2007 PREVIEW

In 2007, the Capital University football team looks to reload rather than rebuild in its efforts to challenge for an Ohio Athletic Conference championship and make a third-straight trip to the NCAA Division III Football Playoffs.

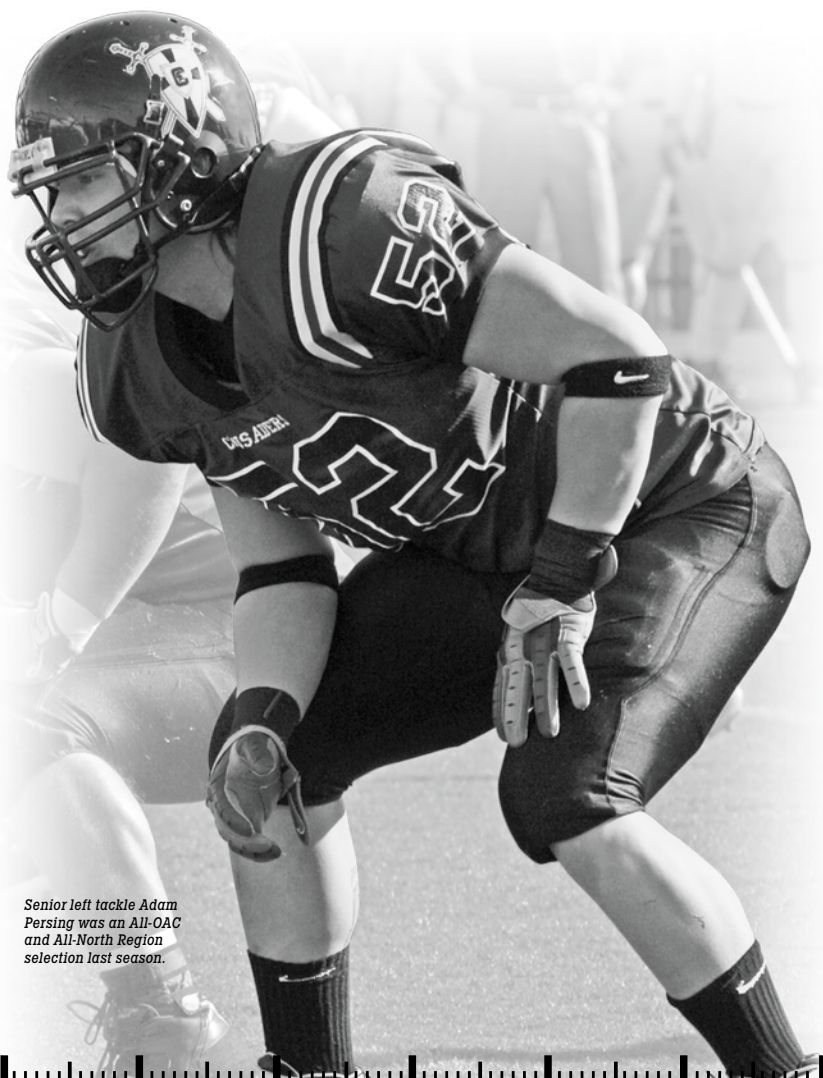
The Crusaders finished last year ranked No. 3 in the nation, a school-record 11 wins and a second straight appearance in the NCAA Playoff National Quarterfinals, but must replace two-time All-American quarterback and OAC all-time passing leader Rocky Pentello; the OAC's all-time interception leader in All-American safety Kyle Hausler; Kyle's twin brother Thom Hausler, who was the eighth player in NCAA Division III history with over 1,000 punt and 1,000 kickoff return yards in a career.

The cupboard is far from bare at Capital as a trio of All-Americans in defensive back James Starks, wide receiver Derick Alexander and placekicker Matt Spitz return for their senior seasons.

Starks led the team in interceptions last year and along with fellow seniors in defensive back Matt Coleman, linebacker Eric Andriacco, defensive linemen Nick Bucci and Zac McKenzie join junior linebacker Pete Ankrom as the six returning starters on the defense. Andriacco and Bucci were all-region selections last year, while McKenzie was an All-OAC pick.

Alexander, left tackle Adam Persing and left guard Will Smith are the three returning starters on offense. Alexander, the third receiver in school history to post over 1,000 yards receiving in a season, and Persing were All-OAC First Team and all-region selections. Sophomore quarterback Marty Assmann is projected to be at the helm of the nation's No. 5 rated offense from a year ago.

Spitz is a two-time All-American that bested his own school-record for kicking points in a season with 85 points and is 6-for-8 over the last two seasons in field goals over 40 yards. Along with Spitz, junior punter Shaun Stencil also returns.



Senior left tackle Adam Persing was an All-OAC and All-North Region selection last season.

Capital University enters its 81st season as a member of the Ohio Athletic Conference in 2007-2008. The OAC is the nation's third-oldest collegiate athletic conference and from its beginnings in 1902 has never wavered in its focus on the entire development of the student-athlete. The conference's unparalleled success of all of its members on and off the playing field has made the OAC one of the nation's finest college conferences.

The OAC is predated only by the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association (1888) and the Big Ten (1895). The OAC is older than the Rose Bowl, the World Series and even the NCAA itself and has survived two world wars, the Great Depression, the Korean War and the Vietnam Conflict. From a modest beginning of six charter members in 1902, the OAC grew to as many as 24 members in the mid-1920s. Through the years a total of 31 colleges and universities at one time or another have been members of the OAC. Currently, the conference consists of 10 members: Baldwin-Wallace College, Capital University, Heidelberg College, John Carroll University, Marietta College, Mount Union College, Muskingum College, Ohio Northern University, Otterbein College and Wilmington College.

Case Tech's football team won the OAC's first conference title with a 5-0-0 record. Outdoor track was added a year later and a third sport, cross country, became a conference sport in 1914. More sports were steadily added to the OAC's repertoire throughout the years, culminating in the addition of women's sports in 1984. The OAC currently sponsors championships in 21 sports, 11 men's and 10 women's. All 10 of the OAC institutions were founded in the 19th century and have long and outstanding academic reputations.

While maintaining these high academic standards, Ohio Athletic Conference athletic teams and athletes consistently have enjoyed a great deal of success on a regional and national level. The athletic competition is viewed not as an end in itself, but as an extension of the educational programs.

The entire CAP Family has and continues to embrace the fine athletic and academic values that make the OAC one of the finest conferences in the nation.

2006 REVIEW

FOOTBALL POSTS ANOTHER RECORD-BREAKING SEASON IN 2006

For the second straight season, Capital University's football team set a school record for wins and advanced to the Division III national quarterfinals.

Despite a 17-14 loss to the nation's No. 1 team and Ohio Athletic Conference rival Mount Union College in their final game, the Crusaders eclipsed last year's then-record 10 wins, finishing the season with an 11-2 mark and hosting postseason games for the first time since the 1970 Stagg Bowl.

The Crusaders maintained a top-five national ranking the entire season, bolstered by several tight wins on the road. Trailing by a score of 21-17 at John Carroll University, senior quarterback Rocky Pentello connected with senior tight end Dylan Kelly (Hilliard/Darby) for the game-winning touchdown with less than a minute left. A week later, Pentello and junior receiver Derick Alexander hooked up on a 69-yard strike in the fourth quarter to take a 17-10 lead, and win, over Ohio Northern University.

After finishing its regular season with a 9-1 mark, Capital earned the second seed in the Mount Union bracket and the right to have two playoff games at Bernlohr Stadium. After defeating Wittenberg University 32-14 in the opening round of the NCAA Playoffs, the Crusaders advanced to face North Central (Ill.) College in a rematch of a playoff contest from last season. While last year's game, a 21-19 Crusaders win, was close throughout, Capital took charge early in this matchup and won 41-13.

Pentello finished his collegiate career ranking as the third all-time passing leader in Division III history with 12,569 total yards, which also ranks 12th in all divisions. He completed over 64 percent of his passes this season and threw for 3,625 yards and 36 touchdowns.

Alexander, in his first season with Capital, led the team with 67 catches and 1,093 yards and added 11 touchdown catches. Senior Mike Niedzwiecki made 64 catches for 894 yards and a team-best 12 touchdowns, while Kelly accounted for 778 yards and 10 scores.

A pair of senior running backs in Jeremy Mulkey and Charlie Smith carried the load for Capital's rushing attack, combining for almost 1,200 yards rushing and 17 touchdowns, helping the offense finish the season with 34.9 points per game.

Capital's defense also played a major role in the team's success, limiting opponents to just 12.2 points per game and forcing 28 turnovers. Senior safety Thom Hausler led the team with 80 tackles and senior lineman Nick Bucci finished with 11.5 of the team's 33 sacks. Junior corner James Starks helped anchor the secondary, accounting for four interceptions on the season and registering 73 tackles.

Junior kicker Matt Spitz broke his own school record with 80 total points, including 12 made field goals.

Sixteen Crusaders players earned All-OAC honors this season, including Pentello, who was named the Mike Gregory Outstanding Offensive Back of the Year. Head coach Jim Collins was named the OAC Coach of the Year for the third time in his 10 seasons leading the Crusaders.

Quarterback Rocky Pentello led the nation in passing yards in 2006 with 3,625 yards.

COACHING STAFF



JIM COLLINS

HEAD COACH

Entering his 11th season as head coach, Jim Collins has been the architect behind the rebuilding of the Capital University football program into one of the elite programs in the Ohio Athletic Conference and all of NCAA Division III.

In each of the last two seasons, Collins has led Capital to back-to-back appearances in the NCAA National Quarterfinals where each time the Crusaders lost by three points to the eventual national champions. In 2005, the Crusaders were 2-2 then won six-straight games to finish 8-2 and earn an at-large bid to the NCAA Playoffs. In the playoffs, Capital was the only team to win back-to-back road games and knock off a pair of conference champions to get there. In 2006, Capital had its best season in school history, going 9-1 in the regular season then hosted the first-ever post-season games at Capital in 36 years, posting impressive first- and second-round victories before a 17-14 loss at eventual national champion Mount Union College. The Crusaders finished the campaign with an 11-2 record and ranked No. 3 in the national polls.

The playoff runs over the last two seasons are just the latest highlights in Collins' tenure as head coach. Under his watch, Capital has had six-straight winning seasons, posting a 27-5 home record over that time and he was named OAC Coach of the Year in 2001, 2003 and 2006. He was the AFCA North Region Coach of the Year in 2005 and Football Gazette North Region Coach of the Year and the Lee Tressel Ohio College Coach of the Year in 2006.

Collins' enthusiasm, contagious positive attitude and strong work ethic are evident throughout the entire Capital football program but particularly in the offense for which he is offensive coordinator. Collins' teams have rewritten the school record books, setting more than 40 records over the past eight years.

His program's accomplishments are not limited to the field as more than 50-percent of the roster maintains a 3.00 grade point average or better. Collins also has written numerous articles on coaching, served as the North Region chair of the NCAA Division III National Football Committee and is currently a member of American Football Coaches Association Coaches Council that helps act as a legislative liaison with the NCAA and develop the program for the annual convention.



JIM BICKEL

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH/DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Jim Bickel is in his seventh season as associate head coach, defensive coordinator and assistant athletic director at Capital.

Bickel's impact on the Capital program has been a smart, aggressive defense that has produced a national defensive player of the year, an All-American player in each of the last six seasons and four years ago a school-record 27 interceptions on his way to OAC Assistant Coach of the Year honors.

Bickel has been a part of college football in Central Ohio for the past 31 seasons, beginning in 1977 when he became an assistant coach at his alma mater, Denison University in Granville, Ohio. In 21 seasons with the Big Red, Bickel coached both the offensive and

defensive lines for a combined nine seasons and was defensive coordinator for 12 seasons. Through his tenure as defensive coordinator, Denison won a pair of North Coast Athletic Conference Championships (1985-86) and one NCAA Division III Playoff appearance (1985). Aside from his football coaching duties, he was an assistant professor of physical education and an assistant baseball coach. In 1999, Bickel came to Columbus to become the defensive coordinator at Otterbein College. In 2000, his Cardinal defense led the OAC in passing defense and was third in total defense. A certified strength and conditioning specialist, he was also the team's strength and conditioning coach, an instructor within the department of physical education and intramural sports director.

Bickel also serves as assistant athletic director at Capital and is responsible for game management for the Crusaders' eight spring sports (baseball, softball, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's golf and men's and women's track & field).

The Newark, Ohio, native holds a bachelor's degree from Denison (1977) in speech communications and economics and a master's degree in physical education from Ohio State (1981). He and his wife, Kathy, reside in Columbus and have three grown children and six grandchildren.

Collins, his wife Brooke and their three sons, 14-year old Zach, 11-year old Ryan and six-year old Brady reside in New Albany.

Entering its seventh year, The Capital Center is a 126,000-square-foot recreational and athletic complex that includes a 2,100-seat arena, Bernlohr Stadium, a 51,000-square-foot multipurpose forum, a 5,000-square-foot fitness center, and a multitude of offices, classrooms and hospitality areas.

The 2,100-seat arena is home to the women's volleyball and men's and women's basketball programs. The arena has a pair of hospitality suites, a pair of broadcast booths and a camera booth with approximately 175 chair-back stadium seats and the remaining bleacher seating.

Football and men's and women's soccer play on a state-of-the-art artificial surface called AstroPlay in Bernlohr Stadium. Within a brick grandstand are two observation decks, a hospitality suite and press box. The stadium includes a three-lane track around the field perimeter for fitness and recreation endeavors.

Functionality and usability are the key in the multipurpose forum, as the infield of the NCAA regulation indoor track has four courts with lines for basketball, volleyball and tennis. Suspended from the ceiling is netting that can split the area into a multitude of configurations for a variety of events, as well as a pair of hitting cages for baseball, softball and golf. Part of the forum also makes up 1,200 square feet of the fitness center with a complete cardiovascular area filled with treadmills, Stairmasters and a universal unit. The remaining 3,800 square feet of the fitness center is a room complete with weight training equipment from Hammer Strength.

The health and sport sciences department calls The Capital Center home with a complete sports medicine and athletic training center, sports science laboratory, classrooms and more than ample space for activity classes. The athletic department also has an office suite with a conference room and administrative work areas.

Like many facilities, it is the small things that separate the adequate from the memorable. The Capital Center with its towers of brick and plaster, terrazzo flooring, hand-painted tile, skylights and enormous walls of glass not only pays homage to the tradition and architecture of the 177-year-old university, but also provides a functional and modern place for Capital to reach new horizons.

Capital's vision has been simple – to have a center that is an integral part of university life, encompassing health and wellness activities, academic programs, intercollegiate athletics, intramural sports, social activities and community partnerships. The Capital Center embodies that vision and is a testament to the dedication, values and commitment to service of the entire CAP Family.
