#### **GREYHOUND NOTES**

#### THIS WEEK

The Hounds return to conference play this week with a trio of GLVC games. Ulndy hosts McKendree tonight before traveling to Missouri S&T on Thursday then returning home to host Lindenwood on Saturday. All games will be aired on the GLVC Sports Network at www.glvcsn.com/uindy and broadcast live on WICR 88.7 FM.

#### **LAST WEEK**

Ulndy returned from the holiday break with a 2-0 week at home last week. The Hounds topped Edinboro of the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference 88-62 before beating East West University 105-61. The win move Ulndy to 7-2 at home on the season while they completed the non-conference portion of their schedule at 6-2. In Thursday's win over Edinboro, both Cory Miller Jr. and Jesse Bingham scored 20+ plus to reach new season highs in scoring. The Fighting Scots averaged 82.9 points per game entering the contest but a stellar Ulndy defense held them to their second lowest scoring output of the season. In the New Year's Eve win over East West University, Aaron Etherington put on a career-best performance, scoring 26 points along with 7 rebounds, 6 assists, 2 blocks and 1 steal. For the second time in three games, six Hounds reached double figures in scoring. Full box score and recap on page 5.

#### **SCOUTING McKENDREE**

The Bearcats were selected last in the GLVC East Division preseason poll and have a 1-3 record in GLVC play thus far. Southern Indiana topped McKendree on Sunday in Lebanon, IL. After opening the season with four straight wins, the Bearcats have lost three of their last four with their lone win being a victory over then No. 21 Union (Tenn.). McKendree is averaging 65.9 points per game but is averaging just 55.8 ppg in GLVC play. They are averaging third-best in the league at 36.5 rebounds per game while shooting 44 percent from the field. The Bearcats have arguably the best defense in the league, pacing the GLVC in both scoring defense (61.8 ppg) and field goal percentage defense (39.0%). They have held seven of their eight opponents under 70 points.

#### SERIES HISTORY vs. THE BEARCATS

Ulndy was victorious in the first 11 meetings with the Bearcats but the last four meetings have been split 2-2. The Bearcats have never won inside Nicoson Hall. Head coach Paul Corsaro is 1-1 against McKendree but this will be his first meeting with first year head coach George Suggs. Last meeting box score and recap on page 6.

#### **SEEING DOUBLE**

Ulndy has had at least three players record 10+ points in all 11 games to start this season. In two of their last three games, six Hounds have reached double digits. Before then, the last time it was six players was 107 games ago on Jan. 4, 2018 in a 93-77 victory over Quincy inside Nicoson Hall. Kendrick Tchoua and Jakobie Robinson are the only Hounds to record a double-double this season. They both have two thus far.

#### **GLVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

Kendrick Tchoua garnered the first GLVC Player of the Week award of his career on November 29. The sophomore guided the Hounds to a 2-0 week with wins over Ohio Valley and midwest region for Northwood. Tchoua averaged 15.5 points and 10 rebounds per game while shooting .579 (11-of-19) from the floor. Defensively he added three blocks.

#### **EXHIBITION SLATE**

Ulndy had a hefty exhibition slate to start the season with three games in five days, including a pair of B1G opponents and Top 20 opponents. The Hounds fell to #17 Ohio State 82-46 on Monday followed by a 86-64 loss at #7 Purdue. They closed out the week with a 73-68 loss at Butler.

#### **HOME SWEET HOME**

After not having fans for home games last season, the Greyhounds have an immense home schedule on tap this season. All but one of their non-conference games will be played in Indianapolis inside Nicoson Hall. In total, Ulndy has 17 home games this year.

#### **ALL-LEAGUE LAURELS**

Ulndy has three All-Great Lakes Valley Conference selections returning to the roster this year. Both Dee Montgomery and Cory Miller Jr. were named to the All-GLVC Second Team, with Miller Jr. also earning his second straight inclusion on the All-Defensive Team. Jesse Bingham was one of just five players voted to the All-Freshman Team.

#### MEN'S BASKETBALL RUNS PAST EAST WEST IN FINAL NON-CONFERENCE TILT

**INDIANAPOLIS** – A career-best performance from Aaron Etherington led the University of Indianapolis men's basketball team to their fourth straight win on Friday afternoon. The Hounds scored the first 14 points of the game and never looked back in a 105-61 win over East West University in their final non-conference game of the season.

#### **HOW IT HAPPENED**

Dee Montgomery started the scoring off with a corner three on the assist from Etherington. The Hounds went on to score the first 14 points of the game before the Phantoms got on the board. Ulndy took a 59-18 lead to the locker room, marking the most points they've scored in a half this season and the largest lead they've taken to the break.

Etherington shot 4-for-5 from three in the first half alone. The Fishers, IN native went on to finish with a career-high 26 points along with 7 rebounds, 6 assists, 2 blocks and 1 steal.

Ulndy's 105 points is the first time they've eclipsed the century mark under head coach Paul Corsaro and the most points they've put up in a single game this season. The Hounds hadn't scored 100 points since November 2019 when they scored 112 against Spring Hill.

#### SEEING DOUBLE

For the second time in three games, six Hounds reached double figures in scoring in Etheringon (26), Jesse Bingham (14), Jakobie Robinson (14), Kendrick Tchoua (12), Ben Nicoson (11) and Josiah Tynes (10). Prior to happening against St. Mary of the Woods, the feat hadn't happened in 107 games dating back to Jan. 4, 2018. In all 11 games this year at least three Hounds have reach double figures.

#### **INSIDE THE BOX SCORE**

- Robinson posted his first double-double of the season, tallying 14 points and 13 assists.
- The Hounds outrebounded the Phantoms 47-26 to improve to 7-0 when outrebounding their opponents.
- Along with 13 made three's, Ulndy was also a threat down low, scoring 38 points in the paint.

#### MILLER'S BUZZER BEATER LIFTS HOUNDS TO VICTORY, 69-68

INDIANAPOLIS - The Ulndy men's basketball team earned a thriller 69-68 comeback win versus McKendree at Nicoson Hall Tuesday night. The Greyhounds (9-10) overcame a seven-point deficit in the final two-and-a-half minutes, capped by a game-winning layup from senior Cory Miller Jr.

#### **INS & OUTS**

With the Hounds up one and seven minutes to go, the visiting Bearcats (9-8, 9-8 GLVC) ran off 10 unanswered points and looked to escape with the win.

With the clock dwindling, Dee Montgomery rose up and buried a triple and the frantic comeback was on. The senior from Horn Lake, Miss., went on to score 11 consecutive points for the Hounds, pulling them to within a single point for the Hounds' final possession.

All the while, the Ulndy defense clamped down as well, as McKendree went scoreless for the final 2:30 to help set up Miller's heroics.

Coming out of a timeout with 7.9 ticks on the clock, Miller got the ball near midcourt and drove down the right side of the lane, all the way to the hoop and finished with what proved the difference maker.

#### **INSIDE THE BOX**

- Montgomery's late salvo upped his point total to a career-high 24 points. He hit six 3-pointers on the night.
- Sophomore Kendrick Tchoua notched his fifth double-double of the season, going to 20 and 13.
- Ulndy held the Bearcats to 39-percent shooting in the second half.
- Miller Jr. Finished with 11 points, four assists and two steals.
- Senior Mikail Simmons set a personal best with eight rebounds.

Ulndy entered the night in 10th in the GLVC Point Rating standings (PDF), while McKendree was fifth. The result inched the Hounds closer to that coveted No. 8 spot, but the Bearcat's loss dropped them all the way to ninth. Just 0.14 points separate Nos. 5-10 ... Only eight teams will advance to the GLVC Tournament play, with guarterfinal games scheduled for Wednesday, March 3.

#### HEAD COACH PAUL CORSARO



Indianapolis native and Ulndy alumnus **Paul Corsaro** was named the 13th men's basketball head coach in Ulndy program history in April of 2020. Corsaro earned his first head coaching position after serving as an assistant coach for the Greyhounds for six seasons before serving in the same capacity for two years at DI Purdue Fort Wayne.

Overcoming some of the unique challenges of the pandemic in his very first season at the helm, Corsaro and his Greyhounds found their groove midway through the 2020-21 season, racking up 11 wins in their final 16 games. The stretch started in January with a 62-61 comeback win versus in-state rival Southern Indiana and its head coach Stan Gouard. Corsaro's

former mentor at Ulndy, and ended in a thriller 75-73 victory against Truman, the No. 2-ranked team in the nation, in the GLVC Tournament quarterfinals. Three Hounds went on to earn postseason honors with the trio being named GLVC All-Conference honorees.

A product of local Roncalli High School, Corsaro's time as an assistant on the Ulndy bench coincided with some of the most successful seasons in school history. He helped the Hounds to four 20-win seasons, including four consecutive NCAA tournament berths from 2013-16. He mentored a total of 13 All-GLVC honorees in his six years, as well as eight GLVC All-Defensive Team members, one GLVC Freshman of the Year and a pair of All-Midwest Region performers in Joe Lawson (2015) and Jordan Loyd (2016).

Additionally, Corsaro helped guide the Hounds to a combined 49 wins in 2013-14 and 2014-15, with the latter's 25 victories good for the most by a Greyhound squad in 50 years. With help from a season-opening 17-game winning streak, the '14-15 club spent nine weeks ranked in the top 10, including a two-week stay at No. 1, before earning the program's first-ever "Sweet Sixteen" berth.

Corsaro moved on to Purdue Fort Wayne in 2018 as an assistant under head coach Jon Coffman. The Mastodons amassed 32 wins in Corsaro's two seasons, including a third-place finish in The Summit League in 2018-19.

As a two-sport student-athlete at Ulndy, Corsaro earned three varstiy letters as a member of the Greyhound football team and three more on the hardwood under Head Coach Stan Gouard – often given the toughest defensive assignment for the opposing team. He was a part of Gouard's first NCAA Tournament team in 2011 and a member of the Hounds' first DII football playoff team in 2012. He still holds the modern program record for most rushing touchdowns by a quarterback with eight in 2010.

Corsaro graduated with a bachelor's degree in Communication in 2012 and a master's in Business Administration in 2014 – both from Ulndy. He is also the all-time leading scorer at Roncalli High School with 1,156 career points.

#### **ASSISTANT COACHES**



**Mike Burris**, Indiana native and former head coach at Olney Central College, joined Corsaro's staff as an assistant coach in the fall of 2020.

Burris is the winningest coach in OCC history, racking up 252 wins over 15 seasons from 2005-20. After taking over as the youngest head coach in the school's history at age 26, Burris had 68 players sign with NCAA DI and DII programs, while graduating 97 percent of his student-athletes.

Burris guided OCC to its best-ever six-year stretch before coming to Ulndy, amassing 118 wins in that span. The

Blue Knights compiled a 25-6 record in 2018-19, defeated two top-five programs and finishing the season with a No. 14 national rankings. Per Massey Ratings, the Blue Knights also topped the NJCAA in offensive production.

With the team success came personal accolades, as Burris was voted the Great Rivers Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 2012 and the NJCAA Region 24 Coach of the Year in 2013.

Prior to his success at OCC, Burris himself donned the Blue Knights jersey from 1997-99 before transferring to Division I Cal Poly University. He then returned to OCC as an assistant coach, and obtained his bachelor's degree in liberal arts from Eastern Illinois University in 2004.

Burris grew up 75 miles from the city of Indianapolis in Owensburg, Ind., graduating from Eastern Greene in 1997.



Former Butler standout **Roosevelt Jones** joined the Ulndy staff in 2020-21. An All-Big East performer for the crosstown Bulldogs, Jones returned to the Cirice City after spending the last two seasons an assistant at IU-Kokomo, including the 2019-20 campaign as Associate Head Coach

In Jones' two years at IUK, the Cougars amassed a 53-15 (.779) record and a pair of NAIA national tournament appearances. They reached No. 10 in the NAIA coaches poll last spring, finishing the season at No. 22 after a first-round tournament win.

Before entering the coaching side of the game, Jones authored a stellar collegiate career at Division I Butler, etching his name all over the Bulldogs' record book. He racked up 1,533 career points in four seasons, good for 11th all-time. He also ranks in program's career top 10 in starts (1st), assists (4th), rebounds (5th) and steals (8th). The 6-foot-4 combo guard was awarded All-Big East Second Team honors as both a junior and a senior, as well as earning an NABC All-District nod after his final season in 2015-16.

Jones went on to play professionally for two years with the Canton Charge, the G-League affiliate of the NBA's Cleveland Cavaliers, while additionally training players during the offseason in his hometown of O'Fallon, Ill.
