GREYHOUND NOTES

ABOUT MCKENDREE

Saturday's matchup features the GLVC's only four-win teams; McKendree is off to its best start since 2015 while UIndy is still unbeaten. The Bearcat offense features one of the most productive passing attacks in Division II. Veteran QB Turner Pullen is on pace to break a number of school records, as the redshirt-junior leads the nation in both completion percentage and passing touchdowns while ranking second in passing yards.

HOUNDS vs. BEARCATS

UIndy owns a perfect 10-0 mark all-time versus McKendree, good for its best record versus any GLVC institution. The Greyhounds own a combined 49-5 (.907) record versus the six other current conference members, with no team defeated the Hounds more than one time. See left for a breakdown.

In last season's matchup, UIndy got an historic performance from running back Toriano Clinton in a 57-28 Homecoming win versus the Bearcats. Clinton set a school record with 287 rushing yards and added four touchdowns. Overall the Hounds put up a season-high 741 yards of total offense in the victory. Furthermore, UIndy has scored an average of 57.0 points in the previous three meetings.

LAST TIME OUT

UIndy celebrated Homecoming with a 44-17 win against Southwest Baptist last Saturday. Behind the sixth career 200-yard rushing game by Tori Clinton, the Greyhounds notched their 11th consecutive victory on Homecoming week. D-lineman Dylan Shelton got the Hounds on the board with a five-yard sack that went for a safety – UIndy's second in as many home games. Clinton took the next play from scrimmage 63 yards to a score as the Hounds never looked back.

THE BIG 4-0

UIndy is off to a perfect start through the season's opening month. Counting this year, the Greyhounds have won each of their first four games just seven times in the program's 85-year history two coming under. Head coach Chris Keevers has been a part of four of those teams, including two as the head coach (2019, '22) and two as an assistant (1997, '17). The Hounds also started 4-0 in both 1973 and '75, as well as the program's only undefeated season in 1953.

LIKE A BROKEN RECORD

Clinton continued his personal assault on the UIndy record book last week. Seven days after becoming the UIndy all-time rushing king, the Chicago native set two more major benchmarks versus Southwest Baptist. Clinton found the end zone three times against the Bearcats to set new UIndy records for both career rushing and total touchdowns. Next up are school records for total points and all-purpose yards. FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

Sophomore QB Connor Kinneth threw an interception in the first quarter last week, good for both his first career pick and the Greyhounds' first turnover of the season. UIndy still leads Division II in turnovers lost, however, as the only school just one giveaway. UIndy and Fort Lewis State entered play last weekend as the only two DII schools without a turnover, but the latter coughed the ball up three times.

POLL POSITION

The Hounds continued their ascent of the AFCA DII Coaches Poll this week. After receiving votes in the pre-season poll, UIndy appeared in the top 25 for each of the last five weeks, cracking the top 10 in this week's edition. The Hounds' current ranking of No. 8 matches their peak position during the 2019 playoff push. UIndy's highest-ever ranking from the coaches came in 2017 when it spent two weeks at No. 5. GLVC GIANT

UIndy has secured seven of the 11 GLVC championship trophies handed out since the league's inaugural season. The Greyhounds captured each of the first four conference crowns (2012-15) and added championship rings in 2017, 2018 and the spring of '21.

PLAYOFF POTENTIAL

UIndy is looking to return to the playoffs for the first time since 2019. That season, Chris Keevers' first as the UIndy head coach, the Hounds earned their third straight trip to the postseason before falling at 15th-ranked Central Missouri in the first round, 37-27. Eleven current Greyhounds saw playing time that afternoon, including five as starters: Zachery Clark (OL), Toriano Clinton (RB), Kiave' Guerrier (LB), Jacob Jones (DT) and Landry Mavungu (CB).

HEAD COACH CHRIS KEEVERS



Chris Keevers enters his fourth season as the Ulndy head coach in 2022, having racked up a number of accolades in his short time at the helm. The 2020-21 GLVC Coach of the Year captured a conference championship in the spring of 2021 after earning a spot in the 2019 NCAA DII Playoffs in his very first season.

After spending the previous 25 years as an assistant at Ulndy, Keevers took over as the head man in 2019 and orchestrated a season that any first-year head coach would envy. The Greyhounds rolled through the regular season with a 9-1 mark to earn a coveted spot in the NCAA DII Playoffs – their sixth postseason trip in eight years.

Keevers enters week 6 of the 2022 season with a 23-6 career record, including a 14-3 mark in GLVC play.

Ulndy was particularly dominant 2019, topping the conference and ranking in the nation's top 10 in a number of statistical categories. The Greyhounds led all of Division II in fewest turnovers lost, while ranking second in scoring offense, fourth in time of possession, fourth in punt return average, sixth in team passing efficiency and eighth in tackles for a loss.

The Hounds also surpassed multiple team records in Keevers' first season, including scoring offense, total offense, total touchdowns and rushing first downs. They went on to amass a league-leading 20 All-GLVC awards and finished the season ranked No. 17 in the final DII coaches poll.

With pandemic challenges abound the following year, Keevers led the Hounds to their league-best seventh GLVC championship in the abbreviated 2020-21 season. Ulndy compiled a perfect 3-0 record that spring, including a 46-29 win over Truman in the first-ever GLVC Championship Game.

In the fall of 2021, Keevers led the Hounds to their 12th consecutive winning season with a 7-4 record. The campaign was highlighted by a record-setting performance by All-American running back Toriano Clinton, who broke

both the program's single-game and single-season rushing records. Clinton was also named an Academic All-American, as was offensive lineman Clay Hadley.

Prior to taking over the head job at Ulndy, Keevers wore numerous coaching hats, working with all positions on the defensive side of the ball, while also spending time as both a special teams and strength & conditioning coach. In his 12th and final season as the Greyhound defensive coordinator in 2018, he led a unit that ranked 13th in Division II in passing defense, 15th in scoring defense and 18th in total defense.

Since Ulndy football joined the Great Lakes Valley Conference in 2012, Keevers has helped the Hounds to seven conference titles and six NCAA Division II playoff appearances, a span that includes a 85-23 (.787) overall record and a stellar 47-7 (.870) mark at home.

Prior to joining the Ulndy staff in 1994, Keevers helped Division II St. Mary's College (Calif.) to three winning seasons as the Gaels' defensive line, special teams and strength & conditioning coach from 1991-93. He also spent three seasons as the defensive line graduate and student assistant at Purdue.

As a player, Keevers' career began at Coffeyville Community College (Kan.), where he was a Junior College All-America Honorable Mention honoree. He transferred to Big Ten-member Purdue University and excelled on the defensive line as a two-year starter.

In 1986, he earned a spot on the Boilermaker d-line and started on the same side of the ball as future NFL Hall of Famer Rod Woodson. As a senior in '87, Keevers was named the ABC "Player of the Game" for his performance at Iowa in October of that season, and he later won the team's Leonard Wilson Award (for "unselfishness and dedication"). He was also nominated for the athletic department's Red Mackey Award (for "competitive spirit, a positive attitude, loyalty, self-discipline, hard work for the best interest of the team and a willingness to help others").

A graduate of local John Marshall Community High School, Keevers earned a communications degree in 1989 and a master's degree in education administration in '91 – both at Purdue. He and wife Alexis have four children: Chris, Jessica, Tucker (who is currently on the Ulndy football roster) and Porter.
