KEY STORYLINES

AMERICAN at VIRGINIA

- The Eagles went 7-1 at home in non-conference play, but have yet to win on the road this season in four tries.
- Virginia is the first ranked team AU will face in 2025-26, and the third Power Four team after Wake Forest and Rutgers.
- AU's loss at VCU snapped a three-game win streak that included an exciting comeback win over Drexel after trailing by 13 at halftime.
- Freshman Madden Collins was the PL Rookie of the Week on Dec. 8 after scoring 19 points vs. Drexel and leading AU with 14 ppg in a 2-0 week.
- The Eagles lost at Virginia exactly a year ago, falling 63-58 in a tight game on Dec. 22, 2024 after having a lead in the final five minutes. AU hit 11 three-pointers and turned the ball over a season-low seven times.
- Five different players—Wyatt Nausadis, Madden Collins, Kade Sebastian, Greg Jones, and Dean Hogans—have been leading scorers so far.
- The Eagles have hit 14 triples in two straight games and three times this season, all tying for fourth in a single game in program history.
- AU currently has six players averaging 8.5 ppg or more, which no other AU team in the past 25 years can boast.

LAST TIME OUT

- Despite five players reaching double digits in scoring for AU, the Eagles were out-played on the glass lost 105-83 at VCU on Dec. 18.
- Junior Wyatt Nausadis led AU with 17 points, senior Geoff Sprouse scored a season-high 16, and sophomore Julen Iturbe finished with 15.
- VCU pulled down 43 rebounds to American's 26, and had a 23-9 advantage in second-chance points. The Rams also kept AU out of the paint, with only 11 of AU's 25 field goals being two-pointers.

PATRIOT LEAGUE LEADERS

- As a team, AU leads the Patriot League in scoring offense (81.8 ppg), scoring margin (8.4 ppg), turnover margin (3.00), and steals (9.00 pg).

YOUTH MOVEMENT

- On this year's roster of 19, nine are true freshmen including six scholarship players. With the freshman class making up nearly half the team, some of these talented newcomers are making an immediate impact.
- Madden Collins currently leads the team with 13.0 points per game. He scored 25 points in AU's home-opening win over Penn on Nov. 9, 16 at Rutgers, 20 against Marywood, and 19 to lead AU against Drexel.
- Kade Sebastian did not score against Drexel, but had been averaging 11.8 points over the previous six contests, scoring 20 vs. Marywood and 15 vs. Maine. In one four-game stretch, Sebastian shot 71.4 percent from the field. His 23.1 minutes per game lead all the freshmen so far this season.
- Chris Eagan scored 15 points on 6-of-8 shooting from the field against Central Penn, also grabbing five rebounds.
- Dean Hogans scored 16 points against Central Penn, hitting 6-of-11 shots.
- Carson McDonald scored in double figures in AU's first two games against Wake Forest and Penn, but was sidelined for the remainder of the season after a knee injury suffered early in the game against Central Penn.

SCOUTING VIRGINIA

- The Cavaliers are 10-1 overall and moved into the national rankings in early December, currently standing in 23rd in the AP Poll and 22nd in the Coaches Poll.
- Virginia is averaging 18.5 points per game more than its opponents, ranking fourth in the ACC. The Cavaliers lead the ACC in 3-point field-goal percentage and offensive rebounds. Their 86.5 points per game are the second-most in school history.
- UVA has scored 80 or more points in 10 games, the most since nine during the Cavaliers' championship season in 2018-19.
- Thijs De Ridder leads UVA with 15.1 points per game and 5.8 rebounds per game. Three others also average in double digits in scoring for the Cavaliers.
- Ryan Odom was named head coach in March after spending two seasons at VCU, leading the Rams to a 52-21 record and a 2025 NCAA Tournament berth.

SERIES HISTORY

- Virginia has a 6-1 lead in the all-time series after a five-point win exactly a year ago, but this will be just the third meeting in the modern era.
- The Cavaliers pulled out a close, 63-58 win on their home court last year, also Dec. 22. Prior to that, they won 91-70 on their home court on Dec. 28, 2006 in the only other "recent" meeting between the two programs.
- AU and UVA played five times between 1938 and 1951, with the Eagles winning only the last of those in the only game in D.C., 69-54 on Feb. 3, 1951.

THREE-POINT THREATS

- In two straight games, and three times this season, the Eagles have made 14 three-pointers to tie for fourth all-time in a single game in program history.
- AU's 10.0 three-pointers made per game rank second in the Patriot League. Senior Geoff Sprouse hit 5-of-9 at VCU and leads the team with 24 three-pointers made this season.

PATRIOT LEAGUE LEADERS

- As a team, AU leads the PL in scoring offense (81.8 ppg), scoring margin (8.4 ppg), turnover margin (3.00), and steals (9.00 pg).
- Individuals ranked in the top five after the opening 11 games of the season are Matt Mayo in FG percentage (5th, .565) and 3-pt FG percentage (1st, .516), Kade Sebastian in 3-pt FG percentage (3rd, .469), and Madden Collins in steals (5th, 1.7 per game).

BEST FREE-THROW PERFORMANCE IN SEVEN YEARS

- The Eagles' 92-66 rout of Longwood on Nov. 30 saw them sink their most free throws in nearly seven years, hitting 27-of-30.
- The most recent performance to top it in terms of free throws made was a 52-of-45 performance in a win over Bucknell in January of 2019.
- Junior Greg Jones posted a 9-for-9 performance, freshman Kade Sebastian was 6-for-6, and senior Geoff Sprouse hit 5-of-5.

FIRST ROOKIE HONOR FOR MADDEN COLLINS

- The first Patriot League weekly honor of the season for AU belonged to freshman guard Madden Collins, named PL Rookie of the Week after the Eagles' wins over Drexel and UMES.
- Collins came off the bench for a team-high 19 points in a 75-73 comeback win over Drexel, also pulling down five boards. Three days later he scored nine points off the bench in a 78-60 win over UMES, again adding five rebounds. He had three steals and three assists for the week with zero turnovers.

BALANCED OFFENSE IS HISTORY IN THE MAKING

- After 12 games played this season, there are six Eagles currently averaging 8.5 points per game or better in a very balanced offense.
- Going back through 25 years of available season statistics, no other AU team ever finished a season with six players reaching that figure. The closest was five just two seasons ago in 2023-24.
- All five AU starters are part of the group at 8.5 ppg or above, while freshman Madden Collins leads the way with 13.0 ppg off the bench this season.

RECORD-SETTING WINS

- In defeating Central Penn (USCAA Div. II) and Marywood (DIII), American put up some rare and never-before-seen numbers in Bender Arena on Nov. 15 and Nov. 24.
- The Eagles scored 115 points vs. Central Penn, the sixth-most all-time in program history. Their 65-point margin of victory was the largest all-time. AU's 113 points vs. Marywood ties for eighth.
- Dating back at least to 2008, no other game has seen seven AU players reach double figures in scoring, which happened against Central Penn. Five reached double digits against Marywood.
- The Eagles' 55 rebounds against Central Penn were the most in over two decades, with the last known 50+-rebound game being in 2004 against Lafayette (50 rebounds).
- AU's 43 field goals made vs. Marywood ties for 10th all-time, the Eagles' 14 three-pointers made ties for fourth all-time in a game, and their 26 assists in both victories ties for ninth all-time.
- Madden Collins and Kade Sebastian scored 20 points each against Marywood, becoming the first freshman duo to each score at least 20 points since Sa'eed Nelson and Mark Gasperini had 20 each on Feb. 15, 2017, in a 78-65 loss at Lafayette.

THREE-POINT SPECIALIST GEOFF SPROUSE RETURNS

- Senior Geoff Sprouse missed 15 games due to injury last season, but still posted 42 three-pointers to rank in a tie for third.
- Sprouse has 166 career three-point field goals which ranks sixth all-time at AU with much of a season left to play.
- He once hit seven triples in a win over Hood College in 2023-24, and in the Eagles' NCAA First Four game against Mount St. Mary's on March 19, 2025, Sprouse connected on 6-of-12 three-pointers.

OPENING STATEMENTS

- Although the Eagles came up short in their season opener at Wake Forest, some stat lines were impressive.
- Sophomore Wyatt Nausadis scored a career-high 22 points on 8-of-16 shooting including 4-of-8 from long range.
- Junior Greg Jones added seven rebounds, a career-high six assists, and four steals to 14 points, hitting 8-of-8 free throws.
- The Eagles scored 40 second-half points, losing by just two in the half and hitting 48.3 percent from the field in that period.

GREG JONES NAMED PL PRESEASON DEFENSIVE POY

- Junior guard Greg Jones was selected by the Patriot League head coaches as 2025-26 Preseason Defensive Player of the Year.
- Jones, a PL All-Defensive Team selection last season, averaged 10.3 points and 3.9 rebounds per game to rank third in both for AU.
- Jones helped the Eagles lead the League in scoring defense (67.7) and finish second in opponent 3-point field goal percentage (.331).

INJURY REPORT

- Sophomore Eric Michaels is out this season after undergoing surgery on his right knee in September.
- Freshman Carson McDonald is out for the rest of the season after injuring his left knee on Nov. 15 against Central Penn.
- Freshman Kamran Prince has been out due to a foot injury for the Eagles' first 12 games so far.

HARD TO SAY GOODBYE

- American is without four of its consistent starters from last season, including three fifth-years and a senior.
- PL Championship MVP and All-PL First Teamer Matt Rogers led AU with 16.7 points per game, finishing his career ranked sixth all-time in scoring.
- All-Patriot League Third Team honoree Elijah Stephens led AU and ranked fourth in the PL with 3.8 assists per game and 1.6 steals per game. Colin Smalls averaged 9.8 points per game to rank fourth last season, and Lincoln Ball led AU with 5.7 rebounds per game.

SECOND-HALF SURGES

- Twice last season, the Eagles trailed by double digits at halftime and come back to win, both times at home.
- On Jan. 11 against Bucknell, AU trailed by 11 at the half but won 68-58 after a huge second half fueled by Matt Rogers.
- On March 6 in their PL quarterfinal, the Eagles again trailed by 11 to Lafayette, but came back with a 14-0 run in the second half to win 71-69.
- Already in 2025-26, AU has come back from a 13-point halftime deficit against Drexel at home on Dec. 3, winning 75-73.

RECORD-BREAKING SEASON IN 2024-25

- Last year, AU had its first 22-win season since a 22-9 record in 2010-11, and its first 20-win season since 2013-14.
- AU claimed the PL title for the first time in 11 years, and did so for the fourth time in program history after winning in '14, '09, and '08.
- The Eagles claimed a share of the PL regular season championship, doing so for the first time since 2009.
- With 13 Patriot League victories, the Eagles completed the 2024-25 PL season tied for the most wins in program history, matching both the 2013-14 and 2008-09 squads.
- AU had its longest conference win streak (seven games) since the 2013-14 season. The Eagles won 15 of their last 19 games, going 8-4 after the streak ended.
- In front of a sold-out crowd of 2,578, the Eagles rolled to a 74-52 win over Navy in the title game of the 2025 PL Championship in Bender.

HEAD COACH DUANE SIMPKINS

» Nationally recognized coach and legendary DMV basketball star Duane Simpkins is in his third season as head coach of the American University men's basketball team in 2025-26.

» In just his second year, Simpkins led the Eagles to a historic season, winning the 2024-25 Patriot League Championship and earning the program's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2014. American finished 22-13 overall and 13-5 in the Patriot League, matching the program's all-time record for league wins in a season. The championship was clinched on the Eagles' home floor at Bender Arena in front of a packed house, capping off a season in which AU led the Patriot League in home attendance for the first time in over a decade.

» The 2024-25 campaign also saw the Eagles break their own program record for made three-pointers with 299 on the season. Under Simpkins' leadership, the team embraced an up-tempo, modern style of play and re-energized the fan base with its high-effort, high-character identity.

» Individually, Simpkins earned national recognition, landing on the watchlists for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, the Ben Jobe Award, and the ABIS Mid-Major Coaches Watchlist. He coached two-time All-Patriot League First Teamer Matt Rogers for his final season, one in which Rogers earned Patriot League Tournament MVP honors. Also earning All-PL recognition in Simpkins' second season was Elijah Stephens (All-PL Third Team) and Greg Jones (All-PL Defensive Team).

» In his first season at the helm, Simpkins guided AU to a 16-16 record and a tie for second place in the Patriot League, despite multiple key injuries in the second half of the year. The team set a new program record with 279 three-pointers that season and earned a signature win at Colgate to close the regular season, snapping one of the nation's longest winning streaks.

» Over his first two seasons, Simpkins has coached multiple All-Patriot League selections including Matt Rogers, Elijah Stephens, Greg Jones, and Matt Mayock, and has continued to emphasize academic success. The program has earned the NABC Team Academic Excellence Award in both of his seasons so far, and has seen numerous players recognized on the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll while getting both Matt Rogers (2024) and Lincoln Ball (2025) named to the Academic All-Patriot League Team.

» Simpkins came to American after eight seasons on the staff at George Mason. During his time in Fairfax, Simpkins helped guide the Patriots to program bests within the Atlantic 10. Mason set or matched A-10 bests in league wins and tournament seeds in four seasons during his tenure. The Patriots matched a program best with 11 Atlantic 10 victories in 2022-23, and finished at 20-13 overall.

» A DMV basketball legend, Simpkins earned McDonald's High School All-America honors at DeMatha Catholic under Hall of Fame coach Morgan Wootten, and was just the third freshman to make DeMatha's varsity team.

» He was a three-time honorable mention All-ACC selection at the University of Maryland, helping the Terrapins to three NCAA appearances, including a pair of Sweet 16 showings. A three-year starter and captain under coach Gary Williams from 1992-96, Simpkins finished his career with 1,123 points over 119 games.

» Simpkins and his wife Kirsten have three kids – Kai, Darian and Elijah.


