GREYHOUND NOTES

FIND CHIKAMBA DOWN LOW

Coming off an All-GLVC Second Team nod last season, UIndy forward Patricia Chikamba is off to a hot start this year. Chikamba's 14.4 points-per-game average sits eighth in the league, and leads the Hounds' in rebounds with 5.2. The senior led the Hounds in scoring and rebounding last season, averaging 16.6 points and 7.6 boards per game.

(BACK HOME AGAIN IN) INDIANA

Facilitating the backcourt alongside Sapenter has been the sharpshooting transfer Graycie Poe, who's averaged 8.5 points. Poe had her best game donning the Crimson and Grey with 21 points against Rockhurst.

Poe made the return to her home state of Indiana after spending the 2024-2025 campaign at Limestone University. The Bicknell, Ind., native brings a breadth of experience and scoring prowess at the Division II level, averaging 10.6 points per game through 30.9 minutes per game last season. Poe also shot 42.9% from deep last season, which ranked second in the SAC.

STOCKS RISING

UIndy's defense is forcing 16.8 turnovers per game midway through the season, collecting 244 steals and 65 blocks. Amyrah Sapenter leads the way with 42 steals and Taylor Van Meter has 40, while Kyla Lawson steers UIndy's rim protection with 21 blocks on the season.

LAST GAME

In the Hounds' final road game of the 2025-26 season, they attempted to make furious second half comeback against Truman, but came up just short, 82-76. The second half was all Greyhounds after the eight minute mark in the third quarter, shooting an impressive 17-for-26 clip from the field, good enough for a .549 shooting percentage for the game.

UIndy had five players in double figures for the second time in the Sharp era, with the other game coming against UMSL last season. Graycie Poe and Autumn Rucker led the way with 19 and 18 points, respectively, while Amyrah Sapenter, Halie Gilbert and Patricia Chikamba all notched 10 plus points as well. The five of them combined for 68 of the team's 76 points against the Bulldogs.

ABOUT QUINCY

The Hawks, led by first year coach Ali Schwagmeyer-Belger, sit at 14-12 and right on the bubble of the GLVC Tournament field. It's a tale of two stories on both sides of the ball, as they shoot the ball at a GLVC high, .336 clip, but the Hawks rank near the bottom in the GLVC in opponent three-point percentage, .319.

Katey Flynn leads the charge for the Hawks on the offensive side, averaging 12 points per game. She dropped 32 points and seven boards against Ursuline earlier this season. Hayven Harden is the other double digit scorer with 10.8 points for Quincy, and is a presence down low, swatting at least 24 shots this season.

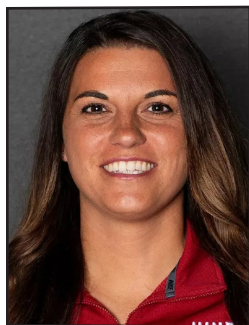

HEAD COACH - JAMA SHARP



A former Stetson University three-time captain, Female Athlete of the Year, and 2022 Assistant Coach of the Year, Jama Sharp was announced as the 11th head coach in Greyhound program history in May 2024.

Sharp returns to her home state for the first time since 2011 when she

graduated as Mooresville High School's all-time leading scorer and was named an Indiana All-Star before attending college at Stetson.

Sharp earned her first win as a collegiate head coach on Nov. 14, 2024, in a 98-87 win at Saint Mary-of-the-Woods before recording her first win against an NCAA DII opponent a week later at Purdue Northwest. In her first season, Sharp mentored All-GLVC Second Team selection Patricia Chikamba, who led the team in scoring and rebounding in 2024-25.

During her coaching tenure at Stetson, Sharp progressed from coordinating and organizing practices, creating recruiting graphics and materials, running the team's social media accounts, and specifically working on-court with guards, to later leading the offense, and, most recently serving as Stetson's defensive coordinator.

As a point guard and member of the Hatters from 2011-15, Sharp scored more than 1,200 career points and played in all 133 games while twice earning A-SUN All-Conference honors and graduating cum laude.

Prior to joining the Stetson bench, Sharp made stops at three academically-selective Power Five programs with in the SEC, Big 12, and ACC. Initially beginning as part of the scouting and video coordination teams at the University of Florida, the University of Texas, and the University of Virginia, Sharp advanced to become an assistant coach at Virginia for one season.

Sharp recently earned her Master of Business Administration from Stetson, two years removed from being inducted into the university's athletics hall of fame. She was also inducted into the Mooresville High School Hall of Fame in 2022.
