GREYHOUND NOTES

HAPPY HOMECOMING

It's Homecoming Week, and Ulndy fans and alumni have become somewhat accustomed to success at this annual event. The Greyhounds have won nine consecutive Homecoming games and 13 of their last 14, with the lone loss in that span coming in 2010 versus Northwood. Saturday's contest marks the first time McKendree has served as the Hounds' Homecoming opponent since 2016 – a 34-24 Ulndy victory.

HOUNDS vs. BEARCATS

McKendree has yet to defeat the Hounds in the teams' all-time series, with Ulndy a perfect 9-0 since they first hooked up in 2012. Every game has been decided by 10 points or more, including a minimum of 28 points in the last three meetings.

The previous meeting came last spring at Key Stadium and ended in a 51-23 final. Trailing 16-7 midway through the second quarter, Ulndy ran off four unanswered touchdowns to take control and later forced three McKendree interceptions in the second half to help ice it. QB Bryce Stancombe threw for 325 yards and a career-high five touchdowns, RB Toriano Clinton rushed for 147 yards, while CB Kasyus Kurns had a pair of picks.

LAST TIME OUT

Ulndy opened GLVC play last weekend with an impressive 77-10 rout at Southwest Baptist. The Greyhounds racked up a gaudy 601 yards of total offense on the way to the highest point total in Division II this season, as well as their highest total ever in a road contest and their most in any game since putting up a school-record 97 points versus Oakland City back in 1928.

RUSH WEEK

The Hounds did the majority of their damage at SBU on the ground. Led by a record-breaking output from Toriano Clinton, Ulndy totaled 448 rushing yards – most by the Hounds in the GLVC era (since 2012). Clinton racked up all of his 197 yards in the first quarter, setting a new NCAA Division II record for most rushing yards in a single quarter.

Meanwhile, all four Ulndy running backs on the trip garnered at least 11 carries, with Lenny Bennett (96 yds, 2 TDs), Kellen Porter (76 yds, 2 TDs) and JaQuan Buchanan (72 yds, 1 TD) joining Clinton as prominent contributors to the box score. Quarterback Bryce Stancombe got in on the action as well, scoring his first career rushing touchdown in the first quarter.

WELL RECEIVED

Despite the success of running game at SBU, freshman receiver/return man Jeremiah Lee managed a breakout performance. The Union, Ky., native amassed 94 receiving yards on just three catches – all touchdowns – after returning the game's opening kickoff for a 95-yard TD.

In all, the Hounds threw the ball just 11 times, with Stancombe going 6-for-9 for 140 yards and back-up Connor Kinnett completing both of his attempts in his season debut.

JUST FOR KICKS

Not to but overshadowed was special teams standout Paul Buisman. The veteran kicker/punter broke his own GLVC record for most PATs in a game at SBU, going a perfect 11-for-11 on extra point attempts and later earning his second GLVC Special Teams Player of the Week award of the season. He currently ranks in the Ulndy career top 10 in a number of categories (see page 3).

CLINTON WATCH

Ulndy running back Toriano Clinton continued his ascent of Ulndy's all-time rushing list last week. The Calumet, Ill., product enters the week just 217 yards shy of becoming just the seventh Greyhound ever with 3,000 career rushing yards. In addition to the aforementioned DII single-quarter rushing record he set last week, Clinton broke the Ulndy single-game record with a whopping 270 rushing yards at Hillsdale in week 2, and he currently ranks fifth among all active DII rushers in career yards (see below). PRESSURE COOKER

The Greyhound defense leads the GLVC in both sacks and tackles for a loss, ranking 13th and ninth in Division II, respectively. Last weekend, the Hounds were in the SBU backfield seemingly all afternoon, racking up a season-high 14 TFLs and season-high-tying five sacks.

LET IT REIGN

Ulndy entered the fall as the conference favorite, topping the 2021 GLVC Preseason Coaches Poll (see page 3). Ulndy swept through the abbreviated 2021 spring season, capped by a 46-29 win against Truman in the first-ever GLVC Championship Game.

Ulndy is 59-5 (.922) all-time in GLVC play and has won seven league crowns since the conference began sponsoring football in 2012.

HEAD COACH CHRIS KEEVERS



Third-year head coach Chris Keevers has racked up a number of accolades in his short time at the helm of the Greyhound football program. The 2020-21 GLVC Coach of the Year captured a conference championship last spring after earning a spot in the 2019 NCAA DII Playoffs.

After spending the previous 25 years as an assistant at UIndy, Keevers took over as the head man in 2019 and orchestrated a season that any first-year head coach would envy, leading the Greyhounds to a 9-1 regular season and an appearance in the NCAA DII Playoffs – their sixth postseason trip in eight years.

UIndy was dominant 2019, topping the GLVC and ranking in the nation's top 10 in a number of statistical categories. The Greyhounds led all of Division II in fewest turnovers lost, while ranking second in scoring offense, fourth in time of possession, fourth in punt return average, sixth in team passing efficiency and eighth in tackles for a loss.

The Hounds also surpassed multiple team records in Keevers' first season, including scoring offense, total offense, total touchdowns and rushing first downs. They went on to amass a league-leading 20 All-GLVC awards and finished the season ranked No. 17 in the final DII coaches poll.

Prior to taking over the head job at UIndy, Keevers wore numerous coaching hats, working with all positions on the defensive side of the ball, while also spending time as both a special teams and strength & conditioning coach.

The 2018 season marked the 12th overall for Keevers as the Greyhound defensive coordinator. That fall, he led a unit that ranked 13th in Division II in passing defense, 15th in scoring defense and 18th in total defense.

Since UIndy football joined the Great Lakes Valley Conference in 2012, Keevers has helped the Hounds to seven conference titles and seven NCAA Division II playoff appearances, a span that includes a stellar 75-19 (.798) overall record.

Prior to joining the UIndy staff in 1994, Keevers helped Division II St. Mary's College (Calif.) to three winning seasons as the Gaels' defensive line, special teams and strength & conditioning coach from 1991-93. He also spent three seasons as the defensive line graduate and student assistant at Purdue.

As a player, Keevers' career began at Coffeyville Community College (Kan.), where he was a Junior College All-America Honorable Mention honoree. He transferred to Big Ten-member Purdue University and excelled on the defensive line as a two-year starter.

In 1986, he earned a spot on the Boilermaker d-line and started on the same side of the ball as future NFL Hall of Famer Rod Woodson. As a senior in '87, Keevers was named the ABC "Player of the Game" for his performance at Iowa in October of that season, and he later won the team's Leonard Wilson Award (for "unselfishness and dedication"). He was also nominated for the athletic department's Red Mackey Award (for "competitive spirit, a positive attitude, loyalty, self-discipline, hard work for the best interest of the team and a willingness to help others").

A graduate of local John Marshall Community High School, Keevers earned a communications degree in 1989 and a master's degree in education administration in '91 – both at Purdue. He and wife Alexis have four children: Chris, Jessica, Tucker (who is currently on the UIndy football roster) and Porter.
