SUN DEVIL MBB HOSTS NO. 5 HOUSTON

The Sun Devils will face a Top-25 opponent for the seventh time this season

Sun Devil Men's Basketball stays at home to take on No. 5 Houston on Tuesday at 7 PM MST. For the second time this season, Arizona State (12-13, 3-11) hosts a Top-5 team in Houston at Desert Financial Arena. This is one of only three remaining home games for the Sun Devils and represents a prime opportunity for a signature victory. The Sun Devils have four wins over Top-10 foes in the Bobby Hurley era.

THE MATCHUP

One of the premier matchups of the home slate features Top-5 Houston coming to Desert Financial Arena. This will be the first meeting between the two programs since 1986. In six previous contests, the two sides have each won three games. Houston last played in Tempe as part of the 1986 Kactus Classic. This is ASU's only game with the Cougars this season.

HOW TO FOLLOW

Arizona State is back on the national stage, as their game with No. 5 Houston on Tuesday, February 18 at 7 PM MST will be featured on ESPN2. It is the 15th time the program will be featured on national television so far in 2024-25. John Schriffen (play-by-play) and King McClure (analyst) are on the call. Make sure to listen to Tim Healey and Kyle Dodd on Arizona Sports 98.7 FM (KMVP).

Sun Devil freshman forward Jayden Quaintance is one of 15 players named to the Naismith National Defensive Player of the Year Watchlist. He is one of two freshman to make the list, joined by Duke's Cooper Flagg. The Big 12 has three representatives on the list, as Quaintance is joined by Iowa State guard Tamin Lipsey and Houston forward Joseph Tugler.

ONE OF ONE

Freshman forward Jayden Quaintance has proven to be one of the nation's most unique and versatile athletes. He is currently the ONLY PLAYER IN THE NATION averaging at least 9.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, and 2.8 blocks. He produces at that high of a level while playing 31.5 minutes per game. Quaintance is averaging exactly 9.5 points, 8.2 rebounds, and 2.8 blocks with room to spare on two of the three qualifiers.

BUYING "STOCKS"

Quaintance has combined for 87 'stocks' (62 blocks + 25 steals) in only 22 games so far this season. He is one of only two players in the nation (only high major conference player) to boast these numbers (60+ blocks and 25+ steals) despite missing three full games and exiting another with ten minutes remaining in first half. The only Power 4 + Big East player with similar numbers is Creighton senior center Ryan Kalkbrenner, with the same 87 stocks in three extra games (69 blocks + 18 steals). Another comparison is National Defensive Player of the Year candidate Johni Broome from Auburn, who has 80 stocks in 23 games (62 blocks + 18 steals).

WE WILL BLOCK YOU

Arizona State is first in the Big 12 and 26th nationally averaging 4.9 blocks per game. Freshman Jayden Quaintance is a big reason why, contributing a league-best 2.8. Basheer Jihad, Shawn Phillips Jr., and BJ Freeman each have ten or more blocks this season.

MR. RELIABLE

Senior guard Alston Mason has been a steady presence in the lineup for Head Coach Bobby Hurley at point guard. Mason has led the team in minutes in 21 of the 25 games and has played 38+ minutes on nine occasions, including another full 40 minutes of action on Saturday. He averages 36.4 minutes per game, tied with West Virginia's Javon Small (36.4) for the most

in the Big 12 and also Top-20 nationally (16th). Mason is also shooting a team-high 84.3% from the free-throw line, which is 7th in the Big 12.

DOUBLE A INSURANCE

Freshman Amier Ali has made the most of his increased playing time over the past three games, averaging 12.3 points per game. Ali recorded his first career double double against Oklahoma State, finishing with 12 points and 10 rebounds in 35 minutes. He was also 4-for-4 from the free throw line and added a steal and an assist. In the matchup with Texas Tech, he set a new career-high scoring 18 points on 6-of-7 shooting. He has led the Sun Devils rebounding in two of the past three games. He now has five games reaching double figures scoring coming off the bench.

FROM THE STRIPE

Over the past three games, Arizona State's ability to knock down shots from the free throw line has been a bright spot. The Sun Devils are a combined 46-of-56 (82.1%) from the line despite being on the road in hostile environments in two of the three games. The backcourt of Alston Mason and Joson Sanon have combined to go 20-of-21 (95.2%) from the stripe. Mason has made his last 24 free throws in a row, with his last miss coming in the second half against lowa State on January 25. Amier Ali is shooting 88% (23-of-26) at the line in Big 12 games and is 8-for-8 in the last 3 games.

THE HURLEY ERA

Bobby Hurley has won 167 games at ASU and is only the third coach in program history to reach the mark. He is now the second-winningest coach in program history.

HEAD COACH BOBBY HURLEY

One of the most recognizable names in college basketball history became the 14th men's head coach of the Sun Devil Men's Basketball program, as Arizona State named 1992 NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player Bobby Hurley as the head coach on April 9, 2015. What has followed is aggressive scheduling, lots of fast-paced hoops, playing hard, several big-time wins both home and away and back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for Arizona State for the first time since Byron Scott, Fat Lever and Alton Lister were starring in Tempe (1980-81 to be exact).

In his ten seasons as head coach, Sun Devil Men's Basketball has matched its highest ranking in school history (third in the Associated Press Poll in December of 2017), notched its best two average attendances in history (10,603 in 2017-18 is the ASU record), reached the NCAA Tournament three times, notched its best two non-conference wins in school history (vs. No. 1 Kansas on Dec. 22, 2018 and at No. 2 Kansas on Dec. 10, 2017) and defeated two eventual 2018 No. 1 seeds in a span of a few weeks (Kansas and Xavier).

Following a three-year drought without a First or Second Team Pac-12 All-Conference selection, ASU had at least one in six straight seasons under Hurley (2018-23) and Frankie Collins received Honorable Mention distinction in 2024. Hurley has coached two Pac-12 Sixth Man of the Year winners in addition to the 2019 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year (Lu Dort). Three Sun Devils have been selected to

A signature of Hurley's teams have been their successs in close games and ability to erase deficits. Arizona State is 40-20 (.666) in close games (two possesions or less) over the past five seasons. The 40 wins are a Top-10 total in the nation during that span. To take it a step further, ASU is 25-17 in two point or less games under Bobby Hurley. Arizona State has come back to win a game when trailing at halftime 44 times during the Bobby Hurley era. The 44 comeback wins place Arizona State in the Top-15 nationally since 2015-16.

- Houston's 11-game road winning streak ties for the longest in Big 12 history in Conference road games, matching two streaks from Kansas from 2020-21 and 2001-03. The Cougars are the nation's only undefeated team in true road games.
- -The Big 12 was represented with five of the top 16 seeds in the NCAA Bracket Preview, released prior to games of Feb. 15. Houston was tabbed as a No. 2 seed, Arizona and Iowa State were projected as No. 3 seeds and Kansas and Texas Tech were placed on the No. 4 seed line. The Big 12's five were one off the national lead and tied for the second-most among Conferences.
- Iowa State's Tamin Lipsey, Arizona State's Jayden Quaintance and Houston's Joseph Tugler were named to the Naismith Defensive Player of the Year Watch List on Feb. 5.
- The Big 12 embarks on its first season as a 16-team league, with league games starting December 30.
