THE NATIONAL MEET -- Thirteen-time national champion Augsburg University will compete at the NCAA Division III National Championships on Friday and Saturday, March 11-12 at the Alliant Energy Powerhouse in Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

Action begins at 11 a.m. (Central time) on Friday with preliminary rounds, and quarterfinal and wrestleback action at 6 p.m., determining the eight All-Americans in each weight class.

On Saturday, action continues at 10 a.m. with championship semifinals, consolation action and placing matches for third, fifth and seventh places. Parade of All-Americans will be at 6:30 p.m., with the 10 national championship matches scheduled to begin at 7 p.m.

AUGSBURG'S ALL-AMERICAN TRADITION -- Depth has always been a hallmark of the Augsburg men's wrestling program, and that has shown in the number of All-Americans -- finishers in the top eight of each weight class -- that the team has had in national competition. Augsburg has earned at least two All-Americans every year since 1988, and has had at least five All-Americans 30 of the last 33 years.

Augsburg has had at least one All-American in national competition every year since 1977 -- 45 straight years. Augsburg has now earned 264 wrestling All-Americans in program history (213 in NCAA competition, 38 in NAIA, 13 by the NWCA in 2020 and 2021).

AUGGIES WIN REGIONAL TITLE. QUALIFY SEVEN

WRESTLERS TO NATIONALS -- Qualifying individuals in seven of 10 weight classes to the national championships, the Augsburg wrestling team claimed its 19th straight NCAA regional title, winning the NCAA Division III Upper Midwest Regional crown on Feb. 25-26 at Wisconsin-Eau Claire.

Augsburg won the won the 18-team regional with 163.5 points. Augsburg has won the team title in its NCAA regional every year since starting regional competition in the 2002-03 season. Augsburg has now had seven or more national tournament qualifiers in 18 of the last 19 seasons.

Augsburg had four regional champions, two runners-up and two third-place finishers. In the two-day tournament, the Auggies combined for a 33-10 record, with seven pins, four technical falls and six major decisions.

Augsburg, ranked No. 6 in the final National Wrestling Coaches Association Division III national poll, is one of four schools with seven national tournament, joining top-ranked Wartburg (Iowa), No. 4-ranked Wabash (Ind.) and No. 5-ranked Baldwin-Wallace (Ohio). Coe (Iowa) and The College of New Jersey each have six qualifiers, and Nroth Central (III.), Johnson & Wales (R.I.), U.S. Coast Guard Academy (Conn.), Wisconsin-Eau Claire and Ithaca (N.Y.) had five qualifiers each.

The Auggies, winners of 13 Division III team national championships since 1991, have five seeded wrestlers, with No. 3-ranked 157-pounder **Tyler Shilson** (JR, Maple Grove, Minn./Centennial HS) and No. 4-ranked 174-pounder **Solomon Nielsen** (SR, Luverne, Minn./Luverne HS) each seeded fifth, No. 7-ranked 285-pounder **Tyler Kim** (JR, Burnsville, Minn./Apple Valley HS) seeded sixth, No. 7-ranked 141-pounder **Sam Stuhl** (JR, Ellsworth, Wis./Ellsworth HS) seeded seventh, and 125-pounder **Derek Steele** (FY, Winthrop, Minn./Sibley East HS) seeded eighth. Two Auggies both ranked 10th nationally -184-pounder **Nick Rogge** (SR, Eastman, Wis./Prairie du Chien HS) and 197-pounder **Bentley Schwane-beck-Ostermann** (JR, Loyal, Wis./Marshfield HS) -- are unseeded.

A two-time NWCA Division III All-American, Nielsen has qualified for his fourth national tournament. He went 2-2 in the 2019 NCAA tournament at 184 pounds and qualified for the 2020 tournament at 174, which was not held due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In 2021, he finished second at 174 pounds at the NWCA Division III national meet in Coralville, lowa.

Shilson, who competed at Division I schools Wisconsin in 2017-18 and Chattanooga (Tenn.) in 201-20, is competing in his second national tournament as an Auggie, after finishing third at 157 pounds at the NWCA meet last year.

Kim is competing in his second national tournament, after finishing second at 285 pounds at last year's NWCA tournament. Rogge is also competing in his second national tournament, after finishing fifth at 184 pounds at the 2021 NWCA meet. Schwanebeck-Ostermann is competing in his second national tournament, after finishing sixth at 197 pounds at last year's NWCA tournament.

Two Auggies are making their national tournament debuts -- Stuhl, a mid-season transfer from Division I North Dakota State at 141 pounds, and Steele at 125 pounds.

Augsburg University -- a tradition of men's wrestling excellence

Augsburg's men's wrestling team has dominated small-college competition over the last three decades.

- Augsburg has finished among the top two teams in men's wrestling national competition 26 times since 1975, winning national titles 13 times in NCAA Division III competition and earning runner-up honors 13 times (12 in Division III, once in NAIA). Augsburg finished among the top four teams nationally in Division III competition every year from 1989 to 2012.
- The Auggies have won 13 NCAA Division III national championships in the last 29 seasons (1991, 1993, 1995, 1997, 1998, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2005, 2007, 2010, 2015, 2019), the second-most in Division III history. Augsburg is one of only four NCAA schools to have won 10 or more college wrestling national titles (Oklahoma State has won 34 Division I team titles, while lowa has won 23 Division I team titles and Wartburg has won 14 Division III team titles). Augsburg has also finished second 12 times since 1984 and in the top 20 nationally (NCAA from 1983 to present, NAIA pre-1983) every year since 1971.
- Against opponents from Divisions II and III, Augsburg is 352-56-1 in dual meets since the 1989-90 season. Augsburg has lost just 52 matches to non-Division I opponents since the 1995-96 season.
- Against strictly NCAA Division III opponents, Augsburg is 338-55-1 since the 1979-80 season. Since the 1989-90 season, Augsburg is 263-45-1 against Division III opponents.
- Against opponents from the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, Augsburg is 215-7 since the 1975-76 season. In winning each of the 14 MIAC Team Dual Meet tournaments, Augsburg outscored its conference opponents by a 3,266-145 margin in going 68-0. The MIAC no longer sponsors an individual tournament and ended the MIAC Team Duals in the 2003-04 season.

Augsburg has a record of individual success nationally, both on the mat and in the classroom.

- Since Pat Marcy won the school's first NAIA national title at 150 pounds in 1972, Augsburg men's wrestlers have earned 56 individual national championships, including 52 NCAA Division III national titles, the most in Division III history (Augsburg has been an NCAA Division III member since 1983). Wartburg (Iowa) is second with 47 NCAA Division III individual titles, while Montclair State (N.J.) is third with 28, Brockport State (N.Y.) is fourth with 25, and The College of New Jersey is fifth with 22.
- Augsburg has earned 264 All-Americans in school history (since 1969; 38 NAIA, 213 NCAA, 13 NWCA). Augsburg has had at least one All-American in national wrestling competition (NAIA and NCAA) every season since 1977, and has had three or more All-Americans at 41 different national tournaments. At the 2005 NCAA Division III national championships, Augsburg earned All-Americans in all 10 weight classes for the first time in program history and just the second time in Division III history (Wartburg in 2003).
- Augsburg University has also been a success in the classroom. Over the past 35 seasons, Augsburg has produced 174 National College Wrestling Association (NWCA) Scholar All-Americans. Augsburg had eight Scholar All-Americans in 2020-21 and has had 153 athletes honored since 1997. Since the NWCA has awarded Division III academic team national championships, Augsburg has finished second four times and first twice (1998-99, 2011-12), including the 2011-12 academic national title with a team grade-point average of 3.7341 (4.00 scale). Augsburg finished second in the 2016-17 academic national race with a 3.46 team GPA. Augsburg has also had 12 College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-Americans in wrestling -- Dan Lewandowski (1996-97), Josh Cagle (1998-99 and 1999-2000), Jim Peterson (1998-99), Brian Jones (1999-2000), Mark Matzek (2004-05), Ryan Valek (2004-05 and 2005-06), Tony Valek (2010-11 and 2011-12), Victor Gliva (2017-18) and Sam Bennyhoff (2017-18).



Co-Head Coach Jim Moulsoff

- Jim Moulsoff (Minnesota '03) was named the 10th head coach in the history of the Augsburg University men's wrestling program in the fall of 2014, now serving as co-head coach with **Tony Valek**. The 2021-22 season is Moulsoff's 15th on the Augsburg coaching staff, serving as an assistant coach for one season under former head coach **Sam Barber** and six seasons under former head coach **Mark Matzek**. During his Augsburg coaching tenure, Moulsoff was a part of the 2009-10, 2014-15 and 2018-19 national title squads and national runner-up squads in 2008-09, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2016-17 and 2017-18, with 75 All-Americans (62 NCAA, 13 NWCA) and 14 national champions. Augsburg is 138-40-1 in dual meets in Moulsoff's 13 seasons on the staff, 73-17 as head coach.
- Moulsoff is a well-known figure in Minnesota's wrestling community, having served as a high school coach for 18 seasons before joining the Augsburg coaching staff in 2008. He was promoted to a full-time assistant coaching position prior to the 2010-11 season, serving as the top assistant coach on the Augsburg staff.
- In 2018-19, Moulsoff earned D3wrestle.com Division III National Coach of the Year honors, and earned NWCA Division III National Tournament Coach of the Year honors in both 2015 and 2019, and Rookie Coach of the Year honors in 2015. He also earned West Region Coach of the Year honors in 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17, and Upper Midwest Region Co-Coach of the Year honors in 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20. In 2013-14, Moulsoff was named West Region Assistant Coach of the Year by his coaching peers.
- Prior to joining the Auggie staff, Moulsoff spent 15 years as head coach of the Minnehaha Academy High School wrestling program (1993-2008). In the 2002-03 season, Moulsoff led the Redhawk program to a 12-5 dual meet record and earned the Metro Alliance Conference Coach of the Year honors. He was an assistant coach at Whapeton (N.D.) High School from 1990-93.
- In addition to his experience at the high school level, Moulsoff has been active as a coach in many levels of amateur wrestling and has served as the cadet director for Minnesota/USA Wrestling. A native of Breckenridge, Minn., Moulsoff wrestled at the North Dakota State College of Science from 1981-83, and earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Minnesota in 2003.



Co-Head Coach Tony Valek

- Tony Valek (Augsburg '12) was named the 11th head coach in the history of the Augsburg University men's wrestling program in the summer of 2019, joining Jim Moulsoff as co-head coaches. The 2021-22 season is Valek's ninth on the Augsburg coaching staff, serving as a graduate assistant coach from 2012-14, assistant coach in 2014-15, and associate head coach from 2015-19. During his Augsburg coaching tenure, Valek was a part of the 2014-15 and 2018-19 national title squads and national runner-up squads in 2016-17 and 2017-18, with 45 All-Americans (32 NCAA, 13 NWCA) and 10 national champions. Augsburg is 87-28 in dual meets in Valek's eight seasons on the staff, 14-4 as head coach.
- As an assistant coach, Valek earned National Wrestling Coaches Association Division III Region Assistant Coach of the Year honors in the 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19 seasons. He was named NWCA National Assistant Coach of the Year in the 2014-15 season. He was named NWCA Upper Midwest Region Co-Coach of the Year in 2019-20.
- As an Augsburg wrestler, Valek had a 136-25 career record, with 87 bonus-point victories (60 pins, six technical falls, 21 major decisions). He qualified for the NCAA Division III national championships all four seasons, earning All-American honors three times. He was a two-time national runner-up at 149 pounds (2010, 2011) and placed third in 2012. He earned NCAA Division III Great Lakes Regional titles in both 2010 and 2012.
- Academically, Valek was named the winner of the NCAA Elite 89 Award at the 2012 national championships, as the student-ath-lete competing with highest cumulative grade-point average. He earned NWCA Scholar All-America honors in 2010, 2011 and 2012, and earned College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Division III Academic All-America first-team honors and Academic All-District honors in both 2011 and 2012. Valek received his bachelor's degree in accounting and business management from Augsburg in 2012 and completed his master in arts of leadership at Augsburg in 2014.

The 2003 and 2004 MIAC championships were from the Team Duals tournament; the MIAC individual tournament ended in the 2001-02 season; the MIAC no longer sponsors wrestling as a championship sport.
