

# FIELDS AND FACILITIES

PSU's campus includes 40 acres of playing and practice fields, ALLWell North, Hanaway Rink and the Savage Welcome Center and the Morgridge Strength and Performance Lab.

### **ALLWell North / Bank of NH Field House**

Active Living, Learning, and Wellness (ALLWell) North is an advanced academic and athletic complex that is home to PSU men's and women's track & field and wrestling teams. The facility also contains the Bank of New Hampshire Field House and George E. Davis '63 Track, as well as the PSU Outdoor Center, classroom space, coaches' offices and five varsity locker rooms.

The 107,600-square-foot complex is also utilized by students in the Health and Human Enrichment cluster. In addition to a 200-meter track, the field house contains four tennis courts where the PSU women's tennis team competes during inclement weather.

#### Paul E. Arold Field

Paul E. Arold Field is the home of PSU men's and women's soccer. Arold Field features permanent bleachers, an LEC scoreboard, public address system and multi-tiered press box. The enclosed field is large enough to have an adjacent practice area.

### **Panther Field**

Panther Field is home to PSU football, field hockey and men's and women's lacrosse. The turf field also serves as a back-up for men's and women's soccer during inclement weather and offers extra practice space for all sports, as well as Campus Recreation and student clubs. The field has fully ADA-accessible bleachers, state of the art lighting and a three-room press box complete with filming deck.

#### **D&M Park**

The home of Plymouth State softball is a two-field facility owned by Plymouth Athletic Cluband is used by both PSU and Plymouth Regional High School, as well as other youth and adult community leagues. Both fields are complete with dugouts, press boxes with public address systems, permanent bleachers, electronic scoreboards, lights for night games, and adjustable fences.

## Hanaway Rink / Savage Welcome Center

Savage Welcome Center & Ice Arena, which features Hanaway Rink, is home to the PSU men's and women's ice hockey teams. The facility seats 860 and serves the student body with academic and recreational opportunities as well as community programming. The arena is open approximately 10 months of the year, and private rentals are available.

## John C. Foley Gymnasium

Home of PSU women's volleyball and men's and women's basketball, Foley Gym is a spacious 1,600-seat gymnasium with LED scoreboards at both ends and two elevated press boxes, including accommodations for live television broadcasts. Foley Gym also hosts University and community assemblies, such as convocation, high school concerts, and graduations.

#### Sharon and Carleton Parish '71 Field


Parish Field is home to PSU baseball. The fully enclosed diamond includes a well-groomed playing surface surrounded by spacious dugouts and two large press boxes. A large LED scoreboard is in left field, with bullpens down each baseline, a batting cage and trees surrounding the outfield fence. The right field fence is 15 feet high, giving the field a unique geometry. PSU's baseball facilities are also home to various other state events, including Babe Ruth and American Legion games.

### **PSU Natatorium**

This 25-yard, six-lane pool is home to the PSU men's & women's swim teams. The pool has a state-of-the-art electronic Colorado timing system with a large wall display, two pace-clocks, a full-wall PSU record board, Duraflex diving stands with Maxi-B one and three-meter diving boards, and a 300-seat spectator balcony.

## **Morgridge Strength & Performance Lab**

This 16,000-square-foot facility is a state-of-the-art space with top-rated sports performance flooring. The area houses 24 exercise platforms, treadmills, ellipticals, stationary bikes and separate areas for free weights and plate-loaded equipment. A 45-yard long strip of artificial turf is used for rehab and speed training. The space also includes a climbing wall.

### **Commercials**

Commercials are 30-seconds in length and must be finalized video in .mp4 or .mov format. Each will be shown a minimum of one time during the broadcast, and up to a maximum of four times (depending on purchase). Commercials can be updated at any point during the school year, however new files must be submitted 48-hours prior to broadcast.

(15-minutes before game time). During the show the commentators discuss the following:

- In-depth analysis of both teams (statistics, style of play, headlines)
- Sport review in the LEC or MASCAC Conferences and Standings
- "X-Factors" (key players) and "Keys to the Game"

# "Panther Rewind" / Coach's Interview Shows

Our staff occassionally conducts recorded interviews for our Panther Pre-Game Shows. Coaches and players are asked to analyze previous games, breakdown the week's preparations and examine upcoming opponents. Athlete interviews also include discussion on how they selected Plymouth State University as their school and life with their teammates.




Plymouth State Athletics connects with our fans through our social media pages on Facebook, Instagram and Twitter/X.


