### SATURDAY OVERVIEW

- ▶The Soaring Eagles are seeking their third consecutive non-conference win on Saturday against Penn College.
- ▶ Saturday's contest is the final game of the 2018 portion of the schedule for Elmira. The Soaring Eagles will have nearly a month off, before returning to action on January 4.
- ▶ Today's meeting with the Wildcats is the final home game for EC until January 15, over five weeks until the Empire 8 Conference home-opener vs. St. John Fisher.
- ▶ Elmira's matchup against the Wildcats is the penultimate non-conference game of the 2018-19 season. The lone remaining non-league game is on Monday, January 7, at Keuka.
- ▶A win today would be the third in a row for the Soaring Eagles, which would be the longest win streak for EC since the start of the 2017-18 season, when the Purple and Gold opened with a 7-0 record.

#### A LOOK AT LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ The Soaring Eagles topped Wells, 58-45, for their third win overall and the team's first pf the season inside Speidel Gymnasium.
- ▶ Elmira shot 37.3 percent from the field (22-of-59), finishing with a slight advantage over the Express, who shot 32.7 percent (17-of-52).
- ▶ The EC defense logged a season-high 14 steals against the Express, while forcing Wells to turn the ball over 26 times, the most for an Elmira opponent in a game this year.
- ▶EC held Wells to just six points in the first quarter, outscoring the Express 16-6 after 10 minutes of action. Elmira led by as many as 17 points on several occasions in the second quarter, including a 33-16 advantage the Soaring Eagles took into the halftime break.
- Senior forward Rachel Vespucci netted a team-high 15 points and paced all players with a game-high 11 rebounds for her second double-double of the year.
- Lindsey Heaton and Lauren Franklin each came close to recording double-doubles; Heaton had 10 points with nine rebounds, while Franklin scored nine points with 10 boards.
- As a result of her performance in a 2-0 week for Elmira, **Heaton** was crowned the Empire 8 Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week. She averaged a teambest 14.0 points per game across EC's two wins vs. Clarks Summit and Wells.

#### ALL-AROUND CONTRIBUTIONS

- ▶Several young faces and bench players made contributions to Elmira's recent wins over Clarks Summit and Wells.
- Six different players scored off of the bench against Clarks Summit, including freshman Taylor Albrecht with five points, as well as Sally Hogan, Sarah Garner and Kaylene Sauschuck with four points apiece.
- For Sauschuck, a 6-foot-tall freshman forward, the win over the Defenders marked her collegiate debut.
- Senior quard Makayla Krause played a season-high 24 minutes vs. Clarks Summit, adding two points, two assists and two steals.
- ▶Against Wells, Albrecht logged seasonhighs in minutes (19), points (6), made field goals (3) and blocks (1).
- ▶ Hogan, a fourth-year forward, is averaging 5.7 points per game in her last three appearances off of the bench, this after averaging less than one point per contest in the three games prior.

#### SCOUTING PENN COLLEGE

- ▶The Wildcats have struggled out of the starting gates in 2018-19, having lost seven in a row to open the season.
- ▶Only one of Penn College's six losses have come by single-digit points, a 62-56 loss to Westminster at the Susquehanna Trailways Tip-Off Tournament on November 18.
- ▶Of those seven losses, three have come against North Eastern Athletic Conference (NEAC) competition, including an 86-59 defeat against Penn State Berks last time out on December 5.
- Six of the 11 student-athletes on the Penn College roster are freshmen; there is only one senior and one graduate student-athlete.
- ▶Two freshmen 5-foot-6-inch quard Madison Klock and 5-foot-3-inch guard Kaylah Brown - lead the team in scoring with averages of 12.3 points and 9.4 points, respectively.
- ▶Klock and Brown have started all seven games and both are averaging over 30 minutes per game. They also pace the team in 3-pointers with nine apiece.
- ▶ As a team, the Wildcats are averaging 54.6 points per game as a team, second-to-last out of the 12 teams in the NEAC but up from a 48.4 points-per-game average from the 2017-18 season.

# **SERIES HISTORY**

#### ELMIRA VS. PENN COLLEGE

- ▶The Soaring Eagles lead the all-time series against Penn College with a 12-0 record.
- ▶Elmira has surpassed the 80-point barrier on six occasions against the Wildcats, most recently in 2015-16, when the Soaring Eagles beat Penn College 82-47.
- ▶The Purple and Gold have played stifling defense against Penn College over the years, allowing more than 60 points only three times, while limiting the Wildcats to less than 50 points in eight of the previous 12 meetings.
- ▶Elmira's average margin of victory over the Wildcats in the all-time series is 39 points, as EC is averaging 76.0 points per game vs. Penn College, while allowing just 47.0 points per game.
- ▶Only two games in the series have been decided by less than 10 points, a 70-64 Elmira win in the 2013-14 season and a 69-64 win for the Soaring Eagles in 2010-11.
