Series History: 16-9

WEDNESDAY OVERVIEW

▶Elmira returns home to host Keuka inside Speidel Gymnasium tonight at 7:00 p.m. for a non-conference game.

- ▶The Soaring Eagles are playing their third home game in the opening month of the season, but it marks their final game at Speidel until January 15.
- ▶EC has performed better at home so far in 2018-19, averaging more points per game (94.0-to-70.0), and shooting better in all three phases of the game. The Soaring Eagles have shot the ball at a rate of 50.7 percent from the floor, 44.8 percent from 3-point range, and 76.0 percent from the foul line in two games at home.
- ▶ Elmira will be playing Keuka for the second consecutive season. However, prior to last year's meeting, the Soaring Eagles and Wolves did not meet between 2009-16.
- ▶Today's game is the first in the series in Elmira since February 19, 2008. Each of the two most recent meetings, including last year's 70-68 loss to the Wolves, were played in Keuka Park, New York.

A LOOK AT LAST TIME OUT

- ▶EC faced a pair of quality opponents in the University of Rochester and Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute at U of R's Holiday Inn Rochester Downtown Tournament.
- ▶ Elmira opened the tournament with a solid first-half performance against the Yellow-jackets, scoring the first 10 points of the game and leading at halftime, 45-40.
- ▶ Rochester came from behind in the second half with a stingy defensive effort, limiting EC to 28 points in the second half en route to an 84-73 win.
- ▶In the tournament consolation game on Sunday, November 25, the Purple and Gold were unable to overcome a slow start against RPI, falling 84-76 to the Engineers.
- Although Elmira did not shoot the ball well, the Soaring Eagles kept themselves in the game with a noteworthy performance from the charity stripe.
- ▶EC made 31-of-36 foul shots, with the 31 makes not only marking a season-high, but the most for the Soaring Eagles in over 17
- ▶ Justin Porrett was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 16.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and 5.5 assists per game.
- ▶ Jeremy Every, who made 11-of-13 free throws against RPI, was second on the team in scoring with 14.0 points per game.
- Shawn Backus was EC's leading rebounder, collecting 8.0 rebounds per game to go along with a 12.0 points-per-game average.

BACKUS BREAKING OUT

- ▶Shawn Backus' freshman season was disrupted due to an early-season injury, but the second-year forward is hitting his stride in 2018-19
- ▶After averaging 7.1 points per game in 19 games last year, **Backus** has more than doubled his scoring production with 15.7 points per game as a sophomore.
- ▶Including the final two games of his freshman season, the Hamden, Connecticut, native has logged double-digit points in seven consecutive contests.
- ▶ Backus had his first double-double with 15 points and 13 rebounds in a home win over Penn College on November 13, and has tied a single-game career-high with 22 points on two occasions this season.

LANKY LINEUP

- ▶In both games of the Holiday Inn Rochester Downtown Tournament, Elmira head coach Randie Torgalski trotted out a new lineup rotation that boasted some added length.
- ▶This group included forwards Shawn Backus (6-foot-4), Henry Cuffee (6-foot-5), Matt Amoddio (6-foot-7), and Kyle McCreery (6-foot-8).

SCOUTING KEUKA

- ▶ The Wolves went 11-13 a year ago, thanks to a last-second 3-pointer that lifted Keuka over EC, 70-68, in the 2017-18 opener.
- ▶ Keuka finished fifth defensively in the North Eastern Athletic Conference (NEAC), allowing 73.2 points per game. Offensively, the Wolves were 11th in the 14-team conference with 70.7 points per game.
- ▶Through four games in 2018-19, Keuka has started 3-1 with an average of 71.0 points per game and 73.5 points per game against, nearly identical to last year's figures.
- ▶ Keuka's only loss so far was against No. 18-ranked Emory, 109-73, at Roanoke's Dick Leftwich Tournament in Salem, Virginia.
- ▶ Leading the charge is a 6-foot-8-inch senior forward, **Ryan Mansfield**, who transferred to Keuka after playing his first two seasons at Division II Ohio Dominican University.
- ▶ Mansfield is averaging a double-double with a team-leading 15.8 points and 10.8 rebounds per contest.
- ▶In an 86-84 win over Hilbert last time out on November 20, **Mansfield** recorded career highs in points (30) and rebounds (16), helping the Wolves overcome a halftime deficit.

SERIES HISTORY

ELMIRA VS. KEUKA

- ▶The Soaring Eagles lead the all-time series against Keuka, 16-9, through the first 25 games of the rivalry.
- ▶The Wolves have won the two most recent games against Elmira, both of which were played in Keuka Park, New York.
- ▶ Prior to the two-game skid, the Soaring Eagles had won seven in a row over Keuka, the longest win streak by either side in the series, which has been played annually since 1988-89.
