

HOME. SWEET HOME OPENER:

After four straight road contests to start the regular year, and an exhibition just up the road agianst the Auburn Tigers, the Warhawks play in front of the home crowd for the first time in the 2023-2023 season tonight. AUM roared out of the gate to start the year with road wins over Saint Leo University and Florida Southern College, but stumbled in its last two outings. The weekend sweep of Sunshine State Conference opponents to begin the season marked the first time since the 2015-2016 season, and the first time in the NCAA Division II era, that AUM won back-to-back games to start the year.

♦ WARHAWKS AMONG THE TOP 25 RANKS:

For the first time as an NCAA Division II school, the Warhawks found themselves ranked inside the Top 25 of the College Sports Communicators Top 25 poll. After knocking off Saint Leo and Florida Southern, AUM ranked tied for 20th in the first poll. The Warhawks also entered last week receiving votes in the NABC Top 25 poll for the first time in school history. New polls are released on Tuesday. November 28.

© CLEANING UP THE BOARDS:

A season removed from averaging 37.7 rebounds per game to lead the Gulf South Conference, AUM is ranked fifth in the league in rebounds per game (38.0) to open the season. The Warhawks rank last in the league thus far in defensive rebounds per game (21.0), but are the No.1 offensive rebounding team in the conference at 17.0 per game. Newcomer Malachi Rhodes leads the way with 8.5 rebounds per game, which ranks second in the GSC, to go along with 11.5 points per game. Guard Jalen Gaston is second on the team at 6.3 rebounds, while Deven Tucker sits third on the squad at 4.3 rebounds per contest.

SCOUTING THE CHARGERS:

The Chargers sit third in the conference in scoring, averaging 90.4 points per game in five games thus far this year. Lipscomb transfer Tommy Murr leads the way at 20.4 points per contest, while Luke Burnett is right behind him averaging 19.8 points per contest. Burnett has already drilled 24 three-point field goals, the most in the league, and the Chargers are shooting the ball at a 53 percent clip from the field.

NEWS & NOTES:

PETURNING WARHAWKS:

The Warhawks return 9 players from last season's squad that went 15-14 and 13-11 in the GSC. AUM finished the season sixth in the Gulf South Conference standings, which earned them the highest conference tournament seed (No. 6) in the program's NCAA Division II history. While two of AUM's leading scorers from last season (James Graham and Roderick Smith) are now playing professionally overseas, the Warhawks return Jalen Gaston, Deven Tucker, Sam Youngblood, Travis Anderson, JaQuan Tyus, Zameron Boozer, Jelal Williams, and Gilbert Croley from last season's squad. Anderson returns as AUM's leading scorer from last season at 14.1 points per game. He also led the team in assists (4.0 per game). Gaston was the squad's third-leading scorer at 13.0 points per game and was also the team's third-leading rebounder (5.0 per game) last season. Joe Lanzi also averged double figures at 11.4 points per game.

ANDERSON NAMED PRESEASON ALL-GSC:

Auburn University at Montgomery guard Travis Anderson was named to the Preseason All-GSC team at the start of the season. Anderson, a senior from Atlanta, Ga., led the Warhawks in scoring at 14.1 points per game last year. He also led the team in three-pointers made (59), free throw percentage (85.1 percent), assists (4.0 per game), and minutes (35.1). Anderson also ranked 15th in the GSC in scoring, fourth in assists, 10th in assist-to-turnover ratio, third in free throw percentage, and sixth in minutes per game.

OULF SOUTH CONFERENCE PRESEASON POLL:

AUM was picked to finish 6th in this season's preseason coaches' poll. The University of Alabama in Huntsville was picked to win the league, and the defending GSC tournament champion the University of West Alabama was picked second. The University of West Georgia (third), Valdosta State University (fourth), and Lee University (fifth), sit just ahead of the Warhawks in the poll.

OCHEANEY TALLIES 100TH AUM VICTORY:

Head coach Michael Cheaney secured his 100th career victory leading the Auburn Montgomery men's basketball program with a Warhawk win over West Florida last season on Feb. 16 last season. Cheaney enters his 10th season at the helm of AUM. Last season, he helped lead the black and orange to 15 wins, the second-highest win total for the program since a 17-win 2015-16 season.

INSTANT IMPACT:

A season removed from getting 49 percent of its scoring from newcomers, AUM has seen newcomers account for 50.1 percent of the team's points thus far. Jalil Robinson, a transfer from Wallace State CC, leads the way at 16.8 points per game, with 2.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists, and 2.3 steals per contest. Chappelle Whitney, a freshman from Warren Central High School in Bowling Green, Kentucky, is averaging 8.0 points and 2.8 rebounds as well for the Warhawks. Forward Malachi Rhodes, a transfer from McNeese State, is adding 11.5 points per game and 8.5 rebounds per game.

SWIPING THE BASKETBALL:

The Warhawks are tied for first in the GSC in steals (43) and steals per game (10.8) per game to open the year. Guard Jalil Robinson, guard Jalen Gaston, and forward Deven Tucker are all tied for the team lead with nine steals, at 2.3 steals per game. Gilbert Croley has five steals, Malachi Rhodes has four, Jelal Williams has tallied three steals, and Chappelle Whitney has totaled three. Ja'Quan Tyus and Zameron Boozer each also have a steal for AUM this year.

THE MICHAEL CHEANEY FILE:

The Warhawks' head men's basketball coach, Michael Cheaney, enters his 10th season at the helm of Auburn Montgomery and 14th overall as a collegiate head coach. Cheaney, a coaching veteran with more than 20 years of experience at the NCAA Division I, II, III and NAIA levels, took over the helm of AUM after spending four seasons as head coach at Voorhees College in Denmark, S.C.

Last season, AUM posted a record of 15-14 and went 13-11 in league play to earn the school's highest conference tournament seed (No. 6) in the program's NCAA Division II history. James Graham and Roderick Smith, the leading scorers a season ago for the Warhawks, both signed professional contracts to continue their careers overseas.

The 2021-2022 season was highlighted by senior guard Isaiah Hart being named Second Team All-GSC. Hart finished third in the conference in points per game (18.2) and led the GSC with 114 assists. Senior guard Jeremiah Bozeman was named to the GSC All-Academic Team and the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team for his efforts both on the court and in the classroom. The Warhawks led all of NCAA Division II with 174 total blocked shots and 6.2 blocks per game. Junior forward James Graham led the GSC with 58 blocks while Roderick Smith ranked second with 42 and Jelal Williams ranked fifth with 30. Hart took home GSC player of the week honors twice while Bozeman and Graham were also named conference player of the week in 2021-22.

Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Cheaney was a standout student-athlete at Kentucky Wesleyan University. During his playing career, Cheaney earned the Senior Award as the Panthers' outstanding athlete and set the school record for field goal percentage, which he still owns today. He was also named the team's Most Improved Player. He still owns that Cheaney earned his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Kentucky Wesleyan in 1996. He went on to earn a master's in sports management from Indiana State University.
