### ➔ SLAGLE'S GEM SETS THE TONE FOR SERIES WIN AGAINST VALDOSTA STATE:

Clay Slagle logged six strong innings with four strikeouts en route to his first win of the season as AUM beat RV Valdosta State 5-1 in the weekend opener. The Blazers, who were receiving votes in the NCBWA Top 25 poll, did not have an answer for Slagle, who did not allow a walk and scattered just four hits in his six frames. Slagle set down the first 10 Blazer hitters he faces, including a trio of strikeouts looking, and worked around a pair of hits allowed in the fourth frame. He gave up a hit in the fifth and a solo home run in the sixth before the bullpen took over and posted three scoreless frames to help Slagle grab his first win of the year.

### ➔ WARHAWKS SOAR PAST RV VALDOSTA STATE 15-4, TAKE SERIES FROM BLAZERS:

The Auburn University at Montgomery baseball team scored 11 runs on seven first-inning hits to set the tone for a 15-4 win in the weekend finale as the Warhawks secured a series win over Valdosta State University, who is receiving votes in the latest NCBWA Top 25 poll. All nine Warhawks scored at least one run, while seven Warhawks tallied at least one hit and at least one RBI. The AUM bullpen allowed just one run in 6.2 innings of relief on five hits. AUM also used a stellar game-one pitching performance from Clay Slagle to win the opening game of the series 5-1 to begin conference play. Slagle logged six strong innings with four strikeouts en route to his first win of the season. The AUM bullpen supported Slagle's start with three shutout innings of relief.

### ➔ MIDWEEK MORSELS:

The Warhawks fell 10-5 on Wednesday night to Gulf South Conference foe the University of Alabama in Huntsville in a non-conference midweek matchup. Ryan Slaten fired a fantastic five frames, as he allowed two runs on five hits with one walk against four strikeouts against the Chargers. Cooper Doughman and JC Tunnell each registered their fourth multi-hit game of the season in the loss. Tyrese Rooks saw his 10-game hitting streak come to an end, but was able to extend his reached base streak up to a team-high 11 games.

### ➔ SCOUTING THE CHOCTAWS:

The Mississippi College enters the second Gulf South Conference weekend of the season as one of the hottest teams in the South Region. The Choctaws have won six of their last seven games, and sponsor one of the top offenses in the league. The Choctaws are hitting .333 as a team, the top mark in the league, and rank second in runs (108) and second in hits (140). MC has also smashed a GSC-best 27 homers, nine more than the next closest team, and are slugging nearly .600 as a squad. Defensively, the Choctaws also sport the GSC's top fielding percentage with the fewest errors in the league. The maize and blue are ranked No. 5 in this week's NCBWA South Region Poll and are also receiving votes in the latest NCBWA Top 25 poll.

## NEWS &amp; NOTES:

## ➔ BUSH SNAGS FIRST COLLEGIATE VICTORY:

Behind a two-run home run from Tyrese Rooks and a 3-for-5 effort from Brendan York, the AUM baseball team defeated Saint Leo University 13-3 in the finale of a three-game series to wrap up the opening weekend of the 2024 season. The win marked the first victory as a collegiate head coach for AUM skipper Franklin Bush. Bush was selected to lead the Warhawks after spending the past six seasons at the University of Montevallo, most recently as Associate Head Coach and Recruiting Coordinator.

## ➔ WALK-OFF WARHAWKS:

AUM has already posted a pair of walk-off wins in the 2024 campaign. A Cooper Doughman RBI single combined with an Embry-Riddle throwing error helped the Warhawks to a 7-6 win in game two of the three-game series. AUM then delivered a 14-13 walk-off win over Georgia Southwestern. Tied at 13-13, Frankland worked a one-out walk and Nick Freeman pinch-ran for him to start the AUM ninth. Doughman followed with an infield single, and Freeman advanced to third on a GSW throwing error. JC Tunnell reached first on a bunt single to load the bases, and Hayden Grier beat out a fielder's choice ground ball to break up a double play and seal the Warhawk win.

## ➔ ROOKS SETTING THE TABLE:

Junior outfielder Tyrese Rooks is off to a hot start in his first season donning the black and orange. Rooks, a Mobile, Ala. native, has posted a team-high 14 runs and also ranks sixth among GSC players in that category. Rooks is getting on base 46 percent of the time for AUM (.468) through the team's first 12 games and already has seven multi-hit games, including multiple hits in six of his last nine games.

## ➔ MULTI-HIT &amp; MULTI-RBI WARHAWKS:

Making his presence felt early at the top of the AUM lineup, Tyrese Rooks has seven multi-hit games thus far this year, including a trio of three-hit games. Brendan York has posted five multi-hit efforts, while JC Tunnell and Cooper Doughman have posted four multi-hit games this season. Zack Dew has three multi-hit efforts, and Nick Freeman, Kasey Clark, and Jarren Wright all have two multi-hit games. Doughman leads the team with three multi-RBI games, while RH Frankland, Dew, Rooks, and York have two multi-RBI games each.

## ➔ LEAVING THE YARD:

Five different Warhawks have hit a home run this season. Rooks, Doughman, Dew, Clark, and Frankland have all hit round-trippers. Four of the dingers have been two-run homers, while Doughman has the only solo homer of the year for AUM.

## ➔ CURRENT STREAKS:

Tyrese Rooks had his 10-game hitting streak snapped in the midweek, but he owns the team's longest reached base streak at 11 games. Cooper Doughman has reached base safely in 10 straight games, while Kasey Clark has hit safely in his last seven. Jackson Ceman has a five-game hitting streak. Dew and York have reached base safely in nine straight games, while Frankland and Ceman have reached base safely in eight straight. Hayden Grier (5) and Jarren Wright (4) round out the current reached-base safely streaks for the Warhawks.

## ➔ GSC STATISTICAL RANKS:

Rooks is tied for third in the conference in runs scored (14), ranks sixth in total hits (20), and ranks seventh in at-bats (51). Zach Dew is tied for second with his one triple, and ranks second in sacrifice flies (2). Clay Slagle ranks fourth in the league in opposing batting average (.190) and ranks second in batters struck out looking (9). Lucas Baggett and Brett Pitts rank in a tie for second in the league in wins (2), and Baggett's one save ranks him in a tie for fifth in the league.

## ➔ TEAM LEADERS:

Offensively, Rooks leads the Warhawks in batting average (.392), at bats (51), runs (14), and hits (20). Cooper Doughman and Brendan York lead the team with nine RBIs, while Kasey Clark, Zach Dew, and Rooks are second with eight RBIs each. Dew leads the squad with four doubles on the year. Rooks and JC Tunnell have three stolen bases each to pace that category. Clark has drawn a team-high eight walks, while Clark, Doughman, and Jackson Ceman have been hit by three pitches this season. Brett Pitts and Lucas Baggett are tied for the team lead with two wins on the mound, and Baggett has the squad's only save. Clay Slagle and Luke Turner lead the team with 15.1 innings logged on the mound, while Slagle has 15 strikeouts. Baggett has not allowed an earned run in 8.0 innings of work, while Trey Bacon (3.1 innings) and Clay Weatherly (1.0 inning) have also yet to allow an earned run for the black and orange.

## ➔ THREE NAMED TO GSC NEWCOMER WATCHLIST:

Tyrese Rooks, Ryan Slaten, and Brendan York were each named to the Gulf South Conference's Newcomer Watchlist ahead of the 2024 season. Rooks starred in the outfield at Bishop State Community College. he was an All-Conference selection in 2022 and posted a .362 batting average in 2023 with 13 doubles, one home run, and 21 runs batted in. Slaten, a 6-foot-5 pitcher, played two seasons at Central Alabama Community College. He posted a 10-4 career record with five complete games in 20 starts. He logged 110 career innings and struck out 110 with a career 3.85 ERA. York appeared in 102 games across three seasons at Chattahoochee Valley Community College. York hit .289 in 44 games in 2023 at shortstop, and also hit .300 across 19 games in his debut collegiate season in 2021.

## ➔ GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE PRESEASON POLL:

A season removed from going 19-31 with an 11-19 record in conference play to finish 10th, AUM was picked to finish 11th in this year's preseason coaches poll. The University of West Florida was picked to finish in the poll position, while Valdosta State University was picked to finish second. Lee University (third), the University of Montevallo (fourth), and the University of Alabama in Huntsville (fifth) rounded out the top five preseason poll vote-getters.

## FRANKLIN BUSH

**HEAD COACH | 1st SEASON AT AUM | BLACKBURN (2014)**

### FRANKLIN BUSH QUICK BIO:

Director of Athletics Erik Maas announced the hiring of Franklin Bush as the head baseball coach at Auburn University at Montgomery on Wednesday, June 28th, 2023. Bush becomes just the third head coach in the baseball program's 37-year history, building on the foundation laid by Q.V. Lowe, who won more than 1,000 games from 1987 to 2014, and Marty Lovrich, who coached the Warhawks to 235 wins from 2015 to 2023.

"We are excited to welcome Franklin Bush as the new head coach of the Warhawk baseball program," said Maas. "AUM Baseball has great tradition and Franklin fits what we were looking for as someone who can develop a championship-level program on and off the field, while honoring that tradition. We are happy to bring Franklin and his family back home to Montgomery to lead this storied program," Maas exclaimed.

Bush comes to the capital city after spending the past six seasons at fellow GSC institution the University of Montevallo, most recently as Associate Head Coach and Recruiting Coordinator. The 2022 Alabama Baseball Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year, Bush helped lead Montevallo to second and third place finishes in the GSC the past two years (with a 75-31 overall record in that span), including an NCAA South Region tournament in 2023.

Bush was heavily involved in all aspects of the program for the Falcons, including on-field coaching, academic management, community involvement initiatives, and facility maintenance. Under his tutelage, the program produced two GSC Players of the Year, an NCBWA Player of the Year, six All-American selections, seven First Team All-GSC selections, five second team All-GSC selections, two College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-Americans, five CSC Academic All-District Honorees, three GSC All-Academic Team selections, and 50 Honor Roll recipients.

"Montgomery is where it all started for me," said Bush. "To come back home and serve as the head baseball coach [for Auburn University at Montgomery] is an absolute dream for me and my family. We are grateful to Chancellor Carl Stockton, Erik Maas, and the search committee for this opportunity. We look forward to working each and every day to build on the success of this baseball program and athletics department."

The baseball program found success both on and off the field, particularly in the classroom, as the program maintained a 3.0 cumulative GPA in each semester of his tenure at Montevallo. Bush served on a coaching staff that led the Falcons to a pair of NCAA South Region tournaments (2018 & 2023) and a pair of nationally ranked recruiting classes. The Falcons' 2019 recruiting class was ranked fourth nationally, and the squad's 2023 recruiting class was ranked 18th nationally. The program also produced a 19th-round pick in the MLB Draft in 2019, the second-highest draft pick in program history.

He also has held three different summer ball coaching positions in his career. Bush began as an assistant coach for the Wellsville Nitros in the New York Collegiate Baseball League in 2016 before taking the head coach position for the Newark Pilots of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League in 2017. Bush then served as head coach of the Madisonville Miners of the Ohio Valley League in Madisonville, Kentucky.

Bush holds a master's degree in Adult Education from Auburn University and a bachelor's degree in Sports Management from Blackburn College in Carlinville, Illinois.

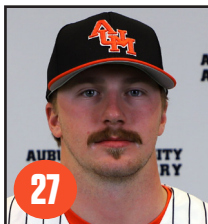

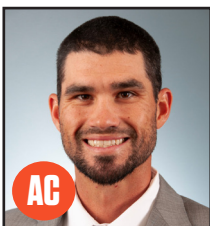
