What's Ahead

Auburn travels to Lexington, Ky., for the 2007 SEC Swimming & Diving Championships. The diving competition will take place Feb. 2-4, while swimming competition will be held Feb. 7-10. All events will take place at the Lancaster Aquatic Center on the campus of the University of Kentucky.

Auburn at the SEC Championships

The Tigers are looking to claim their 11th-consecutive title and 13th in the last 14 years. During the Tigers' 10-year run of owning the title, their largest margin of victory came in 2004 when Auburn scored 1008 points to Florida's 705 for a difference of 303 points. The closest margin of victory was in 2002 in Fayetteville, Ark., when AU squeaked out a 19-point victory over the Gators, 763-744.

Auburn's first-ever SEC Championship came in 1994. Before that AU had three runner-up finishes (1978, 1980 & 1993) and 13-top three showings. The last year that AU did not win the SEC title was in 1996, when the Tigers placed second to Tennessee in Knoxville.

Auburn's 15 SEC titles at the 2004 championships in Athens, Ga., is the most AU has ever collected at one championship. The last time the championships were in Lexington (1999), AU tallied 13 titles.

Seven current AU men have captured SEC titles although only two have won individual event titles. Sophomore Cesar Cielo won six SEC championships last year as a freshman to lead all current squad members in career SEC titles. Former Tiger Fred Bousquet has the most career titles of any Tiger with 15.

SEC Championship Tidbits

This will be the fourth time that Lexington has hosted the SEC Championships, with the previous occurrences coming in 1999, 1991 and 1967. Auburn won the team title in 1999, while Florida claimed the 1991 and 1967 crowns ... The Tigers are looking to extend their SEC Championship streak to 11 years. Florida holds the SEC record for consecutive men's titles, winning 13 straight from 1956-68.

Owning the Conference

The Auburn men's swimming and diving team has been the most dominant team in the SEC since the mid-1990s. Besides winning the last 10 SEC Championships, the Tigers have also won their last 28 dual meets inside of the conference. Auburn's last SEC defeat was on Jan. 30, 1999, when Florida downed the Tigers, 123-119.

For the Record

Tiger men hold, to date, SEC records in four individual and a relay. At the 2004 SEC Championships, former star Fred Bousquet set the 100 free record (42.53) and the relay team of George Bovell, Ryan Wochomurka, Bryan Lundquist and Bousquet set the mark that same year (1:17.25). Aaron Ciarla is the 50 free record holder (19.35), setting that mark in 2000. Ty Richardson set the metric distance record for the 200m breast in 1992 (2:20.21), and Jose Rocha owns the 3-meter diving record for 11 dives, posting a score of 608.80 in 1988.

Tigers Dominate Quartet of Events at Conference

Cesar Cielo won the 50 free and 100 free SEC titles last season, succeeding former Auburn sprinter Fred Bousquet, who won the 50 free each of the previous three seasons and the 100 free the previous two. Auburn's men have also dominated the 200 free relay by taking the last four titles, and three of the four members of last year's relay team return this season for Auburn. An Auburn man has taken home the platform title in four of the last five years, although senior Steven Segerlin finished second at last year's meet before going on to win the NCAA title in that event. Cesar Garcia won back-to-back in 2003 and 2004 and Matt Bricker was the champion in 2002.

Auburn in the Rankings

Auburn has been holding steady at No. 3 in the CSCAA National Rankings, trailing only Texas and Stanford. Auburn has defeated current No. 8 Florida and No. 15 Florida State in dual meets this season.

A Look Ahead

Auburn swimmer's will have the opportunity to earn qualifiers at three meets before traveling to Minneapolis for the NCAA Championships in March. The AU divers will compete at the Zone B Championships in Athens, Ga., on March 2-5.

Saying Goodbye

The Florida State dual meet was the final one for eight Auburn seniors (Mark Johnson, Bryan Lundquist, Sean Osborne, Joey Schneider, John Scott, Steven Segerlin, Daniel Slocki and James Wike). During their four-year careers, the Tigers have posted a 31-1 dual meet record, have won three SEC titles and three NCAA titles. Tallying their individual accomplishments, this class has won five SEC titles and two NCAA titles to go along with 21 NCAA All-American honors.

Sophomores Shine

Although the senior class is often the key to Auburn's success at the SEC and NCAA Championships, Auburn's sophomore class may have the most firepower. Last season, Jakob Andkjaer, Cesar Cielo, Anthony Fleming, Alexei Puninski and Jon Roberts combined to account for a 373 points at the SEC Championships, which was more than any of Auburn's other classes, and 86 points at the NCAA Championships.

Cielo Named SEC Swimmer of the Week

Sophomore Cesar Cielo was named SEC Male Swimmer of the Week Jan. 30 for his performance in Auburn's final dual meet against Florida State. Cielo won the 50 free in 19.72 seconds, which was the second-fastest mark in the SEC, and also led off two relay teams that posted 'B' cut times. He swam a 19.89 opening leg on the 200 free relay team that finished in 1:20.16, which was third best in the SEC this year, and opened for the 200 medley relay team that posted a time of 1:28.04, which ranked second in the SEC.

To 'B' or not to 'B'

With the regular season complete, 18 swimmers/divers have already turned in 'B' cut (zone qualifying) marks. AU has at least one 'B' cut qualifier in seven individual events plus four relays, with five divers posting at least one zone qualifying score.

Seegerlin Earns Two SEC Diver of the Week Awards

Senior Steven Seegerlin has twice been named the SEC Male Diver of the Month this year. He earned the honor after sweeping all three events at the Georgia Diving Invitational Jan. 3-5, becoming just the second person in 11 years of the event to sweep all three events. He won the award again after winning both the 1-meter and 3-meter competitions vs. Florida.

Denniston and Gaines Receive NCAA Honors

Former Auburn swimming national champions Dave Denniston and Rowdy Gaines were honored Jan. 7 as the 2007 recipients of the NCAA Inspiration and the NCAA Silver Anniversary Awards, respectively. Denniston and Gaines were presented the annual awards at the NCAA Honors Celebration at the Gaylord Palms Osceola Ballroom. The NCAA Honors Celebration aired Feb. 2 on ESPN2.

The Inspiration Award was created in 2001 to honor individuals who, when confronted with a life-altering situation, used perseverance, dedication and determination to overcome the event and now serve as a role model to give hope and inspiration to others in similar situations.

The Silver Anniversary Award is given annually to six former student-athletes who have made significant professional and civic contributions since they completed their intercollegiate eligibility 25 years ago.

Seegerlin Makes History At Georgia Diving Invitational

Senior Steven Seegerlin became just the second diver in the 11-year history of the Georgia Diving Invitational to win all three diving events at the competition, joining Georgia's Chris Colwill who achieved the feat in 2006. Seegerlin, who was featured in *Sports Illustrated's* Faces in the Crowd for his accomplishment, won the platform (357.45), 3-meter (348.10) and 1-meter (343.90) competitions. He has not lost all season on the platform or 1-meter board, and has just one runner-up finish on 3-meter this season.

Marsh to Step Down Following Season to Join USOC

Auburn Director of Competitive Aquatics David Marsh is resigning from his current position at the conclusion of the 2006-07 season to accept a position with the Mecklenburg Aquatic Club, which established the United States Olympic Committee Center of Excellence, in Charlotte, N.C. In his new role, Marsh will serve as the Head Elite Coach and CEO of the program, directing the development of future United States' Olympic swimmers.

In his 16 previous seasons at Auburn, Marsh has guided the program to six men's and four women's NCAA crowns and a combined 15 Southeastern Conference titles. The men won national crowns in 1997, 1999, 2003, 2004, 2005, and 2006, while the women captured titles in 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2006.

Marsh's teams have earned a combined 1,312 All-America honors by 276 athletes, along with 40 NCAA individual championship titles and 25 NCAA relay crowns. At the conference level, Marsh's swimmers and divers have captured 178 individual SEC championships and 52 relay conference victories.

Since Marsh took over the Auburn program, the Plains have been home to 22 Olympians, who captured seven medals. Over the course of his coaching career, Marsh has been named National Coach of the Year a total of eight times and the SEC Coach of the Year 13 times. For his outstanding work with the men's and women's squads, Marsh was named the 2003 National Collegiate and Scholastic Swimming Trophy recipient. It was the second time in his career that he was so honored, also garnering the distinguished award in 1999. Marsh is the first to ever receive this prestigious award more than once.

Marsh and Tierney-Walker Named to USA Swimming International Staffs

Auburn head swimming coach David Marsh and co-women's head coach Dorsey Tierney-Walker were named United States assistant coaches for the 2007 Pan American Games in Brazil and the 2007 World University Games in Thailand, respectively.

Marsh is no stranger to the United States international swimming staff as he most recently served in a similar role for the World Championship men's team in 2005. In 2003 Marsh was the head coach for the U.S. World Championship team and has also been head men's coach for the 2003 Mutual of Omaha Duel in the Pool and 1995 Pan-Pacific team.

Tierney-Walker will serve in the same role on the World University Games coaching roster that she did in 2001, when she coached Susan Woessner to a silver medal in the 100m back, bronze in the 50m back and a silver as part of the 400m medley relay. Tierney-Walker has also had international experience in the pool, captaining the 1991 U.S. Pan American team that traveled to Cuba, where she collected three gold medals and set the Pan-Am Games record in the 200m breast.

Tigers Honor Ralph Crocker

For those who might be wondering why the letters "RHOP" can be found on much of Auburn's t-shirts and apparel, it is in honor of Ralph Crocker, Auburn's Associate Director of Intercollegiate Swimming and Diving who passed away Jan. 14 after a lengthy illness at the age of 52. A former Auburn swimmer and 1977 Auburn graduate, Crocker had been with the Auburn swimming and diving program since June, 1999.

As an assistant at Auburn, Crocker had extensive experience working with all groups, but primarily the distance group, or as they fondly call it, "Ralph's House of Pain (RHOP)."

During Crocker's seven full seasons he coached 82 swimmers to 660 All-American honors, and during his tenure eight distance freestyle swimmers won a combined 10 NCAA and SEC individual event crowns.

Auburn Upends Florida on Senior Day

Auburn celebrated senior day in fine fashion, as the Tigers rolled to a victory over Florida in the final home meet for Auburn's eight seniors and David Marsh's last home dual meet as Auburn's Director of Competitive Aquatics. The third-ranked men posted a 163-137 victory over the No. 11 Gators. Cesar Cielo made his season debut a successful one, winning the 100 free with an 'A' cut time of 43.19 seconds, which is the best mark in this year in the SEC, and the 200 free with a time of 1:38.14. Jakob Andkjaer (44.15) and Bryan Lundquist (44.74) completed a sweep of the top three spots in the 100 free.

All Good Things Must End

Auburn's six-year winning streak in dual meets was snapped Jan. 11 by No. 1 Texas, 130-113, breaking the string at 42 straight dual meets won. The Tigers had not suffered a loss since the Longhorns knocked off the Tigers six years to the day, 136.5-103.5, on Jan. 11, 2001, and the Longhorns went on to win the NCAA title that season.

Tigers Continue Dominance Over Tide

Auburn defeated Alabama Nov. 17, 143.5-99.5, pushing Auburn's winning streak against the Crimson Tide to 14 consecutive dual meets. The highlight of the meet for Auburn included 1-2-3 finishes in both the 200 back (Matt Bartlett, John Long and Joey Schneider) and the 200 fly (John Scott, Tyler McGill, Jordan Anderson).

Taming the Bayou Bengals

In Auburn's first contest of the season against LSU, the men dominated the competition by winning 11 of 13 events when not exhibitioning, en route to a 182-110 victory. James Wike was Auburn's lone qualifier as the senior took the win in the 200 back with a 'B' cut time of 1:46.89.

Top Scorer's Return

The Tiger men return 14 All-Americans from the 2006 NCAA Championship team, including four NCAA Champions and seven SEC Champions. The Tigers are without five All-Americans from last year's team: George Bovell, Kurt Cady, Rory Connell, Eric Shanteau and Doug Van Wie.

Leading the Way

Seniors John Scott, Steve Segerlin and James Wike are co-captains for the 2005-06 squad.

Fresh Faces

The Tigers added 17 newcomers to the mix this season. The group hails from 10 different states (Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, North Carolina, Oregon, Virginia and Washington) and two foreign countries (Ireland and Canada).

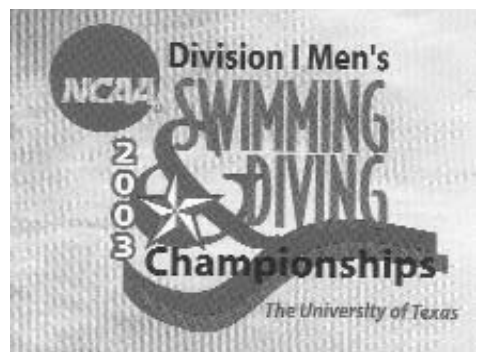
