Series History: 22-5-3

SEMIFINAL PREVIEW

►Following a bye through the quarterfinal round, the No. 1/3 nationally-ranked Elmira College women's ice hockey team will begin its United Collegiate Hockey Conference (UCHC) title defense with a semifinal match-up vs. the fourth-seeded Valiants.

►Manhattanville advanced to the semis after defeating fifth-seeded Utica by a 3-2 final score on Saturday, February 23.

►Elmira, which earned home-ice advantage during the UCHC Championships with a perfect 18-0-0 conference record, swept its regular-season series vs. Manhattanville in a pair of 2-0 contests.

►The last time Elmira and Manhattanville face each other in a postseason game dates all the way back to the 2002-03 NCAA Division III Championship on March 22, 2003, when the Soaring Eagles beat the Valiants 5-1 to capture their second consecutive national title.

►EC is 12-3-0 in home games against Mville. The Valiants last won at the MAC when they split a two-game series in November of 2010.

UCHC CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

►Top-seeded Elmira will face the No. 4-seeded Valiants at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 2, in the first semifinal contest.

►At 7:00 p.m. on Saturday evening, the No. 2 seed, the Nazareth Golden Flyers, will take on third-seeded William Smith in the other semifinal.

►The two advancing teams will compete for the second annual UCHC Championship on Sunday, March 3, at 3:00 p.m. inside the Murray Athletic Center.

ELMIRA IN THE RANKINGS

►Elmira has held onto its No. 1 national ranking in the D3hockey.com Women's Top 10, as the Soaring Eagles earned 142 points and 10-of-15 first-place votes.

►The Soaring Eagles are the only team in the UCHC in the D3hockey.com Women's Top 10, although Manhattanville is receiving votes.

►According to the U.S. College Hockey On-line (USCHO) Division III Women's Poll, EC is third in the country with 125 points, trailing both St. Thomas (146 points) and Plattsburgh State (131 points).

TITLE DEFENSE

►Winners of the inaugural UCHC Championship last winter, the Soaring Eagles will look to successfully defend their title again in 2019.

►A repeat effort would give Elmira its ninth all-time conference championship.

Elmira placed eight players on the 2018-19 UCHC annual awards list, headlined by the Player of the Year, senior forward **Katie Granato**, and the Defensive Player of the Year, senior defender **Meg Lahey**.

The Soaring Eagles boast a perfect home record of 11-0-0 this season, including 10 wins over UCHC opponents at the Murray Athletic Center. Dating back to last season, EC has won 22 consecutive home contests.

The number of goals Elmira allowed in two regular-season meetings with Manhattanville in 2018-19. EC goaltender **Stephanie Martin** held the Valiants scoreless by making a combined 38 saves in a pair of shutouts on the road.

UCHC ALL-CONFERENCE AWARDS

►Elmira saw eight student-athletes win year-end awards from the UCHC.

►**Katie Granato** was elected the 2018-19 UCHC Player of the Year after leading the league in points (42) and goals (25).

►**Meg Lahey** won the Defensive Player of the Year award. The senior blueliner led the UCHC in assists (25) and was tied for first in defenseman scoring with 28 points.

►Joining **Granato** and **Lahey** on the All-UCHC First Team was **Maddy Jerolman**.

►On the All-UCHC Second Team was **Maddie Evangelous**, **Kiana Melvin**, and **Stephanie Martin**.

►**Eliza Beaudin** was named an Honorable Mention, in addition to a member of the All-Rookie Team alongside **Martin** and **Amanda Zenstein**.

SCOUTING MANHATTANVILLE

►The Valiants qualified for the UCHC Championships for the second consecutive year, earning the No. 4 seed with a 12-5-1 conference record during the regular season.

►Manhattanville beat Utica in the quarterfinal round, 3-2, to advance to the semis.

►The Valiants are looking to make a run at a conference title game for the first time since falling to Norwich in the 2016-17 NEHC Championship game.

►Mville's last conference championship was won during the 2010-11 season, as they beat Norwich 4-2 to hoist the ECAC East trophy.

►In 2018-19, the Valiants have performed nearly identical at home and on the road; they are 8-4-0 on home ice and 7-3-1 in true road contests.

►Defense has been Manhattanville's calling card this season, as it ranks third in the UCHC and 19th nationally in scoring defense, allowing just 1.65 goals per game.

►The penalty-kill unit ranks sixth in Division III, allowing just 11 power-play goals while killing 91.3 percent of opponents' woman-up opportunities.

►Goalie **Rose Pijaca** is fourth in the UCHC in goals-against average (1.80) and fifth in save percentage (.930).

►**Pijaca** broke the team's career records for saves (1,818) and minutes played (4252:48).

►Senior forward **Nicole Mensi** (17g-14a) and junior defender **Zoey Pellowitz** (5g-17a) were both named to the All-UCHC First Team.

SERIES HISTORY

ELMIRA VS. MANHATTANVILLE

►Elmira and Manhattanville will meet for the 31st time in the semifinals of the UCHC Championships.

►The Soaring Eagles lead the series 22-5-3 and are 4-0-0 against the Valiants since they both joined the UCHC ahead of the 2017-18 campaign.

►EC has won five in a row over Manhattanville and is unbeaten in the past 10 games (9-0-1).

The last time Mville beat the Soaring Eagles occurred on November 13, 2010, by a 2-1 score, as the two teams split a two-game series at the MAC.
