#### ➔ WARHAWKS MEET NO. 1 UNG IN MIDWEEK CLASH

The Warhawks and North Georgia meet for the ninth time since 2020 and the Warhawks have won five of the last eight. AUM owns the all-time series 6-5 with the first meeting coming in 2017.

#### ➔ BAYNES LEADING AUM IN HITS

Sophomore outfielder Chloe Baynes is leading AUM in hits this season with 44. She owns a batting average of .518 and has one triple this season.

Kat Fallen has posted 32 RBIs this season and has tallied four homers including one this past weekend in the midweek against Shorter.

Auburn Montgomery is 7-1 in home games this season with back-to-back series wins against top 10 ranked teams including No. 6 Mississippi College and No. 13 West Alabama.
