All-Americans and Players in the Pros

FRED FLEMMING '53 was a college division All-American in 1953 in the outfield; he was the first player from Bowdoin, and the first from a Maine college, to be so honored. He was drafted by the Detroit Tigers and was invited to three spring trainings with the Tigers. He played in their minor league system for several years, making it as high as AAA. **BOB BUTKUS '66** was a second team College Division All-American in 1966 as a pitcher. He was drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates and pitched four innings in a Pirate uniform during an exhibition game against the Cleveland Indians. He gave up four hits, one run, walked none and struck out two. **TOM ALDRICH '88** was a second team All-American in 1988, and a first team All-New England selection in 1987 and 1988. He was drafted by the Detroit Tigers and played three years in their minor league organization. **BRUCE MACLEAN '67**, a pitcher, was drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in 1966 and played in their minor league system. **RON WOODS '59** was drafted by the Chicago White Sox and played in their minor league system. **BOB KENNEDY '60** was signed by the Chicago White Sox and played in their minor league system. **ANDY LANO '52** was signed by the Cleveland Indians and played in their minor league system. **BO MCFARLAND '69** was signed by the Kansas City Royals. **EDDIE FILES '08** appeared in two games as a pitcher for the Philadelphia Athletics in 1908, going hitless and earning no decisions. **SQUANTO WILSON '12** made two appearances in the majors, in 1911 with the Tigers and in 1914 with the Red Sox. He was 3 for 16 lifetime, with no extra base hits. **MATT MacDONALD '98** was a Division III Second Team All-American (First Team All-Region) after his record-breaking 1997 season. **DAVID DeCEW '99** was a first team All-New England selection and led the country in batting his senior year with a .553 average. **LEROY DYER '56** was signed by the Milwaukee Braves and saw action in their minor league affiliate team, the Waycross Braves of the Georgia-Florida league in 1958.

Head Coach **DANNY MACFAYDEN** was an excellent major league pitcher for 17 years, compiling a 132-159 record for the Red Sox, Yankees, Boston Braves, Pittsburgh Pirates and Washington Senators. In 1932, he was 16-12 with 17 complete games for the Red Sox. In 1929, his four shutouts led the league. In 1936, he was 17-13 with a 2.87 ERA for the Boston Braves, and in 1938 he was 14-9 with a 2.95 ERA. As a hitter, he was a lifetime .142 hitter, with 1 career home run.
