





Ticket information

Age requirement

Children ages 2 and under will be admitted free to baseball games with a paid adult. Please note free admittance is only valid for a seat in an adult's lap. There is no required pass or ticket for this admittance.

Accessible tickets

All accessible tickets in Phoenix Municipal Stadium are marked and individually ticketed by the Sun Devil Ticket Office. Please make sure to indicate your accommodation needs when purchasing your ticket so the ticket office may provide you with the best and most appropriate seating available. Accessible seating is provided for individuals with specific needs and up to three (3) companion seats will be sold for every one (1) accessible seat sold.

Online: Tickets can be purchased by visiting sundevilstickets.com. Tickets are available online 24 hours a day.

Phone sales: Tickets may be purchased over the phone by calling the Sun Devil Ticket Office at **480-727-0000** or **1-888-SUNDVLS**. Phone sales are available Monday - Friday from 9am - 5pm except holidays.

In-person: The main Sun Devil Ticket Office is located at the South end of Sun Devil Stadium. Office hours are Tuesday - Friday from 9am - 5pm. On game days, the ticket office will open at the Phoenix Municipal Stadium a hour and a half prior to first pitch and remain open until the 7th inning stretch. If you would like to purchase tickets after hours, please visit us at sundevilstickets.com. **The Sun Devil Ticket Office accepts Visa, MasterCard and American Express.**





Pre-game and parking information

Entering stadium

Sun Devil Athletics continues to place a high priority on safety. Enhanced security measures including the clear bag policy, use of magnetometers and no reentry policy will be in effect at Phoenix Municipal Stadium for 2022. We encourage you to arrive early and be patient with these procedures. Fans can enter through the main gate located on the third base line of Phoenix Municipal Stadium.

Accessible event day parking

Parking in the Maroon and Main Lots is \$5 per car. Once the Maroon Lot fills, parking will be directed to the Main Lot. There is ADA parking available in the Main Lot. Free shuttle service is available from the Main Lot to the main gate throughout the game.

General information

Permitted and prohibited items

To ensure a positive gameday experience for you and all of our guests, please refer to the [A-Z Guide](#) prior to the game to make sure your items are permitted in Phoenix Municipal Stadium.

Service animals

Service animals, signal dogs or other animals individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability may enter the stadium with that individual.

Smoking

On August 1, 2013, ASU joined more than 800 universities and colleges nationwide in becoming a tobacco-free campus. Tobacco products are not permitted in Phoenix Municipal Stadium, including e-cigarettes, vaping and smokeless cigarettes/tobacco. Wheelchair accessible

There are ADA accessible stalls in all permanent bathrooms in Phoenix Municipal Stadium. This includes at least one stall as well as an ambulatory stall.

Zero waste/recycling

Arizona State University has a commitment to divert 90% of material away from the landfill. Please assist us by using the blue recycle bins as well as the green compost bins throughout the arena. You can also participate by purchasing a reusable souvenir cup at the beginning of the season to bring back to every game for free refills and reduce your overall waste. Banners/signs/flags

Phoenix Municipal Stadium Event Management allows fans to bring signs smaller than 3' X 2' to the game, provided these items meet prescribed guidelines. Signs cannot be hung over any existing signage, block the view of another guest, or contain any advertisements or profanities. Signs larger than 3' X 2', whiteboards, and poles of any kind or size are not allowed into Phoenix Municipal Stadium. Sun Devil Event Management reserves the right to confiscate any sign/whiteboard.

First aid stations

The first aid station is located behind Section A on the main concourse.

Fan behavior

Guests are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner by refraining from the following acts:

- Impeding Competition
- Using Vulgarities
- Making Threats
- Throwing Objects

Guests who participate in any of the acts listed above may be ejected from the premises at the discretion of event management personnel.

Ejection policy

Threats, actual violence, or impeding competition WILL result in immediate ejection from Phoenix Municipal Stadium. No warning is necessary for any of these actions.

Concession stands

Multiple concession stands are located around the main concourse of Phoenix Municipal Stadium offering a variety of food and beverage items.

Gates opening

Gates open a hour and a half prior to first pitch for all fans.

Merchandise

ASU merchandise can be purchase at the Sparky's Stadium Shop located behind the Upper seating bowl next to the Ticket Office.

Game times

Sun Devil Baseball start times are subject to change. Sun Devil Athletics will post the correct game time and any changes can be found at thesundevils.com.

Restrooms

There are restrooms located throughout Phoenix Municipal Stadium. Baby changing tables are available in men's and women's restrooms throughout the arena.

Family restrooms

The Family restroom is located in the Rock House. The Rock House is located on the main concourse behind the Press Box.

General information

Scoreboard messages

Commemorate a special occasion by displaying a message on the Phoenix Municipal Stadium video board during an Arizona State baseball game. Scoreboard messages can be purchased for \$75 for all fans. Messages can be up to 75 characters, including spaces and punctuation, and will be reviewed for content by Sun Devil Athletics. Messages deemed to be obscene, controversial or offensive include foul language or refer negatively to ASU, our opponent, or any subject matter will not be accepted. The message cannot be used for commercial purposes and are subject to NCAA legislation. Payment must be made prior to announcement. Payment can be made by check or cash only. There are a limited number of messages available each game. Space is limited, so reserve your space early. Reservations and payment must be made by 5pm MST four (4) business days prior to game day. There are seven (7) disabled seating areas available in Phoenix Municipal Stadium. Sections 2, 3, 8, 10, 11, 12 and 13


There are additional ADA options in the GA areas.

Note:

Due to construction, Van Buren Street may have lane restrictions that could affect turns on or off Priest Drive. Traffic patterns could possibly change from week to week.

Please be considerate to others. If you are assigned a designated space, you are required to park in your assigned space or risk being towed. Parking opens 2.5 hours before game time.



NCAA compliance rules

Arizona State University athletics compliance

Integrity is a core principle of Sun Devil Athletics. Essential to that principle is a commitment to athletics compliance – following the rules of the NCAA and Pac-12. Rules compliance is a responsibility shared among all Sun Devil Athletics stakeholders, including SDA coaches, student-athletes, prospective student-athletes, and representatives of ASU's athletics interests (more commonly referred to as "boosters").

As a Sun Devil baseball fan, you are likely to be considered a booster under NCAA legislation, and your actions could therefore have an impact on SDA's sports programs. Remember that once you become an SDA booster, you remain one indefinitely. We ask that you please read and familiarize yourself with the following summary of NCAA booster legislation so you can help us prevent activities that might jeopardize SDA's interests and those of our student-athletes. While the information does not contain all applicable rules, it should serve as a guide regarding whether an activity is permissible.

Summary of NCAA booster rules

Booster rule #1

You cannot recruit prospects, either directly or through prospects' friends or families.

Impermissible recruiting:

- Contacting (e.g., phone, text, in person) prospects or their relatives, coaches, or high school administrators.
- Having face-to-face conversations with prospects (or their relatives) during prospects' visits to campus including game days and practices.

Booster rule #2

You cannot give anything to student-athletes (prospective or current) or their friends or families that is not authorized under NCAA rules.

Impermissible benefits to student-athletes and prospects

- Allowing the use of your personal property (e.g., boats, homes, cars).
- Providing or co-signing for loans.
- Providing cash, gift cards, free or reduced-cost lodging, entertainment, services, or products.
- Promising employment, money, gifts, or anything else of value after college graduation.

NCAA compliance rules

So what are you permitted to do?

The answer depends on whether a student is a prospective or a current student-athlete. An individual becomes a Sun Devil prospect when they begin the ninth grade. A prospect then becomes a student-athlete after beginning team practice or attending class at ASU. The following lists provide examples of activities permitted under NCAA legislation for prospects and student-athletes.

Prospects – Permissible activities

- Attending high school, community college, and public events in which prospects are participating. But you may not attempt to contact or recruit those prospects.
- Continuing established family relationships with prospects and relatives as long as contacts and communications remain unrelated to recruiting.
- Accepting calls from a prospect as long as they are not arranged by coaches or staff members and are unrelated to athletics. You should direct a prospect to an SDA coach or the Compliance Office staff if he or she has questions about athletics.

Student-athletes –

Permissible activities

- Speaking with student-athletes at games, events, banquets, etc. To determine the best way to communicate, ask the student-athlete or coach – generally email is the preferred method.
- Hosting an occasional meal for a student-athlete or an entire team at your home or on ASU's campus. You must obtain prior approval by the Compliance Office.
- Employing a student-athlete, as long as you pay the going rate for work actually and already performed and have documentation of the payments.
- Using a student-athlete to promote your business, so long as ASU's NIL activity policy is followed. NIL activities must not be used to compensate student-athletes for athletics performance or recruit prospective student-athletes to ASU.
