**GOLDEN DAYS:** The traditional gift for 50 years of marriage is gold and this year marks the golden anniversary of the St. John Fisher College football program. Founded in 1971 as a club team, Fisher has won nearly 280 games and boasts a winning percentage of nearly .600 in that time. The College has enjoyed eight seasons with at least 10 wins, six Empire 8 conference title, five NCAA berths, three club national championships and hundreds of All-Conference honorees.

**WHEN LAST WE MET:** The Cardinals and Red Dragons were locked in a shootout on October 26, 2019 as No. 19 Cortland held off a late surge by Fisher to win, 42-37. Hunter Walsh was 30-for-52 for 397 yards and a touchdown while Pat Galer hauled in eight catches for 131 yards. Will Blake had 119 yards on a game-high 12 receptions while TySean Sizer had six grabs for 91 yards. Jason Rodriguez had an interception in the loss while Cameron Bellino had 14 tackles to lead the defense. In all, Fisher racked up 494 yards of offense on 87 plays and moved the chains 29 times overall.

**SERIES HISTORY:** Saturday's pairing will mark the 13th time in program history that Fisher has squared off with Cortland on the gridiron. Over the previous 12 meetings, Fisher has accounted for five wins with its last coming in 2017 behind a 35-28 outcome.

Entering this weekend's matchup with Cortland, Fisher ranks 30th in Division III in strength of schedule. Overall, Fisher's opponents carry a .667 winning percentage. Only Morrisville has played a more difficult schedule within the Empire 8 this season.

Fisher's special teams play has been outstanding this season as the Cardinals rank fourth in the country in punt return average at 20.91 yards per attempt. Over 10 returns this season, senior TySean Sizer leads the Empire 8 and ranks third in the nation at 23.0 yards per return.

With two games remaining in the regular season, Fisher's magic number is five - that's the number of wins needed for the Cardinals to become ECAC Bowl eligible. A win today would obviously go a long way in helping the team's cause.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Fisher's defense showed out in a big way last weekend as the Cardinals routed Hartwick at Wright Stadium, 28-7. In all, the Cardinals allowed just 13 first downs and held the Hawks to just 87 yards on the ground - their lowest total since week two when they surrendered 81 rushing yards in a win over Framingham State. Quarterback Michael Krafty had a solid outing with 175 yards through the air and three touchdowns while the Cardinals running game accounted for 117 yards including 61 from Dahmir Pross who carried the ball 13 times and scored his seventh touchdown of the year in the win. The receiving corps was led by TySean Sizer's five grabs for 85 yards including two touchdowns while Pross and Pat Galer combined for seven catches and 78 yards.

**SENIOR DAY:** With Saturday's pairing marking the final home game of the regular season for Fisher, the Cardinals will honor the members of their senior class prior to the game. This group of student-athletes, volunteers, cheerleaders and student staff have helped to shape the program into what it is today. On behalf of St. John Fisher College Athletics, we would like to thank them for their dedication and passion.

**CHAMPIONSHIP ASPIRATIONS:** Not many teams enter the season with a national championship in mind. A lot of teams talk about that as a goal, but not many are actually capable of achieving it. Enter Cortland to the conversation. The Red Dragons have been an absolute juggernaut in all phases of the game through their first eight contests. Entering this weekend, Cortland ranks second in Division III in scoring defense at just over six points per game while its offense is ranked 12th in the country at just a shade under 47 points on average. Additionally, Cortland ranks third in total defense as it yields just 189.8 yards per game.

**NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOE:** With eight games in the books, sophomore linebacker Joe Miscia has proven to be one of the top tacklers in Division III as his 13.0 tackles per game and 104 total stops are tied for the most in country this season. Overall, Miscia has accounted for at least 15 tackles in a game twice including a career-high 19 against Morrisville last month.

**SCOUTING CORTLAND:** The Red Dragons have already secured the Empire 8 title this season and a berth into the NCAA Championship, but they're still on the verge of completing a perfect regular season. Brees Segala, not to be confused with his brother Brett who started at Cortland in 2019, will handle the passing duties as the Webster native has 1,765 yards on 131 completions. He has proven to be extremely accurate as well with a 67 percent completion rate and 22 touchdowns against just three picks. Overall, Cortland has two receivers with over 500 yards on the year led by JJ Lapp's 576 yards on 34 catches and seven touchdowns. Derek Cruz has caught a team-leading 45 passes for 516 yards and five scores while Trevor Ash has 21 catches for 230 yards and five touchdowns.

In the backfield, the Red Dragons lean on Jaden Alfanostjohn who has amassed 402 yards on just 67 carries. Segala is also a threat to run with 274 total yards and four more touchdowns with his legs.

Defensively, Cortland will run a 4-3 and is paced by former Fisher linebacker Justin Wheeler's 56 stops and 12 quarterback hurries. Dylan Dubuque has 41 tackles and 12 QB hurries while Paul Imperiale and Christian Legagneur have 40 tackles each.

**LOOKING AHEAD:** The Cardinals will have one final regular season game next weekend as they take to the road and make their way east to Utica College. Fisher has traditionally fared well against the Pioneers and former assistant coach Blaise Faggiano with a 16-3 record over 19 all-time meetings. However, Utica has had Fisher's number over the last four seasons with a 3-1 mark including two straight victories. Fisher had won each of the first 15 games dating back to 2001 and both teams will have their eyes set on suring up an opportunity to become eligible for an ECAC bowl game.

## Flashback to Oct. 26, 2019

PITTSFORD, N.Y. – The St. John Fisher College football team snapped the ball a season-high 84 times, but was one play away from upsetting nationally-ranked SUNY Cortland on Saturday as the Cardinals came up on the wrong side of a 42-37 decision inside Growney Stadium. With the defeat, Fisher slipped to 4-4 on the season and 1-3 in the Empire 8 standings while Cortland, which is ranked 19th in the latest D3football.com national poll, remained undefeated at 7-0, 4-0, respectively.

For the first time since 2008, Fisher produced three consecutive games with at least 80 plays as head coach Paul Vosburgh's team racked up nearly 500 yards in total. Fisher, which moved the chains 29 times on the day, averaged 5.7 yards per play and held the football for nearly seven minutes longer than Cortland.

It didn't take long for Fisher's defense to make a play as Jason Rodriguez, who is tied for the most interceptions in the nation, jumped a route for his seventh pick of the year to give the Cardinals the ball at the Cortland 27. From there, Fisher needed just four plays before freshman quarterback Hunter Walsh broke to the outside for an 11-yard touchdown run to give the home team a 7-0 edge.

Following just its third interception of the year, Cortland's offense came back onto the field trailing by seven. With the ball at its own 28, Cortland quickly moved into Fisher's territory with a 67-yard pass before a 10-yard strike on the outside leveled the game at seven points aside.

With the contest all squared up, Fisher began its drive at its own 35 as Walsh hit TySean Sizer and Pat Galer on back-to-back plays to move the sticks. With a fresh set of downs, Fisher would work the ball down to the Cortland 21 before Joe Dotterweich came on to drill a 38-yard field goal to make it a 10-7 affair.

After swapping possessions as the first quarter wrapped up, Cortland would string together a 7-play, 72-yard drive capped off by a 50-yard pass down the middle that found pay dirt and made it 14-10 in the visitors' favor with just 53 seconds gone by in the second period.

The Red Dragons' offense would come up with another big-yardage play on their next drive as Cortland aired it out again for 64 yards and another touchdown to open up an 11-point cushion, 21-10.

Trailing by two scores with just over 10 minutes left to play before halftime, Fisher's offense began to build momentum as Dahmir Pross moved the chains with a 4-yard pickup before Walsh found Blake on the sideline for 10 more yards and a first down. With the ball spotted at the Cortland 47, Walsh would complete three straight passes including a 12-yard ball to Blake in the corner of the end zone to pull Fisher to within 21-17.

Trailing by four points, Fisher kicked it off as Cortland broke to the outside and looked to move the ball up field only to have the kicker, Dotterweich, come up with a huge hit that jarred the ball loose as Kyle Vachon pounced on the turf and recovered the fumble to give the Cardinals possession on Cortland's side of the 50.

From there, the Cardinals went deep into the playbook with a double end-around that was passed back to Walsh who uncorked a 46-yard flea-flicker to Galer who came down with the reception at the Cortland one. On the next play, Pross broke through the line and crossed the plain to put six points on the board as Fisher now led, 23-21.

The momentum carried over on defense as Fisher forced Cortland to punt as it took over at its own 35 with 3:22 still showing on the clock.

Holding a slim lead, the Cardinals looked to move the ball as Walsh completed four straight passes including a 42-yard diving catch by Chris Park to set up a first-and-10 at the Cortland three. Two plays later, Pross punched it in again for his second score of the day as Fisher took a nine-point lead into the locker room, 30-21.

Coming out of the break, neither team was able to put points on the board until the Red Dragons sent the house and blocked a punt before scooping it up and taking it 20 yards for a touchdown to pull to within 30-28.

The play seemed to energize the visitors as they forced Fisher into another punt before marching 71 yards on 10 plays and converting a two-point conversion to hold a 36-30 lead over the Cardinals with 3:42 still showing in the third quarter.

Facing an uphill climb, the Cardinals went to work as Walsh and Fisher's offense orchestrated a 15-play drive that went 72 yards down to the Cortland eight yard line, but did not result in points as a 25-yard field goal attempt missed wide right to keep it a six-point contest.

The Red Dragons took over at their own 20 with time on their side and worked over five minutes off the clock before moving the ball down to the Fisher two. With four downs to work with, Cortland's pass on first down fell to the turf before the Cardinals came up with back-to-back stops to force the Red Dragons into a field goal.

Following an 18-yard kick that sailed through the uprights, Fisher found itself in a 39-30 hole. Trailing by two scores and 7:27 remaining in the game, Walsh moved the chains with his arm as he hit Galer down the seam for 30 yards and a first down. Three plays later, the first-year signal caller hit Sizer downfield for 17 yards before Pross' number was called on four straight plays before the Bishop Kearney graduate broke free and scored his third rushing touchdown of the day to make it 39-37 with just over four minutes still to go.

With momentum favoring the Cardinals, Cortland continued to move the ball as it ran nine plays and moved 58 yards over 3:55 before kicking a 26-yard field goal to make it a five-point game, 42-27.

Needing a touchdown to win, Fisher got the ball back with just 21 seconds to play. Undaunted, Walsh hit Blake on the sideline for 15 yards and came right back with the same play for 12 more. With the ball spotted at the Cortland 24, Walsh found Blake again for 11 yards to move the ball to the 13. From there, Walsh would hit Blake again in the corner of the end zone only to have the Red Dragons knock the ball loose before a holding call with no time showing on the clock signaled the end of the comeback bid.

Walsh had another strong performance after going 30-for-52 for 397 yards and a touchdown. The freshman has now thrown for over 350 yards and no interceptions in consecutive games.

Galer led the receiving corps with a career-high 131 yards on eight catches while Blake continued to dominate on the outside with 12 receptions, 119 yards and a touchdown. The senior leads the conference with 69 receptions and 874 yards. Sizer had six grabs on the day for 91 yards while Park hauled in two catches for 48 total yards.

On the ground, Pross finished with 32 yards on 19 carries along with a game-high three touchdowns while Ryan Ingerson added 54 yards on 11 carries.

Defensively, Cameron Bellino finished with a game-high 14 tackles and a pass breakup while Evan Strassberger and LeMar Peters had seven stops each. Durrel Hutcherson and Leyton Miner each made six stops for Fisher while Rodriguez was credited with five tackles and a pick. Sam Maddi had one sack and three tackles.



## How We Stack Up

### Offense
