O'GARA NAMED GSC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Freshman point guard Grace O'Gara had been averaging 6.3 points per game after seven games in the AUM jersey. She caught fire at Mississippi College and exploded for 26 points shooting 10-for-15 from the field and 5-for-5 from the free throw line. She played 40 minutes for the second time this season. The Worcester, Mass. native dished out four assists, which is her sixth game with four or more assists. She grabbed four boards in the win and had a pair of steals. O'Gara and the Warhawks are 6-4 this season and are 4-2 in Gulf South Conference action.

OGRACE O'GARA NAMED GSC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Grace O'Gara scored 26 points last Sunday in a 64-54 victory over Mississippi College in Clinton, Miss. She was able to win Gulf South Conference Freshman of the Week after shooting 10-for-15 from the field. O'Gara is fifth in the GSC in assists per game with 3.8.

DUDLEY THIRD IN GSC IN POINTS:

Allasha Dudley is third in the Gulf South Conference in points per game. She opened the year tallying 39 in a road victory at Nova Southeastern University. She is averaging 16.1 points per game this season and has reached 161 points this season.

WARHAWKS AT HOME:

The Warhawks are 3-0 at home this season with wins over Arkansas Monticello. Alabama Huntsville, and Shorter University. This will be the toughest test for AUM as they try to defend the home court against.

SCOUTING THE LADY FLAMES:

The Lady Flames are coaches by Marty Rowe, who is in his 26th season coaching and in his 20th season leading Lee University. He is 626-196 over 26 years and has the Lady Flames rolling again in the 2023-24 season. They are 6-2 this season and 5-0 in GSC action. Mallory Hampton is averaging 19 points per game and Addison Smith grabs 4.3 rebounds per contest. The Lady Flames have won four of six games by less than six points.
