Series History: 3-3-0

NCAA QUARTERFINAL PREVIEW

►Winners of back-to-back United Collegiate Hockey Conference (UCHC) championships, the No. 1/3-ranked Soaring Eagles earned a berth into the NCAA Tournament for a seventh consecutive year.

►Elmira will host No. 4/5-ranked Adrian out of the West Region in the quarterfinal round of the 10-team tournament.

►Despite a sizable distance between Adrian, Michigan, and Elmira, New York, the Soaring Eagles and Bulldogs are meeting for the fourth straight season in the NCAA quarterfinals.

►Adrian hosted the first two of four consecutive quarterfinal matchups, but this year's contest will be the second in a row played at the Murray Athletic Center.

►Including regular-season games, the two teams have played each other twice in the past three seasons, equaling six total contests, as EC and Adrian have formed one of the nation's most competitive cross-country rivalries in college hockey.

IN THE RANKINGS

►In the D3hockey.com Women's Top 10, Elmira is still No. 1 with eight first-place votes and 140 total points, while Adrian moved up from seventh to No. 4 this week (89 points).

►The USCHO Division III Women's Poll had EC ranked third for a second week in a row, while Adrian moved up one position to fifth.

PAT THOMPSON TROPHY

►Prior to last weekend's UCHC final, it was announced that the conference has named the title trophies for the men's and women's championships in honor of UCHC Vice President and retired Elmira VP of Athletics, **Pat Thompson**.

LAST TIME OUT

►The top-seeded Soaring Eagles hoisted the Pat Thompson Trophy following an 8-3 victory over third-seeded William Smith in the UCHC Championship on Sunday, March 3.

►EC broke a 2-2 tie at the end of the first period by scoring six unanswered goals in the second and third.

►A dozen player earned a point and seven had multiple points for Elmira in the title game, led by **Eliza Beaudin** (3g-1a) and **Emma Crocker** (4a) with four apiece.

►Beaudin was crowned the tournament MVP, while **Shannon Strawinski** and **Kiana Melvin** were named to the All-Tournament Team.

►Elmira outshot William Smith, 51-to-25, and converted 3-of-5 power-play chances in the win.

EARLY LEADS

► Elmira is one of the best teams in the country at turning an early lead into a victory. In 2018-19, the Soaring Eagles are 16-0-1 when leading after the first period and 22-0-0 when leading after two periods.

► The Soaring Eagles are amidst an astounding streak, having not suffered a loss when leading at the second intermission in over five years.

► EC's last such loss came on January 4, 2014, when Middlebury overcame a 2-1 third-period deficit to win in overtime, 3-2.

► Since then, Elmira is 112-0-5 when holding the lead after two periods of play.

SCOUTING ADRIAN

► The Bulldogs earned their fourth consecutive NCAA Tournament bid by winning the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association's (NCHA) Slaats Cup over St. Scholastica, 3-2, in double-overtime on Sunday, March 3.

► Adrian (22-4-2) is unbeaten in its last 10 games, going 8-0-2 in that span. Its last loss was on January 25 against Lake Forest, 2-0.

► Adrian's offense is ninth nationally with a 4.04 goals-per-game average, while the defensive unit ranks sixth, allowing 1.32 goals per game.

► The penalty-kill unit has been the highlight of the defense, as the Bulldogs are second only to Plattsburgh State (97.2) with a 92.7 penalty-kill percentage. Adrian has allowed only eight power-play goals on 109 chances.

► Scoring on offense is balanced throughout the lineup; Adrian's leading scorer, **Tory Harshman**, has 33 points (14g-19a) and is one of seven Bulldogs with 20-plus points on the season.

► First-year goalie **Denisa Jandova** has stolen the spotlight from 2017-18 AHCA Second-Team All-American **Kate Turner** as of late, as **Jandova** has started the last eight games.

► **Jandova**, an NCHA All-Freshman Team selection, leads the goaltending tandem in minutes (784:14), goals-against average (0.77), and save percentage (.956). She's also unbeaten with a 10-0-2 record.

► **Turner**, a second-year netminder who started last year's playoff game against EC, is 8-4-0 with a 2.16 goals-against average and a .898 save percentage.

► The Bulldogs are coached by first-year bench boss **Shawn Skelly**. **Skelly** replaced **Chad Davis**, who accepted the head coaching position at Division I RIT in August following seven years at Adrian.

SERIES HISTORY

ELMIRA VS. ADRIAN

► Elmira and Adrian will meet for the fourth consecutive season and Saturday's game will mark the fourth straight NCAA quarterfinal pairing between the two programs.

► The two schools have become playoff rivals largely due to their proximity. Although separated by a lengthy bus trip, Adrian and Elmira's campuses fall just within the NCAA's travel limit to avoid a chartered round-trip flight.

► Although Adrian won three of the first four matchups against EC, the Soaring Eagles have leveled the series at 3-3-0 by winning the last two games.

► The Soaring Eagles won last year's NCAA First Round game by a 2-0 final score at the Murray Athletic Center, which was Adrian's first visit to the MAC.
