#### ➔ BAYNES LEADING GSC IN HITS AND THIRD IN NCAA

Chloe Baynes is sitting in third in all of NCAA Division I-III in total hits at 54. She has 129 total in her career, after breaking AUM's single season record for hits last season with 75. She is on pace to break that record again as the Warhawks pass the midway point of the season with a 22-8 overall record and they sit at 11-4 in the Gulf South Conference. Baynes tallied two hits in last season's two games at Union University. Baynes and the Warhawks look to take down Union on Hall of Fame weekend at the AUM Softball Complex.

#### ➔ WARHAWKS AND LADY BULLDOGS CLASH IN GSC SERIES

The Warhawks and Lady Bulldogs meet in a GSC series at the AUM Softball Complex. Both teams are in the top four of the GSC standings entering the weekend.

#### ➔ BAYNES LEADING AUM IN HITS

Sophomore outfielder Chloe Baynes is leading AUM in hits this season with 54. She owns a batting average of .491 and has one triple and one double this season.

#### ➔ AUM'S PITCHING STAFF NUMBERS

The Warhawks pitching staff owns the fifth best ERA in the GSC at 3.92. AUM's Alanna Goble has a 2.53 ERA which is third best in the GSC.

#### ➔ KAT FALLEN LEADING AUM IN RBIS

Kat Fallen has continued to have a strong season as she is third in the GSC in runs batted in with a total of 42. She has 38 hits and hit seven homers this year.

#### ➔ MARTIN LEADING WARHAWKS IN HOMERS

Gia Martin has already broken AUM's home run record in a career this season and she is currently leading AUM with 11, which is seventh best in the GSC.

#### ➔ GOBLE EARNS THIRD GSC PITCHER OF THE WEEK HONORS

Alanna Goble took GSC Pitcher of the Week honors for the third time this season earlier this week. Last week she struck out 26 batters in the week and she did not appear in the midweek at Columbus State.

#### ➔ AUM AT HOME

Auburn Montgomery is 8-2 in home games this season with back-to-back series wins against top 10 ranked teams including No. 6 Mississippi College and No. 13 West Alabama. AUM also took a midweek victory against No. 1 North Georgia at home this season.
