## About Auburn in 2010

- Auburn returns 14 letterwinners from last year's squad that compiled a 11-13 overall mark and a 3-3 SEC record. The 2009 version of the Tigers placed fifth at the SEC Championships and fourth at the NCAA West Regional in Seattle.
- After being ranked as high as No. 4 in the nation and in the top-10 for the first nine weeks of the year, the Tigers closed out their season ranked No. 11 following a fourth place finish in the NCAA West Regional in Seattle.
- Auburn will rely heavily on underclassmen in 2010, as the squad features seven sophomores and six freshman.
- Of the 19 gymnasts on this year's roster, nine have competed in a collegiate meet.
- Thirteen states are represented by this year's team, with only one gymnast hailing from the Yellowhammer State. Both Maryland and Florida are the homes to three Tigers apiece.
- Auburn seeks to replace a trio of solid seniors from a year ago in Lindsay Puckett, A.J. Mills and Claire Seiffert. The trio combined for 80 career titles (Puckett 48, Mills 31, Seiffert 1) in their time at Auburn.

## The Meet

- No. 14 Auburn welcomes No. 3 Alabama to Beard-Eaves-Memorial Coliseum Friday at 7 p.m. for the season-opener for both squads. The meet will also serve as the final home opener for the Tigers in the history of Beard-Eaves-Coliseum as the Tigers will move across the street to Auburn Arena for the 2011 campaign.
- FSN will tape-delay coverage of the meet on Jan. 16 at 10 p.m.
- Friday's matchup marks the 106th meeting between the Tigers and Crimson Tide, with Alabama holding a 97-9 all-time advantage over Auburn.
- Last season, Auburn fell to the Crimson Tide by the slightest margin in series history, 195.675-195.650 (.025), on Jan. 9, 2009 in Auburn. The Tide followed up the victory by knocking off the Tigers again on Feb. 27, 2009 in Tuscaloosa, 197.350-196.175 to sweep the season series.

## Scouting Alabama

- Alabama enters the 2010 season looking to defend its 2009 SEC Championship and NCAA Regional title. Alabama will be searching for its seventh SEC title in program history as well as its 25th Regional title.
- The Crimson Tide won't be lacking any firepower this year, as first-team All-Americans Morgan Dennis and Ricki Lebegern return. Dennis also captured the SEC Vault Championship as well as the SEC and NCAA Northeast Regional Floor Championships. Lebegern was a first-team All-American on the balance beam, as well as a second-team All-American in the all-around. Additionally, she was a second-team All-SEC performer on the floor exercise.
- Also returning is sophomore Ashley Preiss, who earned a quartet of All-American honors in her freshman season. She took home first-team honors on the balance beam as well as the uneven bars, and earned second-team accolades in the all-around and floor exercise. Additionally, she was named second-team All-SEC and was a member of the

- Alabama had a pair of other rising sophomores join Preiss on the Freshman All-SEC team in GERALD Stack-Eaton and Caitlin Sullivan.

- Another freshman, Rachel Terry, earned second-team All-American honors on the vault.

### Auburn Earns Highest Preseason National Ranking Ever at No. 14

- The Tigers have appeared in the preseason poll for seven consecutive seasons, with this year's ranking the highest ever. Last season, the Tigers came in at No. 15 in the preseason poll.

- The team was voted as the No. 14 team in the nation according to GymInfo, the organization announced prior to the season.

- Four-time defending national champion Georgia topped the poll, followed by Utah, Alabama, Florida and UCLA rounding out the top five. Three of the five, Georgia (Jan. 29), Alabama (Jan. 8) and Florida (Feb. 26), will visit The Plains in the upcoming season.

- In total, eight of the 12 teams on this year's schedule are in the top 25. In addition to the three opponents in the top five, The Tigers will travel to No. 6 LSU, No. 8 Arkansas and No. 18 Ohio State while also hosting No. 9 Oklahoma and No. 17 Denver.

### Freshman Class Poised to Replace Valuable Seniors

- The Auburn coaching staff welcomes arguably the best recruiting class the Tigers have ever produced for the 2010 season, as six student-athletes join the program following stellar high school careers. Highlighting the class are Petrina Yokay (Cameron Park, Calif.), Toi Garcia (Severna Park, Md.) and Lindsay DiSalvatore (Orlando, Fla.).

- Yokay was coached by Lisa Poarch and trained at Technique Gymnastics in Rancho Cordova, Calif. In 2008, she tied for 11th in the all-around and placed third on balance beam at the Level 10 National Championships. Yokay was honored as the all-around and floor exercise national champion at the Level 10 Junior Olympic National Championships in 2007. She was also the runner-up on uneven bars, placed fifth on vault and fourth on balance beam.

- Garcia, trained at Docksider's Gymnastics in Millersville, Md., and was coached by Bob Ouellette. In 2008, Garcia was named the alternate to the USA Gymnastics Level 10 national team after finishing as the floor exercise runner-up and placed fifth in the all-around at the 2008 Level 10 Junior Olympic National Championships. Garcia was also named to the Region 7 All-Star team and represented her region last November in Puerto Rico.

- DiSalvatore trained at Orlando Metro Gymnastics and was coached by Jeff Wood and Christi Barineau. She was a 2008 USA Gymnastics Level 10 Regional floor exercise champion and also finished as the runner-up on both uneven bars and balance beam. At the 2008 Junior Olympic National Championships, DiSalvatore finished fifth on vault and 16th in the all-around competition.

- Also joining the program were bars specialist Alex Christopher (Marianna, Fla.), as well as all-around competitors Pamela Sanasith (Auburn, Ala.) and Maya Wickus (Port Washington, Wis.).

- Sanasith, an Auburn native, is the first graduate of the Auburn Gymnastics Academy to be a member of the Auburn gymnastics team since the academy's inception in 2000. The academy is run primarily by the Auburn coaching staff.

### Tigers Unveil 2010 Schedule

- This season's slate shows home meets with SEC foes Alabama, Georgia and Florida, while the Tigers also play host to Oklahoma as well as Denver. The Tigers will hit the road for five meets as the team heads to SEC opponents LSU, Arkansas and Kentucky, as well as non-conference opponents Ohio State and Maryland.

•Five teams on the schedule finished the 2009 season ranked in the top-10 nationally in national champion Georgia, Alabama (No. 3), LSU (No.5), Florida (No. 6), and Oklahoma (No. 9). Of the group, all opponents with the exception of LSU will head to Auburn.

•The 2010 season will begin much like the previous season, as Auburn opens up the home-portion of the year by hosting rival Alabama on Fri., Jan. 8 from Beard-Eaves Coliseum. On Jan. 15, the Tigers welcome the Oklahoma Sooners to the Plains, followed by a road trip to LSU on the Jan. 29 before closing out the month by hosting the national champion Georgia Bulldogs on Jan. 29.

•The month of February begins with a pair of road trips as Auburn travels to Arkansas on Feb. 5 and Lexington, Ky. to take on the Kentucky Wildcats on Feb. 12. Following a week off, the squad returns to action, playing host to the Florida Gators on Feb. 26.

•The Tigers welcome the Pioneers of Denver to the The Plains for the first time ever in their final home meet of the season on March 5. A week later, the Tigers wrap up their regular-season with trips to Ohio State on March 12 and Maryland on March 19.

•Florida will be home to a pair of postseason events, starting off with the SEC Championships on March 27 in Jacksonville, Fla. NCAA Regionals will be held on April 4 with the Tigers destination to be determined following the SEC Championships. Gainesville, Fla. will be the site of the 2010 NCAA National Championships, held at the University of Florida April 16-18.

## Sophomores Look to Make Impact

•Of Auburn's seven-member 2008 recruiting class, four suffered season-ending injuries prior to competing on The Plains.

•Three of the four, Laura Lane, Kelsie Montgomery and Justine Foster will all be in the Tiger lineup in the coming weeks, giving the Tigers a talented, but inexperienced roster. Lane and Foster are all capable of making contributions in the all-around competition, while Montgomery seeks to crack the beam and floor lineup.

•Another sophomore, Kareen Kaveh, will miss the season for the second-straight year due to a torn right Achilles tendon suffered on Jan. 4 during a training session. Last season, she was unable to participate due to a ruptured Achilles tendon on her left foot.

## Auburn Earns Seven Academic All-American Honors

•Seven Auburn gymnasts were honored for academic excellence by the National Association of Collegiate Gymnastics Coaches/Women as Academic All-Americans, the association announced Aug. 5.

•Freshman Laura Lane and junior Krissy Voss led the way for the Tigers, as both earned perfect 4.0 GPA for the 2008-09 academic year. Lane, a Glen Allen, Va. native, earned the perfect GPA majoring in applied math with an actuarial science option. Voss, hailing from Paradise Valley, Ariz., is a chemistry major.

•A pair of graduated seniors also made the NACGC/W Academic All-America list. Claire Seiffert, a political science major, earned the plaudit for the fourth-time in her career. Classmate Lindsey Puckett, who earned Auburn's first All-SEC nod since 2005 last season, makes the list for the first time in her career. Puckett was a supply chain management major.

•Sophomore Leah Vining, a sophomore math major made the list for the second time in her career. Additionally, a pair of freshman business majors, Kylie Shields and Kelsie Montgomery earned the honors during their first season on The Plains.

•In order to be named as an individual scholar athlete by the NACGC/W, student-athletes must possess a 3.5 or higher current or cumulative GPA.

## Auburn Inks Pair for 2011 Season

•Abigail Habicht and Aliaksandra Tsikhanovich have signed National Letters of Intent to attend Auburn University and participate in gymnastics in the 2011 season, the program announced on Nov. 11.

•Habicht, who trains at Orlando Metro Gymnastics in Orlando, Fla. with coach Jeff Wood, was named the 2009 National All-Around Champion at the USA Gymnastics Junior Olympic National Championships. The Orangewood Christian High School senior is a current member of the U.S. National Team and is described by head coach Jeff Thompson as "one of the most intelligent and talented gymnasts" he has ever recruited.

### Tolnay Joins Staff As Administrative Intern

- Tiffany Tolnay, a 16-time All-American for the Georgia GymDogs, is the newest member of the Auburn gymnastics program, head coach Jeff Thompson announced Dec. 26. Tolnay joins the staff as an administrative intern while completing her recreation and leisure studies degree from the University of Georgia.

- Tolnay is no stranger to high-level gymnastics as she was part of four National Championships as well as a pair of SEC titles in her four seasons in Athens from 2006-09. Her 16 All-American honors tied Agina Simpkins for the most in the storied history of the University of Georgia gymnastics program. Additionally, the Grapevine, Texas native earned a trio of All-SEC honors from 2006-08. She also excelled in the classroom, as she was named to the SEC Academic Honor Roll twice, as well as the Georgia Fall Academic Honor Roll her senior season. Upon completion of the internship, Tolnay will graduate from Georgia in May of 2010.

### Mills Earns Atkins Award

- Former Auburn gymnast A.J. Mills was presented with the Atkins Award, the most prestigious award a female athlete at Auburn can receive during halftime of Auburn's football homecoming game against Furman on Nov. 7.

- The Leah Rawls Atkins Award is presented in honor of Dr. Leah Rawls Atkins, noted Alabama historian, world champion water skier and the first woman in the Alabama Sports Hall of Fame. She also served as Director of the Auburn University Center for the Arts and Humanities.

- A four-year letterwinner, Mills recorded 31 event victories during her career, including 14 as a senior. Mills was ranked as high as 10th nationally in the all-around during her senior season and as a junior finished fifth in the all-around at the NCAA Northeast Regionals. She was the 2009 recipient of "The Rock" award, given annually to the most consistent Auburn gymnast.

- The Floyds Knobs, Ind., native, was a four-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll and Auburn Athletics Top Tiger recipient. Twice named an academic All-American, Mills was also a member of the National Society of Collegiate Scholars.

- A three-time SEC Good Works Team recipient for her civic involvement, Mills was very active in the community, participating in over 50 events during her Auburn career. Mills was a staple in the Auburn Student Athlete Advisory Committee, serving as the secretary, vice-president and president. She was also an instrumental force in the development of Auburn PRIDE, a sportsmanship initiative created by SAAC two years ago.

- A marketing major, Mills has a 3.21 cumulative grade point average and is on track to graduate in May 2010. She plans to attend graduate school at Auburn in Fall 2010.

Jeff Thompson enters his 11th season as the head coach of the Auburn gymnastics program. Under the tutelage of Thompson, the Tigers have appeared in seven consecutive NCAA Regional Championships and one NCAA Championship. Thompson has coached five regional champions and six individuals to nine NCAA Championships appearances. The accomplishments of Thompson's gymnasts have twice earned him SEC Coach of the Year and Central Region Coach of the Year honors. Thompson will lead 13 returning gymnasts from 2009 and brings six new faces to the Auburn program for the upcoming season.

In 2009, Thompson guided the Tigers to their seventh-consecutive NCAA Regional Championship after compiling a 11-13 overall mark and an even 3-3 record in SEC competition. Auburn placed fifth at the SEC Championships, where for the second time in Thompson's tenure the Tigers scored higher than 196 with a score of 196.350. The mark was the highest score the Tigers have scored at the meet with Thompson at the helm of the program. After being ranked as high as fourth in the nation near the start of the season, and in the top-10 for the first nine weeks of the season, his Tigers closed out the season ranked 11th in the country after a fourth place finish at the NCAA West Regional.

The 2008 campaign saw Auburn's gymnastics history turn another page with awards garnered, records shattered and a return to the NCAA Regional Championships. Highlighting the season was star-studded senior Julie Dwyer as she became the first gymnast in the program's 34-year history to qualify for a fourth-straight NCAA Championships appearance. Junior Lindsey Puckett was named Central Region Gymnast of the Year in 2007, SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2006 and SEC Freshman of the Year in 2005. Dwyer holds the current top score in Auburn history on vault and all-around and she also ranks among Auburn's top-10 all-time on beam and floor. Outside of the gym, Dwyer was a four-time academic All-American, four-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll and was named 2007 SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year.

Thompson's coaching career began at his alma mater in 1986 as a graduate assistant at Kentucky, a position he held through the 1989 season. He later coached at Wisconsin and Illinois and then became Junior Olympic Program Director at the Cincinnati Gymnastics Academy in 1993. Thompson became an assistant at LSU in 1994 before coming to Auburn in 1999.

A native of Highland Heights, Ky., Thompson played rugby at Kentucky before graduating with a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1986, and earned his master's degree in biomechanics in 1995 from UK.

Rachelle Thompson begins her 11th season as part of the Auburn coaching staff and her fifth as the Tigers' associate head coach. She was previously a full-time assistant for three years and a volunteer assistant coach for three years. Thompson's primary responsibilities include coaching the balance beam and floor, and handling the choreography for both events. Thompson was honored as the NCAA Central Regional Assistant Coach of the Year two seasons ago.

Thompson was a three-year letterwinner and All-American for LSU from 1988-91. She won the Southeastern Conference All-Around Championship in 1991, the vault and floor titles at the 1991 NCAA Regional vault, finished fourth in the all-around at the 1990 NCAA Championships and was a finalist for the Honda-Broderick Award. Thompson was the first gymnast in LSU history to score a perfect 10.00, doing so on floor against Florida in 1991.

A native of Baton Rouge, La., Thompson completed her college degree at Auburn University, graduating *summa cum laude* with a bachelor's degree in education. She is married to head coach Jeff Thompson.

Kurt Hettinger is in his second season with the Auburn gymnastics program as an assistant coach. Hettinger came to The Plains after five years as an assistant with Kent State's women's gymnastics program. In his first year as Auburn's bar coach, he helped the squad to a fourth place team finish at the 2009 SEC Championships, led by standout freshman Allyson Sandusky's 9.9. The Tigers ended the 2009 regular season ranked 11th in the country on bars and hit 96.2% (72 of 75) of their bar routines.

Hettinger was a four-year letterwinner on the University of Illinois men's gymnastics team from 1996-99. He was a part of the 1998 squad that placed third at the NCAA Men's Gymnastics Championships. A native of Tuscola, Ill., he graduated from Illinois in 1999 with a bachelor's degree in history and earned a master's degree in education from Kent State in 2005. He married his wife Katherine, a counselor at Auburn, in July of 2006.
