SCOUTING THE SERIES

The No. 10/11 Arizona State ice hockey team (16-3-5) will faceoff against No. 18 Cornell in another top-20 tilt this weekend. The Sun Devils previously went head-to-head against the Big Red in the Adirondack Winter Invitational championship on Dec. 30 where ASU won in a shootout. Puck drop is slated for 7 p.m. MST on Friday and 5 p.m. MST on Saturday at Mullett Arena. Both games can be streamed on ASU's free Pac-12 Live Stream or listen in on the Sun Devil Hockey Radio Network, Fox Sports 910.

This will be the third series meeting between the two schools where the all-time record currently stands at 2-2-1. The championship game was neck-and-neck after three periods when the Sun Devils scored two unanswered goals to tie the game at 2-2, ultimately sending the game into extra minutes.

Jackson Niedermayer scored his third goal of the season to put the Sun devils on the board in the second period and Matthew Kopperud scored his tenth power play goal of the season 43 seconds into the third period to tie the game. Kyle Smolen put away the game-winner in the shootout to win the program's second-ever tournament win.

The Sun Devils quickly earned the program's third-ever tournament win this past weekend in the Desert Hockey Classic after defeating Harvard and Omaha. Kyle Smolen once again netted the tournament winner in the 2-1 overtime win. ASU is currently 8-0-2 in its last 10 games, the longest undefeated streak in program history (10 games), and have not lost since Nov. 26.

TOP IN THE COUNTRY

The Sun Devils completed an undefeated month of December with four wins and four ties, punctuated by the championship victory at the inaugural Adirondack Winter Invitational to end 2023. The ASU team continues to rank amongst the top in the country in numerous categories:

- Team points leader Lukas Sillinger stands at fourth in the NCAA with 28 pts. His 102 career points is tied at No. 7 amongst active career point scorers.
- Brandon Tabakin's +23 plus/minus is No. 1 in the country. He has never finished a game less than even this season.
- Matthew Kopperud's 10 power play goals this season ranks No. 1. His 34 career power play goals makes him the active career leader in PPG in the country. His 53 goals is third in active career goal scoring.
- Lukas Sillinger and Tim Lovell are tied at No. 3 in assists with 22
- Brian Chambers' 252 faceoff wins ranks fourth in the NCAA
- TJ Semptimphelter is No. 4 in the country in goaltender winning percentage at 77.5 percent. His 14 wins this season is second in the NCAA. With eight career shutouts, Semptimphelter is tied at fifth in the NCAA in career shutouts. His three shutouts this season is tied for second in the country
- Tyler Gratton and Matthew Kopperud are tied at No. 12 in the country in goals with 12 each

THIRD LINE MAGIC

Last weekend, the third line of Benji Eckerle, Ryan O'Reilly, and Kyle Smolen carried the Sun Devil offense, scoring six of ASU's seven goals and tallying 10 total points. O'Reilly tallied two goals in a single game for the first time in his collegiate career on Friday night against Harvard. Smolen made the same feat against the Crimson as the pair scored four of ASU's five goals against Harvard. The next night, Smolen netted

the game-winning goal in overtime to seal the Desert Hockey Classic championship for the Sun Devils. Benji Eckerle tallied two assists and finished the weekend as a +4, boosting his season plus/minus to +10, the second-highest on the team.

COMEBACK KIDS

In three of the last four games, the Sun Devils have come from behind to win. Two weeks ago at the Adirondack Winter Invitational, the Sun Devils were down 2-0 in the second period against both Clarkson and then-No. 17 Cornell, but came back to win against the Knights and tie the Big Red while collecting the shootout win. ASU found itself in the same scenario down 1-0 to Omaha at the beginning of the third period. Thanks to an early goal from Ryan O'Reilly, ASU was able to push the game to overtime and collect an overtime win courtesy of Kyle Smolen.

ACADEMIC WEAPONS

Off the ice, the hockey team competes in the classroom as the team earned a collective semester GPA of 3.44. The group carries a cumulative GPA of 3.52, including eight players who earned a 4.00 semester GPA in Fall 2023. Eighty-six percent of the team earned a 3.00 or higher.

RECORD CHASE

Tim Lovell (22A) is two assists away from breaking Brinson Pasichnuk's single season record for assists (23A) set in 2019-20. Matthew Kopperud is four power play goals away from breaking the program record he set for most power play goals in a single season with 13 in 2021-22. TJ Semptimphelter is one shutout away from setting a program record for career shutouts. The record is set at eight by ASU alum and current NHL Seattle Kraken netminder Joey Daccord.

BETWEEN THE PIPES

Junior goaltender TJ Semptimphelter continues to dominate the net as he picked up several more wins in the past few weeks, maintaining his current standings for winning percentage nationally. The Sun Devils are currently 9-2-2 this season when Semptimphelter records 25+ save games. He also has 21 career 30+ save games with seven recorded in the 2023-24 season.

HEAD COACH GREG POWERS

Coach Powers enters his ninth season as the head coach of the Division I program in 2023-24, and his 16th overall at the helm at ASU. He was a finalist for the 2019 and 2020 Spencer Penrose Award, which is awarded to the Division I Coach of the Year. Coach Powers was also named the 2018-19 Frank Kush Sun Devil Coach of the Year, as voted on by the 26 head coaches at Arizona State. On July 7, 2022, Arizona State University and Greg Powers agreed to a five-year contract extension through the 2026-27 season. In 2021-22, Powers led ASU to five-straight wins versus USCHO.com Top-20 opponents in 2021-22 for the first time in program history (the previous record for consecutive wins against ranked opponents was three-straight games). In 2021-22, the team boasted three of the top-10 scorers in the nation in Colin Theisen. Matthew Kopperud and Josh Doan. ASU scored 116 goals in 35 games for a 3.31 goals per game average, ranked No. 10 in the country. Under Powers, ASU became the fastest start-up collegiate hockey program to qualify for the postseason in 2018-19. At 21-13-1 and No. 10 in the Pairwise rankings, the Sun Devils made the largest jump in all of NCAA Division I year-to-year up from No. 53 at the end of 2017-18. During the 2013-14 season, Coach Powers helped guide the Sun Devils to their firstever ACHA Division I National Championship. Himself a Sun Devil, Powers graduated from the Walter Cronkite School of Journalism in 1999 and was inducted into the ASU Hockey Player Hall of Fame in in 2009. Collegiately, Greg was a three-time ACHA Division I All-American Goaltender while playing for the Sun Devils under the tutelage of Hall of Fame Head Coach Gene Hammett. The Sun Devils qualified for three national championships during Powers' four-season collegiate career, and he was named Team MVP for the 1996-1997 and 1997-1998 seasons.

BREAKING GROUND

- On Wednesday, Dec. 16, 2020, Arizona State University and Sun Devil Athletics announced all required approvals have been received for the
 commencement of construction on a new Multi-Purpose Arena, which will host university and community events and serve as the future home for Sun
 Devil men's ice hockey and wrestling. This project continues the development of the Novus Innovation Corridor, and will be sited south of Rio Salado
 Parkway on the east side of Packard Drive, immediately north of the existing Packard Drive Parking Structure.
- Construction began in January 2021 and recieved its certificate of occupancy on Friday, September 30, 2022.
- Over 8,000 square feet is set aside for a ASU state-of-the-art ASU locker room, weight room, lounge and coaches' offices on the north side of the arena.
 Eight additional locker rooms are accounted for on the west side of the arena between the main arena and community ice sheet that can be utilized for visiting teams, youth programs, ASU club programs, and live events.
- On February 14, 2022, ASU and the NHL's Arizona Coyotes formed the first agreement of its kind between a college and NHL team in 100 years. The last time an NCAA college team and an NHL team shared an arena was the Boston Bruins and Boston University from 1924-28 at Boston Arena, now known as Matthews Arena. Other improvements will now be made, at the Coyotes' expense, to prepare the arena to temporarily house Coyotes home games. These improvements include constructing coaches' rooms, equipment rooms, technology and other aspects of the new ASU arena according to NHL standards. The added cost is up to \$30 million, which will be paid in advance by the Coyotes.
- The 5,000-seat venue is managed and operated by Oak View Group, SCI Architects have designed the arena, while Mortenson Construction will serve as the design builder.
- The second full-size ice sheet will also be accessible to students, the community and youth ice hockey programs at every level, providing an additional public sheet to one of the fastest-growing states for youth hockey participation in the country.
- The seating configuration for Mullett Arena includes 20 luxury suites, two group suites, a large club lounge and event-level premium club seats. The club lounge will consist of a Center Ice Club on the main concourse that runs along center ice and can host up to 500 fans. On the 300-level, a social deck will run the length of the east side of the venue, providing an open-air, aerial view of the arena where fans can interact while still experiencing exceptional sightlines to the competition. The arena would also be able to serve as a backup for sports played on hardwood, such as volleyball.
- · A 942-seat student section occupies the entire west side of the venue to provide an enhanced gameday experience for ASU students.
