» LAST TIME OUT

Wofford outlasted Chattanooga 57-54 in a comeback thriller. Down by a point entering the fourth quarter, the Terriers stepped up to take the lead, and Evangelia Paulk's two clutch blocks in the closing seconds helped seal Wofford's triumph. Paulk posted 15 points, nine rebounds, four assists, and three steals to pace the squad across the board. Maddie Heiss added 12 points, and Helen Matthews netted 10. Overall, Wofford shot 37.5 percent with eight made threes. The Terriers again won the glass, 40-33.

HIGH EXPECTATIONS

- Despite not being the defending champion of the league this year, Wofford entered the 2024-25 campaign with a target on its back. The Terriers were tabbed as the preseason favorites to win the Southern Conference, earning all seven possible first-place votes in the preseason SoCon balloting. The league's coaches have presented high praise and respect to head coach Jimmy Garrity's squad, which enters the season as the first-place pick for the first time in program history.
- On top of the preseason first-place pick, Wofford made history before the campaign even began. Wofford was slated at No. 22 in the CollegeInsider.com preseason mid-major top 25. This marks the first time the Terriers have ever been ranked in that poll or any poll in program history.
- Also a part of the SoCon's preseason balloting, two Terriers were honored with Preseason All-SoCon recognition: Rachael Rose and Helen Matthews. Rose was named the league's preseason player of the year.

TOP DOGS

- Wofford is among the SoCon and national leaders in several statistical categories.
- The Terriers top the conference in assist/turnover ratio (0.90), field goal percentage defense (34.9), defensive rebounds per game (27.3), three-point attempts per game (25.1), three-point percentage defense (25.2), and three-pointers made per game (7.7).
- The Terrier field goal defense is 11th in the nation with the three-point defense 13th. The three-point attempts rank 36th with the makes 54th. Wofford's defensive rebounding checks in at 58th.
- Wofford is second in the league in free throw percentage (74.7), rebound margin (+6.2), rebounds per game (40.05), and scoring margin (+12.5).
- Wofford's free throw percentage ranks 72nd in the nation. The rebounding margin is 45th with the total rebounding average in 52nd. The Terrier scoring margin clocks in at 55th.

OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT

- The Terriers entered SoCon play at 8-5, with the eight wins tied for the second most in program history entering the conference opener. This marks the fourth time in program history that Wofford entered conference play with at least eight wins, and this is third consecutive season doing so. All four instances have come under head coach Jimmy Garrity. The most wins to enter conference play were the 10 of the 2022-23 campaign.
- By defeating Furman 68-51 to open SoCon play, the Terriers improved to 6-3 under Jimmy Garrity in conference openers and secured their fourth victory in the last five league openers.
- The Terriers are 6-0 to start conference play for the first time ever. The program's previous best start to league action was a 4-0 beginning to the 2020-21 campaign.

BATTLE TESTED

- The old saying goes, "To be the best you have to beat the best." Wofford is embodying that philosophy this season, playing a challenging schedule with positive results that will provide great preparation for league play.
- Wofford boasts the toughest NET non-conference strength of schedule in the conference. The Terrier non-conference schedule is the 15th toughest in the nation according to NET SOS. Samford is 23rd as the next-closest SoCon team.
- Entering conference play, Wofford's NET SOS stood as the 11th toughest in the country.
- The Terriers have played three ranked teams this season: No. 19 Kentucky, No. 9 Duke, and No. 2 South Carolina. This is the first time ever that Wofford has played multiple ranked teams in a season, let alone a total of three.
- On top of the ranked Power Conference opponents, the Terriers have been tested by quality mid-majors. High Point, whom Wofford bested in November, won the Big South regular season crown last season and was tabbed as the conference's preseason favorite entering this season. Both Lehigh (third) and Davidson (fourth) were selected top four in the preseason balloting of their respective leagues.
- The high caliber of competition is paying off. Wofford owns the best NET ranking in the SoCon at 132. UNCG is the next-closest team with a NET ranking of 154.

HOME SWEET HOME

- In the friendly confines of Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium, the Terriers went 13-2 last season with those 13 victories a new record for a season, besting the 12 wins of 1992-93, 1993-94 and 2018-19.
- Wofford has posted a record of .500 or better at home for nine-straight seasons and double-digit home wins in now four-straight campaigns with Wofford reaching 10 this season.
- In Jimmy Garrity's nine seasons at the helm, the Terriers have posted an 90-29 home record.
- Adding in the season before Garrity arrived (2015-16) in which Wofford began its run of nine consecutive .500-plus records at home, the Terriers are 101-35 at home during the streak.
- Since the Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium opened in 2017, the Terriers are 83-24 in the venue.
- So far this season, Wofford has won all 11 of its home contests. On the flip side, the Terriers are just 3-5 on the road this season. Wofford went an undefeated 7-0 at home in non-conference play, marking the second time in the last three seasons that the Terriers were unblemished in Spartanburg against non-conference foes.
- Dating back to last season, the Terriers have won nine-straight home non-conference games. The last home non-conference loss was against Bellarmine on

December 2, 2023.

- Wofford's overall home winning streak currently stands at 11 in a row, a new program record for its Division I era. This is also the women's record for Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium. The Terriers are now chasing the overall record for the facility, which is 17 in a row set by the Terrier men's basketball team between 2018-20.
- Entering the 2024-25 season, Wofford boasted the second-highest win total and second-best winning percentage at home since the opening of Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium (2017-18) of any SoCon team. Only Furman was better, and barely so, at 73-23 (.760) with Wofford at 72-24 (.750).

GOING ON THE OFFENSIVE

- The Wofford offense has consistently been one of the best in the conference over the past six seasons.
- Dating back to the 2018-19 season, Wofford has topped the SoCon in scoring offense in five of those six seasons and placed top four in all six.
- A large part of that scoring success is Wofford's ability to score from distance. Over those six seasons, Wofford has paced the league in three-pointers made four times and been top four all six seasons.
- On top of that, the Terriers have led the league in three-point percentage twice over that span and finished top three all but once, a fifth-place result in 2020-21.
- A key component of the success is Wofford boasting a top scorer or two in almost every campaign. Over the last six seasons, at least one Terrier finished in the top five of the league in scoring four times and in the top 10 five times, including two seasons in which two Terriers placed in the top 10. The only season without a Terrier in the top 10 in scoring was the 2020-21 season in which Wofford was not first as a team.
- Wofford finished last season as the conference leader in scoring offense at 66.6 points per game. This is aided by the duo of Rachael Rose and Maddie Heiss ranking first and 11th, respectively, in scoring at 22.3 PPG and 10.7 PPG.
- The Terriers began this season red-hot offensively, posting 76 and 75 points in each of the first two contests. Wofford has scored at least 60 points in every game but three this season and averages 69.2 points per game, third in the conference.
- Helen Matthews leads the offensive charge this season with 11.4 points per game. She is ninth in the conference. Three other Terriers qualify to rank in the top 20 of the league as Evangelia Paulk (11.3 - 10th), Maddie Heiss (10.4 - 16th), and Molly Masingale (10.4 - 17th) join her.
- The Terriers have tallied at least 70 points in nine games this season. Coincidentally, each of Wofford's five losses came when scoring under 70 points, but the Terriers have won each of their 70-point outings.

EASY AS 1, 2, E

- Evangelia Paulk, nicknamed E, also started her career in fashion as a freshman last season.
- She was tabbed as the SoCon Freshman of the Year, the third in program history, by the media poll. She was recognized on the all-freshman team in both the coaches and media polls.
- Paulk tallied five double-doubles as a rookie, breaking the program's freshman record. That bar was originally set by Elizabeth Wells with her four in 1995-96, Wofford's first Division I season.
- With a rebounding average of 6.9, Paulk ranked eighth in the SoCon last season. Among freshmen, Paulk was 20th nationally in rebounding average.
- Paulk is following up her stellar freshman campaign

with the opposite of a sophomore slump.

- Paulk has shined significantly on defense this season, recording 61 steals through 19 games to lead the conference and rank 12th in the NCAA. Paulk's rate of 3.21 per game also tops the league and sits eighth in the country. She is almost exactly one full steal per game away from national leader Megan McConnell of Duquesne (4.10). Paulk is one of just 18 players in the country to own at least 60 swipes.
- Paulk's per game rate is far and away the best in the league. She is almost one full steal per game ahead of the next-closest player, UNCG's Jayde Gamble at 2.50 per game.
- Against Erskine, Paulk made history with 13 steals, setting a single-game program record. This bested the prior mark of 12 set by Rachel Brittenham against Western Carolina in 2011. Those swipes are tied for second most in a game in both SoCon and NCAA history, and they are the most by a current SoCon member school and the most this century by a SoCon player. Both the SoCon and NCAA record is 14 steals.
- Paulk's 13 swipes are the most by a player in a game not just this season but in years. The last Division I player to record 13 steals in a game was Hampton's Monnazjea Finney-Smith on January 20, 2018.
- The most versatile player on the Wofford roster this season, Paulk is 10th in the SoCon in scoring at 11.1 points per game. She is second in the league with 8.1 rebounds per game. Paulk is the only player in the SoCon to rank in the top 10 of the league in scoring and top five in both rebounding and steals. Paulk owns four double-doubles this season.
- She boasts a game of 20-plus points scored, a game of 15-plus rebounds, and a game of 10-plus steals. Paulk is the only player in the entire nation to have achieved each of those three at least once this season.
- Her 15 boards against Western Carolina tied her career high and marked her second 15-rebound game of her career. She is only the third Terrier to ever record multiple games of 15-plus boards, joining Mahogany Williams (five) and Elizabeth Wells (two).
- In SoCon play, Paulk has stepped her game up a level. She is the only player averaging a double-double in league play with 14.2 points per game and 10.7 rebounds per game. Her SoCon boards are first in the conference with the scoring clip fifth.
- Paulk's 46.3 percent shooting clip in league action is fourth in the conference. Settling in beyond the arc, Paulk is knocking down 1.83 threes per game in league action, tied for the third most in the conference.
- With a double-double of 18 points and 11 boards in the SoCon-opening win over Furman, Paulk secured her first-career SoCon Player of the Week recognition. She is the first Terrier not named Rachael Rose to earn the honor since Jackie Carman on February 15, 2022. Rose had earned each of the last eight such honors for Wofford.

MATTHEWS MAGIC

- Fifth-year senior Helen Matthews is back with authority this season after missing the last campaign due to an injury.
- Matthews, a native of Kaiapoi, New Zealand, is leading the team and sitting ninth in the conference in scoring at a rate of 11.4 points per game.
- Efficient with her shot, Matthews is hitting at a clip of 42.4 percent overall with a free throw clip of 87.8 percent.
- The former SoCon All-Defensive Team honoree has elevated her game in conference action, tallying 15.2 points per game in league play, third most in the conference. Her 49.2 percent shooting clip ranks second, and her 90.0 free throw mark is third.

- Unbothered by her recovery, Matthews is posting the best season of her career. Her 42.4 percent shooting clip is the best of her career, as is her 87.8 percent free throw mark. At 11.4 points per game, this is the first time she's ever averaged double-digits with her previous high being 9.7 points per game as a junior.

NEWFOUND DEPTH

- Wofford is reaping the benefits this season of a luxury it did not have last season: depth.
- In the 2023-24 campaign, the Terriers were unfortunately down three players who all suffered season-ending injuries in the preseason. This limited the number of bench players available and as such, the number of bench points that could be provided.
- Wofford amassed 10.9 bench points per game last season, ranking 326th out of 349 Division I programs.
- It has been a near 180-degree turnaround to begin this season. With the Terriers routinely playing nearly every available player on a given night, Wofford is averaging 22.6 bench points per contest. This is third in the conference and 88th in the nation.

PICK YOUR POISON

- Wofford has utilized a balanced attack all season, forcing defenses to choose between a plethora of scoring threats.
- Seven different Terriers have at least tied for the team lead in scoring in a game this season. Evangelia Paulk has done so the most at six times, and Helen Matthews is right behind with five instances. Maddie Heiss boasts four such occasions.
- Wofford has seen at least three Terriers tally double-digits in each game but six this season. The season high is six in double figures against Southern Wesleyan.
- All but one of the 11 Terriers on the roster have scored double-digits in a contest at least once this season. Nine of the 11 have done so multiple times already. Maddie Heiss owns the most double-digit outings with 11.
- Six Terriers have reached 20 points in a game this season. Rachael Rose and Helen Matthews are the only ones to do so multiple times, recording a pair of 20-balls each. The Terriers have one game in which multiple players reached 20-plus points as all three freshmen (Madi Hawk, Molly Masingale, and Toni Warren) reached the 20-point threshold against Erskine. Wofford is the only known team in the nation to have at least three freshmen all score 20-plus points in the same game this season.
- Nine of the 10 Terriers with at least 46 attempts are shooting at least 35 percent from the field. Five of them are shooting over 40 percent: Mia Flor (46.3), Libby Privett (40.6), Molly Masingale (41.6), Helen Matthews (42.4), and Queen Ikhiuwu (41.3).
- Of the Terriers with at least 30 three-point attempts, four are shooting at least 30 percent from deep. Libby Privett is leading the way at 39.4 percent (13-of-33).
- Wofford has five players averaging double-digit points per game: Rachael Rose (12.5), Helen Matthews (11.4), Evangelia Paulk (11.3), Maddie Heiss (10.4), and Molly Masingale (10.4).
- The scoring has been even more balanced in conference play. Two Terriers rank in the top five of the league in conference scoring with Helen Matthews in third (15.2) and Evangelia Paulk in fifth (14.2). Molly Masingale marks a trio of Terriers in the top 10, posting 13.0 per game in ninth. Wofford is the only team in the conference with three players in the top 10 of scoring in league games and two in the top five.

THE BOARD GAME

- Wofford had its best rebounding season in three years during the last campaign. In the 2020-21 season, Wofford led the league with 40.83 rebounds per

game. However, the Terriers have not reached 40 per game since, nor had they finished in the top half of the conference in rebounding average until last season.

- To conclude the 2023-24 campaign, Wofford was fourth in rebounding average at 38.10 per game to rank in the top half of the league for the first time in three years despite still falling short of 40 boards per game. The Terriers were fourth in offensive boards per game (10.9) but really shined on the defensive glass at 27.2 per game, tops in the conference and 66th nationally.
- This was thanks in large part to a pair of Terriers ranking in the top 10 of the SoCon in rebounding. Rachael Rose and Evangelia Paulk averaged 8.6 and 7.0 rebounds per game, respectively, to clock in at first and fifth in the SoCon, respectively. Rose's 240 total boards were third, and Paulk was eighth with her 196 total rebounds.
- The rebounding success has carried over into this season. Overall, Wofford is second in the league and 52nd nationally with 40.05 rebounds per game. If this mark can hold, Wofford will secure its first season of at least 40 rebounds per game since the 2020-21 campaign. On the offensive glass, the Terriers boast 12.7 per game, third in the SoCon. This is paired with the most defensive boards in the league, 27.3, which is 58th nationally.
- Wofford has outrebounded 14 of its 19 opponents this season and boasts a rebounding margin of +6.2, second in the conference and 45th in the country.
- The offensive glass has been a point of pride for the Terriers this season, as Wofford has totaled 10-plus offensive boards in 13 games, including nine of the last 10. The Terriers secured 15 or more in seven contests. These extra possessions have helped Wofford amass 207 second chance points at an average of 10.9 per game.
- The boards have come fast, furious, and consistent in recent affairs. Wofford owns 40-plus rebounds in nine-straight games.
- Leading the efforts on the glass is Evangelia Paulk with 8.1 per game. She is second in the league and right on the heels of SoCon leader Tyja Beans of Western Carolina (8.6). Paulk has reached double-digit rebounds eight times this season with all eight instances coming in the last 12 contests. In league action, she averages 10.7 boards per game to top the conference by almost two total rebounds per game. Khalis Cain of UNCG is second with her mark of 8.8.

COACH GARRITY'S 200 WINS

- Head coach Jimmy Garrity reached a special milestone on January 18 when Wofford defeated Western Carolina. The victory marked the 200th of his illustrious head coaching career. That win total spans between his time at both Anderson and Wofford.
- Garrity has already established himself as the best coach in program history. His 137 wins as a Terrier are the most by a coach in the program's Division I era.
- The program's winningest coach overall is Crystal Sharpe with her 152 triumphs over 11-and-a-half seasons. Garrity is second on Wofford's all-time leaderboard to only her.
- Garrity has elevated the program to new heights, taking over a program that had just one winning season at the Division I level prior to his arrival. In Garrity's eight prior seasons at the helm, the Terriers have posted five seasons with a .500 or better record.
- Under Garrity, Wofford has reached the WNIT twice for its only postseason appearances at the D-I level. Wofford also claimed the 2022-23 SoCon Regular Season Championship, the first conference title for any women's team sport at Wofford.

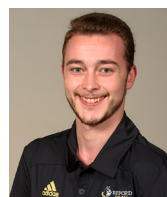

TERRIER TALES (CONT.) »

A TALE OF TWO HALVES

- It has been a tale of two halves for Wofford this season. While not performing poorly in the opening 20 minutes of action, the Terriers seem to kick their game up a notch for the final two quarters.
- Wofford is posting shooting clips of 38.1 percent and 40.3 percent in the first two quarters, respectively. In the first half overall, the Terriers shoot 39.2 percent (233-of-595) with 611 total points scored. Wofford averages 32.2 first-half points per game.
- With halftime adjustments seeming paramount, the Terriers ramp up the intensity to conclude games strong. Wofford shoots over 40 percent in each of the final two quarters, 41.1 and 42.0, respectively. Overall, Wofford shoots 41.5 percent in the second half (240-of-578). With almost 100 more points in the second half (704), the Terriers post a second-half scoring average of 37.1, almost five full points higher than their first-half average.

CHARITY STRIPE

- Wofford has been one of the best free throw shooting teams in the conference this season.
- The Terriers have not gotten to the line as much as their conference mates, boasting 15.6 free throw attempts per game, sixth in the league. Wofford has made 11.668 per game, sixth best in the conference.
- However, when the Terriers get to the stripe, they are one of the most efficient teams in the league. With a free throw clip of 74.7 percent, the Terriers are second in the SoCon and 72nd in the nation.
- Two Terriers are shooting at least 75 percent from the stripe with at least 30 attempts. Helen Matthews has the best clip at 87.8 percent (36-of-41), and Maddie Heiss joins her over 75 percent with her mark of 79.2 (38-of-48). Molly Masingale is barely under the 75 percent mark with her clip of 74.6 (47-of-63).

THREES UP

- Wofford tends to thrive beyond the arc, shooting the most threes per game in the SoCon last season at 25.0 and making the most in the league per game at 7.8. Those three-point attempts were 23rd most in the nation, and the makes were 48th.
- Reliant on the arc again, Wofford is shooting 25.1 threes per game, most in the league and 36th in the country, and the Terriers are making 7.7 per game, first in the conference and 54th in the nation.
- With a three-point percentage of 30.8, Wofford is fourth in the league. Defensively, the Terriers have guarded the three well, holding teams to a 25.2 percent clip from distance, best in the league and 13th in the country.
- It has been a balanced effort beyond the arc with a quartet of Terriers each owning 20 made treys: Molly Masingale (26), Evangelia Paulk (26), Helen Matthews (24), and Maddie Heiss (22). They each boast at least one made three per game with Masingale and Paulk just leading the way at 1.4 each. Matthews touts a 1.3 clip just behind, and Heiss checks in with a rate of 1.2 per game. Madi Hawk boasts 0.9 per game with her 13 total triples.
- In conference play, the Terriers are the most balanced three-point shooting squad. Three Terriers tout a rate of 1.83 threes per game: Maddie Heiss, Evangelia Paulk, and Molly Masingale. They are all tied for third in the conference in league play.
- Wofford has made at least one three-pointer in 187-straight games. The last time the Terriers were blanked beyond the arc was on November 25, 2018 at UNC Asheville.

MASTERFUL MASINGALE

- Freshman Molly Masingale has opened her collegiate career with the Terriers on a high note.

- She owns nine double-digit scoring outings. Her first such came at NC Central with 10 points. The best was her first-career 20-ball against Erskine in which she netted 23 points. That contest was also her first double-double with 10 boards.
- The southpaw shooter put forth her breakout performance at Davidson with a then-career-high 18 points. She thrived at the charity stripe in the contest, going 9-of-12.
- The youngster put forth a near triple-double effort against King in the non-conference finale with 11 points, nine boards, and a career-high eight helpers.
- In her first taste of SoCon action, Masingale has settled in quickly like a seasoned veteran, netting double figures in four of the six contests. Masingale is quickly averaging 13.0 points per game in conference play with a 47.8 percent clip beyond the arc (11-of-23) and 41.0 percent mark overall (25-of-61).
- Masingale shoots at a 41.6 percent clip overall and 37.7 percent from beyond the arc. She adds in 46 assists with seven games of three-plus helpers dished.
- Steady at the charity stripe, Masingale boasts a free throw clip of 74.6 percent.
- Masingale's overall scoring clip of 10.4 is 17th in the league and second best among freshmen in the SoCon.

ROSE GOLD

- Senior guard Rachael Rose has cemented herself as one of the greatest Terriers to ever don the Old Gold and Black. After a Big South Freshman of the Year campaign at USC Upstate, Rose transferred to Wofford and has won back-to-back SoCon Player of the Year honors.
- A scoring machine, Rose has scored 20 or more points 35 times as a Terrier, including 23 times last season and twice this season. One of those performances was a career-high 38 points against UNCG in the semifinals of the SoCon Tournament last season, two points short of the program single-game record. She has four 30-balls in her career, making her only the fourth Terrier all-time with multiple 30-plus performances in a career.
- The senior has netted double-digit points in all but four games played as a Terrier. Until being held to four points against Newberry in the season opener this year, she'd reached double figures in 49-straight affairs. That streak is the current program record, topping the previous mark of 16 set two seasons ago by Jackie Carman. Rose is the only player in program history to net double-digits in 20-plus consecutive games, let alone 30 or more.
- Rose has also displayed her ability to be clutch, as she knocked down the game-winning bucket with under a second left to top Virginia last season on December 16, 2023.
- Rose made more history on January 20, 2023 against Furman with a triple-double (19 points, 16 rebounds, 11 assists), the first in program history.
- Running out of space in her trophy case, Rose is the back-to-back SoCon Player of the Year and has been named to the All-SoCon First Team both seasons in Spartanburg.
- Rose finished last season named by Her Hoop Stats as one of five finalists for the Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award. She entered the 2024-25 campaign on the preseason watch list.
- Rose reached the 1,000 career points milestone on November 14, 2023 against NC Central. This number is the total between her time with USC Upstate and Wofford. She became the 19th player to achieve 1,000 as a Terrier when she reached 1,000 in a Terrier uniform at ETSU on February 3, 2024.

- Rose also joined the 500 rebounds club with her second board at Chattanooga on February 1, 2024.
- She is 10th on Wofford's all-time scoring list, and she sits only 601 points behind all-time leader Jenny Nett and her 1,896 points.

MADDIE ICE

- Maddie Heiss started her collegiate career off in style as a freshman last season. She made her first start in her debut at Wake Forest and notched 17 points.
- She went on to score 20 or more twice, including a high of 21 against Erskine.
- This led to a scoring average of 10.7, 11th best in the league.
- Stout from distance, Heiss made 1.83 threes per game, seventh in the SoCon. Heiss made at least three triples in 10 games and owned at least one three in every game but six.
- Heiss was named to the SoCon All-Freshman Team after her impressive rookie campaign.
- Already off to a good start this year, Heiss opened the season with three-straight outings of double-digit points and has reached double figures in all but eight contests. She currently averages 10.4 points per game, 16th in the conference.
- Heiss has settled in beyond the arc in conference play with 1.83 threes made per game, tied for third most in the league.

INTERNATIONAL FLAIR

- The Wofford women's basketball roster continues to feature international talent after including a quartet of non-Americans last season.
- Helen Matthews, a native of Kaiapoi, New Zealand, returns to the squad for her fifth season as a Terrier.
- She is joined by a pair of Europeans on the roster, one returner and a newcomer. Sara Deidda, a native of Zagreb, Croatia, returns to the team for her sophomore season.
- Another sophomore, newcomer Queen Ikhiuwu, is a native of Madrid, Spain. Ikhiuwu spent her freshman season with Tulsa last year before transferring to Wofford over the summer.
- Last season's squad featured the most international players in program history with four. Though one short of that mark this year, the Terriers are finding balance and success internationally with an influx of different cultures and basketball styles.

BALL SECURITY

- Over the last two seasons, the Terriers have been one of the best teams in the nation at protecting the rock.
- Wofford was third best in the nation in 2022-23 with a turnover rate of 10.3 per game. Despite a slight decline last season at 12.1 per game, the Terriers still topped the SoCon and ranked 11th in the nation.
- The trend is continuing for this season. With 14.8 giveaways per game this season, Wofford is third in the SoCon.

BAKING TURNOVERS

- Wofford forced 15 or more turnovers in 20 of its 30 games last season. Wofford also recorded at least five steals in every contest but two with the lone exceptions falling just shy, four at Georgia and three against Chattanooga. This includes nine games reaching double-digits.
- With 14.90 turnovers forced per game, the Terriers ranked second in the conference. They boasted the best turnover margin at +2.83. This was aided by Wofford's league-leading assist/turnover ratio of 0.98 and 7.5 steals per game, second best in the

conference.

- The Terrier defense is once again pesky this season, forcing 16.84 turnovers per game to rank fourth in the conference.
- Wofford has forced 15-plus turnovers in 11 of the 18 games this season, including two games of 30 or more. Wofford has only forced single-digit turnovers twice this season, mustering just nine each against No. 2 South Carolina and at Samford.
- The Terriers have tallied at least seven steals in every game but eight this season, including six instances of double figures. The season high is 22 against Erskine.

DOGS ON DEFENSE

- The Terriers have been stout defensively this season, proving to be one of the best defenses in the SoCon.
- Wofford holds opponents to a league-low 34.9 percent shooting mark, ranking 11th in the nation. Wofford's 25.2 percent three-point defense is best in the league and 13th nationally.
- The Terriers own a scoring defense of 56.7, fourth in the conference and 36th in the country.
- Wofford has held its opponents to under 60 points 12 times this season and in each of the last eight games.
- In conference play, SoCon teams are averaging just 49.5 points per game against the Terrier defense. No SoCon team has yet to put up 55 points on Wofford with the best scoring effort being Chattanooga's 54 points.

RED HOT TERRIERS

- Wofford is in the midst of an eight-game win streak, its longest in its Division I era.
- During the streak, the Terriers are averaging 72.3 points per game while holding opponents to 46.3. This includes a shooting mark of 42.0 percent overall and 36.2 percent from three.
- Wofford is outrebounding teams 360-242 (45.0-30.3) during the streak.
- Freshman Molly Masingale has led the charge during Wofford's run, as the youngster is scoring 14.0 points per game while shooting 43.5 percent. From three, she's red hot at a 47.2 percent rate. With 11 steals, she is one of two Terriers with double-digit swipes in the streak (Evangelia Paulk, 31).
- Helen Matthews (13.5), Evangelia Paulk (13.4), and Maddie Heiss (10.6) mark four total Terriers scoring in double figures during the streak.

IN THE CLASSROOM

- Wofford College has always taken pride in its academic rigors, and head coach Jimmy Garrity's team was stout in the classroom last year yet again.
- Seven Terriers were named to the SoCon Academic Honor Roll: Indiya Clarke, Mia Flor, Yinka Kruyswijk, Helen Matthews, Libby Privett, Rachael Rose and Ja'Rae Smith.
- The duo of Rose and Clarke earned recognition on the 2024 Spring Academic All-SoCon Team.
- Rose was also named SoCon Student-Athlete of the Week three times last season.
- To further highlight her academic success, Rose was named to the CSC Academic All-America Third Team after also being tabbed to the CSC Academic All-District Team.

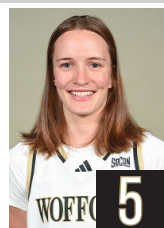

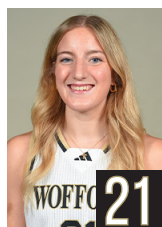

- Wofford was 8-6 in the SoCon, securing the No. 3 seed in the SoCon Tournament. The Terriers were 17-13 overall on the season.
- Despite falling in the semifinals of the SoCon Tournament, the result marked the fourth-straight season that Wofford has advanced to at least the semifinals. It was the fifth time in the last six seasons.
- During the season, Wofford defeated Virginia on the road with a last-second shot, securing the program's first-ever win over an ACC team and just the second triumph over a Power Conference opponent.
- Rachael Rose was named SoCon Player of the Year for a second-straight season. Annabelle Schultz was Third-Team All-SoCon and all-defense. Evangelia Paulk was tabbed freshman of the year, and she was joined by Maddie Heiss on the all-freshman squad.
- Wofford led the league in assist/turnover ratio (0.98), defensive boards per game (27.2) and scoring (66.6).

2022-23 SOCON CHAMPIONSHIP »

Wofford defeated Mercer 82-76 on the final day of the regular season to finish 10-4 in the SoCon, claiming the 2022-23 SoCon Regular Season Championship, the first in program history and for any women's team sport in Wofford Athletics history. The Terriers went into the SoCon Tournament with the No. 1 seed, another program first, and made it all the way to the championship game before falling to Chattanooga. With the regular season title, Wofford earned a second consecutive berth in the WNIT postseason tournament, falling to Florida in the first round by only three points (63-66).

Jimmy Garrity enters his ninth season as the head coach of the Wofford women's basketball program in 2024-25. Garrity was named head coach on April 25, 2016. In his eight seasons at the helm, he has seen players earn 18 All-Southern Conference honors, eight All-Freshman Team honors, five All-Defensive Team selections, two SoCon Freshmen of the Year and two SoCon Players of the Year. Garrity has been named SoCon Coach of the Year once (2022-23), the first in program history. Garrity led the Terriers to their first-ever Division I postseason appearance in 2021-22 with a berth in the WNIT, and he guided Wofford to its first-ever SoCon Regular Season Championship in 2022-23, the first title for any Wofford women's team sport.

The 2023-24 season was another strong year for the program, as Garrity's squad went 17-13 with an 8-6 SoCon record. The season saw another program first, as the Terriers downed Virginia 71-70 on December 16 with Rachael Rose's last-second floater, securing the program's first-ever win over an ACC foe and just the second Power Five win (Alabama, 2012). With a 13-2 home record, the Terriers tallied their largest win total ever at home. Rose's triple-double against Furman on January 20 was another historic feat, the first for the program. At the conclusion of the season, Rose repeated as SoCon Player of the Year to become the only player in program history to garner the award twice, let alone consecutively. Rose was also a First-Team All-SoCon Selection, and Annabelle Schultz earned SoCon All-Defensive Team honors alongside a Third-Team All-SoCon nod. Evangelia Paulk and Maddie Heiss were both named to the SoCon All-Freshman Team, and Paulk was named the SoCon Freshman of the Year to become just the third recipient in program history. Wofford led the SoCon in numerous categories, including assist/turnover ratio (0.98), defensive rebounds per game (27.2), scoring offense (66.6), three-point attempts per game (25.0), three-point percentage defense (25.4), three-pointers per game (7.8), turnover margin (+2.83) and turnovers per game (12.1).

The Terriers continued to rise to unprecedented heights under Garrity in the 2022-23 campaign with a 22-10 overall record and a 10-4 Southern Conference clip. The 22 wins are a new program record for Wofford's Division I era and the first 20-win season at the D-I level. The 10-4 SoCon record was enough to claim the SoCon Regular Season Championship, the first for not just the program but for any Wofford women's team sport. Wofford accomplished more historic firsts during the season, including a road win at Mercer and a season series sweep of the Bears. The Terriers notched a seven-game win streak from Nov. 16 to Dec. 5 early in the season, a new D-I era record for consecutive wins. The Terriers were stout at home, going 11-2 in the Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium, tying for the most home wins in program history. On the road, Wofford was just as good with a 9-7 clip, a new program record for road wins. At the conclusion of the season, Garrity was named SoCon Coach of the Year by the media, the first coach in program history to earn the award. Rachael Rose was tabbed SoCon Player of the Year by the coaches, just the second player in program history to garner the distinction. Rose was named to the All-SoCon First Team, with Jackie Carman (second team) and Lilly Hatton (third team) also being recognized. Helen Matthews was named to the All-Defensive Team. Wofford made its second-ever appearance in the SoCon Championship Game before falling short to Chattanooga, but a record four Terriers earned SoCon All-Tournament honors: Rose, Carman, Hatton and Matthews. Wofford made its second-straight appearance in the WNIT to end the campaign, falling short at Florida despite coming within one shot of the Gators. The Terriers paced the league in assist/turnover ratio (1.09), fouls per game (14.1), scoring offense (69.7), steals per game (7.7), threes made per game (8.4), turnover margin (+5.53) and turnovers per game (10.3). That turnovers average of 10.3 was third-fewest in the entire nation.

The 2021-22 season saw the team continue to reach new heights with a 17-14 overall record and an 11-3 SoCon mark. The 17 overall victories are the most at the Division I level in program history (fourth overall), and the 11-3 SoCon record is also the program's best ever. The team achieved a plethora of historic firsts, including road wins at Furman and Chattanooga and season series sweeps of Furman, Samford and Chattanooga. The season opened with the program's first Preseason WNIT Classic appearance with three games in Raleigh, N.C., including one against the host No. 5 NC State Wolfpack. Upon the conclusion of the regular season, Jackie Carman was named All-SoCon First Team by the coaches and media, and Lilly Hatton earned second-team honors by both. Niyah Lutz and Alexis Tomlin garnered third-team selections from the media. Reagan Rapert was named to the SoCon All-Freshman and All-Defensive Teams. The Terriers led the SoCon in scoring offense (66.2 PPG), free throw percentage (74.6%) and assist/turnover ratio (0.9).

The squad entered the Southern Conference Tournament as the No. 2 seed, its highest seeding ever. After a first-round win over No. 7 ETSU 66-54, the Terriers fell to No. 3 Furman in the semifinals in a close 59-64 contest. Alexis Tomlin and Jackie Carman earned All-Tournament nods on the first and second teams, respectively. The season was not over after the SoCon Tournament, as the Terriers made their first-ever appearance in the WNIT, which was the program's first postseason appearance at the Division I level. Wofford played at Middle Tennessee in the first round.

During the 2020-21 season, the team was 13-11 overall and 7-7 in Southern Conference play. Highlights included

a home win over Furman and a series sweep of East Tennessee State. Following the regular season, Lilly Hatton was named to the All-SoCon Second Team by both the coaches and media, while Jamari McDavid was named to the All-SoCon Third Team by the media and was the recipient of the Ann Lashley Inspiration Award. Among SoCon teams, the Terriers were ranked first in rebounding margin (+3.8), fourth in scoring offense (62.5 ppg) and third in scoring defense (61.3 ppg).

In the Southern Conference Tournament, the team entered as the #4 seed. After a 78-66 win over #5 seed UNCG, the Terriers earned a 75-64 victory against #8 seed East Tennessee State in the semifinals. With the Terriers in the championship game for the first time in school history, Wofford was defeated by #2 seed Mercer. Lilly Hatton and Helen Matthews were named to the All-Tournament Team.

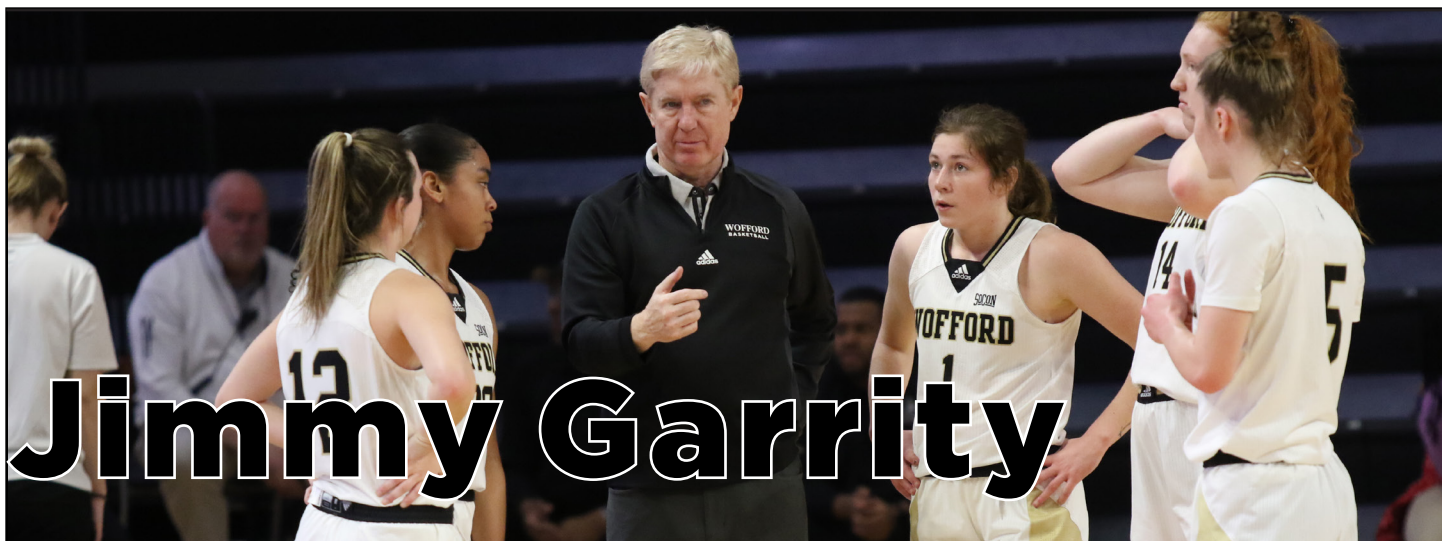
The 2019-2020 season saw the team finish with its best conference record in program history (8-6). They started the season with a last second loss against Auburn, but that showed promise for the year. The Terriers won convincingly against Mercer on 1/11/20 for the first time since 1997. Wofford recorded their first road conference win against ETSU, which started a four-game win streak. Another history marker was when the squad won its first ever game at Samford, defeating them 69-63. By the end of the year, Lilly Hatton was honored as Freshman of the Year, along with Chloe Wanink, Da'Ja Green, and Cairo Booker receiving All-Conference accolades as well.

The 2018-19 season marked the turning point for Wofford women's basketball, as Garrity led the team to their first winning season since the 2001-02 campaign with a 16-15 overall record and 7-7 SoCon mark in his third year at the helm. They earned their highest SoCon tournament seed since 2002 as a No. 5 seed, while Garrity earned his first SoCon tournament win in the quarterfinals with an upset victory over No. 4 seed ETSU, 75-66. The win marked the first playoff win since the 2011-12 season and first semifinals appearance since 2002. Garrity led the team to the program's second best home record (12-1) while also landing a program-best five Terriers on all-conference teams: Chloe Wanink (First Team), Da'Ja Green (Second/Third Team), Cairo Booker (Third/All-Defensive Team), Niyah Lutz and Jackie Carman (All-Freshman Team). Additionally, the team led the SoCon in scoring offense (72.8 ppg), 3-point field goal percentage (.350), and turnover margin (+4.48), while becoming the highest scoring team (2,258 pts - 857 made field goals) and best 3-point shooting team (35.0% - 180 made threes) in program history.

Garrity led the Terriers to a 10-20 record in 2017-18. After losing star guard Chloe Wanink to a season-ending knee injury seven games into the season, Garrity lead a group of young players through the transition from high school to college ball. Despite a record of 10-20 and 3-11 in the conference, the Terriers played numerous close games and picked up just the program's eighth win all-time against Furman in a dominant 79-48 victory over the Paladins. Freshman guard Da'Ja Green was named Second-Team All Conference and joined her teammate and fellow freshman Jamari McDavid on the All-Freshman team.

In Garrity's first season at the helm he led the Terriers to a 13-17 record overall and helped Wofford win six games away from Spartanburg, a vast improvement from the 2015-16 season when the Terriers won just one game on the road. Chloe Wanink was named All-Southern Conference Second Team as she averaged 16 points and 5.8 rebounds per game.

In the three year prior to his arrival at Wofford, Garrity serves as head coach at Anderson University. From 2013-15, Anderson reached the NCAA Division II Tournament twice as an at-large selection and in 2015 advanced to the

Sweet Sixteen. At Anderson, Garrity coached two South Atlantic Conference Players of the Year.

In 2015-16, the Trojans were 23-7 overall, including a 79-55 win over Clemson to open the year. They were the South Atlantic Conference regular season champions with an 18-4 record and were nationally ranked in the top 25. The squad was an at-large selection to the NCAA Tournament. As the #5 seed, they advanced to the second round after a win over #4 seed Clayton State. Senior forward Jennifer Monroe was named the SAC Player of the Year and first team All-Southeast Region. Junior guard Heather Jankowy earned SAC second team honors.

Stringing together one of the program's best seasons in 2014-15, Garrity was tabbed South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year. Garrity led the Trojans to a 27-5 overall record and a berth into the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16. Prior to the postseason run, Garrity became the first coach in conference history to win 20 league games, finishing the season with a 20-2 SAC record and a regular-season championship. Garrity also saw point guard Sierra Simpson earn SAC Player of the Year and SAC first team honors.

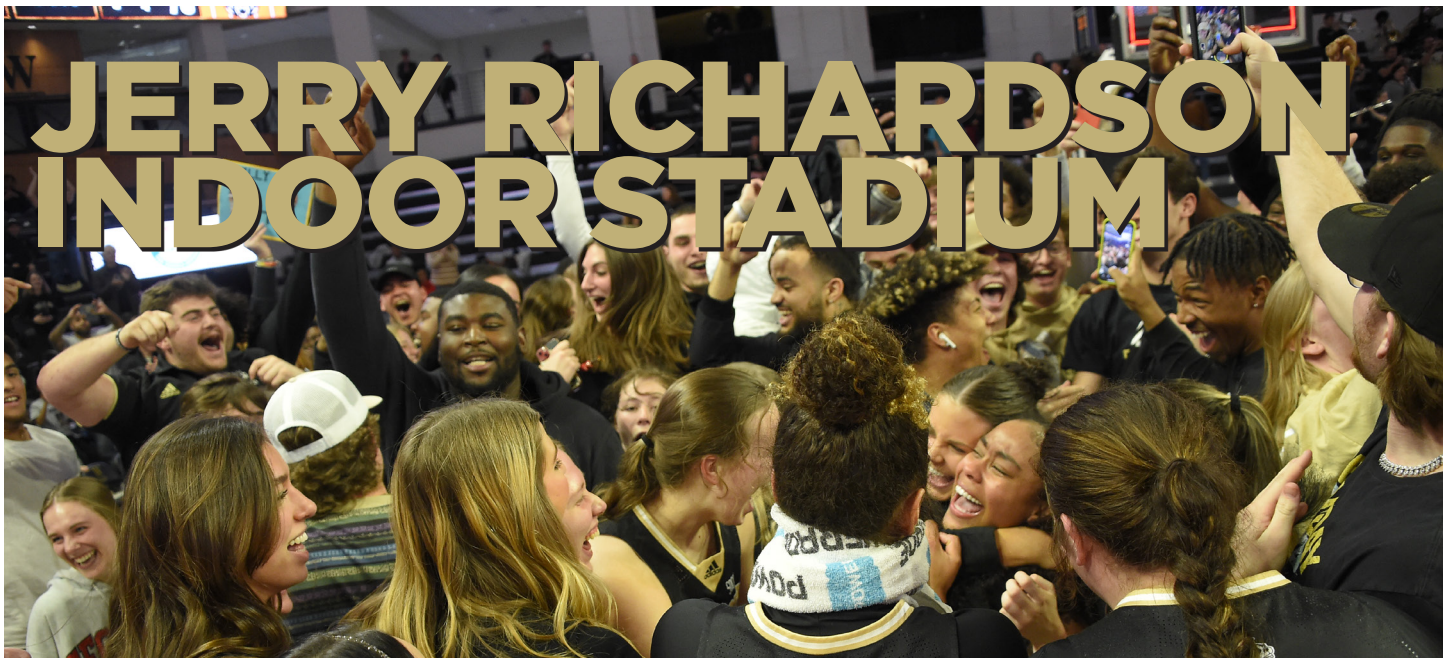
In his first season at Anderson in 2013-14, Garrity led the Trojans to a 16-14 overall record and an 11-11 mark in SAC play. Anderson placed three players on all-conference teams, including Simpson's All-SAC second team honor and Alexis Dillard's all-freshman team spot.

Garrity spent the 2012-13 season at Clemson University as the women's basketball assistant coach. With the Tigers, Garrity was in charge of scouting, practice planning, game scheduling, coordinating of the guards, community service and alumni relations. Garrity also monitored the academic success of the student-athletes.

Before his time at Clemson, Garrity spent a decade in various capacities with the UNC Wilmington basketball program. He was hired as the Director of Basketball Operations in 2002 for both the men's and women's basketball teams. Once the position split into two different roles, Garrity took over just the women's side while also becoming an assistant coach in 2007. Continuing his tenure with UNCW, Garrity was promoted to the associate head coach role in 2011 and coached his team to the second round of the WNIT.

Garrity graduated from Elon in 1989 with a degree in business administration and marketing and later earned a Master's in sports administration from St. Thomas University in Miami, Fla. in 1990.

Garrity is married to Jenny Garrity, who served as UNCW's women's tennis coach for 13 seasons. The couple have two daughters Kacey and Carly, and a son Corey.

A new era at Wofford began in 2018 with the opening of the Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium. The new home of basketball and volleyball is adjacent to the north end of Gibbs Stadium, where the Terriers play football.

Wofford alumnus and trustee Jerry Richardson, Class of 1959, provided the gift to fund the facility that includes a 3,400-seat basketball arena and a 350-seat volleyball competition venue as well as offices, locker rooms, meeting rooms, training rooms and special fan areas, including several open-air suites. The facility replaces Benjamin Johnson Arena, which continues to be used as a first-rate gymnasium for intramural and campus recreational activities.

The facility has already been able to attract top opponents for the basketball teams, including South Carolina, North Carolina, Harvard and Georgia Tech. It also hosted the 2023 and 2024 Southern Conference Volleyball Championships.

The Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium also has a seating capacity for non-athletics functions, such as commencement and concerts, of 4,500. The facility includes "Club 51" for club seat holders, the "Boneyard" lounge in the student section, state of the art sound system and acoustical design, along with electronic charging stations throughout the building.

Richardson Indoor Stadium has quickly become one of the toughest places to play in Southern Conference women's basketball. Entering the 2024-25 season, Wofford boasts the second-highest home win total and win percentage since the 2017-18 season, the venue's first. Wofford's historic 2022-23 SoCon regular-season championship was secured at home with a triumph over Mercer.
