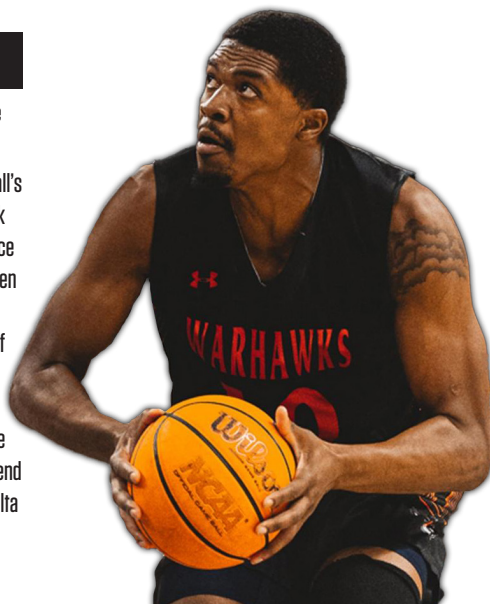

➔ RHODES NAMED WARHAWK OF THE WEEK:

Auburn University at Montgomery men's basketball's Malachi Rhodes was named Warhawk of the Week after having a strong week in Gulf South Conference action. Rhodes scored 18 points and gathered seven rebounds in a 69-58 victory over the University of West Alabama earlier this week. He added a pair of assists and swatted two shots. Rhodes added eight points and grabbed five boards in AUM's second win of the week at Shorter. Rhodes and the Warhawks return to the court for a massive weekend of GSC basketball with Mississippi College and Delta State University coming to town.



NEWS & NOTES

➔ WARHAWKS FALL AT ALABAMA HUNTSVILLE:

Led by 31 points from Travis Anderson and 20 points from Joseph Lanzi, the AUM men's basketball team took down Shorter University 100-80 to win its second consecutive game in GSC action. The Warhawks committed just nine turnovers in the game and scored 31 points off 16 Shorter turnovers. AUM out-rebounded its opponent for the eighth time and recorded its 12th game this year with double-digit steals. Also, for the sixth time in the last eight games, AUM made double-digit three-point field goals.

➔ SCOUTING THE CHOCTAWS:

Rashad Bolden has bolstered the Mississippi College Choctaws 19 games into the season, leading the team and the conference in scoring at 24.6 points per game. Bolden also adds 4.4 rebounds per game and 4.6 assists per game, and ranks fourth in the GSC in assists per game. Cam Brown ranks as the only other Choctaw in double figures on a nightly basis at 12.2 points per contest. Eric Flemming leads the squad at 4.9 rebounds per game. The Choctaws are tied for fifth in the conference standings at 9-6 with nine games left to play in the regular season.



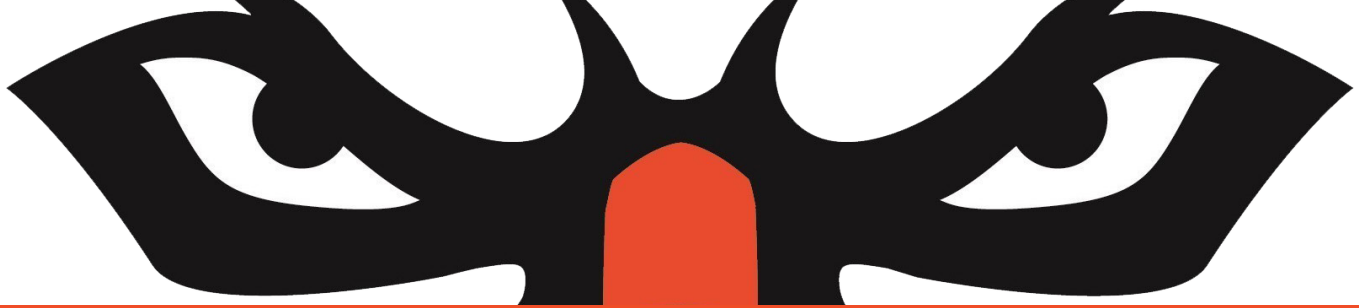
