### SATURDAY OVERVIEW

►After playing six consecutive games on the road, the Soaring Eagles return to the Murray Athletic Center for the first time since November 17 to face the Lakers of Oswego State.

►The home contest against the No. 5/5 nationally-ranked Lakers is the second half of a back-to-back weekend, which begins on Friday, January 11, at SUNY Cortland.

►Saturday's game marks the final non-conference game of the 2018-19 campaign for the Purple and Gold.

►Elmira is 2-3 in non-league games heading into Friday night's meeting with SUNY Cortland. Two of those three losses were against No. 6/7 Hobart, while the third came against No. 4/4 SUNY Geneseo.

►EC ended 2018 with a win at Stevenson (3-1) on December 8 and opened 2019 with a comeback victory at Buffalo State (4-3) on January 8. The back-to-back wins are the first for the Soaring Eagles since winning four in a row from October 30 through November 9.

### LAST TIME OUT

►Before traveling to SUNY Cortland on Friday night, the Soaring Eagles visited Buffalo State on Tuesday, January 8.

►The Bengals scored three times in the second period and held a 3-1 advantage heading into the third period. However, EC responded with three goals in the final 9:30 of regulation to complete the comeback, 4-3.

►**Matthew Cousino** netted a power-play goal at the 10:30 mark, before **Connor Powell** leveled the score at 3-all at 15:28 in the third.

►With just 30 seconds remaining, **Andrew Pucci** deposited his first goal of the season to cap off a 3-0 run and seal the win for EC.

►**Nick Ford** (3a), **Matthew Cuce** (2a), and **Blake O'Neill** (1g-1a) each had multiple points for Elmira.

►In goal, **Jake Sabourin** made 30 saves - his second-highest single-game total of the season - to earn his fifth win of 2018-19.

### YOUTH HOCKEY NIGHT

►Saturday, January 26, will be Youth Hockey Night at the Murray Athletic Center when Elmira hosts Neumann.

►Youth hockey players who wear their jersey to the game receive free admission and will be entered into a raffle to win prizes such as an authentic Washington Capitals team autographed jersey or a **Patrik Laine** signed jersey.

►Signed sticks from the EC men's and women's ice hockey teams will also be raffled off.

## FIRST TIME FEELING

►On Tuesday, a pair of Soaring Eagles recorded their first goals of the 2018-19 season to boost EC to a 4-3 comeback win at Buffalo State.

►Freshman **Matthew Cousino** netted his first collegiate goal on the power play. The defenseman is the fourth Elmira rookie to score a goal in 2018-19.

►**Andrew Pucci** deposited the game-winning goal with 30 seconds left against the Bengals. It was the first goal of his junior season and the second of his career.

## EYEING THE UPSET

►Last season, the Soaring Eagles had a knack at knocking off opponents on the biggest stages, as the EC men went 5-3-0 against nationally-ranked teams.

►However, the Purple and Gold are searching for their first win over a ranked opponent this winter; Elmira is 0-4-0 against teams ranked inside the top 15.

## SCOUTING OSWEGO STATE

►The Lakers of Oswego State boast an 11-3-0 record and a 5-2-0 record against State University of New York Athletic Conference (SUNYAC) teams.

►Before traveling to the Murray Athletic Center on Saturday, the Lakers are scheduled to host Utica on Friday, January 11, at 7:00 p.m.

►Oswego won four in a row entering its Friday meeting with Utica. In three of those wins, the Lakers scored six goals, tying a single-game season-high.

►Oswego has done well on both sides of the puck despite graduating the 2017-18 SUNYAC Player of the Year, **Mitch Herlihey**, and the Defensive Player of the Year, **Devin Campbell**.

►Among Division III leaders, the Lakers rank eighth in scoring offense (4.00) and scoring defense (1.86), resulting in the nation's fifth-best scoring margin at 2.14.

►The offense utilizes a balanced attack, as no player has reached double-digit goals, but six have tallied double-digit points.

►Juniors **Michael Gillespie** (5g-13a), **Josh Zizek** (8g-7a), and **Anthony Passero** (6g-8a) are Oswego's top three point-getters with 18, 15, and 14, respectively.

►The goalie tandem consists of juniors **David Richer** and **Cedric Hansen**. As the starter, **Richer**, an All-Conference Second Teamer in 2017-18, is 7-3-0 with a .906 save percentage and a 2.11 goals-against average in 598:01 minutes.

## SERIES HISTORY

### ELMIRA VS. OSWEGO STATE

►Elmira and Oswego State have been competing against each other since EC's first-ever club season in 1973-74.

►The Lakers hold a one-game lead in the series, which stands at 45-44-6 in Oswego's favor through 95 all-time meetings (series record does not include meeting during EC's club season).

►Oswego has won the past three games against the Soaring Eagles, including the most-recent matchup on October 28, 2017, by a 4-2 score.

►EC's last victory against its long-time rival was earned on January 18, 2014, by a 3-2 score; the following year on January 16, 2015, the two teams played to a 2-2 draw.
