**GREYHOUND NOTES**

**ABOUT ASHLAND**

For the second straight week, the Greyhounds face off against a former GLIAC rival as No. 20 Ashland comes to town for the 2025 home opener. The Eagles are coming off a 13-9 win at Indiana (Pa.) in week 1 after winning the G-MAC title and earning a playoff road win at Charleston last fall.

*Fun fact:* Like UIndy, Ashland was a charter member of the GLVC. The Eagles competed in the league from 1978 through 1994 before moving to the GLIAC in 1995 and later the G-MAC ahead of the 2020-21 academic year..

**HOUNDS vs. EAGLES**

In a series that started in 1954, the former GLIAC—and before that Heartland Collegiate Conference (HCC)—rivals have faced off a total of 34 times, with Ashland owning a 21-13 advantage. UIndy has won the previous two meetings, however, including a 24-9 in the 2019 season opener at Ashland—Chris Keevers’ first game as the Greyhound head coach. Both teams enter the season as reigning conference champions, and starting this fall they now have a chance to meet in the playoffs...

**SUPER SHAKEUP**

Speaking of the playoffs, it’s apropos to mention some major changes going into effect to the Division II postseason format this November...

- First, the bracket was expanded from 28 to 32 teams, meaning each of the four Super Regions will now send eight teams to postseason play. No more first-round byes for the No. 1 seeds.
- Second, Division II did away with the old earned-access model and moved to the more-straight-forward automatic qualifier format. Thus the ‘25 GLVC champion will earn automatic inclusion to the playoff bracket.
- Lastly, the Super Regions experienced realignment for the first time since 2017. UIndy and the other GLVC teams will remain in Super Region 3, as will the GLIAC, but SR3 will now include the G-MAC and the Northern Sun (NSIC). SR4 teams will be forced to deal with the powerhouse programs of the MIAA (Pittsburg State, to name just one) and the GAC (e.g. Harding).

**LAST TIME OUT**

UIndy endured a tough 38-35 loss at in-region Findlay last week. After a scoreless first quarter, the Greyhounds built leads of 10-0 and 17-7, but the host Oilers managed two touchdowns in the final minute of the first half to seize the momentum and the lead. A UIndy field goal in the third pulled the Hounds to within one, but a productive final quarter by the home team ultimately sealed the victory. The final score marked the first time the Greyhounds scored 30 points or more in defeat since week 3 of the 2016—a 41-37 loss at Southwest Baptist.

**CARRYING THE LOAD**

A big component of the Oilers’ win was their impactful rushing game. They racked up 272 yards on the ground, good for the most by a UIndy opponent since McKendree earned 273 rushing yards in a losing effort on Oct. 9, 2021. Three different Findlay rushers found the end zone last Saturday, with Christian Davis leading the way with 109 yards.

**RANK & FILE**

The Findlay loss dropped the Greyhounds out of the AFCA DII Coaches Poll for the first time since week 1 of the 2022 season—snapping the program’s second-longest streak of 39 consecutive weeks in the top 25. UIndy is still clinging to a spot in the D2Football.com media poll, coming in at No. 25 this week. Meanwhile, Ashland is ranked 20th by the both the coaches and the media.

**LET IT REIGN**

The Greyhounds entered the fall as the conference favorite after topping the GLVC Preseason Coaches Poll. The reigning champs have grabbed 10 of the 13 GLVC championship trophies handed out since the league’s inaugural season in 2012, including each of the last three. The only other teams to win a GLVC football championship include 2016 co-champs Truman and Southwest Baptist and now-DI-institution Lindenwood (2019, 2021).

The Greyhounds own an impressive 33-4 (.892) mark versus GLVC opponents in the Chris Keevers era, part of an all-time 82-8 (.902) record in conference play since 2012. Coach Keevers and his ‘25 club are looking to join the 2012-15 Greyhounds as the only teams to win four consecutive GLVC football trophies.

**PLAYOFF PUSH**

With the Hounds rolling the past three seasons, this fall presents a history-making potential: a fourth straight playoff appearance. UIndy secured three consecutive postseason berths from 2017 to ‘19, but a return to the playoffs this November will mark the program’s first-ever four-year run of postseason play. Overall, the Greyhounds have made nine playoff trips since 2012, with first-round wins in ‘12 and ‘18 representing their only postseason victories to date.

**HEAD COACH CHRIS KEEVERS**



Indianapolis-native Chris Keevers enters his seventh season as the UIndy head coach in 2025. After spending 25 years as an assistant at UIndy, He took over as the head man in 2019 and has compiled an impressive list of accomplishments in his time at the helm.

Keevers was voted the GLVC Coach of the Year by his peers four times in the last five years. He captured consecutive conference crowns in 2022, '23 and '24 after earning his first GLVC title in the spring of 2021. He also guided the Greyhounds to four NCAA Division II playoff appearances, while his .797 career winning percentage is tops in program history\*.

Last fall, Keevers guided the Hounds to their fourth-ever 10-win regular season, as well as a third consecutive playoff appearance and GLVC title. UIndy finished the regular season with three straight 50-point performances, including a GLVC-title-clinching win versus Missouri S&T, 55-10. UIndy excelled in all facets of the game, finishing the season ranked fifth in Division II in kickoff return average, sixth in rushing defense, 10th in turnover margin and 12th in total offense.

Prior to taking over the head job at UIndy, Keevers wore numerous coaching hats, working with all positions on the defensive side of the ball, while also spending time as both a special teams and strength & conditioning coach. In his 12th and final season as the Greyhound defensive coordinator in 2018, he led a unit that ranked 13th in Division II in passing defense, 15th in scoring defense and 18th in total defense.

Since UIndy football joined the Great Lakes Valley Conference in 2012, Keevers has helped the Hounds to 10 conference titles and nine NCAA Division II playoff appearances, a span that includes a 113-29 (.796) overall record and a stellar 60-9 (.870) mark at home.

Prior to joining the UIndy staff in 1994, Keevers helped Division II St. Mary's College (Calif.) to three winning seasons as the Gaels' defensive line, special teams and strength & conditioning coach from 1991-93. He also spent three seasons as the defensive line graduate and student assistant at Purdue, his alma mater.

As a player, Keevers' career began at Coffeyville Community College (Kan.), where he was a Junior College All-America Honorable Mention honoree. He transferred to Big Ten-member Purdue University and excelled on the defensive line as a two-year starter.

In 1986, he earned a spot on the Boilermaker d-line and started on the same side of the ball as future NFL Hall of Famer Rod Woodson. As a senior in '87, Keevers was named the ABC "Player of the Game" for his performance at lowa in October of that season, and he later won the team's Leonard Wilson Award (for "unselfishness and dedication"). He was also nominated for the athletic department's Red Mackey Award (for "competitive spirit, a positive attitude, loyalty, self-discipline, hard work for the best interest of the team and a willingness to help others").

A graduate of local John Marshall Community High School, Keevers earned a communications degree in 1989 and a master's degree in education administration in '91 – both at Purdue. He and wife Alexis have four children: Chris, Jessica, Tucker (who played football at UIndy from 2021-24) and Porter (a former UIndy wrestler).
