Arizona State Sun Devils

13-3-4 Overall

The No. 13/14 Arizona State ice hockey team plays in the presence of great hockey history this weekend as participants of the Adirondack Winter Invitational on Dec. 29-30. The holiday tournament is hosted at Herb Brooks Arena at the Olympic Center, the site of the 1980 USA Hockey victory over the Soviet Union immortalized as the "Miracle on Ice."

The Sun Devils (13-3-4) compete against the Clarkson Knights (8-5-1) on Friday, Dec. 29 at 5:30 p.m. on ESPN+ and Fox Sports 910, the home of Sun Devil Hockey Radio Network. In addition to ASU, the tournament includes Clarkson, No. 17 Cornell (6-4-1), and No. 11 Massachusetts (11-4-1). Depending on Friday's results, ASU will play either Cornell or UMass on Saturday, Dec. 30.

This is the first holiday tournament that the Sun Devils have competed in since traveling to Las Vegas for the Ice Vegas Invitational in 2017-18. ASU won that tournament after defeating Northern Michigan, 7-3, and Michigan Tech, 3-2.

TOP IN THE COUNTRY

After a big road sweep of Robert Morris two weeks ago, the Sun Devils head to Lake Placid as national top-10 performers in multiple statistical categories:

- No. 1: ASU has scored 25 power play goals in 20 games which leads the
- Tied-No. 2: ASU's 13 wins is second-most in the country
- Tied-No. 3: Winning percentage at 75 percent
- No. 4: Power play unit converts at a 28.4 percent success rate

- TJ Semptimphelter is tied at No. 2 in the country in goaltender winning percentage at 75 percent. His 11 wins this season is third in the NCAA. With eight career shutouts, Semptimphelter is tied at fifth in the NCAA in career shutouts. His three shutouts this season is tied for first in the country
- Tyler Gratton and Matthew Kopperud are tied at No. 9 in the country in goals with 11 each
- Brandon Tabakin's +15 plus/minus is tied at No. 4 in the country. He has never finished a game less than even this season.

SUN DEVIL NOTES

POWERED UP POWER PLAY

ASU ranks fifth in the nation among NCAA Division I teams for best power play percentage at 28.4 though 20 games. ASU's power play unit kicked into high gear two weeks ago at Robert Morris. The team scored five goals on the man-advantage from two players - Matthew Kopperud and Tyler Gratton, ASU scored three power play goals on Saturday night - the second time this season the Sun Devils have scored so frequently on the PP. Matthew Kopperud scored his 50th career goal on the power play. Lukas Sillinger continues to lead the power play scoring for the Sun Devils with two goals and 16 assists for 18 points. Matthew Kopperud is second on the team in power play scoring with 14 points (9G, 5A). Kopperud has been the go-to goal scorers on the man-advantage with his nation-leading nine PPG.

RANKED DEVILS

ASU continues its 11th-straight week in the national polls. The highest national poll ranking ever received by the Sun Devils was No. 9 on Feb. 17, 2020 in the 2019-20 season.

GONE SILLY

Senior alternate captain Lukas Sillinger put on a massive seven-point weekend at RMU to catapult him into one of the nation's top scorers. With 20 assists this season, the winger ranks No. 2 in the country. He boasts 26 total points which ranks third in the NCAA. Over the weekend he reached 100 career points which makes him a top-10 career point scorer among current skaters in the NCAA. He leads the team in points and points per game at 1.30.

KOPP'IN THE POWER PLAY

Alternate captain and senior forward Matthew Kopperud has stolen the power play spotlight for the Sun Devils. The Colorado native netted three power play goals at RMU two weeks ago to further extend his nation-leading PPG this season to nine. He boasts 33 career power play goals which continues to set the ASU program record and lead the NCAA in career PPG among all skaters. He also reached 50 career goals over the weekend and finished the first half of the schedule with 52 career goals which ranks No. 3 in career scoring among all NCAA players. His nine career game-winning goals, six of which were netted this season, is tied at fourth in NCAA career game-winning goal scoring.

SUPER SENIORS CLASS

The senior class is made up of Matthew Kopperud, Ty and Dylan Jackson, Lukas Sillinger, Ryan O'Reilly, Tim Lovell, Alex Young, and Benji Eckerle combine to be ASU's largest point scoring class this season. The seniors scored 41 of ASU's 69 goals this season and assisted on nearly half of all goals (65 of 119). Kopperud leads the class in goal-scoring with 11. Sillinger leads the entire team in points and assists with 26 and 20, respectively. Multiple seniors are instrumental in ASU's special teams, especially the power play unit. Eighteen of ASU's 25 power play goals were scored by members of the senior class.

BETWEEN THE PIPES

TJ Semptimphelter, still stands within the national rankings in goalie winning percentage, most wins, and save percentage. In game two at Colorado College last month, Semptimphelter tied a program record for career shutouts set by ASU alum and current NHL Seattle Kraken netminder Joey Daccord (8). He completed his last shutout with 38 saves against the Tigers. His counterpart, sophomore Gibson Homer got the nod to start on Saturday vs. Dartmouth - his fourth NCAA start. He boasts an undefeated record at 2-0-2, complete with 92 saves and a 1.90 goals against average and .920 save percentage.

HEAD COACH GREG POWERS

Coach Powers enters his ninth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2023-24. and his 16th overall at the helm at ASU. He was a finalist for the 2019 and 2020 Spencer Penrose Award, which is awarded to the Division I Coach of the Year. Coach Powers was also named the 2018-19 Frank Kush Sun Devil Coach of the Year. as voted on by the 26 head coaches at Arizona State. On July 7, 2022, Arizona State University and Greg Powers agreed to a five-year contract extension through the 2026-27 season. In 2021-22, Powers led ASU to five-straight wins versus USCHO.com Top-20 opponents in 2021-22 for the first time in program history (the previous record for consecutive wins against ranked opponents was three-straight games). In 2021-22, the team boasted three of the top-10 scorers in the nation in Colin Theisen, Matthew Kopperud and Josh Doan. ASU scored 116 goals in 35 games for a 3.31 goals per game average, ranked No. 10 in the country. Under Powers, ASU became the fastest start-up collegiate hockey program to qualify for the postseason in 2018-19. At 21-13-1 and No. 10 in the Pairwise rankings, the Sun Devils made the largest jump in all of NCAA Division I year-to-year up from No. 53 at the end of 2017-18. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their firstever ACHA Division I National Championship. Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers' four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.

BREAKING GROUND

- On Wednesday, Dec. 16, 2020, Arizona State University and Sun Devil Athletics announced all required approvals have been received for the
 commencement of construction on a new Multi-Purpose Arena, which will host university and community events and serve as the future home for Sun
 Devil men's ice hockey and wrestling. This project continues the development of the Novus Innovation Corridor, and will be sited south of Rio Salado
 Parkway on the east side of Packard Drive, immediately north of the existing Packard Drive Parking Structure.
- Construction began in January 2021 and recieved its certificate of occupancy on Friday, September 30, 2022.
- Over 8,000 square feet is set aside for a ASU state-of-the-art ASU locker room, weight room, lounge and coaches' offices on the north side of the arena.
 Eight additional locker rooms are accounted for on the west side of the arena between the main arena and community ice sheet that can be utilized for visiting teams, youth programs, ASU club programs, and live events.
- On February 14, 2022, ASU and the NHL's Arizona Coyotes formed the first agreement of its kind between a college and NHL team in 100 years. The last time an NCAA college team and an NHL team shared an arena was the Boston Bruins and Boston University from 1924-28 at Boston Arena, now known as Matthews Arena. Other improvements will now be made, at the Coyotes' expense, to prepare the arena to temporarily house Coyotes home games. These improvements include constructing coaches' rooms, equipment rooms, technology and other aspects of the new ASU arena according to NHL standards. The added cost is up to \$30 million, which will be paid in advance by the Coyotes.
- The 5,000-seat venue is managed and operated by Oak View Group, SCI Architects have designed the arena, while Mortenson Construction will serve as the design builder.
- The second full-size ice sheet will also be accessible to students, the community and youth ice hockey programs at every level, providing an additional public sheet to one of the fastest-growing states for youth hockey participation in the country.
- The seating configuration for Mullett Arena includes 20 luxury suites, two group suites, a large club lounge and event-level premium club seats. The club lounge will consist of a Center Ice Club on the main concourse that runs along center ice and can host up to 500 fans. On the 300-level, a social deck will run the length of the east side of the venue, providing an open-air, aerial view of the arena where fans can interact while still experiencing exceptional sightlines to the competition. The arena would also be able to serve as a backup for sports played on hardwood, such as volleyball.
- · A 942-seat student section occupies the entire west side of the venue to provide an enhanced gameday experience for ASU students.
