

◆ WARHAWKS FALL AT ALABAMA HUNTSVILLE:

After a sluggish first half, the Auburn University at Montgomery men's basketball team outscored the University of West Alabama 42-21 in the second half en route to a 69-58 win in the Gulf South Conference play. The Warhawks, who did not lead in the first half, shot 34 percent from the field in the opening 20 minutes before shooting a 56-percent clip in the second half. AUM also forced 11 second-half turnovers. Malachi Rhodes led all scorers with 18 points, while Travis Anderson contributed 17., Jalil Robinson (10) rounded out AUM's double-figure scorers.

OCLEANING UP THE BOARDS:

A season removed from averaging 37.0 rebounds per game to lead the Gulf South Conference, AUM is ranked fourth in the league in rebounds per game (36.6) through 17 contests this season. The Warhawks rank 10th in the league thus far in defensive rebounds per game (23.1), but are the No. 2 offensive rebounding team in the conference at 13.6 per game. Malachi Rhodes leads the way with 6.9 rebounds per game, good for sixth in the GSC. Jalen Gaston and Deven Tucker are tied for second on the team at 4.8 rebounds per game.

SCOUTING THE HAWKS:

The Shorter Hawks are led offensively by Gary Clay Jr.'s 13.8 points per game. Shorter features two other players averaging in double figures for the year, as Landon Tillman (11.8 points) and Ricky Knight Jr. (10.9 points) join Clay Jr. to bolster the offense. Chris Cole leads the Hawks with 4.6 rebounds per game, while Knight Jr. also averages 4.1 boards a night. Tillman also leads the club with 2.9 assists per game and 1.3 assists per game. Shorter ranks sixth in the Gulf South Conference in field goal percentage at 45.3 percent and rank fifth in three-point field goal percentage (36.1 percent). Shorter also leads the league in made free throws (297) and free throw percentage (79.8 percent).

NEWS & NOTES:

→-RETURNING WARHAWKS:

The Warhawks return nine players from last season's squad that went 15-14 and 13-11 in the GSC. AUM finished the season sixth in the Gulf South Conference standings, which earned them the highest conference tournament seed (No. 6) in the program's NCAA Division II history. While two of AUM's leading scorers from last season (James Graham and Roderick Smith) are now playing professionally overseas, the Warhawks return Jalen Gaston, Deven Tucker, Sam Youngblood, Travis Anderson, JaQuan Tyus, Zameron Boozer, Jelal Williams, and Gilbert Croley from last season's squad. Anderson returns as AUM's leading scorer from last season at 14.1 points per game. He also led the team in assists (4.0 per game). Gaston was the squad's third-leading scorer at 13.0 points per game and was also the team's third-leading rebounder (5.0 per game) last season. Joe Lanzi also averged double figures at 11.4 points per game.

ANDERSON NAMED PRESEASON ALL-GSC:

Auburn University at Montgomery guard Travis Anderson was named to the Preseason All-GSC team at the start of the season. Anderson, a senior from Atlanta, Ga., led the Warhawks in scoring at 14.1 points per game last year. He also led the team in three-pointers made (59), free throw percentage (85.1 percent), assists (4.0 per game), and minutes (35.1). Anderson also ranked 15th in the GSC in scoring, fourth in assists, 10th in assist-to-turnover ratio, third in free throw percentage, and sixth in minutes per game.

OULF SOUTH CONFERENCE PRESEASON POLL:

AUM was picked to finish 6th in this season's preseason coaches' poll. The University of Alabama in Huntsville was picked to win the league, and the defending GSC tournament champion the University of West Alabama was picked second. The University of West Georgia (third), Valdosta State University (fourth), and Lee University (fifth). sit just ahead of the Warhawks in the poll.

OCHEANEY TALLIES 100TH AUM VICTORY:

Head coach Michael Cheaney secured his 100th career victory leading the Auburn Montgomery men's basketball program with a Warhawk win over West Florida last season on Feb. 16 last season. Cheaney enters his 10th season at the helm of AUM. Last season, he helped lead the black and orange to 15 wins, the second-highest win total for the program since a 17-win 2015-16 season.

INSTANT IMPACT:

A season removed from getting 49 percent of its scoring from newcomers, AUM has seen newcomers account for 41.7 percent of the team's points thus far. Jalil Robinson leads the way for the newcomers at 12.8 points per game, with 3.7 rebounds, 3.2 assists, and 1.7 steals per contest. Forward Malachi Rhodes, a transfer from McNeese State, adds 12.9 points per game and 6.9 rebounds per game for the black and orange. Chappelle Whitney, a freshman from Warren Central High School in Bowling Green, Kentucky, is averaging 5.3 points and 2.8 rebounds as well for the Warhawks.

SWIPING THE BASKETBALL:

The Warhawks rank second in the GSC in steals (164) and rank second in the league in steals per game (9.7) to open the year. Jalil Robinson leads the way at 1.7 per game (29), which ranks fifth in the GSC. Deven Tucker's 1.6 steals per game (27) rank sixth in the league, and Jalen Gaston's 1.4 a game (20) ranks 10th in the GSC. Malachi Rhodes (22), Jelal Williams (13), Travis Anderson (13) and Gilbert Croley (12) all rank top seven on the team in total steals. Joseph Lanzi (10), Chappelle Whitney (9), Sam Youngblood (5), Zameron Boozer (3), and Ja'Quan Tyus (1) have also recorded steals.

THE MICHAEL CHEANEY FILE:

The Warhawks' head men's basketball coach, Michael Cheaney, enters his 10th season at the helm of Auburn Montgomery and 14th overall as a collegiate head coach. Cheaney, a coaching veteran with more than 20 years of experience at the NCAA Division I, II, III and NAIA levels, took over the helm of AUM after spending four seasons as head coach at Voorhees College in Denmark, S.C.

Last season, AUM posted a record of 15-14 and went 13-11 in league play to earn the school's highest conference tournament seed (No. 6) in the program's NCAA Division II history. James Graham and Roderick Smith, the leading scorers a season ago for the Warhawks, both signed professional contracts to continue their careers overseas.

The 2021-2022 season was highlighted by senior guard Isaiah Hart being named Second Team All-GSC. Hart finished third in the conference in points per game (18.2) and led the GSC with 114 assists. Senior guard Jeremiah Bozeman was named to the GSC All-Academic Team and the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team for his efforts both on the court and in the classroom. The Warhawks led all of NCAA Division II with 174 total blocked shots and 6.2 blocks per game. Junior forward James Graham led the GSC with 58 blocks while Roderick Smith ranked second with 42 and Jelal Williams ranked fifth with 30. Hart took home GSC player of the week honors twice while Bozeman and Graham were also named conference player of the week in 2021-22.

Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Cheaney was a standout student-athlete at Kentucky Wesleyan University. During his playing career, Cheaney earned the Senior Award as the Panthers' outstanding athlete and set the school record for field goal percentage, which he still owns today. He was also named the team's Most Improved Player. He still owns that Cheaney earned his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Kentucky Wesleyan in 1996. He went on to earn a master's in sports management from Indiana State University.



posted an all-time record of 814-632, which translates to a .560 winning percentage. AUM reached the 800-win mark as a program on Saturday, Jan. 14 in an 83-78 win over the University of Alabama in Huntsville.

rebounds per game that the Warhawks average this year. AUM ranked first in the GSC in per-game rebounding last

season. They owned the top defensive rebounding mark and the second-best offensive-rebounding mark.

postseason appearances for the men's basketball program all-time between the NAIA and NCAA ranks. Last season, the Warhawks earned their second berth into the GSC tournament ever, with their highest seed ever (6-seed). The Warhawks put together 34 total conference, regional, and national tourney appearances as an NAIA institution.

points per game averaged this season by senior guard Jalen Gaston, which ranks first on the team. The 6-foot-2 guard leads the team in scoring at 14.3 points per game,

and has been in double figures in 12 of his 15 games this year. Gaston adds 4.8 rebounds, 2.9 assists, and 1.3 steals per game this year for the Warhawks.
