

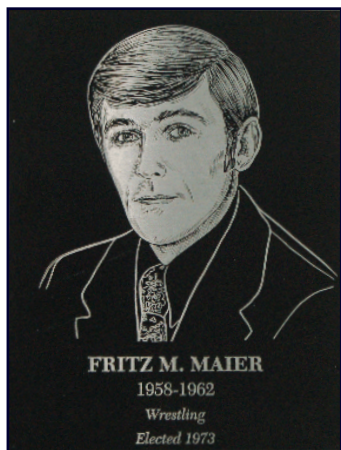

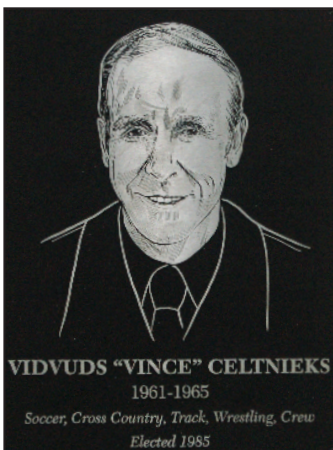


**CHARLES "FRITZ" MAIER**  
INDUCTED 1973

Charles "Fritz" Maier was a four-year member of the American University wrestling team and one of the most skilled grapplers of his day.

In the late '50s and early '60s, Maier consistently outmatched his opponents on the mat and became a four-time Mason-Dixon champion. As a freshman, Maier won his first championship in the 157-pound weight class. In his sophomore season, Maier moved up to 167 pounds, where he proceeded to win three more titles.

Maier was also a key member of the 1959-60 squad which went 8-0 in dual meets and produced American's only Mason-Dixon team championship.

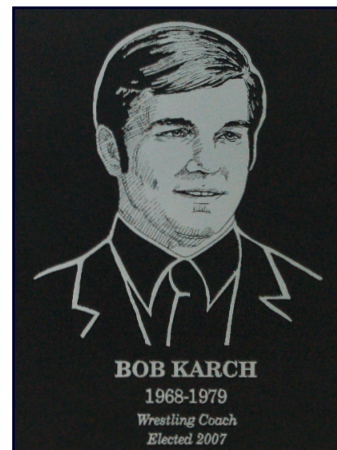


**VINCE CELTNIKS**  
INDUCTED 1985

Vidvuds "Vince" Celtnieks graduated from American University in 1965 as one of the most well-rounded athletes to have ever graced the AU playing surfaces.

In his four years as an Eagle, Celtnieks earned varsity letters in wrestling, cross country, track and soccer. As a wrestler, Celtnieks was coached by both Frank Morgan, who guided American to the Mason-Dixon Team Championship in 1960, and Isidore Abrams.

On the soccer pitch, Celtnieks was a member of the 1964 team which snapped a streak of four consecutive years with a losing record. As a cross country and track athlete, Celtnieks was a teammate to future NCAA Champions Peter Chen and Andrew "Butch" Bell.



**DR. ROBERT KARCH**  
INDUCTED 2007

Dr. Robert Karch headed American University's wrestling program for 10 seasons, between 1968 and 1979.

In his first season as coach, he led a team that had won just one dual match in the previous four seasons to four dual match wins. In the decade which Karch served as the program's mentor, he amassed more than 70 dual match wins and coached 17 conference place-winners, a conference champion and several first-place or second-place finishes at invitational tournaments. No slouch on the mat himself, Karch won three Atlantic Coast Conference Championships while wrestling for the University of Maryland.

In 1979, Karch stepped down as the wrestling coach to develop AU's Master of Science program in Health and Fitness Management, which he continues to direct. He has served the Athletics Department for the last several years as the Faculty Athletic representative.

## STAFFORD H. "POP" CASSELL HALL OF FAME



**JOSH GLENN**  
INDUCTED 2018

Glenn won the NCAA individual championship at 197 pounds during the 2007 NCAA Championships. He is AU's only national champion in wrestling.

Glenn qualified for the NCAA Tournament four times, earning All-America status during three of those trips.

He stands as the only Eagle to have won three EIWA championships (2006, 2007, 2008) and placed second as a freshman. In 2020, Glenn was inducted into the EIWA Hall of Fame.

Glenn's 44 career falls still stands as American's school record. He is fourth on the Eagles' list of career victories with 110.

In 2008, he was the AU Scholar-Athlete of the Year across all sports.



**MIKE CANNON**  
INDUCTED 2020

Three-time All-American Mike Cannon finished a storied career with 122 wins, the second-most in program history.

He earned three top-eight finishes at the NCAA Championships in three different weight classes, placing sixth as a sophomore, eighth as a junior and third as a senior.

He was the 2008 Midlands Champion, a two-time EIWA Champion and qualified for the NCAA Championships in all four years of his career.

Off the mat, Cannon was a three-time NWCA Academic All-American and was named the 2010 American University Male Senior Student-Athlete of the Year. He earned both his bachelor's and master's degrees from the Kogod School of Business.
