DUAL-MEET RECORD: 16-0

THE NATIONAL MEET -- Fifteen-time national champion Augsburg University will compete at the NCAA Division III National Championships on Friday and Saturday, March 14-15 at the Amica Mutual Pavilion in Providence, R.I.

Action begins at 9 a.m. (Central time) on Friday with preliminary rounds, and quarterfinal and wrestleback action at 4 p.m., determining the eight All-Americans in each weight class.

On Saturday, action continues at 9 a.m. with championship semifinals, consolation action and placing matches for third, fifth and seventh places. Parade of All-Americans will be at 5:30 p.m., with the 10 national championship matches scheduled to begin at 6 p.m.

Augsburg will attempt to win its third straight national championship, something it has done once before (2000-2002). Perennial rival Wartburg (Iowa) won four titles in a row from 2011-14, and three in a row from 2016-18.

AUGSBURG'S ALL-AMERICAN TRADITION -- Depth has always been a hallmark of the Augsburg men's wrestling program, and that has shown in the number of All-Americans -- finishers in the top eight of each weight class -- that the team has had in national competition. Augsburg has earned at least two All-Americans every year since 1988, and has had at least five All-Americans in 31 of the last 36 years.

Augsburg has had at least one All-American in national competition every year since 1977 -- 48 straight years. Augsburg has now earned 281 wrestling All-Americans in program history (230 in NCAA competition, 38 in NAIA, 13 by the NWCA in 2020 and 2021).

AUGGIES QUALIFY EIGHT WRESTLERS TO D-III NATIONALS -- Augsburg has eight NCAA Division III national tournament qualifiers this season. Augsburg has had seven or more national tournament qualifiers in 21 of the last 22 seasons.

This year's national tournament is slated to be an evenly-matched affair, as Augsburg's eight qualifiers are second to Wisconsin-La Crosse's nine qualifiers. Vermont State-Castleton also has eight qualifiers. Host Johnson & Wales (R.I.) has seven qualifiers, along with Loras (Iowa) and the College of New Jersey. Wartburg has six qualifiers, along with Alvernia (Pa.), North Central (Ill.), Ohio Northern and Stevens (N.J.).

Three Augsburg All-Americans return to the national championships for the third time in their careers. At 197 pounds, **Parker Venz** (SR, Farmington, Minn./Farmington HS) earned All-American honors last year with a seventh-place national tournament finish. This year, he enters the field as the No. 4 seed. Venz is 19-5 this season with 10 pins, three technical falls and one major decision; he is 88-33 in his career with 57 pins, 16 technical falls and three major decisions. Venz was a two-time state tournament qualifier and placewinner at Farmington HS, finishing third at 195 pounds in 2021 and fourth at 182 pounds in 2020.

At 165, **Cooper Willis** (JR, Kansasville, Wis./Union Grove HS) enters his third national tournament at 27-1 with six pins, five technical falls and eight major decisions. His only loss came in the finals of the Region VII Regional, as he was edged 6-4 by **Tanner Gerber** of UW-La Crosse in the finals. Gerber is the No. 2 seed at nationals at 165, while Willis is the No. 3 seed. Willis is a two-time All-American, finishing fifth nationally at 165 each of the last two seasons. He is 95-14 in his career, with 23 pins, 12 technical falls and 22 major decisions.

At 174, **Seth Goetzinger** (SR, Chatfield, Minn./Chatfield HS) enters his third national tournament at 21-4 with six pins, five technical falls and two major decisions. He finished second at the Region VII Regional to defending national champion **Jared Stricker** of UW-Eau Claire. Goetzinger finished seventh nationally at 174 each of the last two seasons, and is 93-25 in his Auggie career, with 43 pins, 11 technical falls and 11 major decisions. He is the No. 7 seed at 174 at the nationals.

Three Auggies won regional championships and qualified for the national tournament -- 149-pounder **Matthew Randolph** (FY, Jordan, Minn./Jordan HS (Scott West)), 184-pounder **Brandt Bombard** (JR, North Branch, Minn./North Branch HS) and 133-pounder **Chance Suddeth** (SO, Stoughton, Wis./Stoughton HS).

Randolph is 28-2, and will be seeded No. 4 at 149 at the national tournament. Randolph was a four-time state tournament placewinner at Scott West, finishing second at 106 (2021), 120 (2022) and 138 (2023) before winning the Class AA title at 145 in 2024. Bombard, seeded No. 3 at 184, is 24-5 this year, and is 50-22 with 11 pins, a technical fall and seven major decisions in his college career. He is making his first national tournament appearance. Suddeth is entering his second straight NCAA tournament at 133 pounds, with a 26-6 record this season. He is 47-16 in his career.

At 125, Wyatt Kaczrowski (SR, Seymour, Wis./Seymour HS) is competing in his second national tournament. He is 21-7 this season and is 92-50 in his college career. At 141, Cole Becker (JR, Albertville, Minn./St. Michael-Albertville HS) is going to the national meet for the first time. He was sidelined due to injury until early February, and will enter the national tournament with a 7-3 record. He is 67-13 in his college career.

Augsburg University -- a tradition of men's wrestling excellence

Augsburg's men's wrestling team has dominated small-college competition over the last four decades.

- Augsburg has finished among the top two teams in men's wrestling national competition 28 times since 1975, winning national titles 15 times in NCAA Division III competition and earning runner-up honors 13 times (12 in Division III, once in NAIA). Augsburg finished among the top four teams nationally in Division III competition every year from 1989 to 2012, and every year from 2017 to 2024.
- The Auggies have won 15 NCAA Division III national championships in the last 33 seasons (1991, 1993, 1995, 1997, 1998, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2005, 2007, 2010, 2015, 2019, 2023, 2024), tied with Wartburg (Iowa) for the most in Division III history. Augsburg is one of only five NCAA schools to have won 10 or more NCAA wrestling national titles (Oklahoma State has won 34 Division I team titles, while Iowa has won 24 Division I team titles, Wartburg has won 15 Division III team titles and Penn State has won 10 Division I team titles). Augsburg has also finished second 12 times since 1984 and in the top 20 nationally (NCAA from 1983 to present, NAIA pre-1983) every year since 1971.
- Against opponents from Divisions II and III, Augsburg is 387-58-1 in dual meets since the 1989-90 season. Augsburg has lost just 54 matches to non-Division I opponents since the 1995-96 season.
- Against strictly NCAA Division III opponents, Augsburg is 371-57-1 since the 1979-80 season. Since 1989-90, Augsburg is 296-47-1 against Division III opponents.
- Against opponents from the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, Augsburg is 218-7 since the 1975-76 season. In winning each of the 14 MIAC Team Dual Meet tournaments, Augsburg outscored its conference opponents by a 3,266-145 margin in going 68-0. The MIAC no longer sponsors an individual tournament and ended the MIAC Team Duals in the 2003-04 season.

Augsburg has a record of individual success nationally, both on the mat and in the classroom.

- Since **Pat Marcy** won the school's first NAIA national title at 150 pounds in 1972, Augsburg men's wrestlers have earned 59 individual national championships, including 55 NCAA Division III national titles, the most in Division III history (Augsburg has been an NCAA Division III member since 1983). Wartburg (Iowa) is second with 50 NCAA Division III individual titles, while Montclair State (N.J.) is third with 28, Brockport State (N.Y.) is fourth with 25, and The College of New Jersey is fifth with 23.
- Augsburg has earned 281 All-Americans in school history (since 1969; 38 NAIA, 230 NCAA, 13 NWCA). Augsburg has had at least one All-American in national wrestling competition (NAIA and NCAA) every season since 1977, and has had three or more All-Americans at 45 different national tournaments. At the 2005 NCAA Division III national championships, Augsburg earned All-Americans in all 10 weight classes for the first time in program history and just the second time in Division III history (Wartburg in 2003).
- Augsburg University has also been a success in the classroom. Since 1983, Augsburg has produced 222 National College Wrestling Association (NWCA) Scholar All-Americans. Augsburg had a school-record 20 Scholar All-Americans in 2023-24 and has had 199 athletes honored since 1997. Since the NWCA has awarded Division III academic team national championships, Augsburg has finished first three times (1998-99, 2011-12, 2021-22) and second four times, including the 2021-22 academic national title with a team grade-point average of 3.879 (4.00 scale).
- Augsburg has also had 17 College Sports Communicators (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-Americans in wrestling -- **Dan Lewandowski** (1996-97), **Josh Cagle** (1998-99 and 1999-2000), **Jim Peterson** (1998-99), **Brian Jones** (1999-2000), **Mark Matzek** (2004-05), **Ryan Valek** (2004-05 and 2005-06), **Tony Valek** (2010-11 and 2011-12), **Victor Gliva** (2017-18), **Sam Bennyhoff** (2017-18), **Tyler Shilson** (2021-22 and 2022-23 - AAA of the Year), **Charlie Stuhl** (2022-23 and 2023-24) and **Tyler Kim** (2023-24).



Head Coach Tony Valek

- **Tony Valek** (Augsburg '12) was named the 11th head coach in the history of the Augsburg University men's wrestling program in the summer of 2019, joining Jim Moulsoff as a co-head coach. He was named the solo head coach prior to the 2022-23 season. The 2024-25 season is Valek's 13th on the Augsburg coaching staff, serving as a graduate assistant coach from 2012-14, assistant coach in 2014-15, and associate head coach from 2015-19. During his Augsburg coaching tenure, Valek has been a part of the 2014-15, 2018-19, 2022-23 and 2023-24 national title squads and national runner-up squads in 2016-17 and 2017-18, with 62 All-Americans (49 NCAA, 13 NWCA) and 13 national champions. Augsburg is 122-30 in dual meets in Valek's 13 seasons, 49-6 as head coach.
- As an assistant coach, Valek earned National Wrestling Coaches Association Division III Region Assistant Coach of the Year honors in the 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19 seasons. He was named NWCA National Assistant Coach of the Year in the 2014-15 season. He was named NWCA Upper Midwest Region Co-Coach of the Year in 2019-20, and was named NWCA Upper Midwest Region Coach of the Year and The Open Mat NCAA Division III National Coach of the Year in 2022-23, and shared NWCA Upper Midwest Region Coach of the Year honors with UW-La Crosse head coach **Dave Malacek** in 2023-24.
- As an Augsburg wrestler, Valek had a 136-25 career record, with 87 bonus-point victories (60 pins, six technical falls, 21 major decisions). He qualified for the NCAA Division III national championships all four seasons, earning All-American honors three times. He was a two-time national runner-up at 149 pounds (2010, 2011) and placed third in 2012. He earned NCAA Division III Great Lakes Regional titles in both 2010 and 2012.

- Academically, Valek was named the winner of the NCAA Elite 89 Award at the 2012 national championships, as the student-athlete competing with highest cumulative grade-point average. He earned NWCA Scholar All-America honors in 2010, 2011 and 2012, and earned College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Division III Academic All-America first-team honors and Academic All-District honors in both 2011 and 2012. Valek received his bachelor's degree in accounting and business management from Augsburg in 2012 and completed his master in arts of leadership at Augsburg in 2014.



Associate Head Coach Jim Moulsoff

- **Jim Moulsoff** (Minnesota '03) was named the 10th head coach in the history of the Augsburg University men's wrestling program in the fall of 2014, and served as co-head coach with Tony Valek from 2019 to 2022. Prior to the 2022-23 season, he was named as associate head coach. The 2024-25 season is Moulsoff's 18th on the Augsburg coaching staff, serving as an assistant coach for one season under former head coach **Sam Barber** and six seasons under former head coach **Mark Matzek**. During his Augsburg coaching tenure, Moulsoff was a part of the 2009-10, 2014-15, 2018-19, 2022-23 and 2023-24 national title squads and national runner-up squads in 2008-09, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2016-17 and 2017-18, with 92 All-Americans (79 NCAA, 13 NWCA) and 17 national champions. Augsburg is 173-42-1 in dual meets in Moulsoff's 18 seasons on the staff, 73-17 as head coach.
- Moulsoff is a well-known figure in Minnesota's wrestling community, having served as a high school coach for 18 seasons before joining the Augsburg coaching staff in 2008. He was promoted to a full-time assistant coaching position prior to the 2010-11 season.
- In 2018-19, Moulsoff earned D3wrestle.com Division III National Coach of the Year honors, and earned NWCA Division III National Tournament Coach of the Year honors in both 2015 and 2019, and Rookie Coach of the Year honors in 2015. He also earned West Region Coach of the Year honors in 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17, and Upper Midwest Region Co-Coach of the Year honors in 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20. In 2013-14, Moulsoff was named West Region Assistant Coach of the Year by his coaching peers.
- Prior to joining the Auggie staff, Moulsoff spent 15 years as head coach of the Minnehaha Academy High School wrestling program (1993-2008). In the 2002-03 season, Moulsoff led the Redhawk program to a 12-5 dual meet record and earned the Metro Alliance Conference Coach of the Year honors. He was an assistant coach at Whapeton (N.D.) High School from 1990-93.

- In addition to his experience at the high school level, Moulsoff has been active as a coach in many levels of amateur wrestling and has served as the cadet director for Minnesota/USA Wrestling. A native of Breckenridge, Minn., Moulsoff wrestled at the North Dakota State College of Science from 1981-83, and earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Minnesota in 2003.

Key dates in Augsburg University Men's Wrestling history

THE EARLY YEARS:

1949 -- Augsburg wrestling program is founded with Edor Nelson as the team's first head coach.

1961 -- First MIAC championship (Augsburg won 30 MIAC tournament championships and 14 MIAC Team Duals championships in the MIAC's wrestling history).

1963 -- Oscar Blegen named the second head coach in school history; Edor Nelson leaves after founding the program and producing one MIAC title and a 34-21 dual-meet record.

1967 -- Ron Pfeffer named the third head coach in program history; Oscar Blegen leaves after three seasons and a 19-22 dual-meet record.

1970s:

1970 -- First unbeaten dual-meet season (7-0-1; 10 unbeaten seasons so far in school history).

1971 -- First top-10 national tournament finish (7th in NAIA meet).

1971 -- Mike Good named the fourth head coach in program history and coaches the 1971-72 season (14-0-1); Ron Pfeffer leaves after five seasons, three MIAC titles and a 52-10-1 dual-meet record.

1972 -- Pat Marcy wins Augsburg's first individual national title (NAIA, 150 pounds).

1972 -- John Grygelko named the fifth head coach in Augsburg history.

1973 -- Augsburg wins school-record 20 dual meets (20-2) 1973 -- John Grygelko inducted into Minnesota Wrestling Coaches Association/David Bartelma Wrestling Hall of Fame.

1973 -- James Mastro competes on Greco-Roman squad at World University Games.

1974 -- First top-five national finish (5th in NAIA meet) 1974 -- Pat Marcy competes in his first of three U.S. world championship teams in Greco-Roman wrestling.

1975 -- NAIA national runners-up (highest national tourney finish to that point).

1975 -- Pat Marcy wins Pan American Games gold medal in Greco-Roman wrestling (68 kg class).

1976 -- Pat Marcy competes on U.S. Greco-Roman team at Montreal Olympics, places 10th; James Mastro is an alternate on the U.S. Greco-Roman team.

1977 -- 11-0 dual record, 7th-place national finish.

1978 -- 12-1 dual record, 18th-place national finish.

1979 -- 12-0 dual record, 3rd-place national finish.

1979 -- Jeff Swenson wins NAIA national title at 167 pounds.

1980s:

1980 -- Jeff Swenson is named the sixth head coach in Augsburg history; John Grygelko leaves after eight seasons, six MIAC titles and a 98-12-1 dual-meet record.

1980 -- 9-2 dual record, 17th-place national finish.

1981 -- 10-4 dual record, 5th-place national finish.

1982 -- 11-2 dual record, 7th-place national finish.

1983 -- Augsburg placed third in its last NAIA national tournament and third in its first NCAA Division III national tournament (its first top-four NCAA tournament finish), 15-0 dual record.

1984 -- 15-1 dual record, 2nd-place NCAA national finish.

1984 -- Brian Arvold named the seventh head coach in Augsburg history; he coaches the 1984-85 and 1985-86 seasons with a 1985 MIAC title and a 27-12 dual-meet record.

1985 -- 15-3 dual record, 9th-place national finish.

1985 -- Steve Gliva becomes Augsburg's first (and only) five-time All-American.

1986 -- 12-9 dual record, 16th-place national finish.

1986 -- Jeff Swenson returns to Augsburg as head coach.

1987 -- 10-5 dual record, 17th-place national finish.

1988 -- 11-4 dual record, 8th-place national finish.

1989 -- Augsburg places third at NCAA Division III national championships, beginning a streak of 24 top-four national tournament finishes, 12-0 dual record.

1990s:

1990 -- 12-0 dual record, 2nd-place national finish.

1990 -- John Beatty becomes Augsburg's first two-time national champion.

1991 -- Augsburg wins its first NCAA Division III national championship; Jeff Swenson named NWCA Division III National Coach of the Year; he would earn the honor six times in his career, 16-0 dual record.
