN PANNONE

HEAD COACH | IST SEASON

Arkansas State Vice Chancellor for Intercollegiate Athletics Jeff Purinton announced March 30, 2025 that Ryan Pannone, who has gained a reputation over the course of his 23-year career as one of the nation's top offensive minds and player-development coaches, has been named the Red Wolves' 18th all-time head men's basketball coach.


A 2025 selection to Silver Waves Media's prestigious Elite 75 Future Head Coach Power Lunch, Pannone (pronounced Puh-Known) comes to A-State after most recently spending the last two seasons as an assistant coach at Alabama. The Crimson Tide boasted the nation's highest scoring average both years as Pannone helped lead the program to Final Four and Elite Eight appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 2023-24 and 2024-25, respectively. However, his path to Jonesboro also went through six different countries, including the United States, China, Germany, Israel, Korea and Slovakia.

Pannone owns a wealth of experience at numerous levels, including NCAA Division I, NBA, G-League, various professional leagues overseas, junior college, high school and AAU. He has claimed 204 career wins in nine years as a head coach, including stops with the G-League's Erie BayHawks and Birmingham Squadron and the Slovak Basketball League's BC Prievidza.

His background includes 18 years of coaching players with NBA experience. He has coached 82 total NBA players and 46 players selected in the First Round of the NBA Draft, including 30 Lottery picks.

Serving as Alabama's offensive coordinator under head coach Nate Oats, Pannone orchestrated the country's most explosive offenses the last two seasons. The Crimson Tide averaged over 90 points per game both of his years in Tuscaloosa, including a school-record 90.7 average in 2024-25. Alabama made an NCAA Tournament-record 25 three pointers in its Sweet 16 victory over BYU.

The Crimson Tide eclipsed 100 points in 17 contests during Pannone's time with the program, including an SEC-record nine games this year. Alabama also led the nation in offensive tempo each of the last two years while posting a combined 53-21 record.

Pannone spent the season prior to his arrival at Alabama as an assistant coach for the NBA's New Orleans Pelicans, helping lead the squad to 42 victories and a Play-In Tournament berth.

He served as head coach of both the Erie Bay-Hawks and Birmingham Squadron as part of the NBA's G-League from 2019-22. His squads made back-to-back playoff appearances his last two seasons and had 11 combined NBA call-ups.

Pannone was also on the BayHawks coaching staff as an assistant during their 2014-15 campaign, but spent a season before that and the four years after coaching internationally.

His first overseas coaching opportunity came in 2013-14 as an assistant with the Guangzhou Long Lions of the Chinese Basketball Association. His next international coaching job came with the Hanau (Germany) White Wings, also as an assistant in 2015-16.

The 2016-17 season saw Pannone work as an assistant coach with Hapoel Jerusalem, helping the team appear in the Final Four of the EuroCup and claim the Israel Winner League Championship. He then spent the following year as head coach for a BC Prievidza (Slovakia) team that led its league in defense, opponent points per game, rebounding and three-point field goals made and attempted.

Pannone returned to Hapoel Jerusalem as an assistant coach for the 2018-19 season, when the squad led the Champions League in points, assists and rebounds. He also worked remotely as an advanced scout and video coordinator for the Angola National Team in 2019.

Pannone began his coaching career in 2003 while working on his undergraduate degree at the University of South Florida, taking an assistant position at Oldsmar (Fla.) Christian School. He was elevated to head coach three years later in 2006 and served in that role until 2011, posting a 131-42 record that included wins over three USA Today nationally-ranked teams.

Following his time at Oldsmar Christian, and one year before he joined the Guangzhou Long Lions, Pannone spent the 2011-12 campaign as an assistant coach at Wallace State (Ala.) Junior College. His lone season in Hanceville saw the Lions win the Region XXII Championship and Alabama State Championship. They were one of 16 teams in the country to qualify for the JUNCO National

In addition to his numerous coaching stops from 2006-19, Pannone worked at the Pro Training Center as its NBA Director. During that time, he oversaw the development of over 50 NBA players, 33 First-Round NBA Draft selections and 22 Lottery picks.

The Clearwater, Fla., native earned his bachelor's degree in general studies with a concentration of public health from the University of South Florida in 2011. While working on his degree, he was a student manager for the men's basketball program under Robert McCullum in 2006-07.

Pannone and his wife, Dr. Sarah Pannone, have three children -- Raylan (7), Dahlia (5), Trajan (3).

2025-26 NOTABLES

FAST BREAK FACTS

>> Arkansas State men's basketball returns for the 98th season in program history, beginning play during the 1926-27 campaign.

>> The program holds an all-time record of 1,294-1,240 (.511) overall and a 412-438 conference mark across the Sun Belt, American South, and Southland Conferences.

>> A-State has won six regular season conference titles, which includes the 2024-25 Sun Belt Conference championship. The Red Wolves won the SBC Tournament title in 1998-99 and participated in the first NCAA Tournament in program history (non-colleae division).

>> The Scarlet and Black participated in the 2024-25 NIT, the first appearance since 1991. A-State holds a 5-5 all-time record in the postseason tour-

>> The Red Wolves are led by first-year head coach Ryan Pannone, who joins the program following two seasons as an assistant coach at Alabama. He was named the 18th head coach in program history on March 30, 2025.

>> The 2024-25 team, led by head coach Bryan Hodgson, finished with a 25-11 (13-5 SBC) record and posted a 14-2 mark inside First National Bank Arena. A-State defeated a ranked opponent for the first time since the 1991 season on December 8, 2024 at No. 16 Memphis.

A WIN WOULD

>> Be the first at Arkansas State and at the collegiate level for head coach Ryan Pannone.
>> Improve the Red Wolves' record to 3-2 in the

MAC-SBC Challenge.

>> Snap a one-game losing streak to MAC opponents.

>> Be the fourth win in a season opener over the last five seasons.

>> Make Coach Pannone the first head coach to win in his A-State debut since Dickey Nutt defeated Abilene Christian in an 82-78 decision on November 25, 1995.

NEXT TEAM UP

>> In addition to being the first time A-State has not had a returner since the 1944-45 season, 10 transfer additions is the most for a single season in program history.

>> The Red Wolves are the lone Sun Belt team to not return a single player from the previous roster. >> A-State added eight Division I transfers along with two from the JUCO ranks. Five more join the team out of high school.

>> The team consists of one graduate, three seniors, two juniors, four sophomores, and five fresh-

PLENTY OF ROAD AHEAD

>> A-State played three true road games along with three neutral site contests prior to Jan. 1 last season. In 2025-26, the Red Wolves will play five true road games before Thanksgiving Day.

>> Road trips to Ohio (Nov. 3), Stephen F. Austin (Nov. 7), and Missouri State (Nov. 11) open the campaign while trips to Saint Mary's (Nov. 19) and SMU (Nov. 21) follow the first home matchup against Christian Brothers (Nov. 15).

>> The last time A-State played five true road games prior to December 1 was in 2017-18, when the Scarlet and Black opened the season at Evansville and traveled to three campus sites as part of the Hoosier tipoff classic.

>> 16 road contests take up the 31-game slate this

>> Last year, the Red Wolves finished with an 8-6 record on the road and a 3-3 clip at neutral sites, combining for an 11-9 mark outside of First National Bank Arena.

SBC PRESEASON RECOGNITION

>> An SBC Tournament Championship appearance in 2023-24 alongside an SBC Regular Season Championship and an NIT appearance in 2024-25 has established high expectations in Jonesboro.

>> The Red Wolves were selected to win the league

with 12 first place votes in the 2024-25 season Sun Belt Preason Poll.

>> This season, A-State was selected to finish second in the league, claiming 193 points along with three first place votes. South Alabama was the only team to have more first place ballots, recording four compared to three for the Red Wolves.

>> Chandler Jackson was named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt Second Team after averaging 6.3 points, 2.1 rebounds, and 2.0 assists over 27 starts and 29 appearances at Florida State in 2024-25.

THE NATE OATS CONNECTION

>> Ryan Pannone is the second consecutive A-State head coach to join the program after being an assistant under Nate Oats at Alabama.

>> He was brought into Tuscaloosa to coordinate the offense, and the Crimson Tide improved in many categories following his arrival.

>> Alabama improved drastically in field goal and three-point percentage during his first season. The offense improved from a .442 percent (199th) field goal percentage to .476 percent (28th), and increased their three-point percentage from .335 percent (210th) to .373 percent (20th).

>> The field goal percentage improved once again in 2024-25, averaging a .484 percent clip to rank 19th nationally and lead the SEC.

>> In addition, the Crimson Tide averaged 90.1 (1st) points in 2023-24 and 90.7 (1st) in 2024-25, up from the 81.8 (7th) points per game averaged in 2022-23.

NEW LEADERS OF THE PACK

>> A-State brought experience into the roster via one graduate transfer along with three seniors.

>> Matt Hayman transferred to the Red Wolves after three seasons at Stephen F. Austin, where he averaged 14.0 points per game on a .423 percent clip during the 2024-25 campaign.

>> Chandler Jackson arrived in Jonesboro following three seasons at Florida State, where he was named as one of 10 breakout players in the ACC for the 2024-25 season accoring to Jon Rothstein of College Hoops Today.

>> Jalen Hampton adds more experience following stops at Missouri State, South Plains College, and Northwestern State. He led the team with a .581 shooting percentage from the field and swiped a team-high 1.2 steals per game.

>> Jaxon Ellingsworth joined the program following one season at UT Arlington. The senior appeared in 28 games and made one start, averaging 5.1 points on a .490 percent clip over that stretch.

ROOM TO GROW

>> A-State lost all 15 players from the 2024-25 roster. The team had a combined total of 1,032 games played and 461 starts for a total of 19,638 minutes. >> The Red Wolves added eight Division I transfers that bring 443 games, 149 starts, and 7,938 minutes worth of experience to the 2025-26 roster.

>> TJ Caldwell and Joey Chammaa are the remaining Division I transfers that are not seniors.

>> Christian Harmon joined the program following two seasons at Gulf Coast State College, and Fredy-Salam Sylla arrives after a season at Eastern Florida State College.

>> Royal Blue Smith, Tim Matthews, Grayson Bennett, Weston Honeycutt, and CJ Geathers joined the program following strong high school careers.

KEEPING THINGS PROFESSIONAL

>> The A-State coaching staff brings significant experience at the professional level and internationally.

>> Coach Pannone holds five years of international coaching experience across three continents alongside four years of experience in the NBA G League, including three as a head coach. He spent one season in the NBA as an assistant coach as well.

>> Assistant Coach Anthony Goods was a twotime All-PAC 10 honorable mention at Stanford, and played in the NBA D-League (known as G-League today) for three seasons before heading overseas. He played for 11 teams across Venezuela, France, Israel, Italy, Poland, and Ukraine from 2011-19 before joining the Detroit Pistons as a scouting consultant from 2023-25.

>> Assistant Coach Dean Cooper adds 22 years of NBA experience to the program, returning to coaching two seasons removed from being an assistant at UTRGV from 2021-23. He began his NBA career as a video coordinator/scout for the Houston Rockets in 1999, and worked his way to the Vice President of Player Personnel for the organization in 2007. He holds three seasons of assistant coaching experience in the league, last helping the Bulls record the highest opponent turnover percentage in NBA history at 18.3 percent while leading the league in deflections (17.4 per game), steals (10.0 per game) and points off turnovers (21.2 per game). >> A-State brought in three players who are natives of other countries, adding London, England, native Chudi Dioramma from Sacramento State, Conakry, Guinea, native Aly Tounkara, and Paris, France, native Fredy-Salam Sylla from Eastern Florida State College.

THE GREAT ALV

>> Aly Tounkara is listed at 7'3 entering the 2025-26 season, which would have tied him as the second-tallest player with four other athletes last season.

>> The sophomore currently ties as the 29th-tallest basketball player in NCAA history.

>> Kenny George of UNC Asheville (2007-08) is listed as the tallest player at the collegiate level, measuring in at 7'7.

HEIR TO THE MAYOR

>> Freshman guard Weston Honeycutt signed with the Red Wolves out of Westside High School.

>> The 2024-25 4A All-State and All-Tournament selection dropped 48 points in the semifinal of the 4A-2 Regional Tournament – one of just four West-side players to ever score 48 points in a game, a list that includes A-State men's basketball alumnus Avery Felts.

>> He averaged 24.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, and 3.0 assists per game during his senior season.






