Series History: 7-16

TUESDAY OVERVIEW

▶Elmira and SUNY Cortland will rekindle their non-conference rivalry inside Speidel Gymnasium.

▶The Soaring Eagles will play on their home hardwood for the first time in 2018-19, after starting the season with two road trips to the Buffalo area and one at Marymount University's Pablo Coto Tip-Off Tournament in Arlington, Virginia.

▶Last season, Elmira defeated Hilbert, 70-62, in the 2017-18 home- and season-opener. It marked the third consecutive home-opening win for the Soaring Eagles, dating back to the 2015-16 campaign.

▶The last time EC opened its home schedule against SUNY Cortland was in 2012-13, a game the Red Dragons won by a narrow 67-64 margin.

▶In the all-time series, SUNY Cortland leads Elmira, 16-7. However, the Soaring Eagles snapped a 15-game winless streak against the Red Dragons with a 70-68 victory in 2016-17. EC also beat Cortland last season, 82-77. on the road in Cortland, New York.

A LOOK AT LAST TIME OUT

▶The Soaring Eagles fell in the Pablo Coto Tip-Off Tournament consolation game against Ursinus College by a 62-53 final score.

▶EC outscored Ursinus in the second half, 32-27, but the second quarter made the difference for the Bears. Ursinus outscored the Purple and Gold, 15-6, in the second quarter alone, giving the team a 35-21 lead at halftime.

Elmira came within seven points, 57-50, with a minute remaining on a Lindsey Heaton 3-pointer, but the Bears made 5-of-6 foul shots down the stretch to seal the win.

▶ Heaton led all Soaring Eagles with 19 points, followed by Rachel Vespucci with 14 and Lauren Franklin with 10. For Heaton and Franklin, those point totals were single-game seasonhighs.

COACH DEVIN SHEA'S ELMIRA DEBUT

First-year head coach **Devin Shea** will be on the sidelines for her first game inside Speidel Gymnasium tonight vs. SUNY Cortland.

▶Shea took over the EC bench after spending three years as an assistant at Ithaca (2015-18). She began her coaching career as an assistant coach at St. Lawrence for two seasons (2013-15).

During her coaching tenure at Ithaca, the Bombers went 62-23 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament twice.

▶Shea was an Empire 8 All-Conference performer during her playing days at Ithaca. As a senior in 2012-13, she was named the E8 Tournament MVP and helped the Bombers reach the NCAA Tournament round of 16.

STARTING FIVE

- ▶ Early in the season, the Soaring Eagles have turned to the same starting lineup in three of the four games played.
- ▶ That group includes seniors Lindsey Heaton and Rachel Vespucci, juniors Bridget Yaw and Lauren Franklin, and freshman Alyssa Waters.
- ▶ Not only do these five make up EC's starting lineup, they are also Elmira's top-five leading scorers.
- ▶ Senior Sally Hogan has also made one start this year in place of Yaw in the season-opener at Hilbert.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

- ► With 45 rebounds this season, Rachel Vespucci has moved into third-place all-time in program history with 636 career boards.
- ▶ Vespucci has surpassed former teammates Meghan Loya '16 (597) and Danielle Cleary '18 (598), as well as Sherry Mackechnie '98 (621) so far this year.
- ▶ Vespucci is now chasing Martha Bolduc '97, the second all-time leading rebounder in team history, who hauled in 784 boards.

SCOUTING SUNY CORTLAND

- ▶The Red Dragons are coming off of a 15-11 season a year ago, which included a 12-6 record in State University of New York Athletic Conference (SUNYAC) play.
- ▶This year, the Red Dragons are under the direction of first-year head coach Jacey Brooks, who most recently spent the past five seasons as an assistant at Divison I Bowling Green State.
- ▶Brooks, a former standout player for the Buffalo State Bengals, also boasts coaching experience at Canisius and St. Bonaventure.
- ▶ Cortland's roster is deep with veteran experience, led by a core of eight seniors. Among them are twin sisters Justine and Shana Crespo, and Kristy Vitucci, three of the team's starters from last season
- ▶In their lone game thus far, the Red Dragons were defeated by fellow Empire 8 foe, Hartwick, by a 65-51 score on November 13.
- ▶ Cortland shot a mere 25.0 percent [17-of-68] from the field, including a 19.4-percent [6-of-31] effort from 3-point range in the loss.
- ▶ Justine Crespo and second-year guard Shannon McGuire led the team with 18 and 13 points, respectively, which are single-game career-highs for both Red Dragons.

SERIES HISTORY

ELMIRA VS. SUNY CORTLAND

- ▶ The Soaring Eagles trail SUNY Cortland in the all-time series, 7-16, but momentum has shifted in EC's favor in recent years.
- ▶ Elmira has won back-to-back games in the non-conference rivalry, which snapped a 15-game losing streak.
- ▶ The 82 points scored by the Purple and Gold in a win over Cortland last season are the most scored by Elmira in series history.
- ▶The two teams have met annually since the 2001-02 season.
