#### **TUESDAY OVERVIEW**

▶ Following a five-game road trip from December 7 through January 12, the Soaring Eagles are home to host St. John Fisher.

- ▶ Elmira played its first two Empire 8 Conference games on the road, as today's E8 contest is the first at Speidel Gymnasium for the Purple and Gold. On the other hand, it is SJFC's first road conference game.
- ▶ The Soaring Eagles last played at home on November 28, when they defeated Keuka, 88-81, in a non-conference bout.
- ▶EC has a winning record at home as it enters the thick of the conference schedule. The Soaring Eagles are 2-1 inside Speidel this season with wins over the aforementioned Keuka Wolves and Penn College (94-69).
- ▶ Following today's home game, the Soaring Eagles will play their next three games on the road. It will be another 10 days before EC fans can watch the Purple and Gold at home, as the team hosts Sage on Friday, January 25, at 7:30 p.m.

#### A LOOK AT LAST TIME OUT

▶EC's non-conference finale was held in New York, New York, as the Soaring Eagles traveled to the campus of Columbia University on Saturday, January 12.

- ▶ The tilt with the Lions, members of the Division I lvy League, was a countable game for Columbia, but served as an exhibition contest for Elmira.
- The Soaring Eagles ultimately fell to the Lions by a final score of 102-63.
- ▶The height of Columbia's interior defense was a mismatch that EC had trouble solving, but the Elmira men made up for that by shooting well from 3-point range.
- ▶The Soaring Eagles shot 50.0 percent from beyond the arc, making 12-of-24 3-point attempts. EC is just the third team to shoot 50.0-or-better from distance against Columbia in 2018-19.
- ▶ Junior guard Jesse Adelson paced the team with 15 points on 5-of-9 shooting from 3-point distance. Senior guard Justin Porrett also reached double figures with 12 points, including one trey.
- Senior forward **Henry Cuffee** made three of his four 3-point tries and finished the contest with nine points.
- ▶ Shawn Backus followed with eight points, including a perfect 4-for-4 showing from the foul line, while fellow sophomore Mason Weir made a pair of treys and amassed seven points.

#### STILL ATOP THE LEADERBOARDS

- ► Justin Porrett finished his junior season as the No. 1 player across all NCAA divisions with 8.8 assists per game.
- ▶Porrett's per-game average and singleseason totals from 2017-18 both set new EC records.
- ▶The senior from Dumont, New Jersey, enters tonight's game as the leader in the Empire 8 Conference and Division III in assists per game with 7.6.
- ▶ Porrett holds a slim lead over Illinois College's Mason Speer and Nebraska Wesleyan's Ryan Garver, who possess per-game averages of 7.3.
- ▶ Porrett is also Division III's active career leader in assists with 501, the only player in the country who has dished out 500-plus dimes.

#### SCOUTING ST. JOHN FISHER

- ▶After missing out on the Empire 8 Conference Tournament in 2017-18, the Cardinals look to be one of the top teams in the league this season with a 9-4 overall record.
- ▶ Fisher is tied with Nazareth for first in the standings with a 4-0 conference record, joining Alfred [3-0] as the only teams with perfect E8 records.
- ▶ The Cardinals have won four of their last six games, but the two losses have come by a mere two points to Union and SUNY Cortland, both by scores of 80-78. The loss to the Red Dragons occurred into overtime.
- ▶ Last time out, St. John Fisher edged Stevens a team Elmira lost to on an overtime buzzer-beater by a single point, 76-75. The win featured 10 3-pointers from SJFC, tied for second-most in a game this season.
- ▶ Fisher's offense is the highest-scoring unit in the E8; the Cards average 82.5 points per game thanks to a conference-best 47.9 field-goal percentage.
- ▶Sammy Robinson, a 6-foot-5-inch junior, is the team's top scorer with 20.1 points per game, second-most in the Empire 8.
- ▶ Robinson has scored no fewer than 11 points in a game this year and has reached as many as 33 points, which came in a loss to Buffalo State on November 11.
- ▶ Ryan Henderson, a 6-foot-5-inch senior, is second on the team with 16.6 points per game. Henderson leads the E8 with a field-goal percentage of 59.3.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

#### ELMIRA VS. ST. JOHN FISHER

- ▶ The Soaring Eagles and Cardinals have engaged in a lengthy rivalry over the years. Today's game is the 73rd all-time meeting between the two schools.
- ▶St. John Fisher has controlled the series by winning every game since the start of the 2001-02 season.
- ▶The last time that Elmira swept SJFC came in 2000-01 by scores of 74-64 at home and 92-81 on the road.
- ▶ Last season's home bout at Speidel saw the Soaring Eagles take a 42-41 lead at halftime, but the Cardinals outscored EC 50-40 in the second half.
