**GAME DAY: MACALESTER vs. SAINT JOHN'S**

Tonight Macalester begins play at the MIAC Playoffs as the No. 2 seed, taking on No. 3 Saint John's at CHS Field. The Scots finished second in the MIAC with a conference record of 15-5, a turnaround from last year's team that went 5-15 in the MIAC. Earlier this season, Macalester split a doubleheader with the Johnnies on April 21, winning the first game, 3-2 with a walk-off single by senior **Niko Alexander** (Bethesda, Md.) in the bottom of the seventh. Saint John's took the second game, 10-2. The two teams have played once in the MIAC Playoffs, with Macalester winning, 3-1 to eliminate the Johnnies in 2011.

**GAME NOTES**

**Macalester Returns to MIAC Playoffs with Turnaround Season**

The Scots are back in the MIAC Playoffs for the first time since 2018, earning the No. 2 seed with a 15-5 record in conference play. With an overall record of 26-14, Macalester has tied the program record for most wins in a season, set in both 2011 and 2017. This year's MIAC mark is a reversal of last year's 5-15 record that had the Scots in a tie for ninth in the conference standings.

The turnaround can be attributed to improvements in every area, including runs (289 runs vs. 213 in 2025), pitching (5.86 ERA vs. 8.68) and fielding (.963 vs. .955). Macalester also has been a clutch team this season, going 10-4 in one-run games compared to 2-5 a year ago. Those close games have included four walk-off wins, including one apiece against each of the teams in the MIAC Playoffs.

Another momentum comeback came against St. Olaf on Mar. 28, when the Scots erased a 10-3 deficit with 14 runs in the bottom of the sixth to win, 17-10. Of the 10 one-run wins this season, Macalester trailed in five of those games.

**Scots vs. Johnnies This Season**

Macalester hosted Saint John's on April 21 for a MIAC doubleheader. The Scots handed Max Edwards his only loss of the season in the aforementioned walk-off, 3-2 victory in Game 1. Sophomore **Tristan Lander** (West Chester, Pa.) and senior **Nathan Gumagay** (Potomac, Md.), along with senior **Niko Alexander's** (Bethesda, Md.) RBI single in the seventh, drove in runs for Macalester in the win. Senior right-hander **Ben King** (Chicago, Ill.) held Saint John's to one run on three hits over five innings, striking out two without a walk. Sophomore **Haruto Mizuno** (Irving, Texas) pitched a scoreless sixth inning, and senior **Jamie Loizeaux** (Albany, Calif.) earned the win after giving up a hit and an unearned run in the seventh. Edwards, who had an ERA of 0.88 before the game, allowed three runs on seven hits while walking four and striking out six in 6 1/3 innings.

## GAME NOTES

### Scots vs. Johnnies This Season

In the second game, Saint John's registered 11 hits and 10 runs against eight Macalester pitchers in a 10-2 win. Tanner Hoemann and Mason McCurdy drove in three runs apiece, and Reed Marquardt hit a two-run homer. Pitcher Hunter Hoen held the Scots to two runs on nine hits while fanning six and walking two in seven innings. First year **John McMurray** (Washington, D.C.) and seniors **Josh Planko** (Northville, Mich.) and **Stephen Paulsen** (Middleton, Wis.) each had two hits for Macalester.

### 100-Hit Club

The Scots' 100-hit club has grown quite a bit this season, with four Scots registering their 100th career hit this year and one more on the brink. **Niko Alexander** reached the milestone in a win over Dominican on Mar. 14 in Florida; **Josh Planko** hit his 100th hit in Game 2 against Saint Mary's on April 15; **Raymond McCaskey** joined the club on April 27 at Bethany Lutheran; and **Holden Peacock** became the first junior this season to reach 100 career hits in a Game 1 win over Augsburg on April 29. Senior **Nathan Gumagay** hopes to join the club, as he enters tonight's game with 99 career hits.

### Among the Leaders

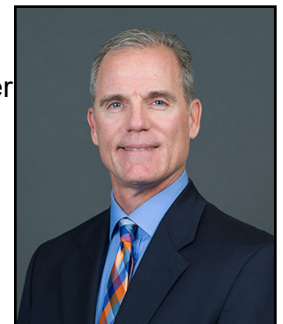
Several Scots are highly ranked in the MIAC in several statistical categories. **John McMurray** is second in hits (59), and fourth in batting average (.393) and RBIs (42). **Raymond McCaskey** is tied for first in runs (50), is third in triples, (4), fourth in hits (52), fifth in total bases (84), seventh in slugging (.604) and eighth in batting (.374) and stolen bases (12). Holden Peacock ranks fifth in stolen bases (14) and is ninth in runs (40). **Ben King** ranks fourth with 47 strikeouts. **Jamie Loizeaux** is among the leaders with five saves. As a team, Macalester is third in batting with a .306 average, and fifth in pitching with an ERA of 5.86.

### Record-Breaking Performance

Senior pitcher **Jamie Loizeaux** has been a reliable reliever for Macalester. He has appeared in a total of 26 games, a new Macalester record, with a 3-1 record, an ERA of 2.16 and five saves. Against Hamline on Saturday, Loizeaux entered the seventh inning of Game 2 and retired the final batter, breaking the MIAC record for single-season pitching appearances in MIAC games with 15 appearances.

### Head Coach Matt Parrington

St. Louis Park native **Matt Parrington** has been coaching baseball at Macalester for 29 years, including the past 27 as head coach. Earlier this season, he reached 400 career wins, all at Macalester, with a 4-1 victory over Minnesota Morris on March 4. The MIAC Coach of the Year in 2011 and 2017, Parrington guided the Scots to a MIAC regular-season crown in 2011 and a MIAC Playoff title in 2017, which earned the program its first trip to the NCAA Tournament. His overall record is 422-535-2.
