Series History: 13-57

TUESDAY OVERVIEW

- ▶ The Soaring Eagles are home for the first time in over a month, having last played inside Speidel Gymnasium on December 8.
- ▶Elmira is also coming off of an eight-day hiatus after having a bye this past weekend.
- ▶Today's contest against St. John Fisher was preceded by a three-game road trip and will be followed by another three-game road swing over the following week.
- ▶ The Soaring Eagles are looking to snap a three-game losing streak, with all three losses coming on the road. The last time EC tasted victory was on December 8 at Speidel Gymnasium.
- ▶In the first three home games of 2018-19, Elmira has posted a winning record at 2-1 and will be seeking win No. 3 tonight.
- ▶ Today's game is the first Empire 8 road game for St. John Fisher and is the first conference home game for Elmira in 2018-19.

A LOOK AT LAST TIME OUT

- ▶The Soaring Eagles haven't hit the hard-wood in over a week, having last played at Keuka on Monday, January 7.
- ▶The Wolves earned the home non-conference win by a final score of 73-56.
- ▶Elmira finished 19-of-51 from the field (37.3 percent) and 4-of-12 from 3-point range (33.3 percent). The 3-point rate was the best for the Soaring Eagles since shooting 37.5 percent (3-of-8) on November 17 against Ursinus
- ▶ Keuka held a significant advantage in rebounds (46-to-33) and was better from the foul line, boasting a 70.8 free-throw percentage (17-of-24) as compared to a 58.3 percentage (14-of-24) by the Soaring Eagles.
- ▶ Four players reached double-digit points for EC, led by senior guard **Lindsey Heaton** with 16 points. **Heaton** was on the floor for 39 minutes and was 6-of-14 (42.9 percent) from the field.
- ▶ Fellow senior **Rachel Vespucci** was one rebound shy of a double-double against the Wolves, as she scored 11 points and secured nine rebounds.
- ▶ Freshman Alyssa Waters and junior Lauren Franklin each had 10 points. Franklin also added six rebounds, three assists, and a team-leading five blocks.

D-FENCE

- ▶Elmira's defense has been a focal point for first-year head coach Devin Shea. Her Soaring Eagles rank fourth in the Empire 8 and 99th nationally (out of 437 ranked teams in Division III) by allowing just 58.1 points per game.
- ▶The Purple and Gold are second in the E8 and 78th in the nation in field-goal percentage defense, as the opposition is shooting just 34.8 percent against the Soaring Eagles.
- ▶ Furthermore, EC is tops in the conference and fourth in all of Division III at guarding 3-point field goals; opposing teams are shooting just 22.4 percent from beyond the arc. For comparison, the No. 1 team in the nation in that category is Misericordia at 21.8 percent.
- ▶ Last season, Elmira also led the E8 in 3-point field-goal defense, ranking 46th in the country at 26.1 percent.

SCOUTING ST. JOHN FISHER

- ▶ The Cardinals, who won the Empire 8 regular-season title a year ago, sit three games above .500 with an 8-5 overall record. In conference, St. John Fisher's record is level at 2-2.
- Fisher's conference wins have come against Houghton (57-52) and Sage (68-63). Its losses were against Hartwick (55-52) on a last-second 3-pointer and Stevens (56-46).
- ▶In both E8 losses, Fisher was leading after the first quarter.
- ▶Like Elmira, St. John Fisher's defense has led the way. The Cardinals are second in the E8, allowing just 57.0 points per game. They're also second in steals per game [10.3].
- ▶On the offensive side of the ball, one of the top 3-point shooting teams will be facing one of the best 3-point defenses. SJFC is second in the conference in 3-point field-goal percentage (34.5) and treys per game (6.9).
- ▶ Four different Cardinals have made 15-ormore 3-pointers, led by **Erin Hulbert** with 20. The 5-foot-7-inch guard also paces the team in rebounds per game (6.4) and steals (30), showing her skill as an all-around player.
- ▶Two players Sydney Masna and Leah Koonmen are averaging in double figures offensively. Masna, a sophomore guard, is scoring a team-best 10.3 points per game. Koonmen, a freshman, is fractions behind at 10.1 points per contest.
- ▶In the team's most recent loss to Stevens, Masna was held to just two points on free throws. Koonmen, on the other hand, hasn't played since the New Year.

SERIES HISTORY

ELMIRA VS. ST. JOHN FISHER

- ▶ The Soaring Eagles and Cardinals will meet for the 71st time in the all-time series today at Speidel Gymnasium.
- Fisher has found the majority of the success in the series, as the Cardinals lead 57-13 and are winners of nine in a row.
- ▶Both games in 2017-18 were decided by just six points.
- ▶Elmira won back-to-back home games against St. John Fisher in the second half of the 2012-13 series and in the opener of the 2013-14 series.
