

WARHAWKS DOWN MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE FOR THIRD STRAIGHT WIN:

Travis Anderson scored 32 points and hit a 30-foot three-point shot with 3.5 seconds remaining in regulation as the Auburn University at Montgomery men's basketball team earned a 79-74 win over Mississippi College. Anderson went 8-for-17 from the floor and 4-for-9 from three-point territory. He also went 12-for-13 at the foul line, pulled down six rebounds, and totaled two assists while playing all 40 minutes of the game. The Warhawks have won a season-high three games after wins over Shorter. Delta State, and Mississippi College.

ANDERSON NAMED GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Point guard Travis Anderson was named GSC Player of the Week for the first time this year after he scored 32 points and hit the game-winning three-pointer with 3.5 seconds left to beat Mississippi College and cap a 3-0 week for AUM. Anderson also scored 26 points and had three steals in a win over Shorter, and 14 points and four three-pointers in a win over Delta State. For the week, Anderson averaged 24.0 points, 3.7 rebounds, 1.7 steals, and shot 50% (12-24) from three-point territory. He went 18-20 from the free throw line and also played all 40 minutes against Delta State and MC over the weekend after scoring his 26 points in 34 minutes at Shorter.

CLEANING UP THE BOARDS:

The Warhawks are averaging 35.5 rebounds per game, which ranks fourth in the GSC, and James Graham leads the way with 6.9 rebounds per game. Graham ranked second in the GSC last season at 7.1 rebounds per game, and ranks eighth this season. He tallied 11 rebounds against Rollins and a season-high 14 against Florida Tech. Jalen Gaston is second on the team averaging 5.1 rebounds and Roderick Smith ranks third on the team averaging 4.8 rebounds. Point guard Travis Anderson ranks fourth on the team with 4.4 boards per game.

SCOUTING THE LEE FLAMES:

Jayce Willingham scores 18.4 points per game to lead the way for Lee, who is 3-2 in GSC play. The Flames are third in the GSC in scoring defense (65 points per game) and also rank first in opposing field goal percentage (40.5 percent). Lee has also been the most successful team in the GSC in knocking down three-point shots, as the Flames have hit 38.9 percent of their three-point attempts.

NEWS & NOTES:

PRETURNING WARHAWKS:

The Warhawks return 10 players from last season's squad that went 12-16 and 9-11 in the GSC. AUM finished in a tie for eighth place in the GSC standings last year but lost out on a playoff birth in a tiebreaker scenario. AUM's top returning scorer is James Graham, who ranked 22nd in the GSC last season averaging 12.5 points per game. He also ranked second in the league in rebounding at 7.7 rebounds per contest. AUM also returns the team's top three shot blockers from last season's squad that finished first in all of NCAA Division II in blocks (174) and blocks per game (6.2). Graham (2.1) ranked first in the GSC in blocks, Roderick Smith (1.6) finished second, and Jelal Williams (1.2) finished fifth in the league in the category. Deven Tucker, Sam Youngblood, Tysen Banks, Jaxon Hunter, Strahinja Ivic, Zameron Boozer, and Gilbert Croley also all return for the Warhawks.

ANDERSON NAMED A TOP NEWCOMER TO WATCH IN GSC:

Auburn University at Montgomery guard Travis Anderson was named to the Gulf South Conference Newcomer Watch List in the preseason. Anderson, a junior from Atlanta, Ga., is a transfer from Charleston Southern University. He was a Big South All-Freshman team member in 2019-2020 after averaging 8.9 points per game and led all Big South bench players in scoring average. He played 45 games for the Buccaneers and played 16.7 minutes per night.

QULF SOUTH CONFERENCE PRESEASON POLL:

AUM was picked to finish 10th in this season's preseason coaches' poll. Defending Gulf South Conference tournament champion the University of Alabama in Huntsville was picked to win the league. They were followed by tournament runner-up, Lee. Valdosta State was picked to finish third in the league, West Alabama (104) was picked fourth. and Union (103) was picked fifth.

CHASING 800:

The Warhawks own a 796-612 record all-time as a program. AUM, who began competing as an NAIA institution in the 1975-76 season, started the school's transition to NCAA Division II in 2016-17 when they competed as an NCAA independent. The Warhawks began playing a Gulf South Conference schedule in 2017-2018. AUM needs four more wins to reach 800 program wins.

NEWCOMER SCORING INFUSION:

The Warhawks have relied heavily on an infusion of scoring by new players on the roster this season. Newcomers this season account for 55.3 percent of AUM's scoring, or 329 of 594 points. The team's leading scorer, at 15.9 points per game, is guard Travis Anderson. Jalen Gaston is second on the squad at 15.6 points per game. Transfer wing Joe Lanzi is also fourth on the team in scoring at 9.6 points per contest for the Warhawks.

MONTGOMERY BLOCK PARTY:

AUM blocked 13 shot attempts against the University of West Alabama earlier this season, setting a new school record along the way. The previous record had been 11 blocks in a game, which the Warhawks did twice (in 2021 against Southeastern Baptist, and in 1997 against LaGrange). For the season, the Warhawks have blocked 28 shots as a team in five games, averaging 5.6 blocks per game. That number ranks first in the Gulf South Conference. James Graham leads the team and the league this season with 16 blocks (3.2 per game). AUM's top three shot blockers from last season are still on the roster, as Graham averaged 2.1 blocks to rank first in the league. The Warhawks totaled 174 blocks, or 6.2 per game. Roderick Smith (1.6) finished second in the GSC last season, and Jelal Williams (1.2) finished fifth.

ANDERSON LEADING IN THE SCORING COLUMN:

Newcomer Travis Anderson leads the way for the AUM offense at 15.9 points per game. Anderson has posted double-figures five times this year, including 32 points against Mississippi College. Anderson also tallied 26 points in a GSC win over Spring Hill, dropped 18 against Alabama Huntsville, put up 16 against Florida Tech, and 14 points against Delta State. Anderson is averaging 15.9 points, 4.4 rebounds, 1.8 assists, and 1.4 steals in 36.5 minutes per game through the team's first eight games.

GSC LEADERS: Newcomer guard Joseph Lanzi is second in the GSC in three-point percentage at 47.8 percent (11-for-23). James Graham leads the GSC in blocks with 19, averaging 2.4 blocks per game, and is eighth in the league in rebounding at 6.9 rebounds per game. Gaston is tied for fifth in steals per game at 1.5 and ranks third in minutes played (35.3 per night). Travis Anderson ranks second in the GSC in minutes played (36.5). The Warhawks rank third in the GSC in blocks per game (4.1), but also rank second-worst in the league in turnovers with 15.3 per game.

THE MICHAEL CHEANEY FILE:

The Warhawks' head men's basketball coach, Michael Cheaney, enters his 9th season at the helm of Auburn Montgomery and 13th overall as a collegiate head coach. Cheaney, a coaching veteran with more than 20 years of experience at the NCAA Division I, II, III and NAIA levels, took over the helm of AUM after spending four seasons as head coach at Voorhees College in Denmark, S.C.

Last season, AUM posted a record of 12-16 in 2021-22, highlighted by senior guard Isaiah Hart being named to the All-GSC second team. Hart finished third in the conference in points per game (18.2) and led the GSC with 114 assists. Senior guard Jeremiah Bozeman was named to the GSC All-Academic Team and the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team for his efforts both on the court and in the classroom. The Warhawks led all of NCAA Division II with 174 total blocked shots and 6.2 blocks per game. Junior forward James Graham led the GSC with 58 blocks while Roderick Smith ranked second with 42 and Jelal Williams ranked fifth with 30. Hart took home GSC player of the week honors twice over the course of the season while Bozeman and Graham were also named conference player of the week in 2021-22.

Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Cheaney was a standout student-athlete at Kentucky Wesleyan University. During his playing career, Cheaney earned the Senior Award as the Panthers' outstanding athlete and set the school record for field goal percentage, which he still owns today. He was also named the team's Most Improved Player. He still owns that Cheaney earned his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Kentucky Wesleyan in 1996. He went on to earn a master's in sports management from Indiana State University.
