

# STARTING LINEUP: WARHAWKS LOOK TO SNAP THREE-GAME LOSING SKID

#### • WARHAWKS SEEK SOME MOMENTUM AHEAD OF THE CHRISTMAS HOLIDAY:

The Auburn University at Montgomery men's basketball team scored road wins over Saint Leo University and Florida Southern College to start the 2023-2024 campaign, but it has been tough sledding for the Warhawks through a road-heavy schedule through the opening 10 games of the season. The Warhawks have fallen in seven of their last eight games overall, but secured a win over Shorter 71-62 to grab the team's first win in front of the home crowd at the AUM Athletics Complex. The Warhawks have played one of the tougher schedule stretches in the GSC to open, and they finish off the first semester hosting Peach Belt Conference foe Georgia College.

#### © CLEANING UP THE BOARDS:

A season removed from averaging 37.0 rebounds per game to lead the Gulf South Conference, AUM is ranked sixth in the league in rebounds per game (36.4) through 10 contests this season. The Warhawks rank 10th in the league thus far in defensive rebounds per game (23.1). but are the No. 2 offensive rebounding team in the conference at 13.3 per game. Malachi Rhodes leads the way with 6.5 rebounds per game. good for eighth in the GSC. Deven Tucker sits second on the team at 5.1 rebounds per contest, and Jalen Gaston is third at 4.6 rebounds.

#### SCOUTING THE BOBCATS:

Georgia College enter sthe game having won seven of its first eight games of the campaign, including a six-game win streak to begin the year. Perhaps even more impressively, the Bobcats have not played a home game to this point in the year. Georgia College sports a 5-1 mark on the road and is 2-0 in neutral site contests. Brendan Rigsbee leads the offensive charge at 15.6 points per game. Richard Crawford III is second on the team at 12.9 points per game, and Zvair Green sits third at 11.0 points a night. Rigsbee also leads the team on the glass with 7.6 rebounds per game. Crawford III dishes out a team-best 2.9 assists per game, and Rigsbee averages 1.0 steals per game. Rigsbee has been in double figures eight times this year, including two 20-plus point efforts against Saint Leo and Southern Weslevan, Crawford III has posted double-digit scoring games six times this year, and Green posted 26 points in a 97-92 win for the Bobcats against Saint Leo.

# **NEWS & NOTES:**

#### **→**-RETURNING WARHAWKS:

The Warhawks return nine players from last season's squad that went 15-14 and 13-11 in the GSC. AUM finished the season sixth in the Gulf South Conference standings, which earned them the highest conference tournament seed (No. 6) in the program's NCAA Division II history. While two of AUM's leading scorers from last season (James Graham and Roderick Smith) are now playing professionally overseas, the Warhawks return Jalen Gaston, Deven Tucker, Sam Youngblood, Travis Anderson, JaQuan Tyus, Zameron Boozer, Jelal Williams, and Gilbert Croley from last season's squad. Anderson returns as AUM's leading scorer from last season at 14.1 points per game. He also led the team in assists (4.0 per game). Gaston was the squad's third-leading scorer at 13.0 points per game and was also the team's third-leading rebounder (5.0 per game) last season. Joe Lanzi also averged double figures at 11.4 points per game.

### **◆ ANDERSON NAMED PRESEASON ALL-GSC:**

Auburn University at Montgomery guard Travis Anderson was named to the Preseason All-GSC team at the start of the season. Anderson, a senior from Atlanta, Ga., led the Warhawks in scoring at 14.1 points per game last year. He also led the team in three-pointers made (59), free throw percentage (85.1 percent), assists (4.0 per game), and minutes (35.1). Anderson also ranked 15th in the GSC in scoring, fourth in assists, 10th in assist-to-turnover ratio, third in free throw percentage, and sixth in minutes per game.

#### **OULF SOUTH CONFERENCE PRESEASON POLL:**

AUM was picked to finish 6th in this season's preseason coaches' poll. The University of Alabama in Huntsville was picked to win the league, and the defending GSC tournament champion the University of West Alabama was picked second. The University of West Georgia (third), Valdosta State University (fourth), and Lee University (fifth). sit just ahead of the Warhawks in the poll.

### **OCHEANEY TALLIES 100TH AUM VICTORY:**

Head coach Michael Cheaney secured his 100th career victory leading the Auburn Montgomery men's basketball program with a Warhawk win over West Florida last season on Feb. 16 last season. Cheaney enters his 10th season at the helm of AUM. Last season, he helped lead the black and orange to 15 wins, the second-highest win total for the program since a 17-win 2015-16 season.

#### **INSTANT IMPACT:**

A season removed from getting 49 percent of its scoring from newcomers, AUM has seen newcomers account for 48.9 percent of the team's points thus far. Jalil Robinson leads the way for the newcomers at 15.1 points per game, with 3.0 rebounds, 3.3 assists, and 1.9 steals per contest. Forward Malachi Rhodes, a transfer from McNeese State, adds 11.6 points per game and 6.5 rebounds per game for the black and orange. Chappelle Whitney, a freshman from Warren Central High School in Bowling Green, Kentucky, is averaging 6.4 points and 3.6 rebounds as well for the Warhawks.

## SWIPING THE BASKETBALL:

The Warhawks rank second in the GSC in steals (98) and rank second in steals per game (9.8) to open the year. Jalil Robinson leads the way at 1.9 per game (19), which ranks fourth in the GSC. Jalen Gaston's 1.8 a game (14) rank seventh in the league, and Deven Tucker's 1.7 steals per game (17) rank ninth in the league. Malachi Rhodes (10), Jelal Williams (10), and Gilbert Croley (9) all rank top six on the team in total steals. Chappelle Whitney (6), Joseph Lanzi (4), Zameron Boozer (3), Travis Anderson (3), Sam Youngblood (2) and Ja'Quan Tyus (1) all also have steals for AUM.

### THE MICHAEL CHEANEY FILE:

The Warhawks' head men's basketball coach, Michael Cheaney, enters his 10th season at the helm of Auburn Montgomery and 14th overall as a collegiate head coach. Cheaney, a coaching veteran with more than 20 years of experience at the NCAA Division I, II, III and NAIA levels, took over the helm of AUM after spending four seasons as head coach at Voorhees College in Denmark, S.C.

Last season, AUM posted a record of 15-14 and went 13-11 in league play to earn the school's highest conference tournament seed (No. 6) in the program's NCAA Division II history. James Graham and Roderick Smith, the leading scorers a season ago for the Warhawks, both signed professional contracts to continue their careers overseas.

The 2021-2022 season was highlighted by senior guard Isaiah Hart being named Second Team All-GSC. Hart finished third in the conference in points per game (18.2) and led the GSC with 114 assists. Senior guard Jeremiah Bozeman was named to the GSC All-Academic Team and the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team for his efforts both on the court and in the classroom. The Warhawks led all of NCAA Division II with 174 total blocked shots and 6.2 blocks per game. Junior forward James Graham led the GSC with 58 blocks while Roderick Smith ranked second with 42 and Jelal Williams ranked fifth with 30. Hart took home GSC player of the week honors twice while Bozeman and Graham were also named conference player of the week in 2021-22.

Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Cheaney was a standout student-athlete at Kentucky Wesleyan University. During his playing career, Cheaney earned the Senior Award as the Panthers' outstanding athlete and set the school record for field goal percentage, which he still owns today. He was also named the team's Most Improved Player. He still owns that Cheaney earned his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Kentucky Wesleyan in 1996. He went on to earn a master's in sports management from Indiana State University.
