## 2008 PREVIEW

In an off season of change, Capital University's football program hopes one thing does not change in 2008; that the Crusaders are challenging for an Ohio Athletic Conference championship, continuing a run that has included three-straight trips to the NCAA Playoffs and staying among the nation's elite NCAA Division III programs.

The biggest change has been at the top as Jim Bickel takes over as head coach after he served as associate head coach and defensive coordinator for the Crusaders for the last seven years. While the coaching staff has changed, one thing that has not changed at Capital is a talented group of returning players that include 51 letterwinners, with 10 starters back on offense, five starters back on defense and the punter.

Since coming to Capital, Bickel's defenses have been known as smart, aggressive and opportunistic units and last year was no exception as the Crusaders were the nation's No. 3 ranked defense. While the Crusaders need to find new starters at cornerback and on the line, the entire linebacking corps return led by seniors Pete Ankrom, Brett Welch and Eric Andriacco along with top returning tackler in junior Matt Heagen. All the safeties return as well, led by senior C.J. Steele and junior Ronnie Smith.

Former Crusader Manny Matsakis returns as offensive coordinator and has plenty to work with in implementing his new offense with 10 starters back that include the return of injured junior quarterback Marty Assmann and senior wide receiver Derick Alexander. Assmann was leading the OAC in passing yards and total offense when he was lost for the season during the fourth game, while Alexander, an All-American in 2006, played just one half of one game a year ago. Four of the five offensive linemen are back, runningbacks in junior Matt Merritt and senior Ty Parks both return along with a fleet of wide receivers including senior Mando Ancona and junior Evan Blake.

The Crusaders must find a replacement for All-American placekicker Matt Spitz, but most of the remaining special teams players return headlined by junior punter Tom Gantner.

Capital University enters its 82nd season as a member of the Ohio Athletic Conference in 2008-2009. The OAC is the nation's third-oldest collegiate athletic conference and from its beginnings in 1902 has never wavered in its focus on the entire development of the student-athlete. The conference's unparalleled success of all of its members on and off the playing field has made the OAC one of the nation's finest college conferences.

The OAC is predated only by the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association (1888) and the Big Ten (1895). The OAC is older than the Rose Bowl, the World Series and even the NCAA itself and has survived two world wars, the Great Depression, the Korean War and the Vietnam Conflict. From a modest beginning of six charter members in 1902, the OAC grew to as many as 24 members in the mid-1920s. Through the years a total of 31 colleges and universities at one time or another have been members of the OAC. Currently, the conference consists of 10 members: Baldwin-Wallace College, Capital University, Heidelberg College, John Carroll University, Marietta College, Mount Union College, Muskingum College, Ohio Northern University, Otterbein College and Wilmington College.

Case Tech's football team won the OAC's first conference title with a 5-0-0 record. Outdoor track was added a year later and a third sport, cross country, became a conference sport in 1914. More sports were steadily added to the OAC's repertoire throughout the years, culminating in the addition of women's sports in 1984. The OAC currently sponsors championships in 21 sports, 11 men's and 10 women's. All 10 of the OAC institutions were founded in the 19th century and have long and outstanding academic reputations.

While maintaining these high academic standards, Ohio Athletic Conference athletic teams and athletes consistently have enjoyed a great deal of success on a regional and national level. The athletic competition is viewed not as an end in itself, but as an extension of the educational programs.

Capital University has and continues to embrace the fine athletic and academic values that makethe OAC one of the finest conferences in the nation.

## 2007 REVIEW



### NATIONALLY RANKED FOOTBALL TEAM POSTS ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL SEASON

The Capital University football team wrapped up another successful season with an 8-3 record and a third consecutive trip to the NCAA Playoffs. The Crusaders were nationally ranked the entire season and posted their seventh straight winning season.

Capital became just the third Ohio Athletic Conference school to qualify for the NCAA tournament in three successive seasons, in addition to Mount Union and Baldwin-Wallace. The Crusaders traveled to play at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater in the first round, and trailed just 20-14 entering the fourth quarter before falling 34-14 to the nation's second-ranked team.

A thrilling victory in the regular season finale helped clinch the at-large bid into the playoffs, as Capital knocked off Baldwin-Wallace 17-16 when a two-point conversion attempt by the Yellow Jackets was unsuccessful in the game's waning seconds. The win came on the heels of another tight victory, as Capital held off Muskingum 19-13 the week before.

Hampered by injuries on offense, the Crusaders turned to the nation's third-ranked defense to carry the squad. Capital limited opponents to just 13.3 points per game and just 200 yards of offense per game while recording a school-record 50 sacks. Seven members of the defense earned All-OAC honors, including senior defensive back James Starks (Toledo/Toledo St. Francis). Starks received the Lee Tressel Award as the most outstanding defensive back in the OAC, finishing the season with a team-leading 65 tackles, seven tackles for loss, four interceptions, nine pass break-ups, two forced fumbles, and two blocked kicks.

Senior defensive tackle Jonathan Spring (Maple Heights/Trinity) was also a first-team selection, finishing with 52 tackles, 9.5 sacks and a team-best 18 tackles for loss. Senior defensive lineman/running back Zac McKenzie (Hilliard/Hilliard Darby), senior defensive lineman Nick Bucci (Hudson/Hudson), sophomore linebacker Matt Heagen (New Concord/John Glenn), and senior defensive back Matt Coleman (Westerville/Westerville South) were all named to the second team.

Bucci led the team with 10.5 sacks and had 15 tackles for loss, Heagen tied with Starks with 65 tackles, while Coleman tallied 48 tackles. McKenzie tallied 4.5 sacks and ran for 112 yards and two touchdowns.

Junior safety C.J. Steele (Hilliard/Bishop Watterson) was an honorable mention selection as he recorded four interceptions and 52 tackles.

Senior left tackle Adam Persing (Springfield Twp./Springfield Local) and senior placekicker Matt Spitz (Xenia/Xenia) were honored as first team selections on offense. Persing anchored the offensive line, while Spitz connected on 15 field goals this season and ranks among the top-five in Division III history in field goals made and percentage. Sophomore receiver Evan Blake (Kingston/Logan Elm) led the offense with 39 catches, 633 yards and five touchdowns and was an honorable mention selection.

Also picking up honors this season as members of the Academic All-OAC team were junior linebackers Pete Ankrom (Springfield/Springfield North) and Steve Payne (Howard/Danville) and sophomore quarterback Marty Assmann (Columbus/Bishop Hartley).

### JIM BICKEL

HEAD COACH

Jim Bickel is in his first season as head football coach after spending the previous seven seasons as associate head coach/defensive coordinator at Capital.

Bickel's impact on the Capital program has been a smart, aggressive defense that has produced a national defensive player of the year, an All-American player in each of the last seven seasons, a school-record 50 quarterback sacks in 2007 and a school-record 27 interceptions in 2002. Bickel has twice been named Ohio Athletic Conference Assistant Coach of the Year.

Bickel has been a part of college football in Central Ohio for the past 31 seasons, beginning in 1977 when he became an assistant coach at his alma mater, Denison University in Granville, Ohio. In 21 seasons with the Big Red, Bickel coached both the offensive and defensive lines for a combined nine seasons and was defensive coordinator for 12 seasons. Through his tenure as defensive coordinator, Denison won a pair of North Coast Athletic Conference Championships (1985-86) and one NCAA Division III Playoff appearance (1985). Aside from his football coaching duties, he was an assistant professor of physical education and an assistant baseball coach. 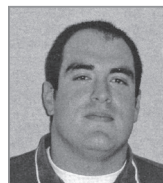


### HENRY STANFORD

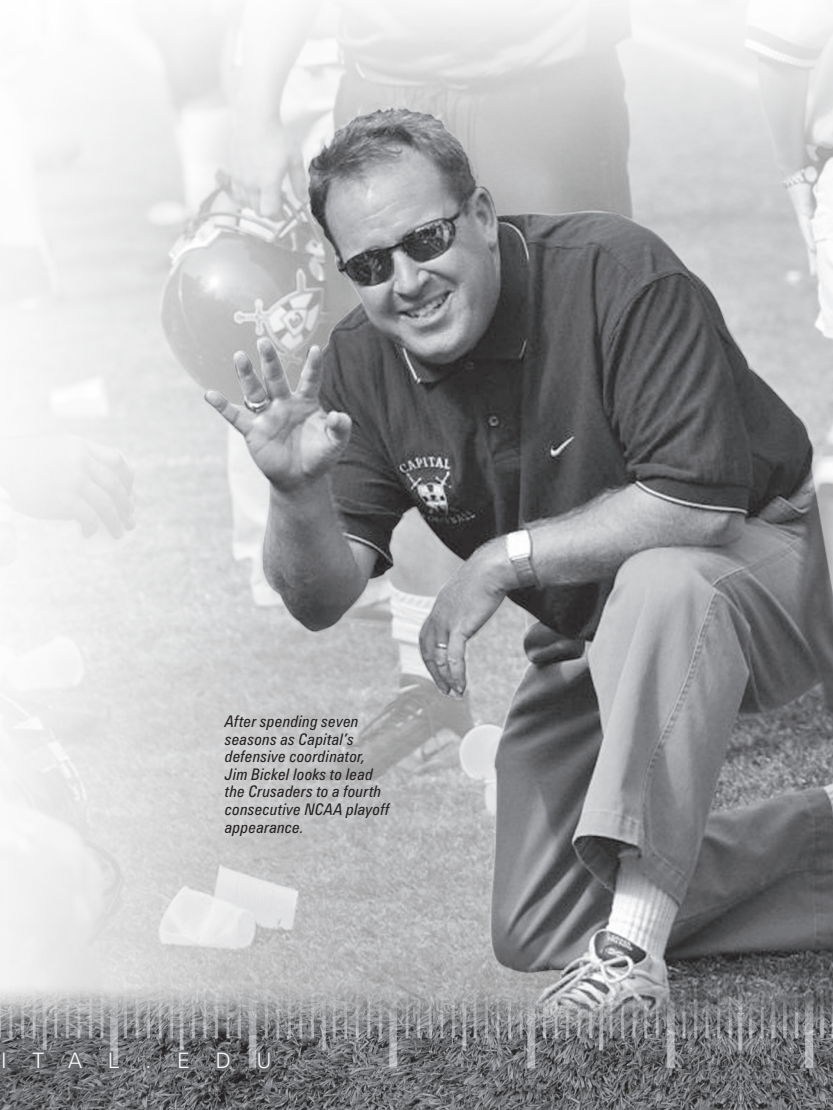


### ROBERT WHITE

### THE CAPITAL CENTER

Entering its eighth year, The Capital Center is a 126,000-square-foot recreational and athletic complex that includes a 2,100-seat arena, a 3,000-seat Bernlohr Stadium, a 51,000-square-foot multipurpose forum, a 5,000-square-foot fitness center, and a multitude of offices, classrooms and hospitality areas.

The 2,100-seat arena is home to the women's volleyball and men's and women's basketball programs. The arena has a pair of hospitality suites, a pair of broadcast booths and a camera booth with approximately 175 chair-back stadium seats and the remaining bleacher seating.

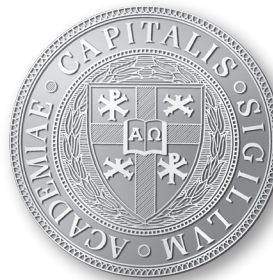
Football and men's and women's soccer play on a state-of-the-art artificial surface called AstroPlay in the 3,000-seat Bernlohr Stadium. Within a brick grandstand are two observation decks, a hospitality suite and press box. The stadium includes a three-lane track around the field perimeter for fitness and recreation endeavors.

Functionality and usability are the key in the multipurpose forum, as the infield of the NCAA regulation indoor track has four courts with lines for basketball, volleyball and tennis. Suspended from the ceiling is netting that can split the area into a multitude of configurations for a variety of events, as well as a pair of hitting cages for baseball, softball and golf. Part of the forum also makes up 1,200 square feet of the fitness center with a complete cardiovascular area, filled with treadmills, Stairmasters and a universal unit. The remaining 3,800 square feet of the fitness center is a room complete with weight training equipment from Hammer Strength.

The health and sport sciences department calls The Capital Center home with a complete sports medicine and athletic training center, sports science laboratory, classrooms and more than ample space for activity classes. The athletic department also has an office suite with a conference room and administrative work areas.

Like many facilities, it is the small things that separate the adequate from the memorable. The Capital Center with its towers of brick and plaster, terrazzo flooring, hand-painted tile, skylights and enormous walls of glass not only pays homage to the tradition and architecture of the 174-year-old campus, but also provides a functional and modern place for the university to reach new horizons.

Capital's vision has been simple – to have a center that is an integral part of university life, encompassing health and wellness activities, academic programs, intercollegiate athletics, intramural sports, social activities and community partnerships. The Capital Center embodies that vision and is a testament to the dedication, values and commitment to service of the entire CAP Family.
