SUN DEVIL LACROSSE PREVIEW

Arizona State Lacrosse (3-3) is headed to Music City to take on Vanderbilt (3-2) on Sunday, March 11 at 10 am MST. The game can be viewed on ESPN+, and is the second road trip for the Sun Devils this season. ASU seeks their first road win of the 2024 season-- the last road win came on April 2, 2023 when the team defeated California 13-9. As an assistant coach at Florida, current head coach Taryn VanThof did not lose to Vanderbilt, with seven wins in her six-year stint.

Sun Devil Outlook:

ASU comes off back-to-back home losses to two ranked teams in No. 6 Michigan and No. 11 Florida. The Sun Devils led for nearly 55 minutes of regulation against the Wolverines, but fell in the final minutes. Senior attacker Mina Scott netted three goals in the game which marked the 11th hat trick for ASU this season. Sophomore attacker Lydia Oldknow also recorded a hat trick in the 22-6 defeat by Florida last weekend.

Scouting the Opponent:

The Commodores return home after a 21-3 defeat to No. 15 Johns Hopkins. Both losses for Vanderbilt have come on the road, as two weeks prior to facing Johns Hopkins, the team was taken down by Sun Devils' Pac-12 foe Stanford. Vandy is undefeated at home this season with wins over Kennesaw State and Central Michigan.

All-Time History:

The two programs have faced off just once before, which came in 2019 when the Sun Devils were faced with a 15-14 defeat at home on March 5, 2019 and nearly knocked off the undefeated Commodores at the time.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS:

-Senior attacker Mina Scott is 6th all-time in goals with 63, and 6th all-time with 76 points. No other active player is in the top-10 for all time goals or assists.
 -With 38 saves this season, junior goalkeeper Katie Vahle has increased her program-leading career save mark to 373 passing Berkeley Bonneau's 310.
 -With three wins in six games this season, Vahle is just two wins shy of tying Berkeley Bonneau's program-best 20 wins.
 -Zoe Mazur's 47 draw controls have her on the single-season leaderboard, sitting at eighth all-time behind Kaylon Buckner's 48, which came in 2022.

TEAM NOTABLES:

-ASU is seeking their first road win this season, and first since April 2, 2023 when the team defeated California in the 13-9 win.
 -The Sun Devils' 3-0 start to the season for the first time in program history, but was halted after a loss to Stony Brook last weekend.
 -In the first half, the Sun Devils have outscored their opponents 53-37, but get outscored 46-27 in the second half of play.
 -The Sun Devils have the third-best clearing percentage in the NCAA at 96.3%.

PLAYER NOTABLES:

-Zoe Mazur's 7.83 draw controls per game are the 12th-best individual mark in the NCAA and third best in the Pac-12.
 -Senior attacker Mina Scott leads the Sun Devils with 19 points (15G-4A) after recording one goal and one assist against Florida.
 -Attackers Mina Scott and Lydia Oldknow have the team-lead 15 goals, which is the eighth-most by a player in the Pac-12. The two each recorded a hat trick in the last week of play.

VanThof comes to Arizona State after an extremely successful six-year stint as the Assistant Coach at national power Florida. There she served as the Offensive Coordinator, Goalie Coach, Draw Specialist, and Recruiting Coordinator for the Gators.

“Thank you to Vice President for University Athletics Ray Anderson and Senior Associate AD/SWA Christina Wombacher for this opportunity to lead the Sun Devil Lacrosse program,” VanThof remarked. “I could not be more thrilled to coach at this extraordinary university.”

Under the direction of VanThof and Head Coach Amanda O’Leary, Florida has emerged as one of the nation’s premiere programs over the past six years. In 2022, the Gators made their fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament, earning a bid every year of VanThof’s tenure.
