

WARHAWKS WIN 14-13 BARNBURNER AGAINST RV GEORGIA SOUTHWESTERN:

The Auburn University at Montgomery baseball team used a game-winning fielder's choice ground ball off the bat of Hayden Grier to cap a 14-13 walk-off win over Georgia Southwestern State University on Tuesday night, Feb. 13, at Q.V. Lowe Field. Georgia Southwestern, receiving votes in the 2024 Preseason Top 25 poll by the National Collegiate Baseball Writer's Association (NCBWA), erased an 11-3 deficit to tie things up at 13-13 before the Warhawks pushed across the winning run.

STREAKING WARHAWKS:

AUM's win over Georgia Southwestern marked its third consecutive victory. After a 1-4 start to the campaign, the Warhawks collected a 7-6 win over Embry-Riddle University in walk-off fashion before shutting down the Eagles 7-1 in the finale to take the series. AUM then walked-off the Hurricanes 14-13 in their last at-bat to steal the midweek win.

MIDWEEK EXTRAS:

Seven different Warhawks recorded a multi-hit game in the win against GSW, a season high for the team. The previous high had been five different players in the lineup with multiple hits as part of AUM's 13-3 win over Saint Leo University. The Warhawks also scored a season-high 14 runs and pounded out a season-high 20 hits. The 20 hits also mark the most in a game since a 17-13 win over Alabama Huntsville on March 20, 2022. Cooper Doughman registered the first five-hit game by a Warhawk since Caleb Beaver went 5-for-6 in that same game against UAH in 2022, and Kasey Clark posted the first five-RBI game of the year from an AUM player.

SCOUTING THE BLAZERS:

The Valdosta State University enters the weekend with a 4-1 overall record as they get set to host the Warhawks to open up the 2024 GSC slate at Billy Grant Field. Dennis Pierce leads the club with a .444 batting average, a triple, two home runs, and 10 RBIs. Pedro Moreno (.400), Jovanni Canegitta (.400), and Jacob Harper (.400) are also hitting .400 or better or VSU thus far. Moreno paces the team in doubles and runs, Canegitta's six runs are second, and Harper's five RBIs are second on the team. Hunter Booth leads VSU on the mound in relief, with a 1.69 ERA and a 2-0 record. He's logged 5.1 innings, allowed two hits, one earned run, and struck out five.

VALDOSTA'S GUILLIAMS STACKING WINS:

Valdosta State skipper Greg Guilliams, in his 34th year coaching collegiate baseball, ranks as the 10th-active winningest coach across any level of the NCAA. Guilliams, who began his college coaching career at NCAA Division III Pennsylvania State-Behrend in the 1991 season, also made a 16-year stop at then-NAIA Embry-Riddle University before taking over at Valdosta State ahead of the 2008 season. Guilliams sports a record of 477-304-1 with the Blazers. VSU finished 33-20 overall last year, earned the No. 4 seed in the conference tournament and fell to West Florida in the GSC title game, and earned a spot in the NCAA South Regional in Tampa, Fla.

NEWS & NOTES:

BUSH SNAGS FIRST COLLEGIATE VICTORY:

Behind a two-run home run from Tyrese Rooks and a 3-for-5 effort from Brendan York, the AUM baseball team defeated Saint Leo University 13-3 in the finale of a three-game series to wrap up the opening weekend of the 2024 season. The win marked the first victory as a collegiate head coach for AUM skipper Franklin Bush. Bush was selected to lead the Warhawks after spending the past six seasons at the University of Montevallo, most recently as Associate Head Coach and Recruiting Coordinator.

WALK-OFF WARHAWKS:

AUM has already posted a pair of walk-off wins in the 2024 campaign. A Cooper Doughman RBI single combined with an Embry-Riddle throwing error helped the Warhawks to a 7-6 win in game two of the three-game series. AUM then delivered a 14-13 walk-off win over Georgia Southwestern. Tied at 13-13, Frankland worked a one-out walk and Nick Freeman pinch-ran for him to start the AUM ninth. Doughman followed with an infield single, and Freeman advanced to third on a GSW throwing error. JC Tunnell reached first on a bunt single to load the bases, and Hayden Grier beat out a fielder's choice ground ball to break up a double play and seal the Warhawk win.

ROOKS SETTING THE TABLE:

Junior outfielder Tyrese Rooks is off to a hot start in his first season donning the black and orange. Rooks, a Mobile, Ala. native, has posted a team-high 12 runs and also ranks first among GSC players in that category. Rooks is getting on base 48 percent of the time for AUM (.475) through the team's first eight games and already has five multi-hit games, including three consecutive games with multiple hits.

MULTI-HIT & MULTI-RBI WARHAWKS:

Making his presence felt early at the top of the AUM lineup, Tyrese Rooks has five multi-hit games thus far this year, including a pair of three-hit games. Brendan York has posted four multi-hit efforts, while JC Tunnell, Nick Freeman, Zack Dew, Kasey Clark, and Cooper Doughman have all posted a pair of multi-hit games this year. Doughman and RH Frankland lead the way for the Warhawks with two multi-RBI games each.

EAVING THE YARD:

Five different Warhawks have hit a home run this season.

Rooks, Doughman, Dew, Clark, and Frankland have all hit round-trippers. Four of the dingers have been two-run homers, while Doughman has the only solo homer of the year for AUM.

TEAM LEADERS:

Offensively, Rooks leads the Warhawks in batting average (.412), at bats (34), runs (12), and hits (14). Clark's eight RBIs lead the team in that category, and Frankland, Dew, Ceman, and McWhorter each have two doubles on the season. Tunnell has three stolen bases, in three tries, to lead the team in that category. Dew and Clark have drawn three walks, and Doughman has been hit by three pitches this season. Pitts' two wins on the nmound are tops on the team, while Luke Turner has logged a team-high 10.2 innings. Clay Slagle has a team-best 11 strikeouts, and Lucas Baggett has not allowed an earned run in 5.1 innings of work.

SEC STATISTICAL RANKS:

Rooks ranks first in the GSC in runs scored (12), and also ranks fourth in total hits (14). He has also posted the second-most at bats in the league (34). Kasey Clark (3rd - 33) and Brendan York (8th - 32) also appear in the top 10 in at-bats. Zach Dew is also tied for second with his one triple. Brett Pitts ranks in a tie for first in the league in wins (2), and Clay Slagle ranks second in the GSC in batters struck out looking. Slagle also ranks ninth in opposing batting average (.200).

O CURRENT STREAKS:

Tyrese Rooks is riding a seven-game hitting streak for the Warhawks. Zach Dew has hit safely in his last five games, and Cooper Doughman has a four-game hitting streak. Doughman has reached base safely in six straight games, second on the team to Rooks, while Brendan York and RH Frankland have also reached base safely in six-straight games. Zach Dew and J Jackson Ceman have both reached base safely in five straight.

THREE NAMED TO GSC NEWCOMER WATCHLIST:

Tyrese Rooks, Ryan Slaten, and Brendan York were each named to the Gulf South Conference's Newcomer Watchlist ahead of the 2024 season. Rooks starred in the outfield at Bishop State Community College. he was an All-Conference selection in 2022 and posted a .362 batting average in 2023 with 13 doubles, one home run, and 21 runs batted in.

Slaten, a 6-foot-5 pitcher, played two seasons at Central Alabama Community College. He posted a 10-4 career record with five complete games in 20 starts. He logged 110 career innings and struck out 110 with a career 3.85 ERA. York appeared in 102 games across three seasons at Chattahoochee Valley Community College. York hit .289 in 44 games in 2023 at shortstop, and also hit .300 across 19 games in his debut collegiate season in 2021.

OULF SOUTH CONFERENCE PRESEASON POLL:

A season removed from going 19-31 with an 11-19 record in conference play to finish 10th, AUM was picked to finish 11th in this year's preseason coaches poll. The University of West Florida was picked to finish in the poll position, while Valdosta State University was picked to finish second. Lee University (third), the University of Montevallo (fourth), and the University of Alabama in Huntsville (fifth) rounded out the top five preseason poll vote-getters.

FRANKLIN BUSH OUICK BIO:

Director of Athletics Erik Maas announced the hiring of Franklin Bush as the head baseball coach at Auburn University at Montgomery on Wednesday, June 28th, 2023. Bush becomes just the third head coach in the baseball program's 37-year history, building on the foundation laid by Q.V. Lowe, who won more than 1,000 games from 1987 to 2014, and Marty Lovrich, who coached the Warhawks to 235 wins from 2015 to 2023.

"We are excited to welcome Franklin Bush as the new head coach of the Warhawk baseball program," said Maas. "AUM Baseball has great tradition and Franklin fits what we were looking for as someone who can develop a championship-level program on and off the field, while honoring that tradition. We are happy to bring Franklin and his family back home to Montgomery to lead this storied program," Maas exclaimed.

Bush comes to the capital city after spending the past six seasons at fellow GSC institution the University of Montevallo, most recently as Associate Head Coach and Recruiting Coordinator. The 2022 Alabama Baseball Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year, Bush helped lead Montevallo to second and third place finishes in the GSC the past two years (with a 75-31 overall record in that span), including an NCAA South Region tournament in 2023.

Bush was heavily involved in all aspects of the program for the Falcons, including on-field coaching, academic management, community involvement initiatives, and facility maintenance. Under his tutelage, the program produced two GSC Players of the Year, an NCBWA Player of the Year, six All-American selections, seven First Team All-GSC selections, five second team All-GSC selections, two College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-Americans, five CSC Academic All-District Honorees, three GSC All-Academic Team selections, and 50 Honor Roll recipients.

"Montgomery is where it all started for me," said Bush. "To come back home and serve as the head baseball coach [for Auburn University at Montgomery] is an absolute dream for me and my family. We are grateful to Chancellor Carl Stockton, Erik Maas, and the search committee for this opportunity. We look forward to working each and every day to build on the success of this baseball program and athletics department."

The baseball program found success both on and off the field, particularly in the classroom, as the program maintained a 3.0 cumulative GPA in each semester of his tenure at Montevallo. Bush served on a coaching staff that led the Falcons to a pair of NCAA South Region tournaments (2018 & 2023) and a pair of nationally ranked recruiting classes. The Falcons' 2019 recruiting class was ranked fourth nationally, and the squad's 2023 recruiting class was ranked 18th nationally. The program also produced a 19th-round pick in the MLB Draft in 2019, the second-highest draft pick in program history.

He also has held three different summer ball coaching positions in his career. Bush began as an assistant coach for the Wellsville Nitros in the New York Collegiate Baseball League in 2016 before taking the head coach position for the Newark Pilots of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League in 2017. Bush then served as head coach of the Madisonville Miners of the Ohio Valley League in Madisonville, Kentucky.

Bush holds a master's degree in Adult Education from Auburn University and a bachelor's degree in Sports Management from Blackburn College in Carlinville, Illinois.
