THIS WEEK'S GAME

The Terriers will begin the 2010 season on the road when they face Ohio University on September 4 ... It will mark the first meeting between the two schools and the first game against a MAC opponent for Wofford ... The Terriers will be opening the season away from home (and against an FBS team that reached a bowl game the previous year) for the second straight season.

ABOUT WOFFORD

Wofford is returning a total of 20 starters from last season and 49 lettermen overall ... Among the 20 returning starters are nine on offense, nine on defense and two specialists ... Key returners include All-SoCon offensive linemen Pat Illig and Clark Bishop ... In addition, the team will have back players such as Eric Breitenstein and Jeremy Marshall who missed a majority of last season due to injury ... The Terriers return the leading scorer (Christian Reed, 47 points), the leading rusher (Mitch Allen, 633 yards), the leading passer (Mitch Allen, 605 yards), the leading receiver (Brenton Bersin, 356 yards) and the top tackler (Tommy Irvin, 74 tackles) for the 2010 season.

ABOUT OHIO

Ohio is returning 14 starters from last season and 58 lettermen overall ... Last season the Bobcats were 9-5 overall and played in both the MAC Championship game and the Little Caesars Pizza Bowl ... Frank Solich is 32-31 at Ohio in six years and has a 90-50 career record.

THE OHIO SERIES

This marks the first meeting between Wofford and Ohio in any major sport (football, men's and women's basketball, and baseball).

TERRIER-BOBCAT CONNECTIONS

The Terriers have six players on the roster from the state of Ohio: Zach Murray (Avon Lake), Mitch Allen (Cincinnati), Josh Hillard (Delaware), Mike Niam (Hudson), Cody Burris (Plain City) and T.J. White (Troy). The Bobcats have one player from the state of South

WOFFORD 2009 SEASON RECAP

Wofford finished the 2009 season 3-8 overall and 2-6 in the Southern Conference. It marked the end of a streak of eight winning seasons in a row. The Terriers had a loss at the University of South Florida, a win at home against Charleston Southern and a loss at Wisconsin in non-conference play. In the league, Wofford had losses to Chattanooga, Georgia Southern, Appalachian State, Elon, Samford and Furman, plus wins over Western Carolina and The Citadel. The rushing offense was second in the nation at 270.18 yards per game, but the passing offense was next to last in the NCAA. The offensive line tied for fifth in the nation for fewest sacks allowed. Injuries took a toll on the Terriers this season and as a result Wofford had 36 different players earn starts this season.

TERRIER TOP TEN

Here are the top ten notes of interest after the 2009 season:

- The Terriers finished second in the nation in rushing with 270.18 yards per game in 2009
- Fourteen players made their first career starts at South Florida and a total of 23 players marked their first career starts this season
- The Terriers had only twelve players start all eleven games last season
- Linebacker Keaton Thompson had a tackle for loss in the last eight straight games of the season
- Wofford had six players among the top 25 rushers in the conference
- The Terriers were led in tackles by six different players in the eleven games this season
- Mike Rucker is second all-time in kickoff return yards with 1,964 and second in kickoff returns with 85
- Wofford led the SoCon in kickoff returns
- The two FBS teams Wofford played last season, Wisconsin and South Florida, both were ranked in the *USA Today* Top 25 during the season and both participated in bowl games
- The offensive line tied for fifth in the nation in fewest sacks allowed

HEAD COACH MIKE AYERS

Wofford head coach Mike Ayers (Georgetown, Ky. '74), the winningest coach in school history, is entering his 23rd season at the Terrier helm with a record of 144-104-1. Ayers is in his 25th year as a collegiate head coach and has a record of 155-125-2 that includes a three-year stint as the head coach at East Tennessee State from 1985-87. Ayers has earned Southern Conference Coach of the Year honors from the league coaches in 2000, 2003 and 2007 and by the media in 2000, '02 and '03. Ayers was the 2003 recipient of the Eddie Robinson Award as Division I-AA's National Coach of the Year and also earned the 2002 Division I-AA National Coach of the Year award from the *College Sporting News* in addition to being the runner-up for the Robinson Award.

SEASON OPENERS

Wofford is 46-54-1 all-time in season openers since posting a 5-1 win over Furman on December 14, 1889 ... Under head coach Mike Ayers, the Terriers are 12-10 in season openers ... The loss at USF in 2009 ended a streak of winning five straight season openers (38-21 over Presbyterian in 2008, 38-21 over Georgetown in 2007, 28-21 over South Carolina State in 2006, 34-24 over Georgetown in 2005, 24-22 over South Carolina State in 2004) ... When Wofford opens the season at home, its record is 24-20-1.

PRESEASON SOUTHERN CONFERENCE POLL

In the 2010 Southern Conference Preseason Poll, defending conference champion Appalachian State was picked to finish first by the coaches and media. Wofford was picked sixth by the coaches and fifth by the media. Elon was picked second by the media and coaches.

PRESEASON ALL-SOUTHERN CONFERENCE

The Terriers had six players recognized by the Southern Conference football coaches on the 2010 preseason all-conference team, including one on the first team. For the defense, juniors Eric Eberhardt (Suwanee, Ga.) and Ameet Pall (Montreal, Quebec) were named to the second team at defensive line. Redshirt sophomore linebacker Mike Niam (Hudson, Ohio) also earned a spot on the second team. On offense, senior lineman Pat Illig (Pittsburg, Pa.) was named to the first team. Illig earned All-SoCon first team honors in 2009. On the second team for the offense are senior running back Mike Rucker (Winston-Salem,

N.C.) and senior offensive lineman Clark Bishop (Leesburg, Ga.).

2009 ALL-SOUTHERN CONFERENCE

Wofford had three players named to the Coaches All-Southern Conference Team. Offensive lineman Pat Illig and punter Chris Tommie were named to the first team and offensive lineman Clark Bishop was named to the second team. Illig and Tommie also earned spots on the SCSMA Media All-Conference Team.

Pat Illig, a junior from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, started all eleven games at left guard and led the team in knockdowns with 98 on the season. The offensive line allowed only nine sacks this year, the sixth-fewest in the nation.

A senior from Greenwood, S.C., Chris Tommie led the conference in punting with a 43.8 average. He also had four punts of over 50 yards and three that were inside the 20. His average is the best in school history for a single season, topping the 42.7 by Scooter White (1969) and Jimmy Miner (2002). Tommie missed the 2008 season due to injury.

Clark Bishop, a junior from Leesburg, Ga., started all eleven games at right tackle and had 61 knockdowns on the season. He was part of an offensive line that paved the way for an average of 270.18 rushing yards per game that was second in the nation.

2009 SOCON ALL-FRESHMAN TEAM

Linebacker SeQuan Stanley earned a spot on the SoCon All-Freshman Team. Stanley started six games for the Terriers and was tied for third on the team with 55 tackles. He also had 5.5 tackles for loss and two sacks, plus two fumble recoveries.

WOFFORD IN THE 2009 NATIONAL RANKINGS

At the end of the regular season, several Terriers were listed in the national rankings. Mitch Allen was 75nd in the nation with a 57.55 rushing average. Mike Rucker was 59th among all-purpose rushers with 106.09 yards per game and he was 72nd in kickoff return yards. Stephon Shelton was 13th in kickoff returns with a 25.82 average. The team was second in rushing offense, 39th in punt returns, 51st in sacks, 18th in net punting, 30th in kickoff returns and fifth in sacks allowed per game.

THE TERRIERS IN THE 2009 CONFERENCE RANKINGS

Wofford was ranked in several key categories in the conference statistics as well last season. Wofford was first in rushing and kickoff returns, second in sacks allowed and third in net punting. In the top 25 conference rushers, Wofford had Mitch Allen (4), Mike Rucker (7), Michael Scott (8), Austin Palmer (18), Stev Davitte (20) and Arsenio Parks (22). Mitch Allen was eighth in total offense, followed by Mike Rucker at 13th and Michael Scott at 15th. Phillip LeGrande, Kendall Bratcher, Tommy Irvin, Jonathon Sharpe, Gary Blount and Mychael Johnson were tied at 21st in interceptions. Ameet Pall and Keaton Thompson were tied for 12th tenth in sacks, while Alex Goltry was 19th. Mike Rucker was sixth in the conference in kickoff return yards and sixth in all-purpose yards. Stephon Shelton led the conference in kickoff returns. Christian Reed was 12th in scoring and ninth in field goals per game. Gary Blount was tenth in tackles for loss. Brenton Bersin was 12th in receiving yards per game.



INJURY UPDATE

Wofford enters the Ohio game with several players already out for the season. These include S Rob Williams (knee), DL Anthony Williamson (knee), RB Derek Boyce (knee), LB Ricco Braxton (knee), and RB Michael Scott (medical). In addition, players that are out for the season opener include S Hunter Hobson (sports hernia), RB Cody Burris (knee), TE Mike Crawford (knee), TE Jamie Chappell (chest), OL Tony Goodwin (knee), LB Mike Niam (knee), LB Sam Johnson (ankle), OL Jared Wilken (back) and RB Sean Lees (ankle).

TERRIERS AGAINST FBS TEAMS

The 2010 season will mark the tenth time in the last eleven seasons the Terriers have played against a member of the FBS (NCAA Division I-A). Last year, Wofford lost at South Florida and at Wisconsin, both of whom played in postseason bowl games. The Terriers were defeated 23-13 by South Carolina in 2008. In 2007, Wofford was defeated 38-17 at NC State after several turnovers hurt the Terriers chances. In 2006, Wofford lost 27-20 at South Carolina as the Terriers brought the score within one touchdown with 4:42 on the clock and then drove to the Gamecock 10-yard line. Recently the Terriers have also played West Virginia (2005), Air Force (2003), Maryland (2002), Clemson (2001), South Carolina (2001) and Louisiana Monroe (2000). South Carolina, Georgia Tech and Clemson are included on future schedules.

THE RETURNING TERRIERS

The Terriers return 18 of 22 starters (plus two specialists), with the only losses WR Justice Joslin, OL Matt Vick, LB Gary Blount and S Mychael Johnson. The Terriers will have back in starting roles HB Jeremy Marshall and FB Eric Breitenstein, who missed most of last season due to injury. Overall the offense can rely on 13 players who have started games in the past, while the defense has 13 returners with starts under their belts.

THE 2010 SCHEDULE

The Terriers will once again have a difficult schedule in front of them in 2010. After the opener at Ohio, who played in the MAC Championship game and the Little Caesars Bowl, Wofford will travel to Charleston Southern. It will be the first time since 2004 the Terriers have played the first two games on the road. The home schedule begins with Union (Ky.) and continues with the first SoCon game against Furman on October 2. In addition, the Terriers will host Western Carolina and The Citadel and travel to Appalachian State, Elon and Samford in SoCon play.

SWITCHING POSITIONS

In preparation for the 2010 season, several players switched positions for spring practice. Clark Gaston has moved from tight end over to outside linebacker, Jordan Ingman has moved to wide receiver from cornerback and T.J. White has moved to the offensive line from the defensive line.

SWITCHING NUMBERS

Several players changed numbers during the off-season. Clark Gaston is wearing #33, T.J. White is #61, Devin Reed is #19, Chris White is #16 and Sam Johnson is #28.

DEAN OF SOUTH CAROLINA COACHES

Head coach Mike Ayers completed his 22nd season at Wofford, the longest-serving coach at the Division I level in South Carolina. With 145 wins at Wofford, he is also the winningest coach among the coaches at their current schools. Here are the numbers following the 2009 season:

THE TRUE FRESHMAN IMPACT IN 2009

True freshmen made a big impact for the Terriers in 2009, primarily on the defensive side of the ball. Eleven true freshmen played, with four getting starts. LB Anthony Carden started six games and LB SeQuan Stanley started six games as well. CB Blake Wylie started five games and Stephon Shelton had two starts. Stanley was third on the team in tackles, while Wylie was seventh with 37 tackles. Other true freshmen with playing time included DB Rob Williams, LB Mark Flott, LB Phillip LeGrande, S Jamar Reaves, DL Josh Roseborough, DB C.J. Turner and PK Christian Reed. A majority of true freshmen were redshirted for the season.

2010 RECRUITING CLASS

Wofford welcomes a total of 18 student-athletes in the 2010 recruiting class. The Terriers freshmen include twelve players on offense, five players on defense and a specialist. The student-athletes are from six different states, including five from North Carolina and four from Georgia. In addition, eight walk-ons will also be joining the team.

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES

Against the University of South Florida in the 2009 season opener, the Terriers had 14 different players record their first career start. On offense, Mitch Allen, Matt Vick, Ben Wilmoth, Clark Bishop, Brenton Bersin and Devin Reed started for the first time. Jordan Ingman, SeQuan Stanley, Ameet Pall, Keaton Thompson, Eric Eberhardt, Alex Goltry, Mike Niam and Kendall Bratcher recorded their first career starts on defense. This season for the Ohio game, players who are slated for their first starts include OL Calvin Cantrell, RB Brad Nocek, LB Phillip LeGrande and LB Mike McCrimon.

NEW FACES ON THE DEPTH CHART

To begin the 2010 season, the Terriers have several new faces on the depth chart. On offense, Tymeoco Gregory, Joey Ready and Jared Singleton are listed among the offensive linemen. Michael Harpe is list at tight end, while Brian Kass and Chris White are at quarterback. Among running backs, Lavadrick Farrar and Brad Nocek are on the two-deep. On the defense, James Zotto, Mike McCrimon, James Lane and Alvon Scioneaux are at linebacker. Kasey Redfern will be the kickoff specialist and punter heading into the first game.

FOURTH DOWN? GO FOR IT!

In 2009, Wofford tied for the lead in the nation with 35 fourth down attempts along with Georgetown. VMI tried it 33 times and Colgate 31 times. The Terriers had a success rate of 37.14%, which was 87th in the nation. Furman (9-11) was first with an 81.2% rate.

WALK-ON SUCCESS

Several true walk-ons made an impact with the Terriers last season. Senior Austin Palmer came to Wofford as a walk-on and earned a scholarship. He had his first career start at Chattanooga and

TERRIERS ON TV

scored two touchdowns at Wisconsin, plus one against Appalachian State and at Furman. Other walk-ons who saw extensive time on the field included RB Alex Dumire, DL Anthony Williamson, LB Sam Johnson and WR David Royster.

THE BIG PLAY IS BACK

After only 14 plays of 20 or more yards (30 or more on kickoff returns) in the first five games of 2009, the Terriers got the big play back against Appalachian State and Western Carolina. Wofford hit nine big plays, including three touchdowns of over 60-yards against the Mountaineers. Brenton Bersin and Justice Joslin each had two big catches, while Stephon Shelton added a 62-yard kickoff return. At Western Carolina, Wofford had nine big plays, including a punt return and rush by Justice Joslin. In 2008, the big play was a staple of the Wofford offense, with 74 total big plays, compared to only 47 in 2009.

GOING OVERTIME

The overtime game on September 27, 2008 at Georgia Southern was only the fourth overtime game in school history. The Terriers lost the first two overtime games. On October 19, 2002, Wofford defeated Western Carolina 31-24. With the 38-37 win at Georgia Southern, Wofford is now 2-2 all-time in overtime games.

POLL POSITION

In 2009, Wofford began the season tenth in both polls, but dropped each week. On September 28, the Terriers fell out of the rankings for the first time since November 3, 2006, the final poll of the season. To start 2010, Wofford is receiving votes in both polls, but unranked.

WINNING SEASONS

Wofford's 9-3 record in 2008 gave the Terriers a winning season for the seventh straight season year. Over the past twenty-two seasons under Coach Ayers, Wofford has recorded 15 winning seasons. With a 3-8 mark in 2009, the streak ended at seven seasons.

WOFFORD VS. NON-CONFERENCE OPPONENTS

Since 2000, Wofford is 17-1 in non-conference regular season FCS games ... Wofford's loss to Coastal Carolina in 2006 snapped a streak of 10 straight regular season non-conference wins against FCS opponents ... The Terriers had not lost a non-conference regular season game to a FCS opponent since dropping the 2000 season opener to Lehigh 34-14 ... In 2000 and 2001, the Terriers defeated Charleston Southern ... In 2002, Wofford had non-league wins over South Carolina State and Elon ... In 2003 and 2004, the Terriers defeated South Carolina State while also adding a win over Gardner-Webb in '04 ... In 2005, Wofford defeated VMI and Gardner-Webb ... The Terriers opened the 2006 campaign with a 28-21 win over South Carolina State and ended the season with a non-conference win over Gardner-Webb. In 2007, Wofford went 3-0 with regular season non-conference wins over Georgetown, Charleston Southern, and Gardner-Webb. In the 2008 season, the Terriers opened with wins over Presbyterian and Charleston Southern for a 2-0 record. Wofford added a win over Charleston Southern in 2009.

TERRIERS AT HOME

Wofford has won 32 of its last 43 games played in Gibbs Stadium ... Since Gibbs Stadium opened on Oct. 5, 1996, Wofford has posted a record of 52-23 (.693) ... Under Mike Ayers, Wofford is 61-37 (.622) in home games ... The Terriers have won 30 of 48 home SoCon games at Gibbs Stadium ... The home crowd has been exceptional, with two of the top five all-time crowds in 2007 ... The Georgia Southern game was witnessed by a school-record 12,124 fans, while the Appalachian State game had 11,042 fans, fifth most in school history.

FACING NUMBER ONE

When Wofford faced Appalachian State on September 22, 2008, it marked only the third time that the Terriers have faced a team at the top of the polls. In 1999, Wofford lost 55-14 at Gibbs Stadium to top-ranked Georgia Southern. In 2003, Wofford lost 24-9 to Delaware in the NCAA Playoffs. With the 42-31 win on September 22, it marked the first time Wofford had defeated a top-ranked team. When the Terriers played at James Madison on November 29, it was the fourth time facing the #1 team.

HOME COOKING

The Terriers were an impressive 6-0 at Gibbs Stadium in 2008. The last time Wofford was undefeated at home was in the 2003 season with a 6-0 regular season mark, plus 2-0 in the postseason. At home in 2009 was not as successful as Wofford was 1-4 on the grass at Gibbs.

DEFENSE BY COMMITTEE

The Terrier defense is receiving contributions from numerous players in 2009. Fifteen players have 20+ tackles on the season, while eleven different players have sacks. Seven players have recovered fumbles and nine players have forced fumbles. Twenty players recorded a tackle for loss.

BEHIND CENTER

The Terriers returning starter at quarterback will be Mitch Allen. Last season he started all eleven games and threw for 605 yards and seven touchdowns along with being the team's leading rusher with 633 yards and six touchdowns. Brian Kass sat out last season as a freshman and is expected to contribute this season. Chris White also returns, having played in three games in 2009. Freshmen Willie Favors and Madison Burr will also be in the mix this season.

PREVENTING THE SACK

In 2009, Wofford allowed only nine sacks which tied for fifth in the nation. VMI allowed only five sacks last season to lead the nation.

DROPPING THE QB

While the offensive line prevented sacks, the defensive line made them with 21 in the 2009 season for a loss of 147 yards to rank fifth in the SoCon and 51st in the nation. In addition, the Terriers had 64 tackles for a loss of 266 yards which is fifth in the conference.

SPREADING AROUND THE CARRIES

The Terriers spread around the carries last season, with 17 players having at least one carry. Seven of those players had more than 100 yards on the season and seven different players scored rushing touchdowns. In addition, six players started at halfback and fullback, compared to only five all of last season.

THE 2009 TERRIERS GROUND ATTACK

At the end of the 2009 season, the Wofford rushing offense was second in the nation with an average of 270.18 yards per game rushing. The top FBS team was Nevada at 362.25 yards per game, followed by Georgia Tech at 307.15 yards.

TURNOVER TURN-AROUND

In 2008, Wofford was second in the Southern Conference and 14th in the nation with a +0.92 turnover margin per game. The Terriers turned the ball over only eleven times in twelve games, four interceptions and seven fumbles. On the other side, Wofford gained 22 turnovers - thirteen interceptions and nine fumble recoveries.

Last season, the tables turned. Wofford turned the ball over 27 times (19 fumbles, eight interceptions) while only taking the ball away 17 times (eleven fumbles, six interceptions). The -0.91 average turnover margin was 104th in the nation. The only three games where Wofford was plus on turnovers were wins (CSU, Citadel and WCU).

RUNNING BY COMMITTEE

Due to injuries, the backfield took a hit last season resulting in many different players seeing time on the field. Overall, 17 players had at least one carry, with seven players having more than 100 yards on the season. Seven different players scored rushing touchdowns. In addition, six players started at halfback and fullback, compared to only five all of last season.

RUCKER ON THE RETURN

Senior running back Mike Rucker has made his mark in the record books on kickoff returns. His 42 kickoff returns in 2008 were the most in a single season at Wofford, while his 931 kickoff return yards also were the most in school history in 2008. He was fifth in the Southern Conference in



kickoff returns and 68th in the nation that season. He is second on the career list in kickoff returns and second on the all-time list in kickoff return yardage with 1833 yards. His 23.2 career average is fourth in school history. Here are the top five all-time kickoff return leaders:

STRICKLAND AND THE NFL

Wide receiver Andy Strickland graduated from Wofford in May 2009 with a degree in finance, but his education on the football field has continued. He signed as a rookie free agent with the Jacksonville Jaguars in 2009 and caught two passes in the first preseason game, plus a 16-yard catch against Tampa Bay. He was released on August 24. Strickland led the Terriers in receiving for three seasons and finished his Wofford career eighth in all-time receptions, fifth all-time in receiving yards and third in career touchdown receptions. He was the Wofford first player in an NFL training camp since 2004. He was signed to the Atlanta Falcons practice squad on December 22 and has played in thier first three preseason games in 2010 with one catch.

HOME OPENERS

Wofford has won the last nine home openers. The last home opening loss came in 2000 when the Terriers lost 34-14 to Lehigh on September 9. With Mike Ayers at the helm, Wofford is 14-8 in home openers.

CONFERENCE OPENERS

The Terriers have lost their SoCon opener seven times in the 13 seasons as members of the conference. Before the loss to Chattanooga on September 26, the Terriers last lost an opener in 2006 against Furman. Wofford also lost to Chattanooga in a SoCon opener in the 2001 season.

ALUMNI COACHES

With the addition of Aaron Johnson to the coaching staff in 2008, Wofford now has six assistant coaches who graduated from Wofford College. The group includes Nathan Fuqua '03, Aaron Johnson '06, Wade Lang '83, Eric Nash '02, Shiel Wood '06 and Nate Woody '84. Nathan Fuqua is also a member of the Wofford Athletics Hall of Fame.

NEW TO THE STAFF

This season the Terriers added two coaches to the football coaching staff. James Adams takes over as cornerbacks coach after spending the last two years on the staff at Wake Forest. Peter Kalinowski joins the staff as the assistant offensive line coach. The two replace Josh Conklin, who is now defensive coordinator at The Citadel, and Lee Hanning who retired as kicking coach.

RECENT SUCCESS

Wofford has finished among the top four teams in the Southern Conference race in six of the last nine years, winning two SoCon Championships. The Terriers have won 39 of their last 59 conference games over the past eight seasons. Over that time, Wofford is the third-winningest program in the Southern Conference trailing only three-time national champion Appalachian State and Furman.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

Wofford's football program has ranked among the top 10 percent of FCS teams in the Academic Performance Review (APR) in four of the last five seasons to earn public recognition. The Terriers lead the SoCon with 74 Academic All-Southern Conference selections since the program started in 2003. When the NCAA released Graduation Success Rates in October 2009, the Wofford football team was second in the conference with a score of 95.

Wofford has had at least one player named CoSIDA/ESPN *The Magazine* First Team All-District in the last nine seasons. On November 5, Joe Fornadel was the latest in this long line when he was named to the All-District Third Team.

ABOUT WOFFORD

Wofford is currently the fourth-smallest school in NCAA Division I with an enrollment of 1,450

students. The smallest school is Centenary with 887, however they are in their final year of Division I competition in 2010-11. Next is Presbyterian College at 1,200 and VMI with 1,300. Wofford College, established in 1854, is an independent liberal arts college in Spartanburg, S.C. (average SAT for incoming class, 1247). Wofford ranks in the top five nationally in the percentage of undergraduates receiving credit for study abroad. Home to one of the nation's 276 Phi Beta Kappa chapters, Wofford's historic 175-acre campus is recognized as a national arboretum. Affiliated with the United Methodist Church, the college is committed to quintessential undergraduate education within the context of values-based inquiry.
