Buffalo was 285-369 (.436) in 22 seasons after going Division I (1991-2013). The Bulls were 42-20 (.678) in Coach Hurley's two seasons.

The Arizona State Sun Devil men's basketball team (5-2), coming off back-to-back two-point wins, hosts a ranked non-conference foe for just the third time in 32 years when No. 18 Texas A&M comes to town Saturday for an ESPN2 8:30 tip. Roxy Bernstein and Adrian Branch are on the call, while Tim Healey and Kyle Dodd have the Sun Devil radio call on 98.7 FM , the Sun Devil Sports Radio Network, presented by MidFirst, Sirius 113/XM 203. ASU is 5-2, including 2-0 against 2015 NCAA Tournament teams with wins over Belmont and NC State, and got a quality road win over Creighton Dec. 2 in front of 16,282 people screaming in blue shirts. ASU has already played four games decided by three points or less (3-1). Its current four-game stretch is about as challenging as one can find among major conference teams in December. The Sun Devils won at Creighton (who was 89-0 when scoring 75 points in its home arena), host hot #18 Texas A&M (who beat Gonzaga), play at No. 1 Kentucky (Dec. 12) and then play at UNLV on Dec. 16 (already beat Indiana).

NOT LETTING GO OF THE ROPE: After going 2-6 in games decided by three points or less last year (losing its first four chances), the Sun Devils have won three straight in this category this year. Creighton led for 28:27 of the Dec. 2 Sun Devil win, while UCSB led for 29:50 of the Nov. 29 Sun Devil win. ASU made it final 14 free throws to get the 70-68 UCSB win on Eric Jacobsen's putback with no time left, while the Sun Devils shot 18-of-28 (.643) from the field in the second half with the Blue Jays to get the road win. ASU trailed 77-76 with 18 seconds left at Creighton and trailed 68-65 with under a minute left vs. UCSB. ASU had 21 assists vs. Creighton (after having just 10 in each of the previous three games).

DON'T SLEEP ON THE BENCH: A big reason ASU won at Creighton despite being down eight the half? Three guys off the bench in 21 minutes combined to go 6-of-10 from the field, 4-of-6 from three and score 16 points with zero turnovers. Obinna Oleka had eight points in 11 minutes, including a three-pointer at 3:25 that broke a tie at 72. Andre Spight for the second game in a row had solid second half, as he hit a three-pointer at 8:10 to give ASU a 67-66 lead and a layup at 7:13 to give ASU a 68-67 lead. Kodi Justice hit a three-pointer at 11:23 to give ASU a 61-57 lead.

KNOCKING DOWN THROWS: The Sun Devils went 23-of-26 (.885) from the free throw line in its 70-68 win over UCSB on Nov. 29, which included making their final 14. The .885 mark is the second-best in school history for at least 25 attempts, behind only the 24-of-26 mark set on Dec. 19, 1981, vs. Cal State-Los Angeles. ASU is 103-of-139 (.741) from the free throw line in the past six games. In case you were wondering, Coach Hurley made .776 of his free throws while in college (441-of-568).

WILLIE THEN AND NOW: Last season Willie Atwood averaged 11.6 minutes, scored 92 total points (3.0 per game) and was 11-of-31 (.355) from the three-point stripe. With a slimmed-down frame, he is a new player through seven games this year. He is averaging 27.7 minutes, made all three of his three-pointers vs. Creighton in posting a career-high 14 points and is averaging 8.6 points and has two double-doubles.

WHAT WE HAVE LEARNED EARLY: Sophomore Tra Holder (7.0 ppg last year) is at 12.0 this year. He is 27-of-33 (.818) from the free throw line and has led the team in scoring in three games after doing it just once last year...senior Gerry Blakes is averaging 5.9 rebounds (4.2 last year) and is a career .804 free throw shooter (74-of-92)...senior Willie Atwood averaged 11.6 minutes last year but is at 27.7 this year...junior Savon Goodman has now led the team in rebounding in 16 of his 32 career games...after averaging 2.1 points and 1.8 rebounds in his first two years (64 games), senior Eric Jacobsen is at 8.4 points and 6.2 rebounds past two seasons (42 games)...ASU is 50-of-65 (.769) from the free throw line in the past two games... the Sun Devils have outrebounded its past six opponents...the eight steals at Creighton is a season high...ASU is 2-1 when trailing at the half this year with wins over UCSB on Nov. 29 (trailed 29-27 and won 70-68) and Creighton (trailed 41-33 and won 79-77). ASU went 2-11 last year when it trailed at the half, and 12-64 (.157) in that category the previous five seasons to this year.

GOOD ON REBOUNDING: ASU is outrebounding its opponents by 9.4 per game and has 43 more offensive rebounds (103-60). Five players have grabbed double-digit rebounds this year, and ASU's rebounding leader in all but one game has notched double-digits. After getting out rebounded by seven in the season opener, the Sun Devils have posted rebounding margins of 14, 29, 12, 10, 3 and 5.

QUICK COACH NOTE: Buffalo was 285-369 (.436) in its first 22 seasons after going Division I (1991-2013). Under Coach Hurley the Bulls were 42-20 (.678) in his two seasons.

OBI ONE TO KEEP AN EYE ON: Junior college transfer Obinna Oleka (Oh-BEE-nah Oh-LEH-ka) had no points and one rebound in the first two games, but since he only played five games for State College of Florida, Manatee-Sarasota two seasons ago and didn't play last year, a slow start was expected. Consider this: Before he took the court in the opener Nov. 13, his previous official game was Dec. 7, 2013...a 705-day break between games. Obi had 19 points vs. Kennesaw State on Nov. 18 to get warmed up, and then had 10 points and 14 rebounds (six on the offensive glass) in 29 minutes vs. Marquette on Nov. 24. Since those first two games he is averaging 10.0 points and seven boards. He also had eight second-half points in 11 minutes in the win at Creighton on Dec. 2.

ROADIES: Kentucky (23,572 average attendance) trailed only Syracuse (23,854) last year, while Creighton (17,048) was sixth. In ASU's nine Pac-12 road games last year the Sun Devils played in front of 69,519. Kentucky, UNLV and Creighton, who ASU plays in this 14-day span, combined for an average total of 52,377 last year.

ANDRE BEEN A SECOND HALF GIANT: Andre Spight is slowly but surely figuring out what it takes to go from junior college to this level, and his second-half efforts the past two games have helped lead ASU to last second wins. Against UCSB on Nov. 29, he had eight second-half points in 11 in minutes, including a three-pointer that tied the game at 68 with 34 seconds left. He had all eight points in the final 6:47 and added an assist in that span. Against Creighton he had five points in five second-half minutes with two buckets that cut lead to 67-66 at 8:10 and gave ASU 68-67 lead at 7:13.

ASU 79, CREIGHTON 77 (DEC. 2, 2015): ASU became the first team to beat CU in its building when it scores 75 (89-1) with the 79-77 comeback win, as Savon Goodman led the way 23 points and seven boards. ASU was the second Pac-12 team to visit Creighton in the regular-season since 1978, and it fell behind by nine early and was down eight at that half (41-33). ASU opened the half with a 14-4 run in the first 3:16 and shot 18-of-28 (.643) from the field in the second half.

TRA IMPROVEMENTS: In his first 15 games last year, Tra Holder averaged 4.2 points per game and made just over 63 percent of his free throws. Starting with the Colorado win on Jan. 17, his play not only earned him Pac-12 All-Freshman honors last year it has carried over to this year, as he is averaging 12.0 ppg and has been ASU's leading scorer in three games (after leading the Sun Devils in scoring just once last year). Tra had a then career-high 17 vs. Sacramento State in the opener, and then led ASU in scoring in both games in the Legends Classic in Brooklyn with 22 in the win over NC State and 15 in the championship loss to Marquette en route to All-Tournament honors. He already has made five three-pointers after making just 12 all of last season.

SAVON UPDATED: Junior Savon Goodman was bothered by a foot injury in the preseason and missed the team's scrimmage at Long Beach State (Oct. 31) and Nov. 7 exhibition game vs. Western New Mexico. He posted 13 points and 12 rebounds in just 22 minutes vs. Belmont. Against NC State in his first start, he had a monster game with 21 points and 16 rebounds. In the past 19 games he is averaging 13.2 points and nine rebounds and is 106-of-169 (.627) from the field. He has played 32 games at ASU and led team in rebounding in 16 of them.

FALL SIGNING PERIOD: ESPN tabbed Arizona State's November signing period two-man class as 19th in the nation. Sam Cunliffe, a 6-6 wing from Seattle who averaged nearly 20 points per game in his junior season, is rated as the top 2016 player in Washington, while shot blocker Jethro Tshisumpa at 6-10 and 260 is ranked as the 12th-best center prospect.

SCHEDULE: Joe Lunardi released his preseason Bracketology on Nov. 11, and it included 11 teams on ASU's schedule. Belmont, North Carolina State, Marquette, Texas A&M, Kentucky and Stephen F. Austin are the teams in the non-conference slate, while Arizona, California, UCLA, Oregon and Utah were picked from the Pac-12. ASU will play North Carolina State on Nov. 23 and then play either LSU or Marquette on Nov. 24 in the Legends Classic in Brooklyn. ASU will play Arizona, California and UCLA twice in Pac-12 play, but won't host Utah or travel to Oregon. So the Sun Devils are scheduled to play 31 games this year, 14 of them against Bracketology projected NCAA teams.

COACH AS A PLAYER: Coach Hurley's Duke career has been talked about a lot. His 145 assists (in 20 games) is a NCAA Tournament record. Here is a numbers breakdown:

.583: In the 1992 Final Four, Coach made 7-of-12 three pointers en route to the Most Outstanding Player honors.

.667: In the April 4, 1992 Final Four game vs. Indiana, Coach went 6-of-9 from the three-point stripe.

2: In addition to 1992 Most Outstanding Player honors, Coach also earned 1991 All-Tournament Team honors.

9: In the 1991 title game vs. Kansas on April 1, he posted nine assists.

16: In the 1991 Final Four he posted 16 assists.

18: In his final game of his career, Coach tossed up 18 three-pointers vs. California.

20: Coach played in 20 NCAA Tournament games.

119: Coach Hurley went 119-26 (.821) in his four years at Duke.

VS. THE AGGIES: At Texas A&M on Dec. 6 last year, ASU led by as many as 13, shot .532 from the field (25-of-47), was 9-of-10 from the free throw line, had 12 three-pointers and outrebounded the Aggies 30-22, but had 17 turnovers and forced just eight in a 72-71 loss. ASU led for over 30 minutes of the game.

GOOD EFFORT: Bobby Hurley's Buffalo squad last year led at the half at Wisconsin (Dec. 28) and at Kentucky (Nov. 16).

KODI NOTE: Kodi Justice was 17-of-37 (.459) from the three-point stripe last year. The game prior to him getting hurt on Jan. 24 at Stanford he had 16 points and made all four of his three-point shots. Against UNLV on Dec. 3, he had 13 points, six assists and no turnovers in 30 minutes.

QUICKLY ON SIX RETURNERS: Senior **Gerry Blakes** had five 20-point games last year and shot .822 (60-of-73) from the free throw line. The Inglewood, Calif., native can score in bunches, as he had 16 straight points in 4:24 at Washington State and 17 at in 5:23 at Washington in back-to-back February games...senior **Eric Jacobsen** has trimmed down and is ready to have a great senior season. The Chandler, Ariz., product averaged 28.6 minutes, 8.3 points and 5.9 rebounds last year in 34 games after averaging 8.8 minutes, 2.1 points and 1.8 rebounds in his first two seasons...senior **Willie Atwood** will see quality time in the frontcourt this year. He once made 33-of-37 free throws in a junior college game...junior **Savon Goodman** in the final 12 games last year averaged 12.9 points and 9.7 rebounds while shooting 66-of-107 (.617) from the field...sophomore **Kodi Justice** is back after suffering a fractured navicular bone in his left foot on Jan. 25 as he missed the remainder of the season. The injury happened the game following a season-high 16 points at California... **Tra Holder** in his first 15 games last year made 15 shots. Two months later, he was named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team, as he averaged double digits in the final 14 (10.1).

EJ MAKES SHOTS: He doesn't take a lot of them, but when he does, he makes them. Eric Jacobsen shot .626 from the field (102-of-163) last season, the fourth-best season mark in Sun Devil history. Jacobsen averaged 28.6 minutes, 8.3 points and 5.9 rebounds last year in 34 games after averaging 8.8 minutes, 2.1 points and 1.8 rebounds in his first two seasons. He is a career .578 shooter (170-of-294) in 105 career games.

LOOKING AHEAD: The Sun Devils might have the best scout-team backcourt in the nation, Shannon Evans (transferred from Buffalo) and Torian Graham (transferred from Houston) give the regular rotation fits in practice. Evans spent two seasons under Coach Hurley at Buffalo and as a sophomore averaged 15.4 points, 3.2 rebounds, and 4.6 assists helping lead the Bulls to the NCAA Tournament as he earned second-team All-MAC honors. As a true freshman he averaged 8.5 points and 3.3 assists per game and was named to the All-MAC Freshman Team. He played in all 29 games off the bench posting one of the highest minute totals amongst all bench players nationally (26.4 minutes per game). Graham played two seasons at Chipola Junior College and left Buffalo to go with Coach Hurley and was rated as the No. 91 overall prospect by ESPN and No. 67 by Rivals in the Class of 2012.

THREE NON-CONFERENCE ROADIES? When you toss out neutral site tournaments and talk only true road games, the 2015-16 season is just the second time since 1989-90 (also in 2010-11) that ASU will play three non-conference road games.

FINAL FOUR IN 2017: Arizona State and Glendale/Phoenix host the 2017 Final Four, the first Final Four held west of Texas since Seattle in 1995. It will be held at University of Phoenix Stadium, home of the Arizona Cardinals. The 2017 Final Four will also mark the 25th anniversary of Bobby Hurley earning 1992 Most Outstanding Player honors.

OOO RANKED TEAM: ASU has hosted the likes of Final Four-bound Kansas in 1990-91, Final-Four bound Oklahoma State in 1994-95, Texas, Georgia, Kerry Kittles-led Villanova, Kenny Thomas-led New Mexico, BYU, 2006 defending Big Ten Tournament champ Iowa and Louisville since 1990, but for whatever reason No. 18 Texas A&M will only be the third non-conference ranked opponent to visit Wells Fargo Arena in the past 32 seasons (1984-85 to present). No. 17 Xavier is the highest ranked non-conference foe to visit ASU since No. 14 ASU beat No. 7 Ohio State 71-58 on Dec. 20, 1980. ASU defeated XU 77-55 on Dec. 15, 2007. Xavier was the first non-conference ranked foe to visit Tempe since No. 18 UTEP topped ASU 60-55 on Dec. 18, 1983. ASU then beat No. 25 Marquette 79-77 on Nov. 25, 2013, on Jordan Bachynski's walk-off block en route to the NCAA Tournament.

GERRY: Inglewood native Gerry Blakes averaged 11.1 points and 4.2 rebounds last year after playing two seasons at San Bernardino Valley College (2012-14)...SBVC coach was ASU alumni Quincy Brewer, who played on the Sun Devil 1994-95 Sweet Sixteen team... had 24 at WSU on Feb. 13 (including ASU's final 16 in 4:24)...in Feb. 15 win at UW, he had 17 points in 5:23 of the second half (11:05 to 5:42) and ASU needed every bucket to stop an eight-game skid against UW and give ASU its first win in Seattle since another southpaw (with a small beard) was doing his thing in 2008.

GOOD SIGN: ASU is 2-1 when trailing at the half this year with wins over UCSB on Nov. 29 (trailed 29-27 and won 70-68) and Creighton (trailed 41-33 and won 79-77). ASU went 2-11 last year when it trailed at the half, and 12-64 (.157) in that category the previous five seasons to this year.

ABOUT THAT PAC-12 OPENER: The Sun Devils will open the Pac-12 season on Sunday, Jan. 3 in Tempe, against Arizona at noon on FOX Sports 1. ASU has won three of the past four against the Wildcats in Tempe and is 9-8 vs. Arizona in the past eight seasons.

VS. TEXAS A&M: ASU leads the series 4-1, but the Aggies won the last one (72-71) at Reed Arena on Dec. 6, 2014, when Kourtney Roberson made a free throw with 5.1 seconds left...Coach Hurdley's first game as a head coach was at Texas A&M, as Buffalo fell to the Aggies 82-58 to open the 2013-14 season...first meeting occurred on Dec. 27, 1987, when the Sun Devils earned a 79-73 win during the Rainbow Classic in Honolulu, Hawaii...ASU won a 103-73 game in Maui on Nov. 21, 1994, en route to the Maui title that year.

GOOD SCHEDULE: ASU has 10 OOC against teams who finished in the top 155 of last year's RPI with Kentucky (1), Stephen F. Austin (33), NC State (39), Marquette (147), Texas A&M (67), UCSB (87), Belmont (105), UNLV (114), Sacramento State (142) and Creighton (151). Kentucky, Stephen F. Austin, NC State, and Belmont made the 2015 NCAA Tournament.

BEAT LEAGUE CHAMPS: ASU is the only team to beat Pac-12 champions in each of the past three seasons. ASU and OSU beat UA in 2014-15 (16-2). In 2013-14 only Cal, Oregon and ASU beat the Wildcats (15-3). In 2012-13, UCLA won the league at 13-5, with losses at WSU, at Cal, at Oregon, at ASU and to USC in Pauley Pavilion. **The Pac-12 champions are 44-10 in the past three seasons, and ASU is the only team to have three of the wins.**

47-8 PRETTY DARN GOOD: The Sun Devils entered the 2015-16 season 47-8 (.854) at home in the past three seasons, one of the best marks in the four decades of hoops in Wells Fargo Arena. Since the Lionel Hollins-led Sun Devils opened the building in 1974-75, the most home wins in any four-year era is 51 (1991-95 and 2007-11). The best winning percentage in a four-year span came from 1979-83, when the Sun Devils went 49-12 (.803).

TRA'S SEASON: Back on Jan. 15, ASU had just lost to Utah 76-59 to drop to 8-9 overall and 0-4 in the league. Freshman Tra Holder was averaging 4.2 points (tied for eighth on the team) in under 20 minutes per game, had not played in two tilts and had made 15 shots. Nearly two months later, he earned Pac-12 All-Freshman honors. After not making a shot in his first four Pac-12 games, he averaged double digits in final 14. He set career-best with eight assists (and 15 points) vs. #6 Arizona on Feb. 7 in the 81-78 win going against arguably the nation's best point guard in T.J. McConnell.

TRA AGAINST NBA PLAYER T.J.: How good was Tra's 15 points and eight assists vs. Arizona in the Feb. 7, 2015, ASU win vs. #6 UA and T.J. McConnell? Jahii Carson was one of the best freshmen guards in the Pac-12 the past decade. He did that in a Pac-12 game once in his freshman year (21/8 vs. USC). Derek Glasser, a four-year starter at point guard who set Sun Devil career records for games (131), assists (551) and free throw percentage (.838) and is the only Sun Devil with 1,000 career points and 500 assists, never had eight assists in his freshman season (2006-07) and scored 15 points twice all season.

ABOUT THOSE HOME WINS: ASU entered this year 47-8 (.854) in the previous three seasons at home (49-8 in previous 57), and is the only team to beat the past three Pac-12 champions in those seasons (UCLA in 2013, UA in 2014 and 2015). Wondering how 47 wins stacked up? In the Pac-12 it was fourth, but in the nation it was tied for tenth. ASU has posted records of 16-4 (2012-13), 16-1 (2013-14) and 15-3 (2014-15) the past three seasons that includes a 21-6 mark in the Pac-12.
