THE MATCHUP

Rose-Hulman and Trine meet at Angola, Indiana in the second game of the season for the third year in a row. Each of the last two meetings between the Thunder and Fightin' Engineers were decided by two points.

ROSE-HULMAN NOTES

Rose-Hulman looks to return to the NCAA Division III playoffs this season after falling in the HCAC Championship at Mount St. Joseph in 2022. The Fightin' Engineers were picked to finish 2nd in the HCAC preseason poll, only behind the Lions...Jeff Sokol enters his 13th year at Rose-Hulman with a career record of 77-41 and the top winning percentage in program history at .653. Sokol has led Rose-Hulman to three HCAC titles and NCAA Playoff appearances in 2016 and 2021...Rose-Hulman returns 9 of its 11 primary starters on the offensive side of the ball, but they only return 2 on the defensive side from last season's team...Daniel Huery was named a preseason All-American by D3football.com. Pierson, a 1st-Team all-HCAC and 2nd-Team all-region selection in 2022, earned third-team preseason honors...Andrew Toler was also named a preseason All-American by The CFB Network. Toler, a 1st-Team all-HCAC selection in 2022, earned third-team honors as well...Jailen Hobbs is coming off an All-American season in 2022 as he became the first two-sport All-American in school history in track and football. Hobbs was the HCAC Special Teams Player of the Year and the HCAC Male Athlete of the Year in 2022-23.

TRINE NOTES

Trine is coming off a 3rd place finish in the Michigna Intercollegiate Athletic Association last season. The Thunder won 6 of their first 7 games before dropping two in a row to Albion and Hope by a combined eight points to finish at 7-3... Trine was picked to finish 3rd in the MIAA Preseason Coaches Poll this year. They finished narrowly ahead of Rose-Hulman's next opponent, Albion... Trine beat Anderson 61-0 in week one. The Thunder outgained the Ravens 444-149, and they averaged nearly six yards per carry en route to 224 rushing yards. Five different players recorded rushing touchdowns in the season opener.

LAST MEETING

Trine came to Terre Haute and defeated Rose-Hulman 24-23 last year. The Fightin' Engineers held a 23-3 lead at the half, but they totaled just 62 yards of offense in the second half, and Trine was able to score the game-winning touchdown with 1:37 to go.

10 THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT ROSE-HULMAN FOOTBALL

1) The Rose-Hulman football team represents an institution that has been ranked No. 1 among U.S. engineering colleges that are focused on bachelor's and master's level education in the U.S. News & World Report 2023 Best Colleges Guide. Rose-Hulman has been named No. 1 in the specialized engineering category by U.S. News for the past 24 years. In addition, Rose-Hulman earned No. 1 rankings in the most recent 2022 U.S. News Best Colleges Guide in four academic departments: civil engineering, computer engineering, electrical engineering and mechanical engineering.

2) When we say the Fightin' Engineers... we mean Engineers. 96 of the 106 players have the word "engineering" within the name of their academic major (and the remaining 10 are computer science majors).

3) Rose-Hulman's football team is one of the most geographically diverse squads in NCAA Division III football. The Fightin' Engineer roster includes players from 25 different states.

4) The single-season school record for wins at Rose-Hulman is 9, set in 1987. Rose-Hulman has had two undefeated seasons (7-0 in 1941; 8-0 in 1958). 2021 marked the 4th time since 2015 that head coach Jeff Sokol has recorded an 8-win season.

5) Rose-Hulman has earned 50 CoSIDA Academic All-American awards in football, including 19 since Jeff Sokol arrived on campus in 2011. The total includes 18 Academic All-Americans since 2013.

6) Rose-Hulman has appeared in the NCAA Division III Playoffs in 2016 and in 2021. North Central defeated Rose-Hulman 41-7 in the Fightin' Engineers 2016 playoff appearance, and North Central would later win the 2019 NCAA Division III National Championship. DePauw won 26-21 over the Engineers in the 2021 NCAA Playoffs.

7) Daniel Huery earned preseason All-American recognition from D3football.com. He was a 2nd-Team All-Region honoree and a 1st-Team All-HCAC honoree in 2022.

8) Andrew Toler also earned preseason All-American honors from The CFB Network. He was a 1st-Team All-HCAC punter in 2022.

9) The 2023 Rose-Hulman schedule includes matchups against the defending NCAC Champions (DePauw) and the 2nd and 3rd place MIAA teams (Albion and Trine). They also play three teams who are receiving votes in the D3Football Top-25 poll including DePauw, Albion, and Mount St. Joseph.

10) 2023 marks the 131st year of Rose-Hulman football. The Fightin' Engineers have won 13 conference championships (1953, '57, '58, '74, '75, '79, '81, '83, '86, '88, 2013, '16, '21) and enter the 2023 season with an all-time record of 479-548-30.

HEAD COACH JEFF SOKOL



Jeff Sokol has helped rewrite the Rose-Hulman football record book in his 13 years as head coach, including leading the Fightin' Engineers to their first two NCAA Division III playoff appearances in 2016 and 2021. He is also a 4-time HCAC Coach of the Year selection (2013, 2016, 2020, 2021).

Sokol has a career record of 77-41 at Rose-Hulman including a 69-21 mark in Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference games. He has led the Fightin' Engineers to three HCAC regular season championships, two NCAA Division III Playoff appearances and four HCAC runner-up finishes since 2013.

In 2013, Rose-Hulman won seven of eight conference games to earn a share of the conference championship. The Fightin' Engineers completed their largest in-game rally since 1988 by turning a 20-0 deficit into a 34-26 victory at Bluffton University.

In 2016, Rose-Hulman defeated a nationally ranked team for the first time since 1993, when the Engineers won 23-22 at No. 14 Franklin in October. The effort proved the tiebreaker for an NCAA Division III Playoff bid between this year's conference co-championship teams.

In 2021, Rose-Hulman rolled through the HCAC schedule unbeaten by averaging 51 points per game in league play. The league championship came down to a winner take all game on the season's final week, and Rose-Hulman topped Mount St. Joseph 58-21 to win the outright title and earn a trip to the NCAA Playoffs.

Sokol has led four Fightin' Engineer teams since 2015 to 8-win seasons, just one victory shy of the Rose-Hulman single-season school record of 9 wins.

Sokol came to Rose-Hulman after spending 11 seasons as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator at the University of Chicago, a member of NCAA Division III and the University Athletic Association.

The Maroons captured UAA championships in 2000, 2005 and 2010, while recording three runner-up league finishes during his 11 years as coordinator under head coach Dick Maloney. Chicago established a modern era school record with eight wins in 2010, including victories over Case Western Reserve and Washington University to win the league title.

Prior to his Chicago experience, Sokol spent one season at fellow UAA member Case Western Reserve University as the recruiting coordinator and defensive backs coach. He also spent two seasons as a graduate assistant coach at Defiance College and one year as wide receivers coach at Kalamazoo College.

Sokol earned a bachelor's degree in economics from Kalamazoo in 1996 and completed a master's degree in education from Defiance in 1999. He and his wife Alison are the parents of Walter and Teddy.

* Daniel Huery earned preseason All-American recognition from D3football.com. He was a 2nd-Team All-Region honoree and a 1st-Team All-HCAC honoree in 2022.
