**GAME DAY: MACALESTER vs. UW-WHITEWATER**

Today Macalester opens play at the Whitewater Regional of the NCAA Division III Baseball Championship. The Scots (29-15) won the MIAC Playoff championship last weekend to earn the conference's automatic berth into the NCAA Championship. Today's opponent is host and defending Division III national champion UW-Whitewater (41-4). The winner will face the winner of this afternoon's game between Luther (33-11) and Bethany Lutheran (31-6) on Saturday at 2:30 p.m. Today's losers will play at 11:00 a.m. on Friday.

**GAME NOTES**

**Macalester Wins MIAC Playoff Championship**

After finishing second in the MIAC standings during the regular season with a 15-5 record, the Scots beat No. 3 Saint John's on Thursday, downed No. 4 Saint Mary's on Friday and won the 'if' game against the Johnnies, 11-6 to capture the MIAC Playoffs. It is Macalester's second MIAC Playoff title, joining the 2017 squad. Here are highlights of each win:

Macalester 5, Saint John's 4

- The Scots trailed 3-1 before scoring three runs in the bottom of the second to lead 4-3. Saint John's tied it with a run in the top of the third.
- Sophomore **Tristan Lander** (West Chester, Pa.) singled in the bottom of the seventh to plate senior **Raymond McCaskey** (Colorado Springs, Colo.) with the go-ahead run.
- Junior lefty **Jack Nussbaum** (Brunswick, Maine) entered the game with one out in the second, limiting the Johnnies to one run on six hits while walking five and fanning nine over 7 2/3 innings to improve to 4-1.
- Seven Scots recorded hits off Saint John's ace Max Edwards, with sophomore **Bobby Munoz** (Santa Monica, Calif.) registering two hits.
- Senior **Nathan Gumagay's** (Potomac, Md.) RBI single in the second was his 100th career hit.
- The win is the 11th victory for Macalester in one-run games this season, improving its record in such contests to 11-4.

Macalester 11, Saint Mary's 4

- The Scots jumped out to a 4-0 lead in the bottom of the first, with **Tristan Lander** hitting a 3-run double and scoring on a single by **Bobby Munoz**.
- With the score 5-4 Macalester, the Scots broke open the game with six runs over the fifth, sixth and seventh innings. First year **John McMurray** (Washington, D.C.) hit a two-run double in the seventh to make the score 11-4.
- **Raymond McCaskey** went 3-for-3 with two runs and an RBI, while junior **Holden Peacock** (Houston, Texas) had two hits and scored three runs. McMurray, and seniors **Josh Planko** (Northville, Mich.) and **Tristan Jones** (Fairfield, Conn.) each had two hits, as the Scots registered 13 hits on the day.
- Junior lefty **Isaiah Ramirez** (Houston, Texas) held the Cardinals to one run on four hits with two strikeouts over 3 1/3 innings to earn the win.

## GAME NOTES

### Macalester 11, Saint John's 6

- After the Johnnies won Saturday's first game, 10-3 to force a second game, the Scots opened the game with **John McMurray** hitting an RBI triple and scoring on a single by **Tristan Lander** in the first inning.

- Saint John's took a 3-2 lead with a run in the second and two in the fourth before **Nathan Gumagay** delivered a sacrifice fly to score **Bobby Munoz**.

- Three runs in the fifth, including a two-run double by **Tristan Lander** put the Scots ahead, 6-3.

- The Johnnies pulled to within one with two runs in the sixth before Macalester broke open the game with three runs in the seventh and two more in the eighth for an 11-6 win.

- **Tristan Lander** went 4-for-5 with two doubles, three runs and four RBIs, while **Raymond McCaskey**, **John McMurray** and **Josh Planko** each had two hits. McMurray also scored three runs.

- Junior pitcher **Josh Schmidt** (Chicago, Ill.) entered the game in the fourth and held Saint John's to two runs on three hits over two innings to earn the win.

- Senior pitcher **Ben King** (Chicago, Ill.), who started the first game on Thursday against the Johnnies but left in the second inning, allowed a run on three hits over three innings to earn the save.

- **John McMurray**, **Holden Peacock**, **Tristan Lander** and **Jack Nussbaum** were named to the All-Playoff Team.

### Eight Scots Earn All-MIAC Honors

Macalester had four players named to the All-MIAC team and four receive All-MIAC honorable mention. **Ben King**, **Raymond McCaskey**, **Holden Peacock** and **John McMurray** were All-MIAC, marking the most Scots on the All-MIAC team since there were four in 2019. **Nathan Gumagay**, senior pitcher **Jamie Loizeaux** (Albany, Calif), **Jack Nussbaum** and **Tristan Lander** received All-MIAC honorable mention.

### Matt Parrington Named MIAC Coach of the Year

For the third time in his career at Macalester, **Matt Parrington** was chosen the Jim Dimick MIAC Coach of the Year. Parrington, who won the award in 2011 and 2017, guided the Scots to a school-record 29 wins this season following a 12-win campaign in 2025. Parrington has been coaching baseball at Macalester for 29 years, including the past 27 as head coach. Earlier this season, he reached 400 career wins, all at Macalester, with a 4-1 victory over Minnesota Morris on March 4. The program's winningest coach, Parrington led the Scots to a MIAC regular-season crown in 2011 and a MIAC Playoff title in 2017, which earned the program its first trip to the NCAA Tournament. His overall record is 425-535-2.



### Return of Mac to the NCAAs

This is Macalester's second trip to the NCAA Championships, joining the 2017 team that also won the MIAC Playoffs. Coincidentally, the 2017 regional also was at UW-Whitewater. The Scots dropped the first-round game to Concordia Chicago, 8-3, before losing a heartbreaker to former MIAC foe St. Thomas, 3-2 in 11 innings.

### Big Turnaround Sparks Scots' Resurgence

Macalester's record of 29-15, including a 15-5 mark in conference play, seemed out of reach a year ago, when the Scots were 12-23 overall and 5-15 in the MIAC that had the Scots in a tie for ninth in the conference standings.

The turnaround can be attributed to improvements in every area, including runs (289 runs vs. 213 in 2025), pitching (5.86 ERA vs. 8.68) and fielding (.963 vs. .955). Macalester also has been a clutch team this season, going 11-4 in one-run games compared to 2-5 a year ago. Those close games have included four walk-off wins:

- April 8 vs. Bethel, 6-5 (**Tristan Lander** with 2-run double in 7th)
- April 13 vs. UNW, 2-1 (**Nathan Gumagay** with RBI single in 9th)
- April 15 vs. Saint Mary's, 8-7 (**Holden Peacock** with RBI single in 9th)
- April 21 vs. Saint John's, 3-2 (**Niko Alexander** with RBI single in 7th)

Another momentous comeback came against St. Olaf on Mar. 28, when the Scots erased a 10-3 deficit with 14 runs in the bottom of the sixth to win, 17-10. Of the 11 one-run wins this season, Macalester trailed in six of those games.

### 100-Hit Club

The Scots' 100-hit club has grown quite a bit this season, with five Scots registering their 100th career hit this year. Senior **Niko Alexander** (Bethesda, Md.) reached the milestone in a win over Dominican on Mar. 14 in Florida; **Josh Planko** recorded his 100th hit in Game 2 against Saint Mary's on April 15; **Raymond McCaskey** joined the club on April 27 at Bethany Lutheran; **Holden Peacock** became the first junior this season to reach 100 career hits in a Game 1 win over Augsburg on April 29; and **Nathan Gumagay** joined the club on May 7 with his two-run single in the win over Saint John's in the MIAC Playoffs.

### Among the Leaders

Several Scots are highly ranked in the MIAC in multiple statistical categories. **John McMurray** is tied for first in hits (66), ranks third in RBIs (47) and is fifth in batting average (.400). **Raymond McCaskey** ranks first in runs (54), third in triples (4), third in hits (59), sixth in total bases (91), eighth in slugging (.599), sixth in batting (.388) and fifth in stolen bases (16). **Holden Peacock** ranks third in stolen bases (20) and is seventh in runs (47). **Jamie Loizeaux** is among the leaders with five saves. As a team, Macalester is second in batting with a .309 average, and fifth in pitching with an ERA of 5.83.

### Record Breakers

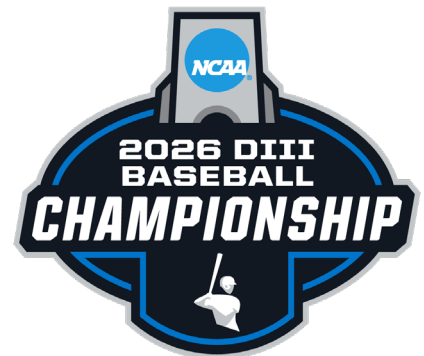
Senior pitcher **Jamie Loizeaux** has been a reliable reliever for Macalester. He has appeared in a total of 28 games, a new Macalester record, with a 3-1 record, an ERA of 2.45 and five saves. This year Loizeaux broke the MIAC record for single-season pitching appearances in MIAC games with 15 appearances.

With seven hits and five RBIs in the MIAC Playoffs, **John McMurray** has tied the school record for hits with 66, and is one RBI away from setting a new program standard with 47. He also is tied for the most at-bats in a season with 165. **Holden Peacock** has the school record for walks in a season with 32.

### Against the Field

Macalester has played all three teams in the NCAA Regional multiple times. The Scots have played UW-Whitewater four times, with the Warhawks winning three times. The Scots' lone win in the series came in a doubleheader split in 1998. The last game between the two teams was in 2005, a 9-4 defeat in the old Metrodome.

Against Luther, Macalester is 3-12 since 1988, with the Norse winning 10 of the last 11 meetings. Luther swept a doubleheader against the Scots in 2024 in Tucson. Macalester played Bethany Lutheran earlier this season, with the Vikings winning, 10-3 on April 27 in Mankato. The Scots are 6-4 against Bethany Lutheran, including a 17-3 decision in 2024.
