THE MATCHUP

Rose-Hulman and Defiance meet in the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference opener for both schools in Ohio on Saturday.

Rose-Hulman stands 1-2 with losses to 2019 NCAA Division III Playoff squads Wabash and Hope. Defiance seeks its first win of the 2021 season.

ROSE-HULMAN NOTES

Rose-Hulman stands 1-2 on the season with losses to a pair of 2019 NCAA Division III Playoff teams in Wabash (20-33) and Hope (20-27)...Andrew Dion ranks No. 2 in career passing yards (7586), No. 2 in career touchdown passes (69), and No. 3 in pass completions (568). Dion needs 708 passing yards and 12 touchdown passes to become the career leader at Rose-Hulman in both categories...Noah Thomas holds the Rose-Hulman career school record for pass reception yards (2942). He ranks No. 2 all-time in pass receptions (212 - 7 shy of school record) and receiving touchdowns (28 - 8 shy of school record) entering today...defensively, Michael Stevens leads the team with 33 tackles and Kyzer Bowen has 29. Reigning HCAC Defensive Player of the Week Rashard Brown has added a team-high 2 interceptions...Michael Stevens (LB) and Shane Welshans (RB) were named first-team Preseason All-Americans by College Football America; and second-team preseason All-Americans by Lindy's Football Magazine. Welshans was also a preseason second-team All-American from D3football.com.

DEFIANCE NOTES

Defiance had its best performance of the 2021 season last weekend in a narrow 35-28 loss to Alfred State...Cole Recker led the offense with a 22-44 performance for 215 yards and 2 TD passes, and also rushed for 45 yards and another score...Machari Bighams led the receivers with five receptions for 60 yards and a score against Alfred State...defensively, Thomas Coltraine had the big day last week with 12 tackles, 3 tackles-for-loss and 1 sack...Defiance also has losses to Capital (41-7) and Albion (51-0) so far this season.

ROSE-HULMAN QUICK FACTS

* Rose-Hulman's football team is one of the most geographically diverse squads in NCAA Division III football. The Fightin' Engineer roster includes players from 24 states.

* When we say the Fightin' Engineers... we mean Engineers. 97 of the 107 players have the word "engineering" within the name of their academic major (and the remaining 10 are computer science majors).

* Rose-Hulman's football history includes 21 All-American and 17 honorable mention All-American selections. Greg Rosinski (1994 and 1995) is the only Fightin' Engineer to earn All-American honors in multiple seasons.

* Rose-Hulman has earned 49 Academic All-American awards within the football program, including 18 since Jeff Sokol arrived on campus in 2011. The total includes 17 Academic All-Americans since 2013.

* The single-season school record for wins at Rose-Hulman is nine, set in 1987. Rose-Hulman has had two undefeated seasons (7-0 in 1941; 8-0 in 1958). The Fightin' Engineers won eight games in three straight seasons from 2015-17, marking the program's first time with three straight eight-plus win seasons since 1987-89.

* Rose-Hulman made its first NCAA Division III Football Playoff appearance in 2016 after earning a share of the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference championship. The Fightin' Engineers signature win was a victory at then No. 14 ranked Franklin by a 23-22 margin.

* 2021 marks the 129th year of Rose-Hulman football. The Fightin' Engineers have won 12 conference championships (1953, '57, '58, '74, '75, '79, '81, '83, '86, '88, 2013, '16) and enter 2021 with an all-time record of 465-541-30.

HEAD COACH JEFF SOKOL



Jeff Sokol has helped rewrite the Rose-Hulman football record book in his 10 years as head coach, including leading the Fightin' Engineers to their first NCAA Division III playoff appearance in 2016.

Sokol has a career record of 64-35 at Rose-Hulman including a 56-20 mark in Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference games. He has led the Fightin' Engineers to two HCAC championships and four runner-up finishes since 2013.

In 2013, Rose-Hulman won seven of eight conference games to earn a share of the conference championship. The Fightin' Engineers completed their largest in-game rally since 1988 by turning a 20-0 deficit into a 34-26 victory at Bluffton University.

In 2016, Rose-Hulman defeated a nationally ranked team for the first time since 1993, when the Engineers won 23-22 at No. 14 Franklin in October. The effort proved the tiebreaker for an NCAA Division III Playoff bid between this year's conference co-championship teams.

Sokol helped the 2015-17 Rose-Hulman teams win eight games in three consecutive years for the first time since 1986-88. His efforts have helped Rose-Hulman earn two Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference championships (2013, 2016) and the program's first NCAA Division III Football Playoff bid in 2016. The 2017 senior class graduated as the winningest class in school history, with a career record of 31-10.

Sokol came to Rose-Hulman after spending 11 seasons as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator at the University of Chicago, a member of NCAA Division III and the University Athletic Association.

The Maroons captured UAA championships in 2000, 2005 and 2010, while recording three runner-up league finishes during his 11 years as coordinator under head coach Dick Maloney. Chicago established a modern era school record with eight wins in 2010, including victories over Case Western Reserve and Washington University to win the league title.

Prior to his Chicago experience, Sokol spent one season at fellow UAA member Case Western Reserve University as the recruiting coordinator and defensive backs coach. He also spent two seasons as a graduate assistant coach at Defiance College and one year as wide receivers coach at Kalamazoo College.

Sokol earned a bachelor's degree in economics from Kalamazoo in 1996 and completed a master's degree in education from Defiance in 1999. He and his wife Alison are the parents of Walter and Teddy.
