The Arizona State Sun Devil men's hoops team (4-0) that returns three senior starters from last year's squad and welcomes six newcomers faces the Kansas State Wildcats on Thanksgiving (Nov. 23) at 4:30 p.m. PT in the Continental Tire Invitational at Orleans Arena in Las Vegas, with Rich Walz and Jim Jackson on the call. ASU, under third-year head coach Bobby Hurley, is led by seniors Tra Holder, Shannon Evans II and Kodi Justice. Tim Healey and Kyle Dodd have the call on the Sun Devil Radio Network/620 AM. ASU is 4-0 for the first time since the 2013-14 NCAA Tournament squad started 6-0. ASU will try and go 5-0 for just the second time in the past 32 seasons.

EASY STAT OUT OF THE GATE: Senior guard Tra Holder has plenty of numbers you can read about later, but as of the first of the week this is the coolest: He is the only player in the nation averaging 22 points (22.3), seven rebounds (7.3) and six assists (6.3).

GETTING 90: ASU has scored 90 points in four straight games, the first time that has happened since Lionel Hollins and crew did it in from Feb. 28-March 15, 1975.

PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK: How good of a week did Tra Holder have in earning Pac-12 Player of the Week? In three wins where ASU averaged 95.3 points, Tra Holder averaged 35.7 minutes, 23.7 points, 6.3 rebounds and 5.7 assists. He shot .548 (23-of-42) from the field, .571 (12-of-21) from three and .813 (13-of-16) from the free throw line. He put the exclamation point on it on Nov. 19 with a career-high 35 points on 13-of-15 shooting in the win over UC Irvine. He is the 36th member of the Sun Devil 1,000-point club and also gets to the free throw line as he is 391-of-526 (.732) from the charity stripe in his 101 games/92 starts, as both marks are second in ASU history behind only Ike Diogu (671-of-854).

VS. KANSAS STATE: Led by sixth-year head coach Bruce Weber, Kansas State returns nine lettermen from a team 21-win team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third time in five seasons. ASU and the Wildcats have met eight times, the last time an 84-80 Kansas State win the 1998 Maui Invitational. ASU will then face either Xavier or George Washington on Friday . The championship game will be on FOX at 2:30 p.m. PT while the consolation game will be played following the title game at 5 p.m. PT on FS1.

ASU 99 (4-0), UC IRVINE (NOV. 19, 2017): ASU jumped out to a 22-6 lead seven minutes in and never let the lead get to single digits against Big West standard UC Irvine as it made 18-of-28 (.692) from the floor in the first half and posted 56 points, the most in the first half since it scored 58 vs. San Francisco on Nov. 20, 2009. Tra Holder had a career-high 35 points on 13-of-15 shooting, while Shannon Evans II had 22 points and seven assists. Romello White added his second double-double with 14/11.

ASU 97 (3-0), NAU 62 (NOV. 17, 2017): ASU jumped out to a 15-3 lead five minutes in and led 54-27 at the half as five players reached double digits. Romello White had 25 points (10-of-12 shooting), while Shannon Evans II had 20 and eight assists. Tra Holder filled the stat sheet with 12 points, nine rebounds, six assists and zero turnovers. ASU had 24 assists, tied for the second-most in the past four seasons.

ASU 90 (2-0), SAN DIEGO STATE 74 (NOV. 14, 2017): For the ninth time under Bobby Hurley ASU trailed at the half but came back and won and did it in convincing fashion with a 90-68 win over San Diego State. ASU was down 40-34 at the half and 43-34 at 19:22 mark before it outscored the Aztecs 56-25, including a 22-2 run from the 14:40 to 6:42 mark. It marked the first time SDSU had given up 90 since Feb. 22, 2006. Tra Holder led the way with 24 points, eight rebounds and six assists. Romello White added 16 points and 15 rebounds in his debut, while De'Quon Lake added 15 points (perfect in seven shots) and seven rebounds off the bench. ASU shot .667 (20-of-30) from the field in the second half and held SDSU to 9-of-30 (.300). Shannon Evans II added 14/6/6 while Remy Martin had 12 points off the bench.

ASU 94, IDAHO STATE 74 (NOV. 10, 2017): Junior De'Quon Lake posted 24 points -- the best Sun Devil debut since Steve Moore had 26 vs. Arkansas-Little Rock on Nov. 22, 2003 -- and added eight rebounds and three blocks in the season opening win. Shannon Evans II added 25 points (with five three-pointers), while Tra Holder had 18 points, nine rebounds and eight assists. Lake finished 10-of-14 from the line after going 1-of-4 in the first half. ASU led 51-33 at the half, sparked by Remy Martin who finished with 16 points and five assists on 6-of-8 shooting in 34 minutes off the bench. ASU had 22 assists and shot 34-of-65 (.523) from the field.

TOP SCORERS: ASU has two of the top five scorers in the Pac-12 returning, as Tra Holder (16.2 ppg) and Shannon Evans II (15.0) averaged more than 31 points.

DIGITS FROM LAST YEAR: ASU's 78.6 points per game last year was its best since the 1997-98 squad averaged 84.5...ASU ranked third in the Pac-12 in free throw shooting (.749) and averaged just 10.4 turnovers (first in the league and T-11th in the nation) and 9.9 three-pointers made (second in Pac-12)...Tra Holder led the league in free throws made and attempted (152-of-197/.772)...ASU likes to shoot the three as its 328 made last year was third-most in league history behind only UCLA (354 in 2016-17) and Oregon (350 in 2006-07).

PREDICTIONS: ASU was picked sixth in the Pac-12 preseason media poll announced on Oct. 12, its top preseason ranking since being picked fourth in the Pac-10 prior to the 2010-11 season. ASU has been picked 11th (2016-17 and 2012-13), eighth (2015-16), ninth (2014-15 and 2011-12), seventh (2013-14) in seven previous Pac-12 polls. UA was picked to finish first, followed by USC, UCLA, UO, Stanford, ASU, Utah, OSU, CU, UW, Cal and WSU.

MEET THE SIX: ASU will have six newcomers fill roles in 2017-18, led by three who were in the program last year. **Romello White** is a 6-8 forward from Suwanee, Ga. who practiced last season as an academic redshirt and was a top-100 player (No. 77 by ESPN, No. 81 by Scout) in the 2016 signing class. Texan **Mickey Mitchell** is a skilled 6-7 sophomore who started seven games and played in 23 for Ohio State in 2015-16, came to ASU in December of 2016 and will be eligible this December, while 6-9 redshirt freshman **Vitaliy Shibel** has a great southpaw shooting stroke but missed last year with an ACL injury. Junior college transfer **De'Quon Lake** has a 6-10 frame and a 7-2 wing span. ESPN 2017 top-100 players **Kimani Lawrence** (New Hampton School/Providence, RI) is a 6-7 swingman with 6-11 wingspan who is No. 54, while **Remy Martin** (Sierra Canyon/Chatsworth, Calif.) is a 6-0 lead guard and is No. 82 in the rankings.

NOT MANY CAN SAY THIS: ASU's backcourt has two 1,300-point career scorers. Tra Holder has 1,304 points in 101 Sun Devil games (12.9 ppg.), while Shannon Evans II has 1,329 career points, with 754 of them coming at Buffalo from 2013-15. Combined the duo has made 806 total field goals, 301 three-pointers, 695 free throws and has dropped 2,633 collegiate points in 200 career games.

THREE-POINT NOTE

Entering 2017-18 ASU had made a three-pointer in 555 straight games. The last time ASU did not make a three-pointer was in an 89-57 win over Washington in Tempe on Feb. 10, 2001.

TOP-10 OPPONENT (PROBABLY): From 1995-96 through 2014-15, ASU played one top-10 team outside of Pac-12 play in the regular season (No. 7 Duke on Nov. 25, 2009, in Madison Square Garden). This year's Dec. 10 game at Kansas has the potential to be the third straight season ASU will play a top-10 non-conference team in the regular season. ASU has played Kentucky the past two seasons and now starts the home-and-home with Kansas this year.

COACH AS A PLAYER: Coach Hurley's Duke career has been talked about a lot. His 145 assists (in 20 games) is a NCAA Tournament record. Here is a numbers breakdown:

.583: In the 1992 Final Four, Coach made 7-of-12 three pointers en route to the Most Outstanding Player honors.

.667: In the April 4, 1992 Final Four game vs. Indiana, Coach went 6-of-9 from the three-point stripe.

2: In addition to 1992 Most Outstanding Player honors, Coach also earned 1991 All-Tournament Team honors.

9: In the 1991 title game vs. Kansas on April 1, he posted nine assists.

16: In the 1991 Final Four he posted 16 assists.

20: Coach played in 20 NCAA Tournament games.

119: Coach Hurley went 119-26 (.821) in his four years at Duke.

18-2: Coach Hurley went 18-2 in his NCAA Tournament career.

ABOUT THE FRESHMEN: From one coast to the other one, Bobby Hurley's staff signed a pair of top-100 players last fall, as 6-7 swingman Kimani Lawrence (New Hampton School in New Hampton, N.H.) and 6-1 guard Remy Martin of Chatsworth (Calif.) Sierra Canyon joined the program this summer. A four-star signee according to Scout, Martin averaged 14.5 points as a junior. Lawrence, a four-star small forward from The New Hampton School in New Hampton, N.H., is the nation's 54th overall prospect according to ESPN.

FREE THROWS: The Sun Devils made free throws at a rate that was third-best in school history (489-of-653/.749) last year. ASU shot .756 in 1977-78 and .754 in 1954-55 for its best seasons.

SPLASH GAMES: Shannon Evans II arrived at ASU after having spent two seasons under Coach Hurley at Buffalo. As a sophomore in 2014-15 he averaged 15.4 points, 3.2 rebounds and 4.6 assists and led the Bulls to the NCAA Tournament as he earned second-team All-MAC honors. He made his first 20 free throws to start last season. Also, he had 50 points in an exhibition win this year against Arizona Christian.

JUSTICE SERVED: Kodi Justice has made 149 three pointers in 87 career games. He suffered a fractured navicular bone in his left foot on Jan. 25, 2015 (freshman year) and missed the remainder of that season, but bounced back with a solid sophomore season. His injury happened the game following a season-high 16 points at California, so he was just starting to get in the groove, and then adapted to a new coaching staff in the summer of 2015 while getting healthy.

DON'T SLEEP ON KODI: In the final five games of 2016-17 Kodi averaged 15.6 points, which included a career-high 22 points in the Feb. 26 win over NCAA Tournament-bound USC. He was in double digits in 11 games in 2016-17 and was 17-of-35 (.486) from the three-point stripe and perfect in nine free throw attempts in those final five games.

NO DEPTH LAST YEAR: Tra Holder led the Pac-12 in minutes per game in conference games last year at 37.9, but not far behind him were Sun Devils Shannon Evans II (36.7/second) and Torian Graham (36.6/third).

40-MINUTE MEN: On Feb. 16 at Washington, Tra Holder and Shannon Evans II each played 40 minutes, while Torian Graham and Kodi Justice both played 39 minutes in the 83-81 win. According to Stats Inc., it was the only time in the past 21 seasons (1996-97 to present) that four Sun Devils played at least 39 minutes in a regulation game and marked the first time any Pac-12 team had done it since Oregon State at Arizona State on March 5, 2011. It was so crazy and would probably never happen again...except it did vs. No. 5 UCLA on Feb. 23, when the ASU starters played 199 minutes a week later.

SHANNON FTS: Shannon Evans II finished tied for second in the Pac-12 in free throw percentage (100-of-120/.833), just .002 off the leader. Two Sun Devils have led the Pac-12, as Chris Beasley shot .875 (112-of-128) in 1983-84 and Alex Austin made 69-of-80 (.863) in 1988-89.
